

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

rescue him <u>28\_HOS\_05\_14</u># For I [will be] unto Ephraim as a lion, and as a young lion to the house of Judah: I, [even] I, will tear and go away; I will take away, and none shall rescue [him].

rescue my soul <u>19\_PSA\_35\_17</u># Lord, how long wilt thou look on? rescue my soul from their destructions, my darling from the lions.

rescue them <u>05\_DEU\_28\_31</u> # Thine ox [shall be] slain before thine eyes, and thou shalt not eat thereof: thine ass [shall be] violently taken away from before thy face, and shall not be restored to thee: thy sheep [shall be] given unto thine enemies, and thou shalt have none to rescue [them].

rescued him having <u>44\_ACT\_23\_27</u> # This man was taken of the Jews, and should have been killed of them: then came I with an army, and rescued him, having understood that he was a Roman.

rescued his two <u>09\_1SA\_30\_18</u># And David recovered all that the Amalekites had carried away: and David rescued his two wives.

rescued Jonathan that <u>09\_1SA\_14\_45</u> # And the people said unto Saul, Shall Jonathan die, who hath wrought this great salvation in Israel? God forbid: [as] the LORD liveth, there shall not one hair of his head fall to the ground; for he hath wrought with God this day. So the people rescued Jonathan, that he died not.

rescueth and he <u>27\_DAN\_06\_27</u># He delivereth and rescueth, and he worketh signs and wonders in heaven and in earth, who hath delivered Daniel from the power of the lions.
