arrow beyond him <u>09\_1SA\_20\_36</u># And he said unto his lad, Run, find out now the arrows which I shoot. [And] as the lad ran, he shot an arrow beyond him.

arrow beyond thee <u>09\_1SA\_20\_37</u> # And when the lad was come to the place of the arrow which Jonathan had shot, Jonathan cried after the lad, and said, [Is] not the arrow beyond thee?

arrow cannot make <u>18\_JOB\_41\_28</u> # The arrow cannot make him flee: slingstones are turned with him into stubble.

arrow of deliverance 12\_2KI\_13\_17 # And he said, Open the window eastward. And he opened [it]. Then Elisha said, Shoot. And he shot. And he said, The arrow of the LORD'S deliverance, and the arrow of deliverance from Syria: for thou shalt smite the Syrians in Aphek, till thou have consumed [them].

arrow of the <u>12\_2KI\_13\_17</u># And he said, Open the window eastward. And he opened [it]. Then Elisha said, Shoot. And he shot. arrow there nor 12 2KI 19 32 # Therefore thus saith the LORD concerning the king of Assyria, He shall not come into this city, nor shoot an arrow there, nor come before it with shield, nor cast a bank against it.

arrow there nor 23 ISA 37 33 # Therefore thus saith the LORD concerning the king of Assyria, He shall not come into this city, nor shoot an arrow there, nor come before it with shields, nor cast a bank against it.

arrow upon the 19\_PSA\_11\_02 # For, lo, the wicked bend [their] bow, they make ready their arrow upon the string, that they may privily shoot at the upright in heart.

arrow went out 12\_2KI\_09\_24 # And Jehu drew a bow with his full strength, and smote Jehoram between his arms, and the arrow went out at his heart, and he sunk down in his chariot.

arrow which Jonathan <u>09\_1SA\_20\_37</u> # And when the lad was come to the place of the arrow which Jonathan had shot, Jonathan cried after the lad, and said, [Is] not the arrow beyond thee?

arrow 25 LAM 03 12 # He hath bent his bow, and set me as a mark for the arrow.

arrow <u>20\_PRO\_25\_18</u># A man that beareth false witness against his neighbour [is] a maul, and a sword, and a sharp arrow.

arrows against the <u>19\_PSA\_07\_13</u># He hath also prepared for him the instruments of death; he ordaineth his arrows against the persecutors.

arrows also went <u>19\_PSA\_77\_17</u># The clouds poured out water: the skies sent out a sound: thine arrows also went abroad.

arrows and came <u>09\_1SA\_20\_38</u># And Jonathan cried after the lad, Make speed, haste, stay not. And Jonathan's lad gathered up the arrows, and came to his master.

arrows and death 20\_PRO\_26\_18 # As a mad [man] who casteth firebrands, arrows, and death,

arrows and destroy 19\_PSA\_144\_06 # Cast forth lightning, and scatter them: shoot out thine arrows, and destroy them.

arrows and great <u>14\_2CH\_26\_15</u># And he made in Jerusalem engines, invented by cunning men, to be on the towers and upon the bulwarks, to shoot arrows and great stones withal. And his name spread far abroad; for he was marvellously helped, till he was strong.

arrows And he 12\_2KI\_13\_15 # And Elisha said unto him, Take bow and arrows. And he took unto him bow and arrows.

arrows And he 12 2KI 13 18 # And he said, Take the arrows. And he took [them]. And he said unto the king of Israel, Smite upon the ground. And he smote thrice, and stayed.

arrows and scattered <u>10\_2SA\_22\_15</u># And he sent out arrows, and scattered them; lightning, and discomfited them.

arrows and scattered 19 PSA 18 14 # Yea, he sent out his arrows, and scattered them; and he shot out lightnings, and discomfited them.

arrows and the <u>26\_EZE\_39\_09</u># And they that dwell in the cities of Israel shall go forth, and shall set on fire and burn the weapons, both the shields and the bucklers, the bows and the arrows, and the handstaves, and the spears, and they shall burn them with fire seven years:

arrows bright he <u>26\_EZE\_21\_21</u># For the king of Babylon stood at the parting of the way, at the head of the two ways, to use divination: he made [his] arrows bright, he consulted with images, he looked in the liver.

