

# KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Jeroboam all the <u>11\_1KI\_15\_06</u># And there was war between Rehoboam and Jeroboam all the days of his life.

Jeroboam all their <u>11\_1KI\_14\_30</u># And there was war between Rehoboam and Jeroboam all [their] days.

Jeroboam also set <u>14\_2CH\_13\_03</u> # And Abijah set the battle in array with an army of valiant men of war, [even] four hundred thousand chosen men: Jeroboam also set the battle in array against him with eight hundred thousand chosen men, [being] mighty men of valour.

Jeroboam and all <u>11\_1KI\_12\_03</u># That they sent and called him. And Jeroboam and all the congregation of Israel came, and spake unto Rehoboam, saying,

Jeroboam and all <u>11\_1KI\_12\_12</u># So Jeroboam and all the people came to Rehoboam the third day, as the king had appointed, saying, Come to me again the third day.

Jeroboam and all <u>14\_2CH\_10\_03</u># And they sent and called him. So Jeroboam and all Israel came and spake to Rehoboam, saying,

Jeroboam and all <u>14\_2CH\_10\_12</u> # So Jeroboam and all the people came to Rehoboam on the third day, as the king bade, saying, Come again to me on the third day.

Jeroboam and all <u>14\_2CH\_13\_04</u> # And Abijah stood up upon mount Zemaraim, which [is] in mount Ephraim, and said, Hear me, thou Jeroboam, and all Israel;

Jeroboam and all <u>14\_2CH\_13\_15</u> # Then the men of Judah gave a shout: and as the men of Judah shouted, it came to pass, that God smote Jeroboam and all Israel before Abijah and Judah.

Jeroboam and all <u>12\_2KI\_14\_28</u> # Now the rest of the acts of Jeroboam, and all that he did, and his might, how he warred, and how he recovered Damascus, and Hamath, [which belonged] to Judah, for Israel, are they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Israel?

Jeroboam and because <u>11\_1KI\_16\_07</u># And also by the hand of the prophet Jehu the son of Hanani came the word of the LORD against Baasha, and against his house, even for all the evil that he did in the sight of the LORD, in provoking him to anger with the work of his hands, in being like the house of Jeroboam; and because he killed him.

Jeroboam and get <u>11\_1KI\_14\_02</u># And Jeroboam said to his wife, Arise, I pray thee, and disguise thyself, that thou be not known to be the wife of Jeroboam; and get thee to Shiloh: behold, there [is] Ahijah the prophet, which told me that [I should be] king over this people.

Jeroboam and hast <u>11\_1KI\_16\_02</u># Forasmuch as I exalted thee out of the dust, and made thee prince over my people Israel; and thou hast walked in the way of Jeroboam, and hast made my people Israel to sin, to provoke me to anger with their sins;

Jeroboam and his <u>14\_2CH\_11\_14</u># For the Levites left their suburbs and their possession, and came to Judah and Jerusalem: for Jeroboam and his sons had cast them off from executing the priest's office unto the LORD:

Jeroboam and in <u>11\_1KI\_15\_34</u># And he did evil in the sight of the LORD, and walked in the way of Jeroboam, and in his sin wherewith he made Israel to sin.

Jeroboam and in <u>11\_1KI\_16\_19</u># For his sins which he sinned in doing evil in the sight of the LORD, in walking in the way of Jeroboam, and in his sin which he did, to make Israel to sin.

Jeroboam And Jeroboam <u>11\_1KI\_11\_40</u># Solomon sought therefore to kill Jeroboam. And Jeroboam arose, and fled into Egypt, unto Shishak king of Egypt, and was in Egypt until the death of Solomon.

Jeroboam and took <u>14\_2CH\_13\_19</u># And Abijah pursued after Jeroboam, and took cities from him, Bethel with the towns thereof, and Jeshanah with the towns thereof, and Ephrain with the towns thereof.

Jeroboam and will <u>11\_1KI\_14\_10</u># Therefore, behold, I will bring evil upon the house of Jeroboam, and will cut off from Jeroboam him that pisseth against the wall, [and] him that is shut up and left in Israel, and will take away the remnant of the house of Jeroboam, as a man taketh away dung, till it be all gone.

