arise a matter <u>05\_DEU\_17\_08</u># If there arise a matter too hard for thee in judgment, between blood and blood, between plea and plea, and between stroke and stroke, [being] matters of controversy within thy gates: then shalt thou arise, and get thee up into the place which the LORD thy God shall choose;

arise after them <u>01\_GEN\_41\_30</u> # And there shall arise after them seven years of famine; and all the plenty shall be forgotten in the land of Egypt; and the famine shall consume the land;

arise against the <u>23\_ISA\_31\_02</u> # Yet he also [is] wise, and will bring evil, and will not call back his words: but will arise against the house of the evildoers, and against the help of them that work iniquity.

arise among thy <u>28\_HOS\_10\_14</u># Therefore shall a tumult arise among thy people, and all thy fortresses shall be spoiled, as Shalman spoiled Betharbel in the day of battle: the mother was dashed in pieces upon [her] children.

arise among you <u>05\_DEU\_13\_01</u># If there arise among you a prophet, or a dreamer of dreams, and giveth thee a sign or a wonder,

arise and another <u>27\_DAN\_07\_24</u> # And the ten horns out of this kingdom [are] ten kings [that] shall arise: and another shall rise after them; and he shall be diverse from the first, and he shall subdue three kings.

arise and be <u>44\_ACT\_22\_16</u> # And now why tarriest thou? arise, and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord.

Arise and be <u>40\_MAT\_17\_07</u># And Jesus came and touched them, and said, Arise, and be not afraid.

arise and build <u>16\_NEH\_02\_20</u> # Then answered I them, and said unto them, The God of heaven, he will prosper us; therefore we his servants will arise and build: but ye have no portion, nor right, nor memorial, in Jerusalem.

arise and declare <u>19\_PSA\_78\_06</u># That the generation to come might know [them, even] the children [which] should be born; [who] should arise and declare [them] to their children:

Arise and eat <u>11\_1KI\_19\_05</u># And as he lay and slept under a juniper tree, behold, then an angel touched him, and said unto him, Arise [and] eat.

Arise and eat <u>11\_1KI\_19\_07</u> # And the angel of the LORD came again the second time, and touched him, and said, Arise [and] eat; because the journey [is] too great for thee.

arise and eat <u>11\_1KI\_21\_07</u># And Jezebel his wife said unto him, Dost thou now govern the kingdom of Israel? arise, [and] eat bread, and let thine heart be merry: I will give thee the vineyard of Naboth the Jezreelite.

arise and eat <u>01\_GEN\_27\_31</u># And he also had made savoury meat, and brought it unto his father, and said unto his father, Let my father arise, and eat of his son's venison, that thy soul may bless me.

Arise and go <u>44\_ACT\_22\_10</u> # And I said, What shall I do, Lord? And the Lord said unto me, Arise, and go into Damascus; and there it shall be told thee of all things which are appointed for thee to do.

arise and go <u>01\_GEN\_35\_03</u> # And let us arise, and go up to Bethel; and I will make there an altar unto God, who answered me in the day of my distress, and was with me in the way which I went.

arise and go <u>01\_GEN\_43\_08</u> # And Judah said unto Israel his father, Send the lad with me, and we will arise and go; that we may live, and not die, both we, and thou, [and] also our little ones.

Arise and go <u>24\_JER\_18\_02</u> # Arise, and go down to the potter's house, and there I will cause thee to hear my words.

arise and go <u>42\_LUK\_15\_18</u># I will arise and go to my father, and will say unto him, Father, I have sinned against heaven, and before thee,

arise and have <u>19\_PSA\_102\_13</u> # Thou shalt arise, [and] have mercy upon Zion: for the time to favour her, yea, the set time, is come.

arise and he <u>10\_2SA\_11\_20</u># And if so be that the king's wrath arise, and he say unto thee, Wherefore approached ye so nigh unto the city when ye did fight? knew ye not that they would shoot from the wall?

Arise and let <u>10\_28A\_15\_14</u># And David said unto all his servants that [were] with him at Jerusalem, Arise, and let us flee; for we shall not [else] escape from Absalom: make speed to depart, lest he overtake us suddenly, and bring evil upon us, and smite the city with the edge of the sword.

arise and let <u>24\_JER\_06\_04</u># Prepare ye war against her; arise, and let us go up at noon. Woe unto us! for the day goeth away, for the shadows of the evening are stretched out.

Arise and let <u>24\_JER\_06\_05</u> # Arise, and let us go by night, and let us destroy her palaces.

Arise and let <u>24\_JER\_46\_16</u># He made many to fall, yea, one fell upon another: and they said, Arise, and let us go again to our own people, and to the land of our nativity, from the oppressing sword.

arise and make <u>44\_ACT\_09\_34</u> # And Peter said unto him, AEneas, Jesus Christ maketh thee whole: arise, and make thy bed. And he arose immediately.

Arise and pass <u>10\_2SA\_17\_21</u># And it came to pass, after they were departed, that they came up out of the

well, and went and told king David, and said unto David, Arise, and pass quickly over the water: for thus hath Ahithophel counselled against you.

arise and play <u>10\_2SA\_02\_14</u># And Abner said to Joab, Let the young men now arise, and play before us. And Joab said, Let them arise.

arise and praise <u>19\_PSA\_88\_10</u> # Wilt thou show wonders to the dead? shall the dead arise [and] praise thee? Selah.

arise and pursue <u>10\_2SA\_17\_01</u># Moreover Ahithophel said unto Absalom, Let me now choose out twelve thousand men, and I will arise and pursue after David this night:

Arise and save <u>24\_JER\_02\_27</u> # Saying to a stock, Thou [art] my father; and to a stone, Thou hast brought me forth: for they have turned [their] back unto me, and not [their] face: but in the time of their trouble they will say, Arise, and save us.

arise And she <u>44\_ACT\_09\_40</u> # But Peter put them all forth, and kneeled down, and prayed; and turning [him] to the body said, Tabitha, arise. And she opened her eyes: and when she saw Peter, she sat up.

arise and sit <u>23\_ISA\_52\_02</u> # Shake thyself from the dust; arise, [and] sit down, O Jerusalem: loose thyself from the bands of thy neck, O captive daughter of Zion.

arise and speak <u>24\_JER\_01\_17</u># Thou therefore gird up thy loins, and arise, and speak unto them all that I command thee: be not dismayed at their faces, lest I confound thee before them.

Arise and take <u>42\_LUK\_05\_24</u> # But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power upon earth to forgive sins, [he said unto the sick of the palsy,] I say unto thee, Arise, and take up thy couch, and go into thine house.

Arise and take <u>41\_MAR\_02\_09</u># Whether is it easier to say to the sick of the palsy, [Thy] sins be forgiven thee; or to say, Arise, and take up thy bed, and walk?

Arise and take <u>41\_MAR\_02\_11</u># I say unto thee, Arise, and take up thy bed, and go thy way into thine house.

Arise and take <u>40\_MAT\_02\_13</u># And when they were departed, behold, the angel of the Lord appeareth to Joseph in a dream, saying, Arise, and take the young child and his mother, and flee into Egypt, and be thou there until I bring thee word: for Herod will seek the young child to destroy him.