arrows drunk with <u>05\_DEU\_32\_42</u># I will make mine arrows drunk with blood, and my sword shall devour flesh; [and that] with the blood of the slain and of the captives, from the beginning of revengers upon the enemy.

arrows even bitter 19\_PSA\_64\_03 # Who whet their tongue like a sword, [and] bend [their bows to shoot] their arrows, [even] bitter words:

arrows for she <u>24\_JER\_50\_14</u> # Put yourselves in array against Babylon round about: all ye that bend the bow, shoot at her, spare no arrows: for she hath sinned against the LORD.

arrows gather the <u>24\_JER\_51\_11</u># Make bright the arrows; gather the shields: the LORD hath raised up the spirit of the kings of the Medes: for his device [is] against Babylon, to destroy it; because it [is] the vengeance of the LORD, the vengeance of his temple.

arrows If I <u>09\_1SA\_20\_21</u> # And, behold, I will send a lad, [saying], Go, find out the arrows. If I expressly say unto the lad, Behold, the arrows [are] on this side of thee, take them; then come thou: for [there is] peace to thee, and no hurt; [as] the LORD liveth.

arrows of the <u>19\_PSA\_76\_03</u># There brake he the arrows of the bow, the shield, and the sword, and the battle. Selah.

arrows on the <u>09\_1SA\_20\_20</u> # And I will shoot three arrows on the side [thereof], as though I shot at a mark.

arrows out of <u>13\_1CH\_12\_02</u># [They were] armed with bows, and could use both the right hand and the left in [hurling] stones and [shooting] arrows out of a bow, [even] of Saul's brethren of Benjamin.

arrows shall be <u>24\_JER\_50\_09</u># For, lo, I will raise and cause to come up against Babylon an assembly of great nations from the north country: and they shall set themselves in array against her; from thence she shall be taken: their arrows [shall be] as of a mighty expert man; none shall return in vain.

arrows stick fast 19\_PSA\_38\_02 # For thine arrows stick fast in me, and thy hand presseth me sore.

arrows they went <u>35\_HAB\_03\_11</u># The sun [and] moon stood still in their habitation: at the light of thine arrows they went, [and] at the shining of thy glittering spear.

arrows to fall <u>26\_EZE\_39\_03</u># And I will smite thy bow out of thy left hand, and will cause thine arrows to fall out of thy right hand.

arrows upon them 05\_DEU\_32\_23 # I will heap mischiefs upon them; I will spend mine arrows upon them.

arrows upon thy 19\_PSA\_21\_12 # Therefore shalt thou make them turn their back, [when] thou shalt make ready [thine arrows] upon thy strings against the face of them.

arrows which I <u>09\_1SA\_20\_36</u># And he said unto his lad, Run, find out now the arrows which I shoot. [And] as the lad ran, he shot an arrow beyond him.

arrows 12 2KI 13 15 # And Elisha said unto him, Take bow and arrows. And he took unto him bow and arrows.

arrows <u>04\_NUM\_24\_08</u># God brought him forth out of Egypt; he hath as it were the strength of an unicorn: he shall eat up the nations his enemies, and shall break their bones, and pierce [them] through with his arrows.

borrow and thou <u>05\_DEU\_15\_06</u># For the LORD thy God blesseth thee, as he promised thee: and thou shalt lend unto many nations, but thou shalt not borrow; and thou shalt reign over many nations, but they shall not reign over thee.

borrow not a 12\_2KI\_04\_03 # Then he said, Go, borrow thee vessels abroad of all thy neighbours, [even] empty vessels; borrow not a few.

borrow of her <u>02\_EXO\_03\_22</u> # But every woman shall borrow of her neighbour, and of her that sojourneth in her house, jewels of silver, and jewels of gold, and raiment: and ye shall put [them] upon your sons, and upon your daughters; and ye shall spoil the Egyptians.

borrow of his <u>02\_EXO\_11\_02</u># Speak now in the ears of the people, and let every man borrow of his neighbour, and every woman of her neighbour, jewels of silver, and jewels of gold.