Jeroboam any that <u>11\_1KI\_15\_29</u># And it came to pass, when he reigned, [that] he smote all the house of Jeroboam; he left not to Jeroboam any that breathed, until he had destroyed him, according unto the saying of the LORD, which he spake by his servant Ahijah the Shilonite:

Jeroboam arose and <u>11\_1KI\_11\_40</u># Solomon sought therefore to kill Jeroboam. And Jeroboam arose, and fled into Egypt, unto Shishak king of Egypt, and was in Egypt until the death of Solomon.

Jeroboam as a <u>11\_1KI\_14\_10</u># Therefore, behold, I will bring evil upon the house of Jeroboam, and will cut off from Jeroboam him that pisseth against the wall, [and] him that is shut up and left in Israel, and will take away the remnant of the house of Jeroboam, as a man taketh away dung, till it be all gone.

Jeroboam began Abijah <u>14\_2CH\_13\_01</u> # Now in the eighteenth year of king Jeroboam began Abijah to reign over Judah.

Jeroboam began to <u>11\_1KI\_15\_25</u># And Nadab the son of Jeroboam began to reign over Israel in the second year of Asa king of Judah, and reigned over Israel two years.

Jeroboam built Shechem <u>11\_1KI\_12\_25</u># Then Jeroboam built Shechem in mount Ephraim, and dwelt therein; and went out from thence, and built Penuel.

Jeroboam caused an <u>14\_2CH\_13\_13</u> # But Jeroboam caused an ambushment to come about behind them: so they were before Judah, and the ambushment [was] behind them.

Jeroboam cometh to <u>11\_1KI\_14\_05</u># And the LORD said unto Ahijah, Behold, the wife of Jeroboam cometh to ask a thing of thee for her son; for he [is] sick: thus and thus shalt thou say unto her: for it shall be, when she cometh in, that she shall feign herself [to be] another [woman].

Jeroboam continually <u>14\_2CH\_12\_15</u> # Now the acts of Rehoboam, first and last, [are] they not written in the book of Shemaiah the prophet, and of Iddo the seer concerning genealogies? And [there were] wars between Rehoboam and Jeroboam continually.

Jeroboam drave Israel <u>12\_2KI\_17\_21</u> # For he rent Israel from the house of David; and they made Jeroboam the son of Nebat king: and Jeroboam drave Israel from following the LORD, and made them sin a great sin.

Jeroboam dwelt in <u>11\_1KI\_12\_02</u># And it came to pass, when Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who was yet in Egypt, heard [of it], [for he was fled from the presence of king Solomon, and Jeroboam dwelt in Egypt;]

Jeroboam even to <u>11\_1KI\_13\_34</u># And this thing became sin unto the house of Jeroboam, even to cut [it]

off, and to destroy [it] from off the face of the earth.

Jeroboam fell sick <u>11\_1KI\_14\_01</u># At that time Abijah the son of Jeroboam fell sick.

Jeroboam he left <u>11\_1KI\_15\_29</u># And it came to pass, when he reigned, [that] he smote all the house of Jeroboam; he left not to Jeroboam any that breathed, until he had destroyed him, according unto the saying of the LORD, which he spake by his servant Ahijah the Shilonite:

Jeroboam heard the <u>11\_1KI\_13\_04</u># And it came to pass, when king Jeroboam heard the saying of the man of God, which had cried against the altar in Bethel, that he put forth his hand from the altar, saying, Lay hold on him. And his hand, which he put forth against him, dried up, so that he could not pull it in again to him.

Jeroboam him that <u>11\_1KI\_14\_10</u># Therefore, behold, I will bring evil upon the house of Jeroboam, and will cut off from Jeroboam him that pisseth against the wall, [and] him that is shut up and left in Israel, and will take away the remnant of the house of Jeroboam, as a man taketh away dung, till it be all gone.

Jeroboam his son <u>12\_2KI\_14\_16</u># And Jehoash slept with his fathers, and was buried in Samaria with the kings of Israel; and Jeroboam his son reigned in his stead.

Jeroboam how he <u>11\_1KI\_14\_19</u># And the rest of the acts of Jeroboam, how he warred, and how he reigned, behold, they [are] written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Israel.