Arise and take <u>40\_MAT\_02\_20</u># Saying, Arise, and take the young child and his mother, and go into the land of Israel: for they are dead which sought the young child's life.

arise and the <u>18\_JOB\_07\_04</u> # When I lie down, I say, When shall I arise, and the night be gone? and I am full of tossings to and fro unto the dawning of the day.

Arise and thresh <u>33\_MIC\_04\_13</u> # Arise and thresh, O daughter of Zion: for I will make thine horn iron, and I will make thy hoofs brass: and thou shalt beat in pieces many people: and I will consecrate their gain unto the LORD, and their substance unto the Lord of the whole earth.

Arise and walk <u>40\_MAT\_09\_05</u># For whether is easier, to say, [Thy] sins be forgiven thee; or to say, Arise, and walk?

Arise anoint him <u>09\_1SA\_16\_12</u> # And he sent, and brought him in. Now he [was] ruddy, [and] withal of a beautiful countenance, and goodly to look to. And the LORD said, Arise, anoint him: for this [is] he.

arise another kingdom <u>27\_DAN\_02\_39</u># And after thee shall arise another kingdom inferior to thee, and another third kingdom of brass, which shall bear rule over all the earth.

arise Awake and 23\_ISA\_26\_19 # Thy dead [men] shall live, [together with] my dead body shall they arise. Awake and sing, ye that dwell in dust: for thy dew [is as] the dew of herbs, and the earth shall cast out the dead.

arise Barak and <u>07\_JUD\_05\_12</u># Awake, awake, Deborah: awake, awake, utter a song: arise, Barak, and lead thy captivity captive, thou son of Abinoam.

Arise be gone <u>10\_28A\_13\_15</u># Then Amnon hated her exceedingly; so that the hatred wherewith he hated her [was] greater than the love wherewith he had loved her. And Amnon said unto her, Arise, be gone.

arise call upon <u>32\_JON\_01\_06</u># So the shipmaster came to him, and said unto him, What meanest thou, O sleeper? arise, call upon thy God, if so be that God will think upon us, that we perish not.

arise cast us <u>19\_PSA\_44\_23</u> # Awake, why sleepest thou, O Lord? arise, cast [us] not off for ever.

Arise contend thou <u>33\_MIC\_06\_01</u># Hear ye now what the LORD saith; Arise, contend thou before the mountains, and let the hills hear thy voice.

Arise cry out <u>25\_LAM\_02\_19</u> # Arise, cry out in the night: in the beginning of the watches pour out thine heart like water before the face of the Lord: lift up thy hands toward him for the life of thy young children, that faint for hunger in the top of every street.

Arise devour much <u>27\_DAN\_07\_05</u> # And behold another beast, a second, like to a bear, and it raised up itself on one side, and [it had] three ribs in the mouth of it between the teeth of it: and they said thus unto it, Arise, devour much flesh.

arise false Christs <u>40\_MAT\_24\_24</u># For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall show great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if [it were] possible, they shall deceive the very elect.

arise flee thou <u>01\_GEN\_27\_43</u># Now therefore, my son, obey my voice; and arise, flee thou to Laban my brother to Haran;

arise for he <u>30\_AMO\_07\_02</u> # And it came to pass, [that] when they had made an end of eating the grass of the land, then I said, O Lord GOD, forgive, I beseech thee: by whom shall Jacob arise? for he [is] small.

arise for he <u>30\_AMO\_07\_05</u># Then said I, O Lord GOD, cease, I beseech thee: by whom shall Jacob arise? for he [is] small.

Arise for our <u>19\_PSA\_44\_26</u> # Arise for our help, and redeem us for thy mercies' sake.

Arise for the <u>07\_JUD\_07\_15</u> # And it was [so], when Gideon heard the telling of the dream, and the interpretation thereof, that he worshipped, and returned into the host of Israel, and said, Arise; for the LORD hath delivered into your hand the host of Midian.

Arise for this <u>15\_EZR\_10\_04</u> # Arise; for [this] matter [belongeth] unto thee: we also [will be] with thee: be of good courage, and do [it].

arise from the <u>49\_EPH\_05\_14</u># Wherefore he saith, Awake thou that sleepest, and arise from the dead, and Christ shall give thee light.

Arise get thee <u>11\_1KI\_17\_09</u># Arise, get thee to Zarephath, which [belongeth] to Zidon, and dwell there: behold, I have commanded a widow woman there to sustain thee.

Arise get thee <u>05\_DEU\_09\_12</u># And the LORD said unto me, Arise, get thee down quickly from hence; for thy people which thou hast brought forth out of Egypt have corrupted [themselves]; they are quickly turned aside out of the way which I commanded them; they have made them a molten image.

arise get thee <u>01\_GEN\_31\_13</u># I [am] the God of Bethel, where thou anointedst the pillar, [and] where thou vowedst a vow unto me: now arise, get thee out from this land, and return unto the land of thy kindred.

Arise get thee <u>07\_JUD\_07\_09</u># And it came to pass the same night, that the LORD said unto him, Arise, get thee down unto the host; for I have delivered it into thine hand.

Arise get you <u>24\_JER\_49\_31</u># Arise, get you up unto the wealthy nation, that dwelleth without care, saith the LORD, which have neither gates nor bars, [which] dwell alone.

arise go again <u>01\_GEN\_43\_13</u> # Take also your brother, and arise, go again unto the man:

Arise go down <u>11\_1KI\_21\_18</u># Arise, go down to meet Ahab king of Israel, which [is] in Samaria: behold, [he is] in the vineyard of Naboth, whither he is gone down to possess it.

Arise go down <u>09\_1SA\_23\_04</u> # Then David inquired of the LORD yet again. And the LORD answered him and said, Arise, go down to Keilah: for I will deliver the Philistines into thine hand.

arise go forth <u>10\_2SA\_19\_07</u> # Now therefore arise, go forth, and speak comfortably unto thy servants: for I swear by the LORD, if thou go not forth, there will not tarry one with thee this night: and that will be worse unto thee than all the evil that befell thee from thy youth until now.

Arise go forth <u>26\_EZE\_03\_22</u> # And the hand of the LORD was there upon me; and he said unto me, Arise, go forth into the plain, and I will there talk with thee.

arise go over <u>06\_JOS\_01\_02</u># Moses my servant is dead; now therefore arise, go over this Jordan, thou, and all this people, unto the land which I do give to them, [even] to the children of Israel.

arise go seek <u>09\_1SA\_09\_03</u># And the asses of Kish Saul's father were lost. And Kish said to Saul his son, Take now one of the servants with thee, and arise, go seek the asses.

Arise go thy <u>42\_LUK\_17\_19</u># And he said unto him, Arise, go thy way: thy faith hath made thee whole.

Arise go to <u>01\_GEN\_28\_02</u># Arise, go to Padanaram, to the house of Bethuel thy mother's father; and take thee a wife from thence of the daughters of Laban thy mother's brother.

arise go to <u>24\_JER\_13\_04</u># Take the girdle that thou hast got, which [is] upon thy loins, and arise, go to Euphrates, and hide it there in a hole of the rock.

Arise go to <u>24\_JER\_13\_06</u> # And it came to pass after many days, that the LORD said unto me, Arise, go to Euphrates, and take the girdle from thence, which I commanded thee to hide there.

Arise go to <u>32\_JON\_01\_02</u># Arise, go to Nineveh, that great city, and cry against it; for their wickedness is come up before me.

