assault made both <u>44\_ACT\_14\_05</u> # And when there was an assault made both of the Gentiles, and also of the Jews with their rulers, to use [them] despitefully, and to stone them,

assault them both <u>17\_EST\_08\_11</u> # Wherein the king granted the Jews which [were] in every city to gather themselves together, and to stand for their life, to destroy, to slay, and to cause to perish, all the power of the people and province that would assault them, [both] little ones and women, and [to take] the spoil of them for a prey,

assaulted the house <u>44\_ACT\_17\_05</u> # But the Jews which believed not, moved with envy, took unto them certain lewd fellows of the baser sort, and gathered a company, and set all the city on an uproar, and assaulted the house of Jason, and sought to bring them out to the people.

Saul a choice <u>09\_1SA\_09\_02</u> # And he had a son, whose name [was] Saul, a choice young man, and a goodly: and [there was] not among the children of Israel a goodlier person than he: from his shoulders and upward [he was] higher than any of the people.

Saul a servant <u>10\_2SA\_09\_02</u> # And [there was] of the house of Saul a servant whose name [was] Ziba. And when they had called him unto David, the king said unto him, [Art] thou Ziba? And he said, Thy servant [is he].

Saul abode in <u>09\_1SA\_22\_06</u># When Saul heard that David was discovered, and the men that [were] with him, [now Saul abode in Gibeah under a tree in Ramah, having his spear in his hand, and all his servants [were] standing about him;]

Saul again and <u>09\_1SA\_09\_08</u> # And the servant answered Saul again, and said, Behold, I have here at hand the fourth part of a shekel of silver: [that] will I give to the man of God, to tell us our way.

Saul also among <u>09\_1SA\_10\_11</u># And it came to pass, when all that knew him beforetime saw that, behold, he prophesied among the prophets, then the people said one to another, What [is] this [that] is come unto the son of Kish? [Is] Saul also among the prophets?

Saul also among <u>09\_1SA\_10\_12</u> # And one of the same place answered and said, But who [is] their father? Therefore it became a proverb, [Is] Saul also among the prophets?

Saul also among <u>09\_1SA\_19\_24</u> # And he stripped off his clothes also, and prophesied before Samuel in like manner, and lay down naked all that day and all that night. Wherefore they say, [Is] Saul also among the prophets?

Saul also and <u>09\_1SA\_23\_25</u># Saul also and his men went to seek [him]. And they told David: wherefore he came down into a rock, and abode in the wilderness of Maon. And when Saul heard [that], he pursued after David in the wilderness of Maon.

Saul also sent <u>09\_1SA\_19\_11</u># Saul also sent messengers unto David's house, to watch him, and to slay him in the morning: and Michal David's wife told him, saying, If thou save not thy life to night, to morrow thou shalt be slain.

Saul also went <u>09\_1SA\_10\_26</u># And Saul also went home to Gibeah; and there went with him a band of men, whose hearts God had touched.

Saul and after <u>13\_1CH\_10\_02</u># And the Philistines followed hard after Saul, and after his sons; and the Philistines slew Jonathan, and Abinadab, and Malchishua, the sons of Saul.

Saul and after <u>09\_1SA\_11\_07</u> # And he took a yoke of oxen, and hewed them in pieces, and sent [them] throughout all the coasts of Israel by the hands of messengers, saying, Whosoever cometh not forth after Saul and after Samuel, so shall it be done unto his oxen. And the fear of the LORD fell on the people, and they came out with one consent.

Saul and all <u>09\_1SA\_11\_15</u># And all the people went to Gilgal; and there they made Saul king before the LORD in Gilgal; and there they sacrificed sacrifices of peace offerings before the LORD; and there Saul and all the men of Israel rejoiced greatly.

Saul and all <u>09\_1SA\_14\_20</u># And Saul and all the people that [were] with him assembled themselves, and they came to the battle: and, behold, every man's sword was against his fellow, [and there was] a very great discomfiture.

Saul and all <u>09\_1SA\_17\_11</u># When Saul and all Israel heard those words of the Philistine, they were dismayed, and greatly afraid.

Saul and an <u>09\_1SA\_16\_14</u># But the spirit of the LORD departed from Saul, and an evil spirit from the LORD troubled him.

Saul and before <u>09\_1SA\_28\_25</u> # And she brought [it] before Saul, and before his servants; and they did eat. Then they rose up, and went away that night.

Saul and brought <u>10\_2SA\_02\_08</u># But Abner the son of Ner, captain of Saul's host, took Ishbosheth the son of Saul, and brought him over to Mahanaim;

Saul and desired <u>44\_ACT\_13\_07</u># Which was with the deputy of the country, Sergius Paulus, a prudent man; who called for Barnabas and Saul, and desired to hear the word of God.

Saul and for <u>10\_2SA\_01\_12</u> # And they mourned, and wept, and fasted until even, for Saul, and for Jonathan his son, and for the people of the LORD, and for the house of Israel; because they were fallen by the sword.

Saul and for <u>10\_2SA\_21\_01</u> # Then there was a famine in the days of David three years, year after year; and David inquired of the LORD. And the LORD answered, [It is] for Saul, and for [his] bloody house, because he slew the Gibeonites.