Jeroboam in the <u>11\_1KI\_14\_11</u># Him that dieth of Jeroboam in the city shall the dogs eat; and him that dieth in the field shall the fowls of the air eat: for the LORD hath spoken [it].

Jeroboam king of <u>13\_1CH\_05\_17</u> # All these were reckoned by genealogies in the days of Jotham king of Judah, and in the days of Jeroboam king of Israel.

Jeroboam king of <u>11\_1KI\_15\_09</u># And in the twentieth year of Jeroboam king of Israel reigned Asa over Judah.

Jeroboam king of <u>12\_2KI\_15\_01</u> # In the twenty and seventh year of Jeroboam king of Israel began Azariah son of Amaziah king of Judah to reign.

Jeroboam king of <u>30\_AMO\_07\_10</u> # Then Amaziah the priest of Bethel sent to Jeroboam king of Israel, saying, Amos hath conspired against thee in the midst of the house of Israel: the land is not able to bear all his words.

Jeroboam made you <u>14\_2CH\_13\_08</u># And now ye think to withstand the kingdom of the LORD in the hand of the sons of David; and ye [be] a great multitude, and [there are] with you golden calves, which Jeroboam made you for gods.

Jeroboam ordained a <u>11\_1KI\_12\_32</u># And Jeroboam ordained a feast in the eighth month, on the fifteenth day of the month, like unto the feast that [is] in Judah, and he offered upon the altar. So did he in Bethel, sacrificing unto the calves that he had made: and he placed in Bethel the priests of the high places which he had made.

Jeroboam recover strength <u>14\_2CH\_13\_20</u> # Neither did Jeroboam recover strength again in the days of Abijah: and the LORD struck him, and he died.

Jeroboam reign over <u>12\_2KI\_15\_08</u> # In the thirty and eighth year of Azariah king of Judah did Zachariah the son of Jeroboam reign over Israel in Samaria six months.

Jeroboam reigned were <u>11\_1KI\_14\_20</u># And the days which Jeroboam reigned [were] two and twenty

years: and he slept with his fathers, and Nadab his son reigned in his stead.

Jeroboam returned not <u>11\_1KI\_13\_33</u># After this thing Jeroboam returned not from his evil way, but made again of the lowest of the people priests of the high places: whosoever would, he consecrated him, and he became [one] of the priests of the high places.

Jeroboam returned out <u>14\_2CH\_10\_02</u> # And it came to pass, when Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who [was] in Egypt, whither he had fled from the presence of Solomon the king, heard [it], that Jeroboam returned out of Egypt.

Jeroboam said in <u>11\_1KI\_12\_26</u># And Jeroboam said in his heart, Now shall the kingdom return to the house of David:

Jeroboam said to <u>11\_1KI\_14\_02</u># And Jeroboam said to his wife, Arise, I pray thee, and disguise thyself, that thou be not known to be the wife of Jeroboam; and get thee to Shiloh: behold, there [is] Ahijah the prophet, which told me that [I should be] king over this people.

Jeroboam sat upon <u>12\_2KI\_13\_13</u># And Joash slept with his fathers; and Jeroboam sat upon his throne: and Joash was buried in Samaria with the kings of Israel.

Jeroboam shall come <u>11\_1KI\_14\_13</u># And all Israel shall mourn for him, and bury him: for he only of Jeroboam shall come to the grave, because in him there is found [some] good thing toward the LORD God of Israel in the house of Jeroboam.

Jeroboam shall die <u>30\_AMO\_07\_11</u># For thus Amos saith, Jeroboam shall die by the sword, and Israel shall surely be led away captive out of their own land.

Jeroboam slept with <u>12\_2KI\_14\_29</u># And Jeroboam slept with his fathers, [even] with the kings of Israel; and Zachariah his son reigned in his stead.

Jeroboam stood by <u>11\_1KI\_13\_01</u># And, behold, there came a man of God out of Judah by the word of the LORD unto Bethel: and Jeroboam stood by the altar to burn incense.