Arise go unto <u>32\_JON\_03\_02</u># Arise, go unto Nineveh, that great city, and preach unto it the preaching that I bid thee.

Arise go up <u>12\_2KI\_01\_03</u> # But the angel of the LORD said to Elijah the Tishbite, Arise, go up to meet the messengers of the king of Samaria, and say unto them, [Is it] not because [there is] not a God in Israel, [that] ye go to inquire of Baalzebub the god of Ekron?

Arise go up <u>01\_GEN\_35\_01</u> # And God said unto Jacob, Arise, go up to Bethel, and dwell there: and make there an altar unto God, that appeared unto thee when thou fleddest from the face of Esau thy brother.

arise go up <u>06\_JOS\_08\_01</u> # And the LORD said unto Joshua, Fear not, neither be thou dismayed: take all the people of war with thee, and arise, go up to Ai: see, I have given into thy hand the king of Ai, and his people, and his city, and his land:

Arise I pray <u>11\_1KI\_14\_02</u># And Jeroboam said to his wife, Arise, I pray thee, and disguise thyself, that thou be not known to be the wife of Jeroboam; and get thee to Shiloh: behold, there [is] Ahijah the prophet, which told me that [I should be] king over this people.

arise I pray <u>01\_GEN\_27\_19</u># And Jacob said unto his father, I [am] Esau thy firstborn; I have done according as thou badest me: arise, I pray thee, sit and eat of my venison, that thy soul may bless me.

arise if they <u>24\_JER\_02\_28</u> # But where [are] thy gods that thou hast made thee? let them arise, if they can save thee in the time of thy trouble: for [according to] the number of thy cities are thy gods, O Judah.

arise in your <u>61\_2PE\_01\_19</u># We have also a more sure word of prophecy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as unto a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts:

arise in your <u>42\_LUK\_24\_38</u># And he said unto them, Why are ye troubled? and why do thoughts arise in your hearts?

Arise it shall <u>35\_HAB\_02\_19</u> # Woe unto him that saith to the wood, Awake; to the dumb stone, Arise, it shall teach! Behold, it [is] laid over with gold and silver, and [there is] no breath at all in the midst of it.

arise let his <u>19\_PSA\_68\_01</u># To the chief Musician, A Psalm [or] Song of David. Let God arise, let his enemies be scattered: let them also that hate him flee before him.

arise let them <u>19\_PSA\_109\_28</u># Let them curse, but bless thou: when they arise, let them be ashamed; but let thy servant rejoice.

Arise let us <u>43\_JOH\_14\_31</u> # But that the world may know that I love the Father; and as the Father gave me commandment, even so I do. Arise, let us go hence.

Arise lift up <u>01\_GEN\_21\_18</u># Arise, lift up the lad, and hold him in thine hand; for I will make him a great nation.

arise like unto <u>11\_1KI\_03\_12</u># Behold, I have done according to thy words: lo, I have given thee a wise and an understanding heart; so that there was none like thee before thee, neither after thee shall any arise like unto thee.

Arise my love <u>22\_SON\_02\_13</u># The fig tree putteth forth her green figs, and the vines [with] the tender grape give a [good] smell. Arise, my love, my fair one, and come away.

Arise O God <u>19\_PSA\_74\_22</u># Arise, O God, plead thine own cause: remember how the foolish man reproacheth thee daily.

Arise O God <u>19\_PSA\_82\_08</u> # Arise, O God, judge the earth: for thou shalt inherit all nations.

arise O LORD <u>14\_2CH\_06\_41</u> # Now therefore arise, O LORD God, into thy resting place, thou, and the ark of thy strength: let thy priests, O LORD God, be clothed with salvation, and let thy saints rejoice in goodness.

Arise O LORD <u>19\_PSA\_03\_07</u># Arise, O LORD; save me, O my God: for thou hast smitten all mine enemies [upon] the cheek bone; thou hast broken the teeth of the ungodly.

Arise O LORD <u>19\_PSA\_07\_06</u># Arise, O LORD, in thine anger, lift up thyself because of the rage of mine enemies: and awake for me [to] the judgment [that] thou hast commanded.

Arise O LORD <u>19\_PSA\_09\_19</u># Arise, O LORD; let not man prevail: let the heathen be judged in thy sight.

Arise O LORD <u>19 PSA\_10\_12</u> # Arise, O LORD; O God, lift up thine hand: forget not the humble.

Arise O LORD <u>19\_PSA\_132\_08</u> # Arise, O LORD, into thy rest; thou, and the ark of thy strength.

Arise O LORD <u>19\_PSA\_17\_13</u># Arise, O LORD, disappoint him, cast him down: deliver my soul from the wicked, [which is] thy sword:

arise out of <u>27\_DAN\_07\_17</u># These great beasts, which are four, [are] four kings, [which] shall arise out of the earth.

arise out of 20\_PRO\_06\_09 # How long wilt thou sleep, O sluggard? when wilt thou arise out of thy sleep?

arise pass over <u>23\_ISA\_23\_12</u> # And he said, Thou shalt no more rejoice, O thou oppressed virgin, daughter of Zidon: arise, pass over to Chittim; there also shalt thou have no rest.

Arise Peter slay <u>44\_ACT\_11\_07</u># And I heard a voice saying unto me, Arise, Peter; slay and eat.

arise princes also <u>23\_ISA\_49\_07</u> # Thus saith the LORD, the Redeemer of Israel, [and] his Holy One, to him whom man despiseth, to him whom the nation abhorreth, to a servant of rulers, Kings shall see and arise, princes also shall worship, because of the LORD that is faithful, [and] the Holy One of Israel, and he shall choose thee.

arise saith the <u>19\_PSA\_12\_05</u># For the oppression of the poor, for the sighing of the needy, now will I arise, saith the LORD; I will set [him] in safety [from him that] puffeth at him.

arise shall he <u>24\_JER\_08\_04</u> # Moreover thou shalt say unto them, Thus saith the LORD; Shall they fall, and not arise? shall he turn away, and not return?

Arise shine for <u>23\_ISA\_60\_01</u> # Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and the glory of the LORD is risen upon thee.

arise speaking perverse <u>44\_ACT\_20\_30</u> # Also of your own selves shall men arise, speaking perverse things, to draw away disciples after them.

Arise take possession <u>11\_1KI\_21\_15</u># And it came to pass, when Jezebel heard that Naboth was stoned, and was dead, that Jezebel said to Ahab, Arise, take possession of the vineyard of Naboth the Jezreelite, which he refused to give thee for money: for Naboth is not alive, but dead.

Arise take thy <u>05\_DEU\_10\_11</u># And the LORD said unto me, Arise, take [thy] journey before the people, that they may go in and possess the land, which I sware unto their fathers to give unto them.

Arise take thy <u>01\_GEN\_19\_15</u># And when the morning arose, then the angels hastened Lot, saying, Arise, take thy wife, and thy two daughters, which are here; lest thou be consumed in the iniquity of the city.

Arise take up <u>40\_MAT\_09\_06</u># But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power on earth to forgive

sins, [then saith he to the sick of the palsy,] Arise, take up thy bed, and go unto thine house.

arise that God <u>32\_JON\_04\_08</u># And it came to pass, when the sun did arise, that God prepared a vehement east wind; and the sun beat upon the head of Jonah, that he fainted, and wished in himself to die, and said, [It is] better for me to die than to live.