Saul and have <u>10\_2SA\_02\_05</u> # And David sent messengers unto the men of Jabeshgilead, and said unto them, Blessed [be] ye of the LORD, that ye have showed this kindness unto your lord, [even] unto Saul, and have buried him.

Saul and he <u>09\_18A\_17\_31</u># And when the words were heard which David spake, they rehearsed [them] before Saul: and he sent for him.

Saul and he <u>09\_1SA\_18\_10</u># And it came to pass on the morrow, that the evil spirit from God came upon Saul, and he prophesied in the midst of the house: and David played with his hand, as at other times: and [there was] a javelin in Saul's hand.

Saul and he <u>09\_1SA\_19\_07</u># And Jonathan called David, and Jonathan showed him all those things. And Jonathan brought David to Saul, and he was in his presence, as in times past.

Saul And he <u>19\_PSA\_18\_01</u> # To the chief Musician, [A Psalm] of David, the servant of the LORD, who

spake unto the LORD the words of this song in the day [that] the LORD delivered him from the hand of all his enemies, and from the hand of Saul: And he said, I will love thee, O LORD, my strength.

Saul and his <u>13\_1CH\_10\_07</u># And when all the men of Israel that [were] in the valley saw that they fled, and that Saul and his sons were dead, then they forsook their cities, and fled: and the Philistines came and dwelt in them.

Saul and his <u>13\_1CH\_10\_08</u> # And it came to pass on the morrow, when the Philistines came to strip the slain, that they found Saul and his sons fallen in mount Gilboa.

Saul and his <u>09\_1SA\_09\_22</u> # And Samuel took Saul and his servant, and brought them into the parlour, and made them sit in the chiefest place among them that were bidden, which [were] about thirty persons.

Saul and his <u>09\_1SA\_23\_26</u> # And Saul went on this side of the mountain, and David and his men on that side of the mountain: and David made haste to get away for fear of Saul; for Saul and his men compassed David and his men round about to take them.

Saul and his <u>09\_1SA\_31\_07</u> # And when the men of Israel that [were] on the other side of the valley, and [they] that [were] on the other side Jordan, saw that the men of Israel fled, and that Saul and his sons were dead, they forsook the cities, and fled; and the Philistines came and dwelt in them.

Saul and his <u>09\_1SA\_31\_08</u> # And it came to pass on the morrow, when the Philistines came to strip the slain, that they found Saul and his three sons fallen in mount Gilboa.

Saul and his <u>10\_2SA\_19\_17</u> # And [there were] a thousand men of Benjamin with him, and Ziba the servant of the house of Saul, and his fifteen sons and his twenty servants with him; and they went over Jordan before the king.

Saul and Jonathan <u>09\_1SA\_13\_16</u># And Saul, and Jonathan his son, and the people [that were] present with them, abode in Gibeah of Benjamin: but the Philistines encamped in Michmash.

Saul and Jonathan <u>09\_1SA\_13\_22</u># So it came to pass in the day of battle, that there was neither sword nor spear found in the hand of any of the people that [were] with Saul and Jonathan: but with Saul and with Jonathan his son was there found.

Saul and Jonathan <u>09\_1SA\_14\_21</u> # Moreover the Hebrews [that] were with the Philistines before that time, which went up with them into the camp [from the country] round about, even they also [turned] to be with the Israelites that [were] with Saul and Jonathan.

Saul and Jonathan 09\_18A\_14\_41 # Therefore Saul said unto the LORD God of Israel, Give a perfect [lot]. And Saul and Jonathan were taken: but the people escaped.

Saul and Jonathan <u>10\_2SA\_01\_04</u># And David said unto him, How went the matter? I pray thee, tell me. And he answered, That the people are fled from the battle, and many of the people also are fallen and dead; and Saul and Jonathan his son are dead also.

Saul and Jonathan <u>10\_28A\_01\_05</u> # And David said unto the young man that told him, How knowest thou that Saul and Jonathan his son be dead?

Saul and Jonathan <u>10\_2SA\_01\_23</u> # Saul and Jonathan [were] lovely and pleasant in their lives, and in their death they were not divided: they were swifter than eagles, they were stronger than lions.

Saul and Jonathan <u>10\_2SA\_04\_04</u> # And Jonathan, Saul's son, had a son [that was] lame of [his] feet. He was five years old when the tidings came of Saul and Jonathan out of Jezreel, and his nurse took him up, and fled: and it came to pass, as she made haste to flee, that he fell, and became lame. And his name [was]

Mephibosheth.

Saul and Jonathan <u>10\_2SA\_21\_14</u># And the bones of Saul and Jonathan his son buried they in the country of Benjamin in Zelah, in the sepulchre of Kish his father: and they performed all that the king commanded. And after that God was entreated for the land.

Saul and Ner <u>09\_1SA\_14\_51</u> # And Kish [was] the father of Saul; and Ner the father of Abner [was] the son of Abiel.

Saul and of <u>10\_2SA\_04\_08</u> # And they brought the head of Ishbosheth unto David to Hebron, and said to the king, Behold the head of Ishbosheth the son of Saul thine enemy, which sought thy life; and the LORD hath avenged my lord the king this day of Saul, and of his seed.

