rotten rags and <u>24\_JER\_38\_11</u># So Ebedmelech took the men with him, and went into the house of the king under the treasury, and took thence old cast clouts and old rotten rags, and let them down by cords into the dungeon to Jeremiah.

rotten rags under <u>24\_JER\_38\_12</u> # And Ebedmelech the Ethiopian said unto Jeremiah, Put now [these] old cast clouts and rotten rags under thine armholes under the cords. And Jeremiah did so.

rotten thing consumeth <u>18\_JOB\_13\_28</u># And he, as a rotten thing, consumeth, as a garment that is moth eaten.

rotten under their <u>29\_JOE\_01\_17</u># The seed is rotten under their clods, the garners are laid desolate, the barns are broken down; for the corn is withered.

rotten wood <u>18\_JOB\_41\_27</u> # He esteemeth iron as straw, [and] brass as rotten wood.

rottenness and their <u>23\_ISA\_05\_24</u># Therefore as the fire devoureth the stubble, and the flame consumeth the chaff, [so] their root shall be as rottenness, and their blossom shall go up as dust: because they have cast away the law of the LORD of hosts, and despised the word of the Holy One of Israel.

rottenness entered into <u>35\_HAB\_03\_16</u> # When I heard, my belly trembled; my lips quivered at the voice: rottenness entered into my bones, and I trembled in myself, that I might rest in the day of trouble: when he cometh up unto the people, he will invade them with his troops.

rottenness in his <u>20\_PRO\_12\_04</u> # A virtuous woman [is] a crown to her husband: but she that maketh ashamed [is] as rottenness in his bones.

rottenness of the <u>20\_PRO\_14\_30</u> # A sound heart [is] the life of the flesh: but envy the rottenness of the bones.

rottenness <u>28\_HOS\_05\_12</u> # Therefore [will] I [be] unto Ephraim as a moth, and to the house of Judah as rottenness.