borrow of thee <u>40\_MAT\_05\_42</u># Give to him that asketh thee, and from him that would borrow of thee turn not thou away.

borrow ought of <u>02\_EXO\_22\_14</u># And if a man borrow [ought] of his neighbour, and it be hurt, or die, the owner thereof [being] not with it, he shall surely make [it] good.

borrow thee vessels <u>12\_2KI\_04\_03</u> # Then he said, Go, borrow thee vessels abroad of all thy neighbours, [even] empty vessels; borrow not a few.

borrow <u>05\_DEU\_28\_12</u> # The LORD shall open unto thee his good treasure, the heaven to give the rain unto thy land in his season, and to bless all the work of thine hand: and thou shalt lend unto many nations, and thou shalt not borrow.

borrowed money for <u>16\_NEH\_05\_04</u> # There were also that said, We have borrowed money for the king's tribute, [and that upon] our lands and vineyards.

borrowed of the <u>02\_EXO\_12\_35</u> # And the children of Israel did according to the word of Moses; and they borrowed of the Egyptians jewels of silver, and jewels of gold, and raiment:

borrowed 12\_2KI\_06\_05 # But as one was felling a beam, the ax head fell into the water: and he cried, and said, Alas, master! for it was borrowed.

borrower as with 23 ISA 24 02 # And it shall be, as with the people, so with the priest; as with the servant, so with his master; as with the maid, so with her mistress; as with the buyer, so with the seller; as with the lender, so with the borrower; as with the taker of usury, so with the giver of usury to him.

borrower is servant <u>20\_PRO\_22\_07</u># The rich ruleth over the poor, and the borrower [is] servant to the lender.

borroweth and payeth 19 PSA 37 21 # The wicked borroweth, and payeth not again: but the righteous showeth mercy, and giveth.

brow brass 23\_ISA\_48\_04 # Because I knew that thou [art] obstinate, and thy neck [is] an iron sinew, and thy brow brass;

brow of the <u>42\_LUK\_04\_29</u> # And rose up, and thrust him out of the city, and led him unto the brow of the hill whereon their city was built, that they might cast him down headlong.

brown among the <u>01\_GEN\_30\_33</u> # So shall my righteousness answer for me in time to come, when it shall come for my hire before thy face: every one that [is] not speckled and spotted among the goats, and brown among the sheep, that shall be counted stolen with me.

brown among the <u>01\_GEN\_30\_35</u> # And he removed that day the he goats that were ringstreaked and spotted, and all the she goats that were speckled and spotted, [and] every one that had [some] white in it, and all the brown among the sheep, and gave [them] into the hand of his sons.

brown cattle among <u>01\_GEN\_30\_32</u># I will pass through all thy flock to day, removing from thence all the speckled and spotted cattle, and all the brown cattle among the sheep, and the spotted and speckled among the goats: and [of such] shall be my hire.

brown in the <u>01\_GEN\_30\_40</u> # And Jacob did separate the lambs, and set the faces of the flocks toward the ringstreaked, and all the brown in the flock of Laban; and he put his own flocks by themselves, and put them not unto Laban's cattle.

cockcrowing or in <u>41\_MAR\_13\_35</u># Watch ye therefore: for ye know not when the master of the house cometh, at even, or at midnight, or at the cockcrowing, or in the morning:

crow this day <u>42\_LUK\_22\_34</u> # And he said, I tell thee, Peter, the cock shall not crow this day, before that thou shalt thrice deny that thou knowest me.

crow thou shalt <u>42\_LUK\_22\_61</u> # And the Lord turned, and looked upon Peter. And Peter remembered the word of the Lord, how he had said unto him, Before the cock crow, thou shalt deny me thrice.

crow thou shalt <u>40\_MAT\_26\_34</u># Jesus said unto him, Verily I say unto thee, That this night, before the cock crow, thou shalt deny me thrice.

crow thou shalt <u>40\_MAT\_26\_75</u># And Peter remembered the word of Jesus, which said unto him, Before the cock crow, thou shalt deny me thrice. And he went out, and wept bitterly.

crow till thou <u>43\_JOH\_13\_38</u># Jesus answered him, Wilt thou lay down thy life for my sake? Verily, verily, I say unto thee, The cock shall not crow, till thou hast denied me thrice.

