Samuel abroad <u>09_1SA_09_26</u> # And they arose early: and it came to pass about the spring of the day, that Samuel called Saul to the top of the house, saying, Up, that I may send thee away. And Saul arose, and they went out both of them, he and Samuel, abroad.

Samuel again the <u>09_1SA_03_08</u> # And the LORD called Samuel again the third time. And he arose and went to Eli, and said, Here [am] I; for thou didst call me. And Eli perceived that the LORD had called the child.

Samuel also said <u>09_1SA_15_01</u> # Samuel also said unto Saul, The LORD sent me to anoint thee [to be] king over his people, over Israel: now therefore hearken thou unto the voice of the words of the LORD.

Samuel among them <u>19_PSA_99_06</u># Moses and Aaron among his priests, and Samuel among them that call upon his name; they called upon the LORD, and he answered them.

Samuel and David <u>09_1SA_19_22</u> # Then went he also to Ramah, and came to a great well that [is] in Sechu: and he asked and said, Where [are] Samuel and David? And [one] said, Behold, [they be] at Naioth in Ramah.

Samuel and delivered <u>09_1SA_12_11</u># And the LORD sent Jerubbaal, and Bedan, and Jephthah, and Samuel, and delivered you out of the hand of your enemies on every side, and ye dwelled safe.

Samuel and he <u>09_1SA_03_04</u> # That the LORD called Samuel: and he answered, Here [am] I.

Samuel and he <u>09_1SA_15_11</u># It repenteth me that I have set up Saul [to be] king: for he is turned back from following me, and hath not performed my commandments. And it grieved Samuel; and he cried unto the LORD all night.

Samuel And he <u>09_1SA_16_08</u> # Then Jesse called Abinadab, and made him pass before Samuel. And he said, Neither hath the LORD chosen this.

Samuel and he <u>09_1SA_28_14</u># And he said unto her, What form [is] he of? And she said, An old man cometh up; and he [is] covered with a mantle. And Saul perceived that it [was] Samuel, and he stooped with [his] face to the ground, and bowed himself.

Samuel and of <u>58_HEB_11_32</u># And what shall I more say? for the time would fail me to tell of Gedeon, and [of] Barak, and [of] Samson, and [of] Jephthae; [of] David also, and Samuel, and [of] the prophets:

Samuel and said <u>09_1SA_03_16</u># Then Eli called Samuel, and said, Samuel, my son. And he answered, Here [am] I.

Samuel And Samuel <u>09_1SA_03_06</u> # And the LORD called yet again, Samuel. And Samuel arose and went to Eli, and said, Here [am] I; for thou didst call me. And he answered, I called not, my son; lie down again.

Samuel And Samuel <u>09_1SA_16_10</u># Again, Jesse made seven of his sons to pass before Samuel. And Samuel said unto Jesse, The LORD hath not chosen these.

Samuel and there <u>09_1SA_28_20</u> # Then Saul fell straightway all along on the earth, and was sore afraid, because of the words of Samuel: and there was no strength in him; for he had eaten no bread all the day,

nor all the night.

Samuel and they <u>09_1SA_08_19</u># Nevertheless the people refused to obey the voice of Samuel; and they said, Nay; but we will have a king over us;

Samuel and those <u>44_ACT_03_24</u> # Yea, and all the prophets from Samuel and those that follow after, as many as have spoken, have likewise foretold of these days.

Samuel answered Saul <u>09_1SA_09_19</u># And Samuel answered Saul, and said, I [am] the seer: go up before me unto the high place; for ye shall eat with me to day, and to morrow I will let thee go, and will tell thee all that [is] in thine heart.

Samuel answered Speak <u>09_1SA_03_10</u> # And the LORD came, and stood, and called as at other times, Samuel, Samuel. Then Samuel answered, Speak; for thy servant heareth.

Samuel arose and <u>09_1SA_03_06</u># And the LORD called yet again, Samuel. And Samuel arose and went to Eli, and said, Here [am] I; for thou didst call me. And he answered, I called not, my son; lie down again.

Samuel arose and <u>09_18A_13_15</u># And Samuel arose, and gat him up from Gilgal unto Gibeah of Benjamin. And Saul numbered the people [that were] present with him, about six hundred men.

Samuel Behold I <u>09_1SA_03_11</u># And the LORD said to Samuel, Behold, I will do a thing in Israel, at which both the ears of every one that heareth it shall tingle.

