repented according to [19 PSA 106 45](#) # And he remembered for them his covenant, and repented according to the multitude of his mercies.

repented and after [24 JER 31 19](#) # Surely after that I was turned, I repented; and after that I was instructed, I smote upon [my] thigh: I was ashamed, yea, even confounded, because I did bear the reproach of my youth.

repented and went [40 MAT 21 29](#) # He answered and said, I will not: but afterward he repented, and went.

repented at the [42 LUK 11 32](#) # The men of Nineve shall rise up in the judgment with this generation, and shall condemn it: for they repented at the preaching of Jonas; and, behold, a greater than Jonas [is] here.

repented at the [40 MAT 12 41](#) # The men of Nineveh shall rise in judgment with this generation, and shall condemn it: because they repented at the preaching of Jonas; and, behold, a greater than Jonas [is] here.

repented for this [30 AMO 07 03](#) # The LORD repented for this: It shall not be, saith the LORD.

repented for this [30 AMO 07 06](#) # The LORD repented for this: This also shall not be, saith the Lord GOD.

repented him of [13 1CH 21 15](#) # And God sent an angel unto Jerusalem to destroy it: and as he was destroying, the LORD beheld, and he repented him of the evil, and said to the angel that destroyed, It is enough, stay now thine hand. And the angel of the LORD stood by the threshingfloor of Ornan the Jebusite.

repented him of [10 2SA 24 16](#) # And when the angel stretched out his hand upon Jerusalem to destroy it, the LORD repented him of the evil, and said to the angel that destroyed the people, It is enough: stay now thine hand. And the angel of the LORD was by the threshingplace of Araunah the Jebusite.

repented him of [24 JER 08 06](#) # I hearkened and heard, [but] they spake not aright: no man repented him of his wickedness, saying, What have I done? every one turned to his course, as the horse rusheth into the battle.

repented him of [24 JER 26 19](#) # Did Hezekiah king of Judah and all Judah put him at all to death? did he not fear the LORD, and besought the LORD, and the LORD repented him of the evil which he had pronounced against them? Thus might we procure great evil against our souls.

repented himself and [40 MAT 27 03](#) # Then Judas, which had betrayed him, when he saw that he was condemned, repented himself, and brought again the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders,

repented long ago [40 MAT 11 21](#) # Woe unto thee, Chorazin! woe unto thee, Bethsaida! for if the mighty works, which were done in you, had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago in sackcloth and ashes.

repented not afterward [40 MAT 21 32](#) # For John came unto you in the way of righteousness, and ye believed him not: but the publicans and the harlots believed him: and ye, when ye had seen [it], repented not afterward, that ye might believe him.

repented not and [24 JER 20 16](#) # And let that man be as the cities which the LORD overthrew, and repented not: and let him hear the cry in the morning, and the shouting at noontide;

repented not of [66 REV 09 20](#) # And the rest of the men which were not killed by these plagues yet repented not of the works of their hands, that they should not worship devils, and idols of gold, and silver, and brass, and stone, and of wood: which neither can see, nor hear, nor walk:

repented not of [66 REV 16 11](#) # And blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores, and repented not of their deeds.

repented not to [66 REV 16 09](#) # And men were scorched with great heat, and blasphemed the name of God, which hath power over these plagues: and they repented not to give him glory.

repented not [40 MAT 11 20](#) # Then began he to upbraid the cities wherein most of his mighty works were done, because they repented not:

repented not [66 REV 02 21](#) # And I gave her space to repent of her fornication; and she repented not.

repented not [38 ZEC 08 14](#) # For thus saith the LORD of hosts; As I thought to punish you, when your fathers provoked me to wrath, saith the LORD of hosts, and I repented not:

repented of but [47 2CO 07 10](#) # For godly sorrow worketh repentance to salvation not to be repented of: but the sorrow of the world worketh death.

repented of the [47 2CO 12 21](#) # [And] lest, when I come again, my God will humble me among you, and [that] I shall bewail many which have sinned already, and have not repented of the uncleanness and fornication and lasciviousness which they have committed.

repented of the [02 EXO 32 14](#) # And the LORD repented of the evil which he thought to do unto his people.

repented of the [32 JON 03 10](#) # And God saw their works, that they turned from their evil way; and God repented of the evil, that he had said that he would do unto them; and he did [it] not.

repented sitting in [42 LUK 10 13](#) # Woe unto thee, Chorazin! woe unto thee, Bethsaida! for if the mighty works had been done in Tyre and Sidon, which have been done in you, they had a great while ago repented, sitting in sackcloth and ashes.

repented that he [09 ISA 15 35](#) # And Samuel came no more to see Saul until the day of his death: nevertheless Samuel mourned for Saul: and the LORD repented that he had made Saul king over Israel.

repented the LORD [01 GEN 06 06](#) # And it repented the LORD that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him at his heart.

repented the LORD [07 JUD 02 18](#) # And when the LORD raised them up judges, then the LORD was with the judge, and delivered them out of the hand of their enemies all the days of the judge: for it repented the LORD because of their groanings by reason of them that oppressed them and vexed them.

repented them for [07 JUD 21 06](#) # And the children of Israel repented them for Benjamin their brother, and said, There is one tribe cut off from Israel this day.

repented them for [07 JUD 21 15](#) # And the people repented them for Benjamin, because that the LORD had made a breach in the tribes of Israel.