crow twice thou <u>41\_MAR\_14\_30</u> # And Jesus saith unto him, Verily I say unto thee, That this day, [even] in this night, before the cock crow twice, thou shalt deny me thrice.

crow twice thou <u>41\_MAR\_14\_72</u># And the second time the cock crew. And Peter called to mind the word that Jesus said unto him, Before the cock crow twice, thou shalt deny me thrice. And when he thought

thereon, he wept.

crown and gave <u>14\_2CH\_23\_11</u># Then they brought out the king's son, and put upon him the crown, and [gave him] the testimony, and made him king. And Jehoiada and his sons anointed him, and said, God save the king.

crown and in <u>66\_REV\_14\_14</u># And I looked, and behold a white cloud, and upon the cloud [one] sat like unto the Son of man, having on his head a golden crown, and in his hand a sharp sickle.

crown as the <u>03\_LEV\_08\_09</u> # And he put the mitre upon his head; also upon the mitre, [even] upon his forefront, did he put the golden plate, the holy crown; as the LORD commanded Moses.

crown but we <u>46\_1CO\_09\_25</u> # And every man that striveth for the mastery is temperate in all things. Now they [do it] to obtain a corruptible crown; but we an incorruptible.

crown by casting 19 PSA 89 39 # Thou hast made void the covenant of thy servant: thou hast profaned his crown [by casting it] to the ground.

crown endure to <u>20\_PRO\_27\_24</u> # For riches [are] not for ever: and doth the crown [endure] to every generation?

crown flourish 19\_PSA\_132\_18 # His enemies will I clothe with shame: but upon himself shall his crown flourish.

crown from my 18\_JOB\_19\_09 # He hath stripped me of my glory, and taken the crown [from] my head.

crown from off 10 2SA 12 30 # And he took their king's crown from off his head, the weight whereof [was] a talent of gold with the precious stones: and it was [set] on David's head. And he brought forth the spoil of the city in great abundance.

crown is fallen 25\_LAM\_05\_16 # The crown is fallen [from] our head: woe unto us, that we have sinned!

crown lifted up 38\_ZEC\_09\_16 # And the LORD their God shall save them in that day as the flock of his people: for they [shall be as] the stones of a crown, lifted up as an ensign upon his land.

crown of glory 60\_1PE\_05\_04 # And when the chief Shepherd shall appear, ye shall receive a crown of glory that fadeth not away.

crown of glory <u>23\_ISA\_28\_05</u># In that day shall the LORD of hosts be for a crown of glory, and for a diadem of beauty, unto the residue of his people,

crown of glory 23\_ISA\_62\_03# Thou shalt also be a crown of glory in the hand of the LORD, and a royal diadem in the hand of thy God.

crown of glory <u>20\_PRO\_04\_09</u> # She shall give to thine head an ornament of grace: a crown of glory shall she deliver to thee.

crown of glory <u>20\_PRO\_16\_31</u># The hoary head [is] a crown of glory, [if] it be found in the way of righteousness.

crown of gold <u>17\_EST\_08\_15</u># And Mordecai went out from the presence of the king in royal apparel of blue and white, and with a great crown of gold, and with a garment of fine linen and purple: and the city of Shushan rejoiced and was glad.

crown of gold 02\_EXO\_25\_11 # And thou shalt overlay it with pure gold, within and without shalt thou

overlay it, and shalt make upon it a crown of gold round about.

crown of gold <u>02\_EXO\_25\_24</u> # And thou shalt overlay it with pure gold, and make thereto a crown of gold round about.

crown of gold <u>02\_EXO\_30\_03</u> # And thou shalt overlay it with pure gold, the top thereof, and the sides thereof round about, and the horns thereof; and thou shalt make unto it a crown of gold round about.

crown of gold <u>02\_EXO\_37\_02</u># And he overlaid it with pure gold within and without, and made a crown of gold to it round about.

crown of gold <u>02\_EXO\_37\_11</u># And he overlaid it with pure gold, and made thereunto a crown of gold round about.