Saul and over <u>10\_2SA\_01\_17</u># And David lamented with this lamentation over Saul and over Jonathan his son:

Saul and said <u>09\_1SA\_09\_19</u># And Samuel answered Saul, and said, I [am] the seer: go up before me unto the high place; for ye shall eat with me to day, and to morrow I will let thee go, and will tell thee all that [is] in thine heart.

Saul and said <u>09\_1SA\_22\_09</u># Then answered Doeg the Edomite, which was set over the servants of Saul, and said, I saw the son of Jesse coming to Nob, to Ahimelech the son of Ahitub.

Saul and said <u>19\_PSA\_52\_01</u># To the chief Musician, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David, when Doeg the Edomite came and told Saul, and said unto him, David is come to the house of Ahimelech. Why boastest thou thyself in mischief, O mighty man? the goodness of God [endureth] continually.

Saul And Samuel <u>09\_1SA\_09\_24</u> # And the cook took up the shoulder, and [that] which [was] upon it, and set [it] before Saul. And [Samuel] said, Behold that which is left! set [it] before thee, [and] eat: for unto this time hath it been kept for thee since I said, I have invited the people. So Saul did eat with Samuel that day.

Saul and Saul <u>13\_1CH\_08\_33</u># And Ner begat Kish, and Kish begat Saul, and Saul begat Jonathan, and Malchishua, and Abinadab, and Eshbaal.

Saul and Saul <u>13\_1CH\_09\_39</u># And Ner begat Kish; and Kish begat Saul; and Saul begat Jonathan, and Malchishua, and Abinadab, and Eshbaal.

Saul and Saul <u>09\_1SA\_15\_13</u> # And Samuel came to Saul: and Saul said unto him, Blessed [be] thou of the LORD: I have performed the commandment of the LORD.

Saul and Saul <u>09\_1SA\_15\_31</u> # So Samuel turned again after Saul; and Saul worshipped the LORD.

Saul And Saul <u>09\_1SA\_24\_22</u> # And David sware unto Saul. And Saul went home; but David and his men gat them up unto the hold.

Saul and saw <u>09\_1SA\_28\_21</u> # And the woman came unto Saul, and saw that he was sore troubled, and said unto him, Behold, thine handmaid hath obeyed thy voice, and I have put my life in my hand, and have hearkened unto thy words which thou spakest unto me.

Saul and stood <u>09\_1SA\_16\_21</u> # And David came to Saul, and stood before him: and he loved him greatly; and he became his armourbearer.

Saul and the <u>13\_1CH\_10\_03</u> # And the battle went sore against Saul, and the archers hit him, and he was wounded of the archers.

Saul and the <u>13\_1CH\_10\_12</u> # They arose, all the valiant men, and took away the body of Saul, and the bodies of his sons, and brought them to Jabesh, and buried their bones under the oak in Jabesh, and fasted seven days.

Saul and the <u>09\_1SA\_15\_09</u># But Saul and the people spared Agag, and the best of the sheep, and of the oxen, and of the fatlings, and the lambs, and all [that was] good, and would not utterly destroy them: but every thing [that was] vile and refuse, that they destroyed utterly.

Saul and the <u>09\_1SA\_15\_35</u># And Samuel came no more to see Saul until the day of his death: nevertheless Samuel mourned for Saul: and the LORD repented that he had made Saul king over Israel.

Saul and the <u>09\_1SA\_17\_02</u># And Saul and the men of Israel were gathered together, and pitched by the valley of Elah, and set the battle in array against the Philistines.

Saul and the <u>09\_1SA\_18\_20</u># And Michal Saul's daughter loved David: and they told Saul, and the thing pleased him.

Saul And the <u>09\_1SA\_23\_12</u> # Then said David, Will the men of Keilah deliver me and my men into the hand of Saul? And the LORD said, They will deliver [thee] up.

Saul and the <u>09\_1SA\_31\_03</u># And the battle went sore against Saul, and the archers hit him; and he was sore wounded of the archers.

Saul and the <u>09\_1SA\_31\_12</u># All the valiant men arose, and went all night, and took the body of Saul and the bodies of his sons from the wall of Bethshan, and came to Jabesh, and burnt them there.

Saul and the <u>10\_2SA\_03\_01</u> # Now there was long war between the house of Saul and the house of David: but David waxed stronger and stronger, and the house of Saul waxed weaker and weaker.

Saul and the <u>10\_2SA\_03\_06</u> # And it came to pass, while there was war between the house of Saul and the house of David, that Abner made himself strong for the house of Saul.

Saul and the <u>10\_2SA\_21\_12</u># And David went and took the bones of Saul and the bones of Jonathan his son from the men of Jabeshgilead, which had stolen them from the street of Bethshan, where the Philistines had hanged them, when the Philistines had slain Saul in Gilboa:

Saul and the <u>10\_2SA\_21\_13</u># And he brought up from thence the bones of Saul and the bones of Jonathan his son; and they gathered the bones of them that were hanged.

Saul and they <u>09\_18A\_17\_19</u># Now Saul, and they, and all the men of Israel, [were] in the valley of Elah, fighting with the Philistines.