Jeroboam Take thee <u>11\_1KI\_11\_31</u># And he said to Jeroboam, Take thee ten pieces: for thus saith the LORD, the God of Israel, Behold, I will rend the kingdom out of the hand of Solomon, and will give ten tribes to thee:

Jeroboam that day <u>11\_1KI\_14\_14</u># Moreover the LORD shall raise him up a king over Israel, who shall cut off the house of Jeroboam that day: but what? even now.

Jeroboam the son <u>11\_1KI\_11\_26</u># And Jeroboam the son of Nebat, an Ephrathite of Zereda, Solomon's servant, whose mother's name [was] Zeruah, a widow woman, even he lifted up [his] hand against the king.

Jeroboam the son <u>11\_1KI\_12\_02</u># And it came to pass, when Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who was yet in Egypt, heard [of it], [for he was fled from the presence of king Solomon, and Jeroboam dwelt in Egypt;]

Jeroboam the son <u>11\_1KI\_12\_15</u># Wherefore the king hearkened not unto the people; for the cause was from the LORD, that he might perform his saying, which the LORD spake by Ahijah the Shilonite unto Jeroboam the son of Nebat.

Jeroboam the son <u>11\_1KI\_15\_01</u># Now in the eighteenth year of king Jeroboam the son of Nebat reigned Abijam over Judah.

Jeroboam the son <u>11\_1KI\_16\_03</u># Behold, I will take away the posterity of Baasha, and the posterity of his house; and will make thy house like the house of Jeroboam the son of Nebat.

Jeroboam the son <u>11\_1KI\_16\_26</u># For he walked in all the way of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, and in his sin wherewith he made Israel to sin, to provoke the LORD God of Israel to anger with their vanities.

Jeroboam the son <u>11\_1KI\_16\_31</u># And it came to pass, as if it had been a light thing for him to walk in the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, that he took to wife Jezebel the daughter of Ethbaal king of the Zidonians, and went and served Baal, and worshipped him.

Jeroboam the son <u>11\_1KI\_21\_22</u># And will make thine house like the house of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, and like the house of Baasha the son of Ahijah, for the provocation wherewith thou hast provoked [me] to anger, and made Israel to sin.

Jeroboam the son <u>11\_1KI\_22\_52</u># And he did evil in the sight of the LORD, and walked in the way of his father, and in the way of his mother, and in the way of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin:

Jeroboam the son <u>14\_2CH\_09\_29</u> # Now the rest of the acts of Solomon, first and last, [are] they not written in the book of Nathan the prophet, and in the prophecy of Ahijah the Shilonite, and in the visions of Iddo the seer against Jeroboam the son of Nebat?

Jeroboam the son <u>14\_2CH\_10\_02</u> # And it came to pass, when Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who [was] in Egypt, whither he had fled from the presence of Solomon the king, heard [it], that Jeroboam returned out of Egypt.

Jeroboam the son <u>14\_2CH\_10\_15</u> # So the king hearkened not unto the people: for the cause was of God, that the LORD might perform his word, which he spake by the hand of Ahijah the Shilonite to Jeroboam the son of Nebat.

Jeroboam the son <u>14\_2CH\_13\_06</u> # Yet Jeroboam the son of Nebat, the servant of Solomon the son of David, is risen up, and hath rebelled against his lord.

Jeroboam the son <u>12\_2KI\_03\_03</u> # Nevertheless he cleaved unto the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, which made Israel to sin; he departed not therefrom.

Jeroboam the son <u>12\_2KI\_09\_09</u> # And I will make the house of Ahab like the house of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, and like the house of Baasha the son of Ahijah:

Jeroboam the son <u>12\_2KI\_10\_29</u># Howbeit [from] the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin, Jehu departed not from after them, [to wit], the golden calves that [were] in Bethel, and that [were] in Dan.

Jeroboam the son <u>12\_2KI\_13\_02</u> # And he did [that which was] evil in the sight of the LORD, and followed the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, which made Israel to sin; he departed not therefrom.

Jeroboam the son <u>12\_2KI\_13\_11</u># And he did [that which was] evil in the sight of the LORD; he departed not from all the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel sin: [but] he walked therein.

Jeroboam the son <u>12\_2KI\_14\_23</u> # In the fifteenth year of Amaziah the son of Joash king of Judah Jeroboam the son of Joash king of Israel began to reign in Samaria, [and reigned] forty and one years.