crown of gold <u>02\_EXO\_37\_12</u> # Also he made thereunto a border of an handbreadth round about; and made a crown of gold for the border thereof round about.

crown of gold <u>02\_EXO\_37\_26</u> # And he overlaid it with pure gold, [both] the top of it, and the sides thereof round about, and the horns of it: also he made unto it a crown of gold round about.

crown of his <u>10\_2SA\_14\_25</u> # But in all Israel there was none to be so much praised as Absalom for his beauty: from the sole of his foot even to the crown of his head there was no blemish in him.

crown of it <u>02\_EXO\_30\_04</u># And two golden rings shalt thou make to it under the crown of it, by the two corners thereof, upon the two sides of it shalt thou make [it]; and they shall be for places for the staves to bear it withal.

crown of life <u>59\_JAM\_01\_12</u># Blessed [is] the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord hath promised to them that love him.

crown of life <u>66\_REV\_02\_10</u># Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the devil shall cast [some] of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days: be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life.

crown of old <u>20\_PRO\_17\_06</u> # Children's children [are] the crown of old men; and the glory of children [are] their fathers.

crown of pride <u>23\_ISA\_28\_01</u> # Woe to the crown of pride, to the drunkards of Ephraim, whose glorious beauty [is] a fading flower, which [are] on the head of the fat valleys of them that are overcome with wine!

crown of pride <u>23\_ISA\_28\_03</u># The crown of pride, the drunkards of Ephraim, shall be trodden under feet:

crown of pure <u>02\_EXO\_39\_30</u># And they made the plate of the holy crown [of] pure gold, and wrote upon it a writing, [like to] the engravings of a signet, HOLINESS TO THE LORD.

crown of pure 19\_PSA\_21\_03 # For thou preventest him with the blessings of goodness: thou settest a crown of pure gold on his head.

crown of rejoicing <u>52\_1TH\_02\_19</u> # For what [is] our hope, or joy, or crown of rejoicing? [Are] not even ye in the presence of our Lord Jesus Christ at his coming?

crown of righteousness <u>55\_2TI\_04\_08</u># Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that love his appearing.

crown of the <u>05\_DEU\_33\_20</u> # And of Gad he said, Blessed [be] he that enlargeth Gad; he dwelleth as a lion, and teareth the arm with the crown of the head.

crown of the <u>01\_GEN\_49\_26</u># The blessings of thy father have prevailed above the blessings of my progenitors unto the utmost bound of the everlasting hills: they shall be on the head of Joseph, and on the crown of the head of him that was separate from his brethren.

crown of the <u>23\_ISA\_03\_17</u># Therefore the Lord will smite with a scab the crown of the head of the daughters of Zion, and the LORD will discover their secret parts.

crown royal which <u>17\_EST\_06\_08</u> # Let the royal apparel be brought which the king [useth] to wear, and the horse that the king rideth upon, and the crown royal which is set upon his head:

crown so stand <u>50\_PHP\_04\_01</u> # Therefore, my brethren, dearly beloved and longed for, my joy and crown, so stand fast in the Lord, [my] dearly beloved.

crown that was 10 2SA 01 10 # So I stood upon him, and slew him, because I was sure that he could not live after that he was fallen: and I took the crown that [was] upon his head, and the bracelet that [was] on his arm, and have brought them hither unto my lord.

crown thereof by <u>02\_EXO\_37\_27</u># And he made two rings of gold for it under the crown thereof, by the two corners of it, upon the two sides thereof, to be places for the staves to bear it withal.

narrow pit 20\_PRO\_23\_27 # For a whore [is] a deep ditch; and a strange woman [is] a narrow pit.

narrow place where <u>04\_NUM\_22\_26</u># And the angel of the LORD went further, and stood in a narrow place, where [was] no way to turn either to the right hand or to the left.

narrow windows and <u>26\_EZE\_41\_16</u># The door posts, and the narrow windows, and the galleries round about on their three stories, over against the door, ceiled with wood round about, and from the ground up to the windows, and the windows [were] covered;

narrow windows and <u>26\_EZE\_41\_26</u># And [there were] narrow windows and palm trees on the one side and on the other side, on the sides of the porch, and [upon] the side chambers of the house, and thick planks.