Saul and they <u>09\_1SA\_19\_20</u># And Saul sent messengers to take David: and when they saw the company of the prophets prophesying, and Samuel standing [as] appointed over them, the spirit of God was upon the messengers of Saul, and they also prophesied.

Saul And they <u>44\_ACT\_09\_24</u> # But their laying await was known of Saul. And they watched the gates day and night to kill him.

Saul and to <u>10\_2SA\_03\_10</u> # To translate the kingdom from the house of Saul, and to set up the throne of David over Israel and over Judah, from Dan even to Beersheba.

Saul and to <u>10\_2SA\_09\_09</u># Then the king called to Ziba, Saul's servant, and said unto him, I have given unto thy master's son all that pertained to Saul and to all his house.

Saul and told <u>09\_1SA\_11\_04</u># Then came the messengers to Gibeah of Saul, and told the tidings in the ears of the people: and all the people lifted up their voices, and wept.

Saul and twelve <u>10\_2SA\_02\_15</u># Then there arose and went over by number twelve of Benjamin, which [pertained] to Ishbosheth the son of Saul, and twelve of the servants of David.

Saul and upon <u>09\_1SA\_31\_02</u># And the Philistines followed hard upon Saul and upon his sons; and the Philistines slew Jonathan, and Abinadab, and Melchishua, Saul's sons.

Saul and went <u>09\_1SA\_21\_10</u># And David arose, and fled that day for fear of Saul, and went to Achish the king of Gath.

Saul and when <u>09\_1SA\_14\_52</u># And there was sore war against the Philistines all the days of Saul: and when Saul saw any strong man, or any valiant man, he took him unto him.

Saul and with <u>09\_1SA\_13\_22</u> # So it came to pass in the day of battle, that there was neither sword nor spear found in the hand of any of the people that [were] with Saul and Jonathan: but with Saul and with Jonathan his son was there found.

Saul answered and <u>09\_1SA\_09\_21</u># And Saul answered and said, [Am] not I a Benjamite, of the smallest of the tribes of Israel? and my family the least of all the families of the tribe of Benjamin? wherefore then speakest thou so to me?

Saul answered God <u>09\_1SA\_14\_44</u># And Saul answered, God do so and more also: for thou shalt surely die, Jonathan.

Saul answered I <u>09\_1SA\_28\_15</u> # And Samuel said to Saul, Why hast thou disquieted me, to bring me up? And Saul answered, I am sore distressed; for the Philistines make war against me, and God is departed from me, and answereth me no more, neither by prophets, nor by dreams: therefore I have called thee, that thou mayest make known unto me what I shall do.

Saul armed David <u>09\_1SA\_17\_38</u> # And Saul armed David with his armour, and he put an helmet of brass upon his head; also he armed him with a coat of mail.

Saul Armoni and <u>10\_2SA\_21\_08</u> # But the king took the two sons of Rizpah the daughter of Aiah, whom she bare unto Saul, Armoni and Mephibosheth; and the five sons of Michal the daughter of Saul, whom she brought up for Adriel the son of Barzillai the Meholathite:

Saul arose and <u>09\_1SA\_09\_26</u># And they arose early: and it came to pass about the spring of the day, that Samuel called Saul to the top of the house, saying, Up, that I may send thee away. And Saul arose, and they went out both of them, he and Samuel, abroad.

Saul arose and <u>09\_18A\_26\_02</u># Then Saul arose, and went down to the wilderness of Ziph, having three thousand chosen men of Israel with him, to seek David in the wilderness of Ziph.

Saul arose from <u>44\_ACT\_09\_08</u> # And Saul arose from the earth; and when his eyes were opened, he saw no man: but they led him by the hand, and brought [him] into Damascus.

Saul as he <u>09\_1SA\_19\_09</u> # And the evil spirit from the LORD was upon Saul, as he sat in his house with his javelin in his hand: and David played with [his] hand.

Saul as though <u>10\_28A\_01\_21</u># Ye mountains of Gilboa, [let there be] no dew, neither [let there be] rain, upon you, nor fields of offerings: for there the shield of the mighty is vilely cast away, the shield of Saul, [as though he had] not [been] anointed with oil.

Saul asked counsel <u>09\_1SA\_14\_37</u> # And Saul asked counsel of God, Shall I go down after the Philistines? wilt thou deliver them into the hand of Israel? But he answered him not that day.

Saul became David's <u>09\_1SA\_18\_29</u> # And Saul was yet the more afraid of David; and Saul became David's enemy continually.

Saul because of <u>10\_2SA\_21\_07</u># But the king spared Mephibosheth, the son of Jonathan the son of Saul, because of the LORD'S oath that [was] between them, between David and Jonathan the son of Saul.

Saul begat Jonathan <u>13\_1CH\_08\_33</u> # And Ner begat Kish, and Kish begat Saul, and Saul begat Jonathan, and Malchishua, and Abinadab, and Eshbaal.

Saul begat Jonathan <u>13\_1CH\_09\_39</u># And Ner begat Kish; and Kish begat Saul; and Saul begat Jonathan, and Malchishua, and Abinadab, and Eshbaal.