Arise that we <u>07\_JUD\_18\_09</u># And they said, Arise, that we may go up against them: for we have seen the land, and, behold, it [is] very good: and [are] ye still? be not slothful to go, [and] to enter to possess the land.

Arise therefore and <u>13\_1CH\_22\_16</u># Of the gold, the silver, and the brass, and the iron, [there is] no number. Arise [therefore], and be doing, and the LORD be with thee.

arise therefore and <u>13\_1CH\_22\_19</u># Now set your heart and your soul to seek the LORD your God; arise therefore, and build ye the sanctuary of the LORD God, to bring the ark of the covenant of the LORD, and the holy vessels of God, into the house that is to be built to the name of the LORD.

arise up and <u>20\_PRO\_31\_28</u># Her children arise up, and call her blessed; her husband [also], and he praiseth her.

arise up from <u>12\_2KI\_09\_02</u> # And when thou comest thither, look out there Jehu the son of Jehoshaphat the son of Nimshi, and go in, and make him arise up from among his brethren, and carry him to an inner chamber;

arise up out <u>07\_JUD\_20\_40</u># But when the flame began to arise up out of the city with a pillar of smoke, the Benjamites looked behind them, and, behold, the flame of the city ascended up to heaven.

Arise up quickly <u>44\_ACT\_12\_07</u> # And, behold, the angel of the Lord came upon [him], and a light shined in the prison: and he smote Peter on the side, and raised him up, saying, Arise up quickly. And his chains fell off from [his] hands.

arise upon thee <u>23\_ISA\_60\_02</u> # For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: but the LORD shall arise upon thee, and his glory shall be seen upon thee.

Arise walk through <u>01\_GEN\_13\_17</u># Arise, walk through the land in the length of it and in the breadth of it; for I will give it unto thee.

arise when I <u>33\_MIC\_07\_08</u> # Rejoice not against me, O mine enemy: when I fall, I shall arise; when I sit in darkness, the LORD [shall be] a light unto me.

arise with healing <u>39\_MAL\_04\_02</u> # But unto you that fear my name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with healing in his wings; and ye shall go forth, and grow up as calves of the stall.

Arise ye and <u>24\_JER\_31\_06</u># For there shall be a day, [that] the watchmen upon the mount Ephraim shall cry, Arise ye, and let us go up to Zion unto the LORD our God.

Arise ye and <u>33\_MIC\_02\_10</u> # Arise ye, and depart; for this [is] not [your] rest: because it is polluted, it shall destroy [you], even with a sore destruction.

Arise ye and <u>31\_OBA\_01\_01</u># The vision of Obadiah. Thus saith the Lord GOD concerning Edom; We have heard a rumour from the LORD, and an ambassador is sent among the heathen, Arise ye, and let us rise up against her in battle.

Arise ye go 24\_JER\_49\_28 # Concerning Kedar, and concerning the kingdoms of Hazor, which Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon shall smite, thus saith the LORD; Arise ye, go up to Kedar, and spoil the men of the east.

arise ye princes <u>23\_ISA\_21\_05</u># Prepare the table, watch in the watchtower, eat, drink: arise, ye princes, [and] anoint the shield.

arise yea they <u>10\_28A\_22\_39</u># And I have consumed them, and wounded them, that they could not arise: yea, they are fallen under my feet.

arise <u>10\_2SA\_02\_14</u> # And Abner said to Joab, Let the young men now arise, and play before us. And Joab said, Let them arise.

arise <u>18\_JOB\_25\_03</u># Is there any number of his armies? and upon whom doth not his light arise?

Arise <u>42\_LUK\_07\_14</u> # And he came and touched the bier: and they that bare [him] stood still. And he said, Young man, I say unto thee, Arise.

arise <u>42\_LUK\_08\_54</u> # And he put them all out, and took her by the hand, and called, saying, Maid, arise.

arise <u>41\_MAR\_05\_41</u> # And he took the damsel by the hand, and said unto her, Talitha cumi; which is, being interpreted, Damsel, I say unto thee, arise.

ariseth a little <u>11\_1KI\_18\_44</u># And it came to pass at the seventh time, that he said, Behold, there ariseth a little cloud out of the sea, like a man's hand. And he said, Go up, say unto Ahab, Prepare [thy chariot], and get thee down, that the rain stop thee not.

ariseth and the <u>21\_ECC\_01\_05</u># The sun also ariseth, and the sun goeth down, and hasteth to his place where he arose.

ariseth another priest <u>58\_HEB\_07\_15</u> # And it is yet far more evident: for that after the similitude of Melchisedec there ariseth another priest,

ariseth because of <u>40\_MAT\_13\_21</u># Yet hath he not root in himself, but dureth for a while: for when tribulation or persecution ariseth because of the word, by and by he is offended.

ariseth for the <u>41\_MAR\_04\_17</u> # And have no root in themselves, and so endure but for a time: afterward, when affliction or persecution ariseth for the word's sake, immediately they are offended.

ariseth light in <u>19\_PSA\_112\_04</u># Unto the upright there ariseth light in the darkness: [he is] gracious, and full of compassion, and righteous.

ariseth no prophet <u>43\_JOH\_07\_52</u> # They answered and said unto him, Art thou also of Galilee? Search, and look: for out of Galilee ariseth no prophet.

ariseth they flee <u>34\_NAH\_03\_17</u> # Thy crowned [are] as the locusts, and thy captains as the great grasshoppers, which camp in the hedges in the cold day, [but] when the sun ariseth they flee away, and their place is not known where they [are].

ariseth they gather <u>19\_PSA\_104\_22</u> # The sun ariseth, they gather themselves together, and lay them down in their dens.

ariseth to shake <u>23\_ISA\_02\_19</u># And they shall go into the holes of the rocks, and into the caves of the earth, for fear of the LORD, and for the glory of his majesty, when he ariseth to shake terribly the earth.

ariseth to shake <u>23\_ISA\_02\_21</u> # To go into the clefts of the rocks, and into the tops of the ragged rocks, for fear of the LORD, and for the glory of his majesty, when he ariseth to shake terribly the earth.

enterprise <u>18\_JOB\_05\_12</u># He disappointeth the devices of the crafty, so that their hands cannot perform [their] enterprise.

Pharisee and the <u>42\_LUK\_18\_10</u> # Two men went up into the temple to pray; the one a Pharisee, and the other a publican.

Pharisee besought him <u>42\_LUK\_11\_37</u> # And as he spake, a certain Pharisee besought him to dine with him: and he went in, and sat down to meat.

Pharisee named Gamaliel <u>44\_ACT\_05\_34</u> # Then stood there up one in the council, a Pharisee, named Gamaliel, a doctor of the law, had in reputation among all the people, and commanded to put the apostles forth a little space;

Pharisee of the <u>44\_ACT\_23\_06</u> # But when Paul perceived that the one part were Sadducees, and the other Pharisees, he cried out in the council, Men [and] brethren, I am a Pharisee, the son of a Pharisee: of the hope and resurrection of the dead I am called in question.

Pharisee saw it <u>42\_LUK\_11\_38</u># And when the Pharisee saw [it], he marvelled that he had not first washed before dinner.

