Samson And he <u>07_JUD_16_09</u> # Now [there were] men lying in wait, abiding with her in the chamber. And she said unto him, The Philistines [be] upon thee, Samson. And he brake the withs, as a thread of tow is broken when it toucheth the fire. So his strength was not known.

Samson And he <u>07_JUD_16_14</u># And she fastened [it] with the pin, and said unto him, The Philistines [be] upon thee, Samson. And he awaked out of his sleep, and went away with the pin of the beam, and with the web.

Samson And he <u>07_JUD_16_20</u># And she said, The Philistines [be] upon thee, Samson. And he awoke out of his sleep, and said, I will go out as at other times before, and shake myself. And he wist not that the LORD was departed from him.

Samson and of <u>58_HEB_11_32</u># And what shall I more say? for the time would fail me to tell of Gedeon, and [of] Barak, and [of] Samson, and [of] Jephthae; [of] David also, and Samuel, and [of] the prophets:

Samson and the <u>07_JUD_13_24</u># And the woman bare a son, and called his name Samson: and the child grew, and the LORD blessed him.

Samson And there <u>07_JUD_16_12</u> # Delilah therefore took new ropes, and bound him therewith, and said unto him, The Philistines [be] upon thee, Samson. And [there were] liers in wait abiding in the chamber. And he brake them from off his arms like a thread.

Samson are we <u>07_JUD_15_10</u> # And the men of Judah said, Why are ye come up against us? And they answered, To bind Samson are we come up, to do to him as he hath done to us.

Samson Behold thou <u>07_JUD_16_10</u> # And Delilah said unto Samson, Behold, thou hast mocked me, and told me lies: now tell me, I pray thee, wherewith thou mightest be bound.

Samson called unto <u>07_JUD_16_28</u># And Samson called unto the LORD, and said, O Lord GOD, remember me, I pray thee, and strengthen me, I pray thee, only this once, O God, that I may be at once avenged of the Philistines for my two eyes.

Samson down and <u>07_JUD_14_05</u> # Then went Samson down, and his father and his mother, to Timnath, and came to the vineyards of Timnath: and, behold, a young lion roared against him.

Samson Hitherto thou <u>07_JUD_16_13</u># And Delilah said unto Samson, Hitherto thou hast mocked me, and told me lies: tell me wherewith thou mightest be bound. And he said unto her, If thou weavest the seven locks of my head with the web.

Samson is come <u>07_JUD_16_02</u> # [And it was told] the Gazites, saying, Samson is come hither. And they compassed [him] in, and laid wait for him all night in the gate of the city, and were quiet all the night, saying, In the morning, when it is day, we shall kill him.

Samson Knowest thou <u>07_JUD_15_11</u># Then three thousand men of Judah went to the top of the rock Etam, and said to Samson, Knowest thou not that the Philistines [are] rulers over us? what [is] this [that] thou hast done unto us? And he said unto them, As they did unto me, so have I done unto them.

Samson lay till <u>07_JUD_16_03</u> # And Samson lay till midnight, and arose at midnight, and took the doors of

the gate of the city, and the two posts, and went away with them, bar and all, and put [them] upon his shoulders, and carried them up to the top of an hill that [is] before Hebron.

Samson made sport <u>07_JUD_16_27</u># Now the house was full of men and women; and all the lords of the Philistines [were] there; and [there were] upon the roof about three thousand men and women, that beheld while Samson made sport.

Samson made there <u>07_JUD_14_10</u> # So his father went down unto the woman: and Samson made there a feast; for so used the young men to do.

Samson our enemy <u>07_JUD_16_23</u> # Then the lords of the Philistines gathered them together for to offer a great sacrifice unto Dagon their god, and to rejoice: for they said, Our god hath delivered Samson our enemy into our hand.

Samson out of <u>07_JUD_16_25</u># And it came to pass, when their hearts were merry, that they said, Call for Samson, that he may make us sport. And they called for Samson out of the prison house; and he made them sport: and they set him between the pillars.

Samson said concerning <u>07_JUD_15_03</u># And Samson said concerning them, Now shall I be more blameless than the Philistines, though I do them a displeasure.

Samson said Let <u>07_JUD_16_30</u> # And Samson said, Let me die with the Philistines. And he bowed himself with [all his] might; and the house fell upon the lords, and upon all the people that [were] therein. So the dead which he slew at his death were more than [they] which he slew in his life.

Samson said unto <u>07_JUD_14_12</u># And Samson said unto them, I will now put forth a riddle unto you: if ye can certainly declare it me within the seven days of the feast, and find [it] out, then I will give you thirty sheets and thirty change of garments:

Samson said unto <u>07_JUD_15_07</u># And Samson said unto them, Though ye have done this, yet will I be avenged of you, and after that I will cease.

Samson said unto <u>07_JUD_15_12</u># And they said unto him, We are come down to bind thee, that we may deliver thee into the hand of the Philistines. And Samson said unto them, Swear unto me, that ye will not fall upon me yourselves.

Samson said unto <u>07_JUD_16_07</u> # And Samson said unto her, If they bind me with seven green withs that were never dried, then shall I be weak, and be as another man.

Samson said unto <u>07_JUD_16_26</u> # And Samson said unto the lad that held him by the hand, Suffer me that I may feel the pillars whereupon the house standeth, that I may lean upon them.

Samson said With <u>07_JUD_15_16</u> # And Samson said, With the jawbone of an ass, heaps upon heaps, with the jaw of an ass have I slain a thousand men.

Samson Tell me <u>07_JUD_16_06</u> # And Delilah said to Samson, Tell me, I pray thee, wherein thy great strength [lieth], and wherewith thou mightest be bound to afflict thee.