Saul Bid the <u>09\_1SA\_09\_27</u> # [And] as they were going down to the end of the city, Samuel said to Saul, Bid the servant pass on before us, [and he passed on,] but stand thou still a while, that I may show thee the word of God.

Saul blew the <u>09\_1SA\_13\_03</u> # And Jonathan smote the garrison of the Philistines that [was] in Geba, and the Philistines heard [of it]. And Saul blew the trumpet throughout all the land, saying, Let the Hebrews hear.

Saul built an <u>09\_18A\_14\_35</u># And Saul built an altar unto the LORD: the same was the first altar that he built unto the LORD.

Saul but David <u>09\_1SA\_23\_24</u> # And they arose, and went to Ziph before Saul: but David and his men [were] in the wilderness of Maon, in the plain on the south of Jeshimon.

Saul But Saul <u>09\_1SA\_24\_07</u># So David stayed his servants with these words, and suffered them not to rise against Saul. But Saul rose up out of the cave, and went on [his] way.

Saul called all <u>09\_1SA\_23\_08</u> # And Saul called all the people together to war, to go down to Keilah, to besiege David and his men.

Saul came after <u>09\_1SA\_11\_05</u># And, behold, Saul came after the herd out of the field; and Saul said, What [aileth] the people that they weep? And they told him the tidings of the men of Jabesh.

Saul came after <u>09\_1SA\_26\_03</u> # And Saul pitched in the hill of Hachilah, which [is] before Jeshimon, by the way. But David abode in the wilderness, and he saw that Saul came after him into the wilderness.

Saul came down <u>10\_2SA\_19\_24</u># And Mephibosheth the son of Saul came down to meet the king, and had neither dressed his feet, nor trimmed his beard, nor washed his clothes, from the day the king departed until the day he came [again] in peace.

Saul came out <u>10\_2SA\_06\_20</u> # Then David returned to bless his household. And Michal the daughter of Saul came out to meet David, and said, How glorious was the king of Israel to day, who uncovered himself to day in the eyes of the handmaids of his servants, as one of the vain fellows shamelessly uncovereth himself!

Saul came saying <u>09\_1SA\_09\_15</u># Now the LORD had told Samuel in his ear a day before Saul came, saying,

Saul came to <u>09\_18A\_15\_05</u># And Saul came to a city of Amalek, and laid wait in the valley.

Saul came to <u>09\_18A\_15\_12</u># And when Samuel rose early to meet Saul in the morning, it was told Samuel, saying, Saul came to Carmel, and, behold, he set him up a place, and is gone about, and passed on, and gone down to Gilgal.

Saul cast a <u>09\_1SA\_20\_33</u># And Saul cast a javelin at him to smite him: whereby Jonathan knew that it was determined of his father to slay David.

Saul cast the <u>09\_1SA\_18\_11</u># And Saul cast the javelin; for he said, I will smite David even to the wall [with it]. And David avoided out of his presence twice.

Saul certain days <u>44\_ACT\_09\_19</u> # And when he had received meat, he was strengthened. Then was Saul certain days with the disciples which were at Damascus.

Saul choose you <u>09\_1SA\_17\_08</u># And he stood and cried unto the armies of Israel, and said unto them, Why are ye come out to set [your] battle in array? [am] not I a Philistine, and ye servants to Saul? choose you a man for you, and let him come down to me.

Saul chose him <u>09\_18A\_13\_02</u># Saul chose him three thousand [men] of Israel; [whereof] two thousand were with Saul in Michmash and in mount Bethel, and a thousand were with Jonathan in Gibeah of Benjamin: and the rest of the people he sent every man to his tent.

Saul chose him <u>09\_18A\_13\_02</u># Saul chose him three thousand [men] of Israel; [whereof] two thousand were with Saul in Michmash and in mount Bethel, and a thousand were with Jonathan in Gibeah of Benjamin: and the rest of the people he sent every man to his tent.

Saul come down <u>09\_1SA\_23\_11</u># Will the men of Keilah deliver me up into his hand? will Saul come down, as thy servant hath heard? O LORD God of Israel, I beseech thee, tell thy servant. And the LORD said, He will come down.

Saul commanded his <u>09\_1SA\_18\_22</u> # And Saul commanded his servants, [saying], Commune with David secretly, and say, Behold, the king hath delight in thee, and all his servants love thee: now therefore be the king's son in law.

Saul David earnestly <u>09\_1SA\_20\_28</u># And Jonathan answered Saul, David earnestly asked [leave] of me [to go] to Bethlehem:

Saul did eat <u>09\_1SA\_09\_24</u> # And the cook took up the shoulder, and [that] which [was] upon it, and set [it] before Saul. And [Samuel] said, Behold that which is left! set [it] before thee, [and] eat: for unto this time hath it been kept for thee since I said, I have invited the people. So Saul did eat with Samuel that day.

Saul died and <u>13\_1CH\_10\_06</u># So Saul died, and his three sons, and all his house died together.

Saul disguised himself <u>09\_1SA\_28\_08</u> # And Saul disguised himself, and put on other raiment, and he went, and two men with him, and they came to the woman by night: and he said, I pray thee, divine unto me by the familiar spirit, and bring me [him] up, whom I shall name unto thee.

