reprove after the [23 ISA 11 03](#) # And shall make him of quick understanding in the fear of the LORD: and he shall not judge after the sight of his eyes, neither reprove after the hearing of his ears:

reprove another for [28 HOS 04 04](#) # Yet let no man strive, nor reprove another: for thy people [are] as they that strive with the priest.

reprove me it [19 PSA 141 05](#) # Let the righteous smite me; [it shall be] a kindness: and let him reprove me; [it shall be] an excellent oil, [which] shall not break my head: for yet my prayer also [shall be] in their calamities.
