regard and wonder <u>35\_HAB\_01\_05</u># Behold ye among the heathen, and regard, and wonder marvellously: for [I] will work a work in your days, [which] ye will not believe, though it be told [you].

regard any god <u>27\_DAN\_11\_37</u># Neither shall he regard the God of his fathers, nor the desire of women, nor regard any god: for he shall magnify himself above all.

regard any ransom <u>20\_PRO\_06\_35</u># He will not regard any ransom; neither will he rest content, though thou givest many gifts.

regard because that <u>44\_ACT\_08\_11</u># And to him they had regard, because that of long time he had bewitched them with sorceries.

regard discretion and <u>20\_PRO\_05\_02</u> # That thou mayest regard discretion, and [that] thy lips may keep knowledge.

regard iniquity in <u>19\_PSA\_66\_18</u># If I regard iniquity in my heart, the Lord will not hear [me]:

regard it from <u>18\_JOB\_03\_04</u> # Let that day be darkness; let not God regard it from above, neither let the light shine upon it.

regard it He <u>45\_ROM\_14\_06</u># He that regardeth the day, regardeth [it] unto the Lord; and he that regardeth not the day, to the Lord he doth not regard [it]. He that eateth, eateth to the Lord, for he giveth God thanks; and he that eateth not, to the Lord he eateth not, and giveth God thanks.

regard it <u>09\_1SA\_04\_20</u> # And about the time of her death the women that stood by her said unto her, Fear not; for thou hast borne a son. But she answered not, neither did she regard [it].

regard it <u>18\_JOB\_35\_13</u> # Surely God will not hear vanity, neither will the Almighty regard it.

regard it <u>19\_PSA\_94\_07</u> # Yet they say, The LORD shall not see, neither shall the God of Jacob regard [it].

regard lying vanities <u>19\_PSA\_31\_06</u># I have hated them that regard lying vanities: but I trust in the LORD.

regard man <u>42\_LUK\_18\_04</u> # And he would not for a while: but afterward he said within himself, Though I fear not God, nor regard man;

regard not iniquity <u>18\_JOB\_36\_21</u> # Take heed, regard not iniquity: for this hast thou chosen rather than affliction.

regard not the <u>23\_ISA\_05\_12</u> # And the harp, and the viol, the tabret, and pipe, and wine, are in their feasts: but they regard not the work of the LORD, neither consider the operation of his hands.

regard not the <u>19\_PSA\_28\_05</u># Because they regard not the works of the LORD, nor the operation of his hands, he shall destroy them, and not build them up.

Regard not them <u>03\_LEV\_19\_31</u># Regard not them that have familiar spirits, neither seek after wizards, to be defiled by them: I [am] the LORD your God.

regard not this <u>10\_2SA\_13\_20</u> # And Absalom her brother said unto her, Hath Amnon thy brother been with thee? but hold now thy peace, my sister: he [is] thy brother; regard not this thing. So Tamar remained desolate in her brother Absalom's house.

regard not your <u>01\_GEN\_45\_20</u># Also regard not your stuff; for the good of all the land of Egypt [is] yours.

regard of the <u>21\_ECC\_08\_02</u> # I [counsel thee] to keep the king's commandment, and [that] in regard of the oath of God.

regard silver and <u>23\_ISA\_13\_17</u># Behold, I will stir up the Medes against them, which shall not regard silver; and [as for] gold, they shall not delight in it.

regard the God <u>27\_DAN\_11\_37</u># Neither shall he regard the God of his fathers, nor the desire of women, nor regard any god: for he shall magnify himself above all.

regard the peace <u>30\_AMO\_05\_22</u> # Though ye offer me burnt offerings and your meat offerings, I will not accept [them]: neither will I regard the peace offerings of your fat beasts.

regard the person <u>05\_DEU\_28\_50</u> # A nation of fierce countenance, which shall not regard the person of the old, nor show favour to the young:

regard the prayer <u>19\_PSA\_102\_17</u> # He will regard the prayer of the destitute, and not despise their prayer.

regard the presence <u>12\_2KI\_03\_14</u># And Elisha said, [As] the LORD of hosts liveth, before whom I stand, surely, were it not that I regard the presence of Jehoshaphat the king of Judah, I would not look toward thee, nor see thee.

regard them they <u>25\_LAM\_04\_16</u># The anger of the LORD hath divided them; he will no more regard them: they respected not the persons of the priests, they favoured not the elders.

regard this man <u>09\_1SA\_25\_25</u># Let not my lord, I pray thee, regard this man of Belial, [even] Nabal: for as his name [is], so [is] he; Nabal [is] his name, and folly [is] with him: but I thine handmaid saw not the young men of my lord, whom thou didst send.

regard vain words <u>02\_EXO\_05\_09</u> # Let there more work be laid upon the men, that they may labour therein; and let them not regard vain words.

regard your persons <u>39\_MAL\_01\_09</u># And now, I pray you, beseech God that he will be gracious unto us: this hath been by your means: will he regard your persons? saith the LORD of hosts.