Saul drew near <u>09\_1SA\_09\_18</u> # Then Saul drew near to Samuel in the gate, and said, Tell me, I pray thee, where the seer's house [is].

Saul eyed David 09 18A 18 09 # And Saul eyed David from that day and forward.

Saul eyed David <u>09\_1SA\_18\_09</u> # And Saul eyed David from that day and forward.

Saul fell straightway <u>09\_1SA\_28\_20</u># Then Saul fell straightway all along on the earth, and was sore afraid, because of the words of Samuel: and there was no strength in him; for he had eaten no bread all the day, nor all the night.

Saul for Saul <u>09\_1SA\_23\_26</u># And Saul went on this side of the mountain, and David and his men on that side of the mountain: and David made haste to get away for fear of Saul; for Saul and his men compassed David and his men round about to take them.

Saul hath slain <u>09\_1SA\_21\_11</u># And the servants of Achish said unto him, [Is] not this David the king of the land? did they not sing one to another of him in dances, saying, Saul hath slain his thousands, and David his ten thousands?

Saul he made <u>44\_ACT\_08\_03</u> # As for Saul, he made havock of the church, entering into every house, and haling men and women committed [them] to prison.

Saul He said <u>09\_1SA\_19\_17</u># And Saul said unto Michal, Why hast thou deceived me so, and sent away mine enemy, that he is escaped? And Michal answered Saul, He said unto me, Let me go; why should I kill thee?

Saul he sent <u>09\_1SA\_19\_21</u># And when it was told Saul, he sent other messengers, and they prophesied likewise. And Saul sent messengers again the third time, and they prophesied also.

Saul in Gilboa <u>10\_2SA\_21\_12</u> # And David went and took the bones of Saul and the bones of Jonathan his son from the men of Jabeshgilead, which had stolen them from the street of Bethshan, where the Philistines had hanged them, when the Philistines had slain Saul in Gilboa:

Saul said What <u>09\_1SA\_11\_05</u># And, behold, Saul came after the herd out of the field; and Saul said, What [aileth] the people that they weep? And they told him the tidings of the men of Jabesh.

Saul Saul why <u>44\_ACT\_09\_04</u> # And he fell to the earth, and heard a voice saying unto him, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me?

Saul Saul why <u>44\_ACT\_22\_07</u> # And I fell unto the ground, and heard a voice saying unto me, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me?

Saul Saul why <u>44\_ACT\_26\_14</u> # And when we were all fallen to the earth, I heard a voice speaking unto me, and saying in the Hebrew tongue, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me? [it is] hard for thee to kick against the pricks.

Saul saw and <u>09\_1SA\_18\_28</u># And Saul saw and knew that the LORD [was] with David, and [that] Michal Saul's daughter loved him.

Saul saw any <u>09\_1SA\_14\_52</u> # And there was sore war against the Philistines all the days of Saul: and when Saul saw any strong man, or any valiant man, he took him unto him.

Saul saw David <u>09\_1SA\_17\_55</u> # And when Saul saw David go forth against the Philistine, he said unto Abner, the captain of the host, Abner, whose son [is] this youth? And Abner said, [As] thy soul liveth, O king, I cannot tell.

Saul saw that <u>09\_1SA\_18\_15</u> # Wherefore when Saul saw that he behaved himself very wisely, he was afraid of him.

Saul saw the <u>09\_18A\_28\_05</u># And when Saul saw the host of the Philistines, he was afraid, and his heart greatly trembled.

Saul saying Behold <u>09\_1SA\_14\_33</u># Then they told Saul, saying, Behold, the people sin against the LORD, in that they eat with the blood. And he said, Ye have transgressed: roll a great stone unto me this day.

Saul saying Behold <u>09\_1SA\_19\_19</u> # And it was told Saul, saying, Behold, David [is] at Naioth in Ramah.

Saul saying Haste <u>09\_18A\_23\_27</u> # But there came a messenger unto Saul, saying, Haste thee, and come; for the Philistines have invaded the land.

Saul saying My <u>09\_1SA\_24\_08</u># David also arose afterward, and went out of the cave, and cried after Saul, saying, My lord the king. And when Saul looked behind him, David stooped with his face to the earth, and bowed himself.

Saul saying Why <u>09\_18A\_28\_12</u># And when the woman saw Samuel, she cried with a loud voice: and the woman spake to Saul, saying, Why hast thou deceived me? for thou [art] Saul.

Saul secretly practiced <u>09\_1SA\_23\_09</u># And David knew that Saul secretly practiced mischief against him; and he said to Abiathar the priest, Bring hither the ephod.

Saul seeing I <u>09\_1SA\_16\_01</u># And the LORD said unto Samuel, How long wilt thou mourn for Saul, seeing I have rejected him from reigning over Israel? fill thine horn with oil, and go, I will send thee to Jesse the Bethlehemite: for I have provided me a king among his sons.

Saul seeketh to <u>09\_1SA\_23\_10</u> # Then said David, O LORD God of Israel, thy servant hath certainly heard that Saul seeketh to come to Keilah, to destroy the city for my sake.

