current money with [01\\_GEN\\_23\\_16](#) # And Abraham hearkened unto Ephron; and Abraham weighed to Ephron the silver, which he had named in the audience of the sons of Heth, four hundred shekels of silver, current [money] with the merchant.

occurrent [11\\_1KI\\_05\\_04](#) # But now the LORD my God hath given me rest on every side, [so that there is] neither adversary nor evil occurrent.

parents and brethren [42\\_LUK\\_21\\_16](#) # And ye shall be betrayed both by parents, and brethren, and kinsfolks, and friends; and [some] of you shall they cause to be put to death.

parents unthankful unholy [55 2TI 03 02](#) # For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy,

parents went to [42 LUK 02 41](#) # Now his parents went to Jerusalem every year at the feast of the passover.

parents were astonished [42 LUK 08 56](#) # And her parents were astonished: but he charged them that they should tell no man what was done.

parents [45 ROM 01 30](#) # Backbiters, haters of God, spiteful, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents,

rent a kid [07 JUD 14 06](#) # And the spirit of the LORD came mightily upon him, and he rent him as he would have rent a kid, and [he had] nothing in his hand: but he told not his father or his mother what he had done.

rent and bound [06 JOS 09 04](#) # They did work wilily, and went and made as if they had been ambassadors, and took old sacks upon their asses, and wine bottles, old, and rent, and bound up;