regarded man <u>42\_LUK\_18\_02</u> # Saying, There was in a city a judge, which feared not God, neither regarded man:

regarded me according <u>13\_1CH\_17\_17</u> # And [yet] this was a small thing in thine eyes, O God; for thou hast [also] spoken of thy servant's house for a great while to come, and hast regarded me according to the estate of a man of high degree, O LORD God.

regarded not the <u>02\_EXO\_09\_21</u># And he that regarded not the word of the LORD left his servants and his cattle in the field.

regarded the low <u>42\_LUK\_01\_48</u> # For he hath regarded the low estate of his handmaiden: for, behold, from henceforth all generations shall call me blessed.

regarded thee they <u>27\_DAN\_03\_12</u> # There are certain Jews whom thou hast set over the affairs of the province of Babylon, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego; these men, O king, have not regarded thee: they serve not thy gods, nor worship the golden image which thou hast set up.

regarded their affliction <u>19\_PSA\_106\_44</u> # Nevertheless he regarded their affliction, when he heard their cry:

regarded them not <u>58\_HEB\_08\_09</u> # Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; because they continued not in my covenant, and I regarded them not, saith the Lord.

regarded <u>11\_1KI\_18\_29</u># And it came to pass, when midday was past, and they prophesied until the [time] of the offering of the [evening] sacrifice, that [there was] neither voice, nor any to answer, nor any that regarded.

regarded <u>20\_PRO\_01\_24</u># Because I have called, and ye refused; I have stretched out my hand, and no man regarded;

regardest me not <u>18\_JOB\_30\_20</u> # I cry unto thee, and thou dost not hear me: I stand up, and thou regardest me [not].

regardest neither princes <u>10\_2SA\_19\_06</u># In that thou lovest thine enemies, and hatest thy friends. For thou hast declared this day, that thou regardest neither princes nor servants: for this day I perceive, that if Absalom had lived, and all we had died this day, then it had pleased thee well.

regardest not the <u>41\_MAR\_12\_14</u> # And when they were come, they say unto him, Master, we know that thou art true, and carest for no man: for thou regardest not the person of men, but teachest the way of God in truth: Is it lawful to give tribute to Caesar, or not?

regardest not the <u>40\_MAT\_22\_16</u># And they sent out unto him their disciples with the Herodians, saying, Master, we know that thou art true, and teachest the way of God in truth, neither carest thou for any [man]: for thou regardest not the person of men.

regardeth and there <u>21\_ECC\_05\_08</u># If thou seest the oppression of the poor, and violent perverting of judgment and justice in a province, marvel not at the matter: for [he that is] higher than the highest regardeth; and [there be] higher than they.

regardeth he the <u>18\_JOB\_39\_07</u> # He scorneth the multitude of the city, neither regardeth he the crying of the driver.

regardeth it unto <u>45\_ROM\_14\_06</u> # He that regardeth the day, regardeth [it] unto the Lord; and he that regardeth not the day, to the Lord he doth not regard [it]. He that eateth, eateth to the Lord, for he giveth God thanks; and he that eateth not, to the Lord he eateth not, and giveth God thanks.

regardeth no man 23\_ISA\_33\_08 # The highways lie waste, the wayfaring man ceaseth: he hath broken the covenant, he hath despised the cities, he regardeth no man.

regardeth not persons <u>05\_DEU\_10\_17</u># For the LORD your God [is] God of gods, and Lord of lords, a great God, a mighty, and a terrible, which regardeth not persons, nor taketh reward:

regardeth not the <u>39\_MAL\_02\_13</u> # And this have ye done again, covering the altar of the LORD with tears, with weeping, and with crying out, insomuch that he regardeth not the offering any more, or receiveth [it] with good will at your hand.

regardeth reproof shall <u>20\_PRO\_13\_18</u># Poverty and shame [shall be to] him that refuseth instruction: but he that regardeth reproof shall be honoured.

regardeth the clouds <u>21\_ECC\_11\_04</u># He that observeth the wind shall not sow; and he that regardeth the clouds shall not reap.

regardeth the day <u>45\_ROM\_14\_06</u> # He that regardeth the day, regardeth [it] unto the Lord; and he that regardeth not the day, to the Lord he doth not regard [it]. He that eateth, eateth to the Lord, for he giveth God thanks; and he that eateth not, to the Lord he eateth not, and giveth God thanks.

regardeth the life <u>20\_PRO\_12\_10</u># A righteous [man] regardeth the life of his beast: but the tender mercies of the wicked [are] cruel.

regardeth the rich <u>18\_JOB\_34\_19</u># [How much less to him] that accepteth not the persons of princes, nor regardeth the rich more than the poor? for they all [are] the work of his hands.

regarding his life <u>50\_PHP\_02\_30</u># Because for the work of Christ he was nigh unto death, not regarding his life, to supply your lack of service toward me.

regarding it <u>18\_JOB\_04\_20</u># They are destroyed from morning to evening: they perish for ever without any regarding [it].