Saul sent and <u>19\_PSA\_59\_01</u># To the chief Musician, Altaschith, Michtam of David; when Saul sent, and they watched the house to kill him. Deliver me from mine enemies, O my God: defend me from them that rise up against me.

Saul sent him <u>09\_18A\_18\_05</u># And David went out whithersoever Saul sent him, [and] behaved himself wisely: and Saul set him over the men of war, and he was accepted in the sight of all the people, and also in the sight of Saul's servants.

Saul sent messengers <u>09\_1SA\_16\_19</u># Wherefore Saul sent messengers unto Jesse, and said, Send me David thy son, which [is] with the sheep.

Saul sent messengers <u>09\_1SA\_19\_14</u> # And when Saul sent messengers to take David, she said, He [is] sick.

Saul sent messengers <u>09\_1SA\_19\_20</u># And Saul sent messengers to take David: and when they saw the company of the prophets prophesying, and Samuel standing [as] appointed over them, the spirit of God was upon the messengers of Saul, and they also prophesied.

Saul sent messengers <u>09\_1SA\_19\_21</u> # And when it was told Saul, he sent other messengers, and they prophesied likewise. And Saul sent messengers again the third time, and they prophesied also.

Saul sent the <u>09\_1SA\_19\_15</u># And Saul sent the messengers [again] to see David, saying, Bring him up to me in the bed, that I may slay him.

Saul sent to <u>09\_1SA\_16\_22</u># And Saul sent to Jesse, saying, Let David, I pray thee, stand before me; for he hath found favour in my sight.

Saul set him <u>09\_1SA\_18\_05</u> # And David went out whithersoever Saul sent him, [and] behaved himself wisely: and Saul set him over the men of war, and he was accepted in the sight of all the people, and also in the sight of Saul's servants.

Saul shall despair <u>09\_1SA\_27\_01</u> # And David said in his heart, I shall now perish one day by the hand of Saul: [there is] nothing better for me than that I should speedily escape into the land of the Philistines; and Saul shall despair of me, to seek me any more in any coast of Israel: so shall I escape out of his hand.

Saul Shall Jonathan 09\_1SA\_14\_45 # And the people said unto Saul, Shall Jonathan die, who hath wrought

this great salvation in Israel? God forbid: [as] the LORD liveth, there shall not one hair of his head fall to the ground; for he hath wrought with God this day. So the people rescued Jonathan, that he died not.

Saul slew his <u>09\_18A\_29\_05</u># [Is] not this David, of whom they sang one to another in dances, saying, Saul slew his thousands, and David his ten thousands?

Saul smote the <u>09\_1SA\_15\_07</u># And Saul smote the Amalekites from Havilah [until] thou comest to Shur, that [is] over against Egypt.

Saul so that <u>09\_1SA\_18\_30</u># Then the princes of the Philistines went forth: and it came to pass, after they went forth, [that] David behaved himself more wisely than all the servants of Saul; so that his name was much set by.

Saul sought him <u>09\_1SA\_23\_14</u> # And David abode in the wilderness in strong holds, and remained in a mountain in the wilderness of Ziph. And Saul sought him every day, but God delivered him not into his hand.

Saul sought to <u>09\_1SA\_19\_10</u> # And Saul sought to smite David even to the wall with the javelin; but he slipped away out of Saul's presence, and he smote the javelin into the wall: and David fled, and escaped that night.

Saul sought to <u>10\_2SA\_21\_02</u> # And the king called the Gibeonites, and said unto them; [now the Gibeonites [were] not of the children of Israel, but of the remnant of the Amorites; and the children of Israel had sworn unto them: and Saul sought to slay them in his zeal to the children of Israel and Judah.]

Saul spake not <u>09\_18A\_20\_26</u># Nevertheless Saul spake not any thing that day: for he thought, Something hath befallen him, he [is] not clean; surely he [is] not clean.

Saul spake to <u>09\_1SA\_19\_01</u># And Saul spake to Jonathan his son, and to all his servants, that they should kill David.

Saul Stay and <u>09\_1SA\_15\_16</u># Then Samuel said unto Saul, Stay, and I will tell thee what the LORD hath said to me this night. And he said unto him, Say on.

Saul sware As <u>09\_1SA\_19\_06</u># And Saul hearkened unto the voice of Jonathan: and Saul sware, [As] the LORD liveth, he shall not be slain.

Saul sware to <u>09\_1SA\_28\_10</u># And Saul sware to her by the LORD, saying, [As] the LORD liveth, there shall no punishment happen to thee for this thing.

Saul talked unto <u>09\_1SA\_14\_19</u># And it came to pass, while Saul talked unto the priest, that the noise that [was] in the host of the Philistines went on and increased: and Saul said unto the priest, Withdraw thine hand.

Saul tarried in <u>09\_1SA\_14\_02</u> # And Saul tarried in the uttermost part of Gibeah under a pomegranate tree which [is] in Migron: and the people that [were] with him [were] about six hundred men;

Saul that David <u>09\_1SA\_16\_23</u># And it came to pass, when the [evil] spirit from God was upon Saul, that David took an harp, and played with his hand: so Saul was refreshed, and was well, and the evil spirit departed from him.

