bulrush and to <u>23\_ISA\_58\_05</u># Is it such a fast that I have chosen? a day for a man to afflict his soul? [is it] to bow down his head as a bulrush, and to spread sackcloth and ashes [under him]? wilt thou call this a fast, and an acceptable day to the LORD?

bulrushes and daubed <u>02\_EXO\_02\_03</u># And when she could not longer hide him, she took for him an ark of bulrushes, and daubed it with slime and with pitch, and put the child therein; and she laid [it] in the flags by the river's brink.

bulrushes upon the <u>23\_ISA\_18\_02</u> # That sendeth ambassadors by the sea, even in vessels of bulrushes upon the waters, [saying], Go, ye swift messengers, to a nation scattered and peeled, to a people terrible from their beginning hitherto; a nation meted out and trodden down, whose land the rivers have spoiled!

crush my young <u>25\_LAM\_01\_15</u> # The Lord hath trodden under foot all my mighty [men] in the midst of me: he hath called an assembly against me to crush my young men: the Lord hath trodden the virgin, the daughter of Judah, [as] in a winepress.

crush the needy <u>30\_AMO\_04\_01</u> # Hear this word, ye kine of Bashan, that [are] in the mountain of Samaria, which oppress the poor, which crush the needy, which say to their masters, Bring, and let us drink.

crushed in the <u>18\_JOB\_05\_04</u> # His children are far from safety, and they are crushed in the gate, neither [is there] any to deliver [them].

crushed me he <u>24\_JER\_51\_34</u> # Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon hath devoured me, he hath crushed me, he hath made me an empty vessel, he hath swallowed me up like a dragon, he hath filled his belly with my delicates, he hath cast me out.

crushed or broken <u>03\_LEV\_22\_24</u> # Ye shall not offer unto the LORD that which is bruised, or crushed, or broken, or cut; neither shall ye make [any offering thereof] in your land.

rush grow up <u>18\_JOB\_08\_11</u># Can the rush grow up without mire? can the flag grow without water?

rush in one <u>23\_ISA\_09\_14</u># Therefore the LORD will cut off from Israel head and tail, branch and rush, in one day.

rush like the <u>23\_ISA\_17\_13</u># The nations shall rush like the rushing of many waters: but [God] shall rebuke them, and they shall flee far off, and shall be chased as the chaff of the mountains before the wind, and like a rolling thing before the whirlwind.