Jeroboam the son <u>12\_2KI\_14\_24</u> # And he did [that which was] evil in the sight of the LORD: he departed not from all the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin.

Jeroboam the son <u>12\_2KI\_14\_27</u> # And the LORD said not that he would blot out the name of Israel from under heaven: but he saved them by the hand of Jeroboam the son of Joash.

Jeroboam the son <u>12\_2KI\_15\_09</u># And he did [that which was] evil in the sight of the LORD, as his fathers had done: he departed not from the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin.

Jeroboam the son <u>12\_2KI\_15\_18</u> # And he did [that which was] evil in the sight of the LORD: he departed not all his days from the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin.

Jeroboam the son <u>12\_2KI\_15\_24</u> # And he did [that which was] evil in the sight of the LORD: he departed not from the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin.

Jeroboam the son <u>12\_2KI\_15\_28</u> # And he did [that which was] evil in the sight of the LORD: he departed not from the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin.

Jeroboam the son <u>12\_2KI\_17\_21</u># For he rent Israel from the house of David; and they made Jeroboam the son of Nebat king: and Jeroboam drave Israel from following the LORD, and made them sin a great sin.

Jeroboam the son <u>12\_2KI\_23\_15</u> # Moreover the altar that [was] at Bethel, [and] the high place which Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin, had made, both that altar and the high place he brake down, and burned the high place, [and] stamped [it] small to powder, and burned the grove.

Jeroboam the son <u>30\_AMO\_01\_01</u># The words of Amos, who was among the herdmen of Tekoa, which he saw concerning Israel in the days of Uzziah king of Judah, and in the days of Jeroboam the son of Joash king of Israel, two years before the earthquake.

Jeroboam the son 28\_HOS\_01\_01 # The word of the LORD that came unto Hosea, the son of Beeri, in the days of Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz, [and] Hezekiah, kings of Judah, and in the days of Jeroboam the son of Joash, king of Israel.

Jeroboam Thus saith <u>11\_1KI\_14\_07</u># Go, tell Jeroboam, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Forasmuch as I exalted thee from among the people, and made thee prince over my people Israel,

Jeroboam was a <u>11\_1KI\_11\_28</u># And the man Jeroboam [was] a mighty man of valour: and Solomon seeing the young man that he was industrious, he made him ruler over all the charge of the house of Joseph.

Jeroboam was come <u>11\_1KI\_12\_20</u># And it came to pass, when all Israel heard that Jeroboam was come again, that they sent and called him unto the congregation, and made him king over all Israel: there was none that followed the house of David, but the tribe of Judah only.

Jeroboam went out <u>11\_1KI\_11\_29</u># And it came to pass at that time when Jeroboam went out of Jerusalem, that the prophet Ahijah the Shilonite found him in the way; and he had clad himself with a new garment; and they two [were] alone in the field:

Jeroboam which he <u>11\_1KI\_15\_30</u># Because of the sins of Jeroboam which he sinned, and which he made Israel sin, by his provocation wherewith he provoked the LORD God of Israel to anger.

Jeroboam which he <u>12\_2KI\_17\_22</u> # For the children of Israel walked in all the sins of Jeroboam which he did; they departed not from them;

Jeroboam which made <u>12\_2KI\_10\_31</u># But Jehu took no heed to walk in the law of the LORD God of Israel with all his heart: for he departed not from the sins of Jeroboam, which made Israel to sin.

Jeroboam who did <u>11\_1KI\_14\_16</u># And he shall give Israel up because of the sins of Jeroboam, who did sin, and who made Israel to sin.

Jeroboam who made <u>12\_2KI\_13\_06</u># Nevertheless they departed not from the sins of the house of

Jeroboam, who made Israel sin, [but] walked therein: and there remained the grove also in Samaria.]

Jeroboam why feignest <u>11\_1KI\_14\_06</u># And it was [so], when Ahijah heard the sound of her feet, as she came in at the door, that he said, Come in, thou wife of Jeroboam; why feignest thou thyself [to be] another? for I [am] sent to thee [with] heavy [tidings].