Samuel Bring ye <u>09_1SA_15_32</u># Then said Samuel, Bring ye hither to me Agag the king of the Amalekites. And Agag came unto him delicately. And Agag said, Surely the bitterness of death is past.

Samuel called Saul <u>09_1SA_09_26</u># And they arose early: and it came to pass about the spring of the day, that Samuel called Saul to the top of the house, saying, Up, that I may send thee away. And Saul arose, and they went out both of them, he and Samuel, abroad.

Samuel called the <u>09_1SA_10_17</u># And Samuel called the people together unto the LORD to Mizpeh;

Samuel called unto <u>09_1SA_12_18</u># So Samuel called unto the LORD; and the LORD sent thunder and rain that day: and all the people greatly feared the LORD and Samuel.

Samuel came and <u>09_18A_13_10</u># And it came to pass, that as soon as he had made an end of offering the burnt offering, behold, Samuel came; and Saul went out to meet him, that he might salute him.

Samuel came no <u>09_1SA_15_35</u> # And Samuel came no more to see Saul until the day of his death: nevertheless Samuel mourned for Saul: and the LORD repented that he had made Saul king over Israel.

Samuel came not <u>09_1SA_13_08</u> # And he tarried seven days, according to the set time that Samuel [had appointed]: but Samuel came not to Gilgal; and the people were scattered from him.

Samuel came out <u>09_1SA_09_14</u> # And they went up into the city: [and] when they were come into the city, behold, Samuel came out against them, for to go up to the high place.

Samuel came to <u>09_1SA_04_01</u># And the word of Samuel came to all Israel. Now Israel went out against the Philistines to battle, and pitched beside Ebenezer: and the Philistines pitched in Aphek.

Samuel came to <u>09_18A_15_13</u> # And Samuel came to Saul: and Saul said unto him, Blessed [be] thou of the LORD: I have performed the commandment of the LORD.

Samuel Cease not <u>09_1SA_07_08</u># And the children of Israel said to Samuel, Cease not to cry unto the

LORD our God for us, that he will save us out of the hand of the Philistines.

Samuel communed with <u>09_18A_09_25</u># And when they were come down from the high place into the city, [Samuel] communed with Saul upon the top of the house.

Samuel cried unto <u>09_1SA_07_09</u> # And Samuel took a sucking lamb, and offered [it for] a burnt offering wholly unto the LORD: and Samuel cried unto the LORD for Israel; and the LORD heard him.

Samuel did not <u>09_1SA_03_07</u># Now Samuel did not yet know the LORD, neither was the word of the LORD yet revealed unto him.

Samuel did that <u>09_1SA_16_04</u> # And Samuel did that which the LORD spake, and came to Bethlehem. And the elders of the town trembled at his coming, and said, Comest thou peaceably?

Samuel died and <u>09_1SA_25_01</u># And Samuel died; and all the Israelites were gathered together, and lamented him, and buried him in his house at Ramah. And David arose, and went down to the wilderness of Paran.

Samuel feared to <u>09_1SA_03_15</u> # And Samuel lay until the morning, and opened the doors of the house of the LORD. And Samuel feared to show Eli the vision.

Samuel Go lie <u>09_1SA_03_09</u># Therefore Eli said unto Samuel, Go, lie down: and it shall be, if he call thee, that thou shalt say, Speak, LORD; for thy servant heareth. So Samuel went and lay down in his place.

Samuel God gave <u>09_1SA_10_09</u># And it was [so], that when he had turned his back to go from Samuel, God gave him another heart: and all those signs came to pass that day.

Samuel grew and <u>09_1SA_03_19</u># And Samuel grew, and the LORD was with him, and did let none of his words fall to the ground.

Samuel grew before <u>09_1SA_02_21</u># And the LORD visited Hannah, so that she conceived, and bare three sons and two daughters. And the child Samuel grew before the LORD.

Samuel grew on <u>09_1SA_02_26</u># And the child Samuel grew on, and was in favour both with the LORD, and also with men.

Samuel had appointed <u>09_1SA_13_08</u> # And he tarried seven days, according to the set time that Samuel [had appointed]: but Samuel came not to Gilgal; and the people were scattered from him.

Samuel had caused <u>09_1SA_10_20</u># And when Samuel had caused all the tribes of Israel to come near, the tribe of Benjamin was taken.

Samuel heard all <u>09_1SA_08_21</u># And Samuel heard all the words of the people, and he rehearsed them in the ears of the LORD.

Samuel Hearken unto <u>09_1SA_08_07</u> # And the LORD said unto Samuel, Hearken unto the voice of the people in all that they say unto thee: for they have not rejected thee, but they have rejected me, that I should not reign over them.

Samuel Hearken unto <u>09_1SA_08_22</u># And the LORD said to Samuel, Hearken unto their voice, and make them a king. And Samuel said unto the men of Israel, Go ye every man unto his city.

Samuel hewed Agag <u>09_1SA_15_33</u> # And Samuel said, As thy sword hath made women childless, so shall thy mother be childless among women. And Samuel hewed Agag in pieces before the LORD in Gilgal.

Samuel How long <u>09_1SA_16_01</u> # And the LORD said unto Samuel, How long wilt thou mourn for Saul, seeing I have rejected him from reigning over Israel? fill thine horn with oil, and go, I will send thee to Jesse the Bethlehemite: for I have provided me a king among his sons.

Samuel I have <u>09_1SA_15_24</u> # And Saul said unto Samuel, I have sinned: for I have transgressed the commandment of the LORD, and thy words: because I feared the people, and obeyed their voice.

Samuel in his <u>09_1SA_09_15</u> # Now the LORD had told Samuel in his ear a day before Saul came, saying,

Samuel in like <u>09_1SA_19_24</u> # And he stripped off his clothes also, and prophesied before Samuel in like manner, and lay down naked all that day and all that night. Wherefore they say, [Is] Saul also among the prophets?

Samuel in Shiloh <u>09_1SA_03_21</u> # And the LORD appeared again in Shiloh: for the LORD revealed himself to Samuel in Shiloh by the word of the LORD.

Samuel in the <u>09_1SA_09_18</u># Then Saul drew near to Samuel in the gate, and said, Tell me, I pray thee, where the seer's house [is].

Samuel judged Israel <u>09_1SA_07_15</u># And Samuel judged Israel all the days of his life.

Samuel judged the <u>09_1SA_07_06</u># And they gathered together to Mizpeh, and drew water, and poured [it] out before the LORD, and fasted on that day, and said there, We have sinned against the LORD. And Samuel judged the children of Israel in Mizpeh.

Samuel lay until <u>09_1SA_03_15</u> # And Samuel lay until the morning, and opened the doors of the house of the LORD. And Samuel feared to show Eli the vision.

Samuel Look not <u>09_1SA_16_07</u> # But the LORD said unto Samuel, Look not on his countenance, or on the height of his stature; because I have refused him: for [the LORD seeth] not as man seeth; for man looketh on the outward appearance, but the LORD looketh on the heart.

Samuel ministered before <u>09_1SA_02_18</u># But Samuel ministered before the LORD, [being] a child, girded with a linen ephod.

Samuel ministered unto <u>09_1SA_03_01</u># And the child Samuel ministered unto the LORD before Eli. And the word of the LORD was precious in those days; [there was] no open vision.

Samuel mourned for <u>09_1SA_15_35</u># And Samuel came no more to see Saul until the day of his death: nevertheless Samuel mourned for Saul: and the LORD repented that he had made Saul king over Israel.

Samuel my son <u>09_1SA_03_16</u># Then Eli called Samuel, and said, Samuel, my son. And he answered, Here [am] I.

Samuel Pray for <u>09_1SA_12_19</u># And all the people said unto Samuel, Pray for thy servants unto the LORD thy God, that we die not: for we have added unto all our sins [this] evil, to ask us a king.

Samuel prayed unto <u>09_1SA_08_06</u># But the thing displeased Samuel, when they said, Give us a king to judge us. And Samuel prayed unto the LORD.

Samuel rose early <u>09_1SA_15_12</u> # And when Samuel rose early to meet Saul in the morning, it was told Samuel, saying, Saul came to Carmel, and, behold, he set him up a place, and is gone about, and passed on, and gone down to Gilgal.

Samuel rose up <u>09_1SA_16_13</u># Then Samuel took the horn of oil, and anointed him in the midst of his

brethren: and the spirit of the LORD came upon David from that day forward. So Samuel rose up, and went to Ramah.

Samuel said As <u>09_1SA_15_33</u> # And Samuel said, As thy sword hath made women childless, so shall thy mother be childless among women. And Samuel hewed Agag in pieces before the LORD in Gilgal.

Samuel said Behold <u>09_1SA_09_24</u># And the cook took up the shoulder, and [that] which [was] upon it, and set [it] before Saul. And [Samuel] said, Behold that which is left! set [it] before thee, [and] eat: for unto this time hath it been kept for thee since I said, I have invited the people. So Saul did eat with Samuel that day.

Samuel said Gather <u>09_1SA_07_05</u># And Samuel said, Gather all Israel to Mizpeh, and I will pray for you unto the LORD.

Samuel said Hath <u>09_1SA_15_22</u># And Samuel said, Hath the LORD [as great] delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey [is] better than sacrifice, [and] to hearken than the fat of rams.

Samuel said How <u>09_1SA_16_02</u> # And Samuel said, How can I go? if Saul hear [it], he will kill me. And the LORD said, Take an heifer with thee, and say, I am come to sacrifice to the LORD.

Samuel said to <u>09_1SA_09_27</u> # [And] as they were going down to the end of the city, Samuel said to Saul, Bid the servant pass on before us, [and he passed on,] but stand thou still a while, that I may show thee the word of God.

Samuel said to <u>09_1SA_10_24</u># And Samuel said to all the people, See ye him whom the LORD hath chosen, that [there is] none like him among all the people? And all the people shouted, and said, God save the king.

Samuel said to <u>09_1SA_13_13</u> # And Samuel said to Saul, Thou hast done foolishly: thou hast not kept the commandment of the LORD thy God, which he commanded thee: for now would the LORD have established thy kingdom upon Israel for ever.

Samuel said to <u>09_1SA_28_15</u> # And Samuel said to Saul, Why hast thou disquieted me, to bring me up? And Saul answered, I am sore distressed; for the Philistines make war against me, and God is departed from me, and answereth me no more, neither by prophets, nor by dreams: therefore I have called thee, that thou mayest make known unto me what I shall do.

Samuel said unto <u>09_1SA_08_22</u> # And the LORD said to Samuel, Hearken unto their voice, and make them a king. And Samuel said unto the men of Israel, Go ye every man unto his city.

Samuel said unto <u>09_1SA_12_20</u> # And Samuel said unto the people, Fear not: ye have done all this wickedness: yet turn not aside from following the LORD, but serve the LORD with all your heart;

Samuel said unto <u>09_1SA_15_16</u># Then Samuel said unto Saul, Stay, and I will tell thee what the LORD hath said to me this night. And he said unto him, Say on.

Samuel said unto <u>09_1SA_15_26</u># And Samuel said unto Saul, I will not return with thee: for thou hast rejected the word of the LORD, and the LORD hath rejected thee from being king over Israel.

Samuel said unto <u>09_1SA_15_28</u># And Samuel said unto him, The LORD hath rent the kingdom of Israel from thee this day, and hath given it to a neighbour of thine, [that is] better than thou.

Samuel said unto <u>09_1SA_16_10</u># Again, Jesse made seven of his sons to pass before Samuel. And Samuel said unto Jesse, The LORD hath not chosen these.

Samuel said unto <u>09_1SA_16_11</u># And Samuel said unto Jesse, Are here all [thy] children? And he said, There remaineth yet the youngest, and, behold, he keepeth the sheep. And Samuel said unto Jesse, Send and fetch him: for we will not sit down till he come hither.

Samuel said When <u>09_1SA_15_17</u># And Samuel said, When thou [wast] little in thine own sight, [wast] thou not [made] the head of the tribes of Israel, and the LORD anointed thee king over Israel?

Samuel Samuel Then <u>09_1SA_03_10</u> # And the LORD came, and stood, and called as at other times, Samuel, Samuel. Then Samuel answered, Speak; for thy servant heareth.

Samuel saw Saul <u>09_18A_09_17</u># And when Samuel saw Saul, the LORD said unto him, Behold the man whom I spake to thee of! this same shall reign over my people.

Samuel saying Because <u>09_1SA_01_20</u># Wherefore it came to pass, when the time was come about after Hannah had conceived, that she bare a son, and called his name Samuel, [saying], Because I have asked him of the LORD.

Samuel saying Saul <u>09_1SA_15_12</u># And when Samuel rose early to meet Saul in the morning, it was told Samuel, saying, Saul came to Carmel, and, behold, he set him up a place, and is gone about, and passed on, and gone down to Gilgal.

Samuel saying <u>09_1SA_15_10</u> # Then came the word of the LORD unto Samuel, saying,

Samuel sent all <u>09_1SA_10_25</u> # Then Samuel told the people the manner of the kingdom, and wrote [it] in a book, and laid [it] up before the LORD. And Samuel sent all the people away, every man to his house.

Samuel she cried <u>09_1SA_28_12</u> # And when the woman saw Samuel, she cried with a loud voice: and the woman spake to Saul, saying, Why hast thou deceived me? for thou [art] Saul.

Samuel so shall <u>09_1SA_11_07</u> # And he took a yoke of oxen, and hewed them in pieces, and sent [them] throughout all the coasts of Israel by the hands of messengers, saying, Whosoever cometh not forth after Saul and after Samuel, so shall it be done unto his oxen. And the fear of the LORD fell on the people, and

they came out with one consent.

Samuel spake unto <u>09_1SA_07_03</u> # And Samuel spake unto all the house of Israel, saying, If ye do return unto the LORD with all your hearts, [then] put away the strange gods and Ashtaroth from among you, and prepare your hearts unto the LORD, and serve him only: and he will deliver you out of the hand of the Philistines.

Samuel standing as <u>09_1SA_19_20</u> # And Saul sent messengers to take David: and when they saw the company of the prophets prophesying, and Samuel standing [as] appointed over them, the spirit of God was upon the messengers of Saul, and they also prophesied.

Samuel stood before <u>24_JER_15_01</u># Then said the LORD unto me, Though Moses and Samuel stood before me, [yet] my mind [could] not [be] toward this people: cast [them] out of my sight, and let them go forth.

Samuel that day <u>09_1SA_09_24</u> # And the cook took up the shoulder, and [that] which [was] upon it, and set [it] before Saul. And [Samuel] said, Behold that which is left! set [it] before thee, [and] eat: for unto this time hath it been kept for thee since I said, I have invited the people. So Saul did eat with Samuel that day.

Samuel the firstborn <u>13_1CH_06_28</u> # And the sons of Samuel; the firstborn Vashni, and Abiah.

Samuel the prophet <u>14_2CH_35_18</u> # And there was no passover like to that kept in Israel from the days of Samuel the prophet; neither did all the kings of Israel keep such a passover as Josiah kept, and the priests, and the Levites, and all Judah and Israel that were present, and the inhabitants of Jerusalem.

Samuel the prophet <u>44_ACT_13_20</u> # And after that he gave [unto them] judges about the space of four hundred and fifty years, until Samuel the prophet.

Samuel the seer <u>13_1CH_09_22</u> # All these [which were] chosen to be porters in the gates [were] two hundred and twelve. These were reckoned by their genealogy in their villages, whom David and Samuel the seer did ordain in their set office.

Samuel the seer <u>13_1CH_26_28</u> # And all that Samuel the seer, and Saul the son of Kish, and Abner the son of Ner, and Joab the son of Zeruiah, had dedicated; [and] whosoever had dedicated [any thing, it was] under the hand of Shelomith, and of his brethren.

Samuel the seer <u>13_1CH_29_29</u> # Now the acts of David the king, first and last, behold, they [are] written in the book of Samuel the seer, and in the book of Nathan the prophet, and in the book of Gad the seer,

Samuel Then Samuel <u>09_1SA_03_10</u># And the LORD came, and stood, and called as at other times, Samuel, Samuel. Then Samuel answered, Speak; for thy servant heareth.

It [is] the LORD: let him do what seemeth him good.

Samuel told the <u>09_1SA_10_25</u> # Then Samuel told the people the manner of the kingdom, and wrote [it] in a book, and laid [it] up before the LORD. And Samuel sent all the people away, every man to his house.

Samuel took a <u>09_1SA_07_09</u> # And Samuel took a sucking lamb, and offered [it for] a burnt offering wholly unto the LORD: and Samuel cried unto the LORD for Israel; and the LORD heard him.

Samuel took a <u>09_1SA_07_12</u> # Then Samuel took a stone, and set [it] between Mizpeh and Shen, and called the name of it Ebenezer, saying, Hitherto hath the LORD helped us.

Samuel took a <u>09_1SA_10_01</u> # Then Samuel took a vial of oil, and poured [it] upon his head, and kissed him, and said, [Is it] not because the LORD hath anointed thee [to be] captain over his inheritance?

Samuel took Saul <u>09_1SA_09_22</u># And Samuel took Saul and his servant, and brought them into the parlour, and made them sit in the chiefest place among them that were bidden, which [were] about thirty persons.

Samuel took the <u>09_1SA_16_13</u># Then Samuel took the horn of oil, and anointed him in the midst of his brethren: and the spirit of the LORD came upon David from that day forward. So Samuel rose up, and went to Ramah.

Samuel turned about <u>09_1SA_15_27</u># And as Samuel turned about to go away, he laid hold upon the skirt of his mantle, and it rent.

Samuel turned again <u>09_1SA_15_31</u># So Samuel turned again after Saul; and Saul worshipped the LORD.

Samuel unto Ramah <u>09_1SA_08_04</u># Then all the elders of Israel gathered themselves together, and came to Samuel unto Ramah,

Samuel was dead <u>09_1SA_28_03</u> # Now Samuel was dead, and all Israel had lamented him, and buried him in Ramah, even in his own city. And Saul had put away those that had familiar spirits, and the wizards, out of the land.

Samuel was established <u>09_1SA_03_20</u> # And all Israel from Dan even to Beersheba knew that Samuel [was] established [to be] a prophet of the LORD.

Samuel was laid <u>09_1SA_03_03</u># And ere the lamp of God went out in the temple of the LORD, where the ark of God [was], and Samuel was laid down [to sleep];

Samuel was offering <u>09_1SA_07_10</u> # And as Samuel was offering up the burnt offering, the Philistines drew near to battle against Israel: but the LORD thundered with a great thunder on that day upon the Philistines, and discomfited them; and they were smitten before Israel.

Samuel was old <u>09_1SA_08_01</u> # And it came to pass, when Samuel was old, that he made his sons judges over Israel.

Samuel went and <u>09_1SA_03_09</u># Therefore Eli said unto Samuel, Go, lie down: and it shall be, if he call thee, that thou shalt say, Speak, LORD; for thy servant heareth. So Samuel went and lay down in his place.

Samuel went and <u>09_1SA_19_18</u># So David fled, and escaped, and came to Samuel to Ramah, and told him all that Saul had done to him. And he and Samuel went and dwelt in Naioth.

Samuel went to <u>09_1SA_15_34</u># Then Samuel went to Ramah; and Saul went up to his house to Gibeah of Saul.

Samuel when they <u>09_1SA_08_06</u># But the thing displeased Samuel, when they said, Give us a king to judge us. And Samuel prayed unto the LORD.

Samuel Wherefore then <u>09_1SA_28_16</u># Then said Samuel, Wherefore then dost thou ask of me, seeing the LORD is departed from thee, and is become thine enemy?

Samuel Who is <u>09_1SA_11_12</u># And the people said unto Samuel, Who [is] he that said, Shall Saul reign over us? bring the men, that we may put them to death.

Samuel Yea I<u>09_1SA_15_20</u># And Saul said unto Samuel, Yea, I have obeyed the voice of the LORD, and have gone the way which the LORD sent me, and have brought Agag the king of Amalek, and have utterly destroyed the Amalekites.

Samuel <u>13_1CH_11_03</u># Therefore came all the elders of Israel to the king to Hebron; and David made a covenant with them in Hebron before the LORD; and they anointed David king over Israel, according to the word of the LORD by Samuel.

Samuel <u>09_1SA_07_13</u># So the Philistines were subdued, and they came no more into the coast of Israel: and the hand of the LORD was against the Philistines all the days of Samuel.

Samuel <u>09_1SA_10_14</u># And Saul's uncle said unto him and to his servant, Whither went ye? And he said, To seek the asses: and when we saw that [they were] no where, we came to Samuel.

Samuel <u>09_1SA_12_18</u># So Samuel called unto the LORD; and the LORD sent thunder and rain that day: and all the people greatly feared the LORD and Samuel.

Samuel <u>09_1SA_28_11</u># Then said the woman, Whom shall I bring up unto thee? And he said, Bring me up Samuel.