Pharisee stood and <u>42\_LUK\_18\_11</u># The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, God, I thank thee, that I am not as other men [are], extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this publican.

Pharisee the son <u>44\_ACT\_23\_06</u> # But when Paul perceived that the one part were Sadducees, and the other Pharisees, he cried out in the council, Men [and] brethren, I am a Pharisee, the son of a Pharisee: of the hope and resurrection of the dead I am called in question.

Pharisee which had <u>42\_LUK\_07\_39</u> # Now when the Pharisee which had bidden him saw [it], he spake within himself, saying, This man, if he were a prophet, would have known who and what manner of woman [this is] that toucheth him: for she is a sinner.

Pharisee <u>44\_ACT\_26\_05</u># Which knew me from the beginning, if they would testify, that after the most straitest sect of our religion I lived a Pharisee.

Pharisee 50\_PHP\_03\_05 # Circumcised the eighth day, of the stock of Israel, [of] the tribe of Benjamin, an

Hebrew of the Hebrews; as touching the law, a Pharisee;

Pharisee's house and <u>42\_LUK\_07\_36</u># And one of the Pharisees desired him that he would eat with him. And he went into the Pharisee's house, and sat down to meat.

Pharisee's house brought <u>42\_LUK\_07\_37</u># And, behold, a woman in the city, which was a sinner, when she knew that [Jesus] sat at meat in the Pharisee's house, brought an alabaster box of ointment,

Pharisees a council <u>43\_JOH\_11\_47</u># Then gathered the chief priests and the Pharisees a council, and said, What do we? for this man doeth many miracles.

Pharisees also asked <u>43\_JOH\_09\_15</u># Then again the Pharisees also asked him how he had received his sight. He said unto them, He put clay upon mine eyes, and I washed, and do see.

Pharisees also came <u>40\_MAT\_19\_03</u># The Pharisees also came unto him, tempting him, and saying unto him, Is it lawful for a man to put away his wife for every cause?

Pharisees also who <u>42\_LUK\_16\_14</u> # And the Pharisees also, who were covetous, heard all these things: and they derided him.

Pharisees also with <u>40\_MAT\_16\_01</u># The Pharisees also with the Sadducees came, and tempting desired him that he would show them a sign from heaven.

Pharisees and all <u>41\_MAR\_07\_03</u># For the Pharisees, and all the Jews, except they wash [their] hands oft, eat not, holding the tradition of the elders.

Pharisees and certain <u>41\_MAR\_07\_01</u># Then came together unto him the Pharisees, and certain of the scribes, which came from Jerusalem.

Pharisees and doctors <u>42\_LUK\_05\_17</u> # And it came to pass on a certain day, as he was teaching, that there were Pharisees and doctors of the law sitting by, which were come out of every town of Galilee, and Judaea, and Jerusalem: and the power of the Lord was [present] to heal them.

Pharisees and lawyers <u>42\_LUK\_07\_30</u> # But the Pharisees and lawyers rejected the counsel of God against themselves, being not baptized of him.

Pharisees and of <u>41\_MAR\_08\_15</u> # And he charged them, saying, Take heed, beware of the leaven of the Pharisees, and [of] the leaven of Herod.

Pharisees and of <u>41\_MAR\_12\_13</u> # And they send unto him certain of the Pharisees and of the Herodians, to catch him in [his] words.

Pharisees and of <u>40\_MAT\_16\_06</u># Then Jesus said unto them, Take heed and beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees.

Pharisees and of <u>40\_MAT\_16\_11</u># How is it that ye do not understand that I spake [it] not to you concerning bread, that ye should beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees?

Pharisees and of <u>40\_MAT\_16\_12</u># Then understood they how that he bade [them] not beware of the leaven of bread, but of the doctrine of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees.

Pharisees and Sadducees <u>40\_MAT\_03\_07</u> # But when he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees come to his baptism, he said unto them, O generation of vipers, who hath warned you to flee from the wrath to come?

Pharisees and scribes <u>42\_LUK\_15\_02</u> # And the Pharisees and scribes murmured, saying, This man receiveth sinners, and eateth with them.

Pharisees and scribes <u>41\_MAR\_07\_05</u> # Then the Pharisees and scribes asked him, Why walk not thy disciples according to the tradition of the elders, but eat bread with unwashen hands?

Pharisees and the <u>44\_ACT\_23\_07</u># And when he had so said, there arose a dissension between the Pharisees and the Sadducees: and the multitude was divided.

Pharisees and the <u>43\_JOH\_07\_32</u> # The Pharisees heard that the people murmured such things concerning him; and the Pharisees and the chief priests sent officers to take him.

Pharisees and they <u>43\_JOH\_07\_45</u> # Then came the officers to the chief priests and Pharisees; and they said unto them, Why have ye not brought him?

Pharisees and told <u>43\_JOH\_11\_46</u># But some of them went their ways to the Pharisees, and told them what things Jesus had done.

Pharisees and took <u>40\_MAT\_22\_15</u># Then went the Pharisees, and took counsel how they might entangle him in [his] talk.

Pharisees answered saying <u>40\_MAT\_12\_38</u># Then certain of the scribes and of the Pharisees answered, saying, Master, we would see a sign from thee.

Pharisees Are ye <u>43\_JOH\_07\_47</u> # Then answered them the Pharisees, Are ye also deceived?

Pharisees began to <u>42\_LUK\_05\_21</u> # And the scribes and the Pharisees began to reason, saying, Who is this which speaketh blasphemies? Who can forgive sins, but God alone?

Pharisees began to <u>42\_LUK\_11\_53</u># And as he said these things unto them, the scribes and the Pharisees began to urge [him] vehemently, and to provoke him to speak of many things:

Pharisees believed on <u>43\_JOH\_07\_48</u> # Have any of the rulers or of the Pharisees believed on him?

Pharisees brought unto <u>43\_JOH\_08\_03</u> # And the scribes and Pharisees brought unto him a woman taken in adultery; and when they had set her in the midst,

Pharisees but thine <u>42\_LUK\_05\_33</u> # And they said unto him, Why do the disciples of John fast often, and make prayers, and likewise [the disciples] of the Pharisees; but thine eat and drink?

Pharisees came forth <u>41\_MAR\_08\_11</u> # And the Pharisees came forth, and began to question with him, seeking of him a sign from heaven, tempting him.

Pharisees came to <u>41\_MAR\_10\_02</u> # And the Pharisees came to him, and asked him, Is it lawful for a man to put away [his] wife? tempting him.

Pharisees came together <u>40\_MAT\_27\_62</u># Now the next day, that followed the day of the preparation, the chief priests and Pharisees came together unto Pilate,

Pharisees cometh thither <u>43\_JOH\_18\_03</u> # Judas then, having received a band [of men] and officers from the chief priests and Pharisees, cometh thither with lanterns and torches and weapons.

Pharisees confess both <u>44\_ACT\_23\_08</u># For the Sadducees say that there is no resurrection, neither angel, nor spirit: but the Pharisees confess both.

Pharisees desired him <u>42\_LUK\_07\_36</u> # And one of the Pharisees desired him that he would eat with him. And he went into the Pharisee's house, and sat down to meat.

Pharisees fast but <u>41\_MAR\_02\_18</u> # And the disciples of John and of the Pharisees used to fast: and they come and say unto him, Why do the disciples of John and of the Pharisees fast, but thy disciples fast not?