Jeroboam with the <u>30\_AMO\_07\_09</u> # And the high places of Isaac shall be desolate, and the sanctuaries of Israel shall be laid waste; and I will rise against the house of Jeroboam with the sword.

Jeroboam <u>11\_1KI\_14\_13</u># And all Israel shall mourn for him, and bury him: for he only of Jeroboam shall come to the grave, because in him there is found [some] good thing toward the LORD God of Israel in the house of Jeroboam.

Jeroboam <u>11\_1KI\_15\_07</u> # Now the rest of the acts of Abijam, and all that he did, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah? And there was war between Abijam and Jeroboam.

Jeroboam <u>14\_2CH\_11\_04</u># Thus saith the LORD, Ye shall not go up, nor fight against your brethren: return every man to his house: for this thing is done of me. And they obeyed the words of the LORD, and returned from going against Jeroboam.

Jeroboam <u>14\_2CH\_13\_02</u># He reigned three years in Jerusalem. His mother's name also [was] Michaiah the daughter of Uriel of Gibeah. And there was war between Abijah and Jeroboam.

Jeroboam's wife arose <u>11\_1KI\_14\_17</u># And Jeroboam's wife arose, and departed, and came to Tirzah: [and] when she came to the threshold of the door, the child died;

Jeroboam's wife did <u>11\_1KI\_14\_04</u># And Jeroboam's wife did so, and arose, and went to Shiloh, and came to the house of Ahijah. But Ahijah could not see; for his eyes were set by reason of his age.

Patrobas Hermes and <u>45\_ROM\_16\_14</u># Salute Asyncritus, Phlegon, Hermas, Patrobas, Hermes, and the brethren which are with them.

reprobate concerning the <u>55\_2TI\_03\_08</u># Now as Jannes and Jambres withstood Moses, so do these also resist the truth: men of corrupt minds, reprobate concerning the faith.

reprobate mind to <u>45\_ROM\_01\_28</u> # And even as they did not like to retain God in [their] knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient;

Reprobate silver shall <u>24\_JER\_06\_30</u> # Reprobate silver shall [men] call them, because the LORD hath rejected them.

reprobate <u>56\_TIT\_01\_16</u># They profess that they know God; but in works they deny [him], being abominable, and disobedient, and unto every good work reprobate.

reprobates <u>47\_2CO\_13\_05</u> # Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?

reprobates <u>47\_2CO\_13\_06</u> # But I trust that ye shall know that we are not reprobates.

reprobates <u>47\_2CO\_13\_07</u> # Now I pray to God that ye do no evil; not that we should appear approved, but that ye should do that which is honest, though we be as reprobates.

rob God Yet <u>39\_MAL\_03\_08</u> # Will a man rob God? Yet ye have robbed me. But ye say, Wherein have we robbed thee? In tithes and offerings.

rob him the <u>03\_LEV\_19\_13</u># Thou shalt not defraud thy neighbour, neither rob [him]: the wages of him that is hired shall not abide with thee all night until the morning.

Rob not the <u>20\_PRO\_22\_22</u> # Rob not the poor, because he [is] poor: neither oppress the afflicted in the gate:

rob the fatherless <u>23\_ISA\_10\_02</u> # To turn aside the needy from judgment, and to take away the right from the poor of my people, that widows may be their prey, and [that] they may rob the fatherless!

rob the threshingfloors <u>09\_1SA\_23\_01</u> # Then they told David, saying, Behold, the Philistines fight against Keilah, and they rob the threshingfloors.

robbed of her 20\_PRO\_17\_12 # Let a bear robbed of her whelps meet a man, rather than a fool in his folly.

robbed other churches <u>47\_2CO\_11\_08</u># I robbed other churches, taking wages [of them], to do you service.

robbed thee In <u>39\_MAL\_03\_08</u> # Will a man rob God? Yet ye have robbed me. But ye say, Wherein have we robbed thee? In tithes and offerings.

robbed their treasures 23\_ISA\_10\_13 # For he saith, By the strength of my hand I have done [it], and by my wisdom; for I am prudent: and I have removed the bounds of the people, and have robbed their treasures, and I have put down the inhabitants like a valiant [man]:
