reckoned after the 13 1CH 05 01 # Now the sons of Reuben the firstborn of Israel, [for he [was] the firstborn; but, forasmuch as he defiled his father's bed, his birthright was given unto the sons of Joseph the son of Israel: and the genealogy is not to be reckoned after the birthright.

reckoned among the 42 LUK 22 37 # For I say unto you, that this that is written must yet be accomplished in me, And he was reckoned among the transgressors: for the things concerning me have an end.

reckoned among the 04 NUM 23 09 # For from the top of the rocks I see him, and from the hills I behold him: lo, the people shall dwell alone, and shall not be reckoned among the nations.

reckoned by genealogies 13 1CH 05 17 # All these were reckoned by genealogies in the days of Jotham king of Judah, and in the days of Jeroboam king of Israel.

reckoned by genealogies 13 1CH 09 01 # So all Israel were reckoned by genealogies; and, behold, they [were] written in the book of the kings of Israel and Judah, [who] were carried away to Babylon for their transgression.

reckoned by genealogies 14 2CH 31 19 # Also of the sons of Aaron the priests, [which were] in the fields of the suburbs of their cities, in every several city, the men that were expressed by name, to give portions to all the males among the priests, and to all that were reckoned by genealogies among the Levites.

reckoned by genealogy 15 EZR 02 62 # These sought their register [among] those that were reckoned by genealogy, but they were not found: therefore were they, as polluted, put from the priesthood.

reckoned by genealogy 15 EZR 08 03 # Of the sons of Shechaniah, of the sons of Pharosh; Zechariah: and with him were reckoned by genealogy of the males an hundred and fifty.

reckoned by genealogy 16 NEH 07 05 # And my God put into mine heart to gather together the nobles, and the rulers, and the people, that they might be reckoned by genealogy. And I found a register of the genealogy of them which came up at the first, and found written therein,

reckoned by genealogy 16 NEH 07 64 # These sought their register [among] those that were reckoned by genealogy, but it was not found: therefore were they, as polluted, put from the priesthood.

reckoned by their 13 1CH 07 07 # And the sons of Bela; Ezbon, and Uzzi, and Uzziel, and Jerimoth, and Iri, five; heads of the house of [their] fathers, mighty men of valour; and were reckoned by their genealogies twenty and two thousand and thirty and four.

reckoned by their 13 1CH 09 22 # All these [which were] chosen to be porters in the gates [were] two hundred and twelve. These were reckoned by their genealogy in their villages, whom David and Samuel the seer did ordain in their set office.

reckoned in all 13 1CH 07 05# And their brethren among all the families of Issachar [were] valiant men of might, reckoned in all by their genealogies fourscore and seven thousand.

reckoned not with 12 2KI 12 15 # Moreover they reckoned not with the men, into whose hand they delivered the money to be bestowed on workmen: for they dealt faithfully.

reckoned of grace <u>45 ROM 04 04 </u># Now to him that worketh is the reward not reckoned of grace, but of debt.

reckoned till morning 23 ISA 38 13 # I reckoned till morning, [that], as a lion, so will he break all my bones: from day [even] to night wilt thou make an end of me.

reckoned to Abraham 45 ROM 04 09 # [Cometh] this blessedness then upon the circumcision [only], or upon the uncircumcision also? for we say that faith was reckoned to Abraham for righteousness.

reckoned to Benjamin 10 2SA 04 02 # And Saul's son had two men [that were] captains of bands: the name of the one [was] Baanah, and the name of the other Rechab, the sons of Rimmon a Beerothite, of the children of Benjamin: [for Beeroth also was reckoned to Benjamin.

reckoned unto you 04 NUM 18 27 # And [this] your heave offering shall be reckoned unto you, as though [it were] the corn of the threshingfloor, and as the fulness of the winepress.

reckoned up in 19 PSA 40 05 # Many, O LORD my God, [are] thy wonderful works [which] thou hast done, and thy thoughts [which are] to us ward: they cannot be reckoned up in order unto thee: [if] I would declare and speak [of them], they are more than can be numbered.

reckoned were the 13 1CH 05 07 # And his brethren by their families, when the genealogy of their generations was reckoned, [were] the chief, Jeiel, and Zechariah,

reckoned when he 45 ROM 04 10 # How was it then reckoned? when he was in circumcision, or in uncircumcision? Not in circumcision, but in uncircumcision.