Pharisees fast oft <u>40\_MAT\_09\_14</u># Then came to him the disciples of John, saying, Why do we and the Pharisees fast oft, but thy disciples fast not?

Pharisees for ye <u>42\_LUK\_11\_42</u># But woe unto you, Pharisees! for ye tithe mint and rue and all manner of herbs, and pass over judgment and the love of God: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone.

Pharisees for ye <u>42\_LUK\_11\_43</u> # Woe unto you, Pharisees! for ye love the uppermost seats in the synagogues, and greetings in the markets.

Pharisees from among <u>42\_LUK\_19\_39</u> # And some of the Pharisees from among the multitude said unto him, Master, rebuke thy disciples.

Pharisees had given <u>43\_JOH\_11\_57</u> # Now both the chief priests and the Pharisees had given a commandment, that, if any man knew where he were, he should show [it], that they might take him.

Pharisees had heard <u>43\_JOH\_04\_01</u># When therefore the Lord knew how the Pharisees had heard that Jesus made and baptized more disciples than John,

Pharisees had heard <u>40\_MAT\_21\_45</u># And when the chief priests and Pharisees had heard his parables, they perceived that he spake of them.

Pharisees had heard <u>40\_MAT\_22\_34</u># But when the Pharisees had heard that he had put the Sadducees to silence, they were gathered together.

Pharisees he cried <u>44\_ACT\_23\_06</u># But when Paul perceived that the one part were Sadducees, and the other Pharisees, he cried out in the council, Men [and] brethren, I am a Pharisee, the son of a Pharisee: of the hope and resurrection of the dead I am called in question.

Pharisees heard it <u>40\_MAT\_12\_24</u># But when the Pharisees heard [it], they said, This [fellow] doth not cast out devils, but by Beelzebub the prince of the devils.

Pharisees heard that <u>43\_JOH\_07\_32</u> # The Pharisees heard that the people murmured such things concerning him; and the Pharisees and the chief priests sent officers to take him.

Pharisees him that <u>43\_JOH\_09\_13</u> # They brought to the Pharisees him that aforetime was blind.

Pharisees hypocrites because <u>40\_MAT\_23\_29</u># Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! because ye build the tombs of the prophets, and garnish the sepulchres of the righteous,

Pharisees hypocrites for <u>42\_LUK\_11\_44</u># Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye are as graves which appear not, and the men that walk over [them] are not aware [of them].

Pharisees hypocrites for <u>40\_MAT\_23\_13</u># But woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye shut up the kingdom of heaven against men: for ye neither go in [yourselves], neither suffer ye them that are entering to go in.

Pharisees hypocrites for <u>40\_MAT\_23\_14</u># Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye devour widows' houses, and for a pretence make long prayer: therefore ye shall receive the greater damnation.

Pharisees hypocrites for <u>40\_MAT\_23\_15</u># Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye compass sea and land to make one proselyte, and when he is made, ye make him twofold more the child of hell than yourselves.

Pharisees hypocrites for <u>40\_MAT\_23\_23</u># Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have omitted the weightier [matters] of the law, judgment, mercy, and faith: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone.

Pharisees hypocrites for <u>40\_MAT\_23\_25</u># Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye make clean the outside of the cup and of the platter, but within they are full of extortion and excess.

Pharisees hypocrites for <u>40\_MAT\_23\_27</u># Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye are like unto whited sepulchres, which indeed appear beautiful outward, but are within full of dead [men's] bones, and of all uncleanness.

Pharisees make clean <u>42\_LUK\_11\_39</u># And the Lord said unto him, Now do ye Pharisees make clean the outside of the cup and the platter; but your inward part is full of ravening and wickedness.

Pharisees murmured against <u>42\_LUK\_05\_30</u> # But their scribes and Pharisees murmured against his disciples, saying, Why do ye eat and drink with publicans and sinners?

Pharisees named Nicodemus <u>43\_JOH\_03\_01</u> # There was a man of the Pharisees, named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews:

Pharisees part arose <u>44\_ACT\_23\_09</u> # And there arose a great cry: and the scribes [that were] of the Pharisees' part arose, and strove, saying, We find no evil in this man: but if a spirit or an angel hath spoken to him, let us not fight against God.

Pharisees said He <u>40\_MAT\_09\_34</u># But the Pharisees said, He casteth out devils through the prince of the devils.

Pharisees said unto <u>42\_LUK\_06\_02</u> # And certain of the Pharisees said unto them, Why do ye that which is not lawful to do on the sabbath days?

Pharisees said unto <u>41\_MAR\_02\_24</u> # And the Pharisees said unto him, Behold, why do they on the sabbath day that which is not lawful?

Pharisees saw him <u>41\_MAR\_02\_16</u> # And when the scribes and Pharisees saw him eat with publicans and sinners, they said unto his disciples, How is it that he eateth and drinketh with publicans and sinners?

Pharisees saw it <u>40\_MAT\_09\_11</u># And when the Pharisees saw [it], they said unto his disciples, Why eateth your Master with publicans and sinners?

Pharisees saw it <u>40\_MAT\_12\_02</u># But when the Pharisees saw [it], they said unto him, Behold, thy disciples do that which is not lawful to do upon the sabbath day.

Pharisees saying Is <u>42\_LUK\_14\_03</u> # And Jesus answering spake unto the lawyers and Pharisees, saying, Is it lawful to heal on the sabbath day?

Pharisees saying unto <u>42\_LUK\_13\_31</u># The same day there came certain of the Pharisees, saying unto him, Get thee out, and depart hence: for Herod will kill thee.

Pharisees sit in <u>40\_MAT\_23\_02</u># Saying, The scribes and the Pharisees sit in Moses' seat:

Pharisees therefore said <u>43\_JOH\_08\_13</u># The Pharisees therefore said unto him, Thou bearest record of thyself; thy record is not true.

Pharisees therefore said <u>43\_JOH\_12\_19</u># The Pharisees therefore said among themselves, Perceive ye how ye prevail nothing? behold, the world is gone after him.

Pharisees they did <u>43\_JOH\_12\_42</u> # Nevertheless among the chief rulers also many believed on him; but because of the Pharisees they did not confess [him], lest they should be put out of the synagogue:

Pharisees This man <u>43\_JOH\_09\_16</u> # Therefore said some of the Pharisees, This man is not of God, because he keepeth not the sabbath day. Others said, How can a man that is a sinner do such miracles? And there was a division among them.

Pharisees to eat <u>42\_LUK\_14\_01</u> # And it came to pass, as he went into the house of one of the chief Pharisees to eat bread on the sabbath day, that they watched him.

Pharisees used to <u>41\_MAR\_02\_18</u># And the disciples of John and of the Pharisees used to fast: and they come and say unto him, Why do the disciples of John and of the Pharisees fast, but thy disciples fast not?

Pharisees watched him <u>42\_LUK\_06\_07</u> # And the scribes and Pharisees watched him, whether he would heal on the sabbath day; that they might find an accusation against him.

Pharisees went forth <u>41\_MAR\_03\_06</u> # And the Pharisees went forth, and straightway took counsel with the Herodians against him, how they might destroy him.

Pharisees went out <u>40\_MAT\_12\_14</u># Then the Pharisees went out, and held a council against him, how they might destroy him.

Pharisees were gathered <u>40\_MAT\_22\_41</u> # While the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus asked them,

Pharisees were offended <u>40\_MAT\_15\_12</u># Then came his disciples, and said unto him, Knowest thou that the Pharisees were offended, after they heard this saying?

Pharisees when the <u>42\_LUK\_17\_20</u> # And when he was demanded of the Pharisees, when the kingdom of God should come, he answered them and said, The kingdom of God cometh not with observation:

Pharisees which believed <u>44\_ACT\_15\_05</u> # But there rose up certain of the sect of the Pharisees which believed, saying, That it was needful to circumcise them, and to command [them] to keep the law of Moses.

Pharisees which is <u>42\_LUK\_12\_01</u> # In the mean time, when there were gathered together an innumerable multitude of people, insomuch that they trode one upon another, he began to say unto his disciples first of all, Beware ye of the leaven of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy.

Pharisees which were <u>43\_JOH\_09\_40</u> # And [some] of the Pharisees which were with him heard these words, and said unto him, Are we blind also?

Pharisees which were <u>40\_MAT\_15\_01</u># Then came to Jesus scribes and Pharisees, which were of Jerusalem, saying,

Pharisees ye shall <u>40\_MAT\_05\_20</u># For I say unto you, That except your righteousness shall exceed [the righteousness] of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the kingdom of heaven.

Pharisees <u>43\_JOH\_01\_24</u> # And they which were sent were of the Pharisees.

prised at of <u>38\_ZEC\_11\_13</u># And the LORD said unto me, Cast it unto the potter: a goodly price that I was

prised at of them. And I took the thirty [pieces] of silver, and cast them to the potter in the house of the LORD.

rise a man <u>20\_PRO\_28\_12</u> # When righteous [men] do rejoice, [there is] great glory: but when the wicked rise, a man is hidden.

rise after the <u>58\_HEB\_07\_11</u># If therefore perfection were by the Levitical priesthood, [for under it the people received the law,] what further need [was there] that another priest should rise after the order of Melchisedec, and not be called after the order of Aaron?

rise after them <u>27\_DAN\_07\_24</u> # And the ten horns out of this kingdom [are] ten kings [that] shall arise: and another shall rise after them; and he shall be diverse from the first, and he shall subdue three kings.

rise again and <u>02\_EXO\_21\_19</u># If he rise again, and walk abroad upon his staff, then shall he that smote [him] be quit: only he shall pay [for] the loss of his time, and shall cause [him] to be thoroughly healed.

rise again from <u>43\_JOH\_20\_09</u># For as yet they knew not the scripture, that he must rise again from the dead.

rise again in <u>43\_JOH\_11\_24</u># Martha saith unto him, I know that he shall rise again in the resurrection at the last day.

rise again <u>23\_ISA\_24\_20</u># The earth shall reel to and fro like a drunkard, and shall be removed like a cottage; and the transgression thereof shall be heavy upon it; and it shall fall, and not rise again.

rise again <u>43\_JOH\_11\_23</u># Jesus saith unto her, Thy brother shall rise again.

rise again <u>42\_LUK\_18\_33</u># And they shall scourge [him], and put him to death: and the third day he shall rise again.

risen again I <u>40\_MAT\_26\_32</u># But after I am risen again, I will go before you into Galilee.

risen again who <u>45\_ROM\_08\_34</u> # Who [is] he that condemneth? [It is] Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us.

risen again <u>42\_LUK\_09\_08</u># And of some, that Elias had appeared; and of others, that one of the old prophets was risen again.

risen again <u>42\_LUK\_09\_19</u># They answering said, John the Baptist; but some [say], Elias; and others [say], that one of the old prophets is risen again.

risen against me <u>19\_PSA\_86\_14</u># O God, the proud are risen against me, and the assemblies of violent [men] have sought after my soul; and have not set thee before them.

risen against thine <u>10\_2SA\_14\_07</u> # And, behold, the whole family is risen against thine handmaid, and they said, Deliver him that smote his brother, that we may kill him, for the life of his brother whom he slew; and we will destroy the heir also: and so they shall quench my coal which is left, and shall not leave to my husband [neither] name nor remainder upon the earth.

risen and stand <u>19\_PSA\_20\_08</u># They are brought down and fallen: but we are risen, and stand upright.

risen as he <u>40\_MAT\_28\_06</u># He is not here: for he is risen, as he said. Come, see the place where the Lord lay.

risen early and <u>12\_2KI\_06\_15</u># And when the servant of the man of God was risen early, and gone forth, behold, an host compassed the city both with horses and chariots. And his servant said unto him, Alas, my master! how shall we do?

risen early the <u>41\_MAR\_16\_09</u> # Now when [Jesus] was risen early the first [day] of the week, he appeared first to Mary Magdalene, out of whom he had cast seven devils.

risen from the <u>46\_1CO\_15\_20</u># But now is Christ risen from the dead, [and] become the firstfruits of them that slept.

risen from the <u>43\_JOH\_02\_22</u> # When therefore he was risen from the dead, his disciples remembered that he had said this unto them; and they believed the scripture, and the word which Jesus had said.

risen from the <u>43\_JOH\_21\_14</u># This is now the third time that Jesus showed himself to his disciples, after that he was risen from the dead.

risen from the <u>42\_LUK\_09\_07</u> # Now Herod the tetrarch heard of all that was done by him: and he was perplexed, because that it was said of some, that John was risen from the dead;

risen from the <u>41\_MAR\_06\_14</u># And king Herod heard [of him]; [for his name was spread abroad:] and he said, That John the Baptist was risen from the dead, and therefore mighty works do show forth themselves in him.

risen from the <u>41\_MAR\_06\_16</u># But when Herod heard [thereof], he said, It is John, whom I beheaded: he is risen from the dead.

risen from the <u>41\_MAR\_09\_09</u> # And as they came down from the mountain, he charged them that they should tell no man what things they had seen, till the Son of man were risen from the dead.

risen from the <u>40\_MAT\_14\_02</u># And said unto his servants, This is John the Baptist; he is risen from the dead; and therefore mighty works do show forth themselves in him.

risen from the <u>40\_MAT\_27\_64</u># Command therefore that the sepulchre be made sure until the third day, lest his disciples come by night, and steal him away, and say unto the people, He is risen from the dead: so the last error shall be worse than the first.

risen from the <u>40\_MAT\_28\_07</u># And go quickly, and tell his disciples that he is risen from the dead; and, behold, he goeth before you into Galilee; there shall ye see him: lo, I have told you.

risen he is <u>41\_MAR\_16\_06</u> # And he saith unto them, Be not affrighted: Ye seek Jesus of Nazareth, which was crucified: he is risen; he is not here: behold the place where they laid him.

risen I will <u>41\_MAR\_14\_28</u> # But after that I am risen, I will go before you into Galilee.

risen indeed and <u>42\_LUK\_24\_34</u># Saying, The Lord is risen indeed, and hath appeared to Simon.

risen remember how <u>42\_LUK\_24\_06</u> # He is not here, but is risen: remember how he spake unto you when he was yet in Galilee,

risen then is <u>46\_1CO\_15\_14</u> # And if Christ be not risen, then [is] our preaching vain, and your faith [is] also vain.

risen to pursue <u>09\_1SA\_25\_29</u> # Yet a man is risen to pursue thee, and to seek thy soul: but the soul of my lord shall be bound in the bundle of life with the LORD thy God; and the souls of thine enemies, them shall he sling out, [as out] of the middle of a sling.

risen up against <u>07\_JUD\_09\_18</u> # And ye are risen up against my father's house this day, and have slain his sons, threescore and ten persons, upon one stone, and have made Abimelech, the son of his maidservant, king over the men of Shechem, because he [is] your brother;]

risen up against <u>19\_PSA\_27\_12</u> # Deliver me not over unto the will of mine enemies: for false witnesses are risen up against me, and such as breathe out cruelty.

risen up against <u>19\_PSA\_54\_03</u> # For strangers are risen up against me, and oppressors seek after my soul: they have not set God before them. Selah.

risen up among <u>42\_LUK\_07\_16</u> # And there came a fear on all: and they glorified God, saying, That a great prophet is risen up among us; and, That God hath visited his people.

risen up and <u>14\_2CH\_13\_06</u> # Yet Jeroboam the son of Nebat, the servant of Solomon the son of David, is risen up, and hath rebelled against his lord.

risen up and <u>42\_LUK\_13\_25</u># When once the master of the house is risen up, and hath shut to the door, and ye begin to stand without, and to knock at the door, saying, Lord, Lord, open unto us; and he shall answer and say unto you, I know you not whence ye are:

risen up as <u>33\_MIC\_02\_08</u># Even of late my people is risen up as an enemy: ye pull off the robe with the garment from them that pass by securely as men averse from war.

risen up in <u>11\_1KI\_08\_20</u># And the LORD hath performed his word that he spake, and I am risen up in the room of David my father, and sit on the throne of Israel, as the LORD promised, and have built an house for the name of the LORD God of Israel.

risen up in <u>14\_2CH\_06\_10</u> # The LORD therefore hath performed his word that he hath spoken: for I am risen up in the room of David my father, and am set on the throne of Israel, as the LORD promised, and have built the house for the name of the LORD God of Israel.

risen up in <u>04\_NUM\_32\_14</u> # And, behold, ye are risen up in your fathers' stead, an increase of sinful men, to augment yet the fierce anger of the LORD toward Israel.

risen up into <u>26\_EZE\_07\_11</u># Violence is risen up into a rod of wickedness: none of them [shall remain], nor of their multitude, nor of any of theirs: neither [shall there be] wailing for them.

risen up to <u>14\_2CH\_21\_04</u> # Now when Jehoram was risen up to the kingdom of his father, he strengthened himself, and slew all his brethren with the sword, and [divers] also of the princes of Israel.

risen up to <u>08\_RUT\_02\_15</u># And when she was risen up to glean, Boaz commanded his young men, saying, Let her glean even among the sheaves, and reproach her not:

risen upon him <u>02\_EXO\_22\_03</u># If the sun be risen upon him, [there shall be] blood [shed] for him; [for] he should make full restitution; if he have nothing, then he shall be sold for his theft.

risen upon the <u>01\_GEN\_19\_23</u># The sun was risen upon the earth when Lot entered into Zoar.

risen upon thee <u>23\_ISA\_60\_01</u> # Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and the glory of the LORD is risen upon thee.

risen waters to <u>26\_EZE\_47\_05</u> # Afterward he measured a thousand; [and it was] a river that I could not pass over: for the waters were risen, waters to swim in, a river that could not be passed over.

risen with a <u>59\_JAM\_01\_11</u># For the sun is no sooner risen with a burning heat, but it withereth the grass, and the flower thereof falleth, and the grace of the fashion of it perisheth: so also shall the rich man fade away in his ways.

risen with Christ <u>51\_COL\_03\_01</u># If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God.

risen with him <u>51\_COL\_02\_12</u># Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with [him] through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead.

risen <u>46\_1CO\_15\_13</u> # But if there be no resurrection of the dead, then is Christ not risen:

risen <u>41\_MAR\_16\_14</u># Afterward he appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they believed not them which had seen him after he was risen.

risest up <u>05\_DEU\_06\_07</u> # And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up.

risest up <u>05\_DEU\_11\_19</u># And ye shall teach them your children, speaking of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, when thou liest down, and when thou risest up.

riseth against his <u>05\_DEU\_22\_26</u># But unto the damsel thou shalt do nothing; [there is] in the damsel no sin [worthy] of death: for as when a man riseth against his neighbour, and slayeth him, even so [is] this matter:

riseth also while <u>20\_PRO\_31\_15</u># She riseth also while it is yet night, and giveth meat to her household, and a portion to her maidens.

riseth and mischief <u>23\_ISA\_47\_11</u># Therefore shall evil come upon thee; thou shalt not know from whence it riseth: and mischief shall fall upon thee; thou shalt not be able to put it off: and desolation shall come upon thee suddenly, [which] thou shalt not know.

riseth even a <u>10\_2SA\_23\_04</u> # And [he shall be] as the light of the morning, [when] the sun riseth, [even] a morning without clouds; [as] the tender grass [springing] out of the earth by clear shining after rain.

riseth from supper <u>43\_JOH\_13\_04</u> # He riseth from supper, and laid aside his garments; and took a towel, and girded himself.

riseth not and <u>18\_JOB\_09\_07</u># Which commandeth the sun, and it riseth not; and sealeth up the stars.

riseth not till <u>18\_JOB\_14\_12</u> # So man lieth down, and riseth not: till the heavens [be] no more, they shall not awake, nor be raised out of their sleep.

riseth up again <u>20\_PRO\_24\_16</u># For a just [man] falleth seven times, and riseth up again: but the wicked shall fall into mischief.

riseth up against <u>18\_JOB\_27\_07</u> # Let mine enemy be as the wicked, and he that riseth up against me as the unrighteous.

riseth up against <u>33\_MIC\_07\_06</u># For the son dishonoureth the father, the daughter riseth up against her mother, the daughter in law against her mother in law; a man's enemies [are] the men of his own house.

riseth up and <u>18\_JOB\_24\_22</u> # He draweth also the mighty with his power: he riseth up, and no [man] is sure of life.

riseth up and <u>18\_JOB\_31\_14</u># What then shall I do when God riseth up? and when he visiteth, what shall I answer him?

riseth up and <u>06\_JOS\_06\_26</u># And Joshua adjured [them] at that time, saying, Cursed [be] the man before the LORD, that riseth up and buildeth this city Jericho: he shall lay the foundation thereof in his firstborn, and in his youngest [son] shall he set up the gates of it.

riseth up like <u>24\_JER\_46\_08</u># Egypt riseth up like a flood, and [his] waters are moved like the rivers; and he saith, I will go up, [and] will cover the earth; I will destroy the city and the inhabitants thereof.

surprised and the <u>24\_JER\_48\_41</u># Kerioth is taken, and the strong holds are surprised, and the mighty men's hearts in Moab at that day shall be as the heart of a woman in her pangs.

surprised how is <u>24\_JER\_51\_41</u># How is Sheshach taken! and how is the praise of the whole earth surprised! how is Babylon become an astonishment among the nations!

surprised the hypocrites <u>23\_ISA\_33\_14</u># The sinners in Zion are afraid; fearfulness hath surprised the hypocrites. Who among us shall dwell with the devouring fire? who among us shall dwell with everlasting burnings?