Saul that David <u>09\_1SA\_23\_07</u> # And it was told Saul that David was come to Keilah. And Saul said, God hath delivered him into mine hand; for he is shut in, by entering into a town that hath gates and bars.

Saul that David <u>09\_1SA\_23\_13</u> # Then David and his men, [which were] about six hundred, arose and

departed out of Keilah, and went whithersoever they could go. And it was told Saul that David was escaped from Keilah; and he forbare to go forth.

Saul that David <u>09\_1SA\_27\_04</u> # And it was told Saul that David was fled to Gath: and he sought no more again for him.

Saul that I <u>10\_2SA\_09\_01</u># And David said, Is there yet any that is left of the house of Saul, that I may show him kindness for Jonathan's sake?

Saul that I <u>10\_2SA\_09\_03</u># And the king said, [Is] there not yet any of the house of Saul, that I may show the kindness of God unto him? And Ziba said unto the king, Jonathan hath yet a son, [which is] lame on [his] feet.

Saul that Saul <u>09\_1SA\_24\_16</u> # And it came to pass, when David had made an end of speaking these words unto Saul, that Saul said, [Is] this thy voice, my son David? And Saul lifted up his voice, and wept.

Saul that the <u>09\_1SA\_18\_01</u># And it came to pass, when he had made an end of speaking unto Saul, that the soul of Jonathan was knit with the soul of David, and Jonathan loved him as his own soul.

Saul the king <u>09\_1SA\_29\_03</u> # Then said the princes of the Philistines, What [do] these Hebrews [here]? And Achish said unto the princes of the Philistines, [Is] not this David, the servant of Saul the king of Israel, which hath been with me these days, or these years, and I have found no fault in him since he fell [unto me] unto this day?

Saul the LORD <u>09\_1SA\_09\_17</u> # And when Samuel saw Saul, the LORD said unto him, Behold the man whom I spake to thee of! this same shall reign over my people.

Saul The LORD <u>09\_1SA\_15\_01</u> # Samuel also said unto Saul, The LORD sent me to anoint thee [to be] king over his people, over Israel: now therefore hearken thou unto the voice of the words of the LORD.

Saul the Lord <u>44\_ACT\_09\_17</u># And Ananias went his way, and entered into the house; and putting his hands on him said, Brother Saul, the Lord, [even] Jesus, that appeared unto thee in the way as thou camest, hath sent me, that thou mightest receive thy sight, and be filled with the Holy Ghost.

Saul the son <u>13\_1CH\_12\_01</u> # Now these [are] they that came to David to Ziklag, while he yet kept himself close because of Saul the son of Kish: and they [were] among the mighty men, helpers of the war.

Saul the son <u>13\_1CH\_26\_28</u># And all that Samuel the seer, and Saul the son of Kish, and Abner the son of Ner, and Joab the son of Zeruiah, had dedicated; [and] whosoever had dedicated [any thing, it was] under the hand of Shelomith, and of his brethren.

Saul the son <u>09\_1SA\_10\_21</u> # When he had caused the tribe of Benjamin to come near by their families, the family of Matri was taken, and Saul the son of Kish was taken: and when they sought him, he could not be found.

Saul the son <u>44\_ACT\_13\_21</u> # And afterward they desired a king: and God gave unto them Saul the son of Cis, a man of the tribe of Benjamin, by the space of forty years.

Saul there is <u>09\_1SA\_27\_01</u> # And David said in his heart, I shall now perish one day by the hand of Saul: [there is] nothing better for me than that I should speedily escape into the land of the Philistines; and Saul shall despair of me, to seek me any more in any coast of Israel: so shall I escape out of his hand.

Saul they made <u>13\_1CH\_05\_10</u># And in the days of Saul they made war with the Hagarites, who fell by their hand: and they dwelt in their tents throughout all the east [land] of Gilead.

Saul thine enemy <u>10\_2SA\_04\_08</u> # And they brought the head of Ishbosheth unto David to Hebron, and said to the king, Behold the head of Ishbosheth the son of Saul thine enemy, which sought thy life; and the LORD hath avenged my lord the king this day of Saul, and of his seed.

Saul Thou hast <u>09\_1SA\_13\_13</u># And Samuel said to Saul, Thou hast done foolishly: thou hast not kept the commandment of the LORD thy God, which he commanded thee: for now would the LORD have established thy kingdom upon Israel for ever.

Saul thought to <u>09\_1SA\_18\_25</u> # And Saul said, Thus shall ye say to David, The king desireth not any dowry, but an hundred foreskins of the Philistines, to be avenged of the king's enemies. But Saul thought to make David fall by the hand of the Philistines.

Saul three thousand <u>13\_1CH\_12\_29</u> # And of the children of Benjamin, the kindred of Saul, three thousand: for hitherto the greatest part of them had kept the ward of the house of Saul.

Saul thy father <u>10\_2SA\_03\_08</u># Then was Abner very wroth for the words of Ishbosheth, and said, [Am] I a dog's head, which against Judah do show kindness this day unto the house of Saul thy father, to his brethren, and to his friends, and have not delivered thee into the hand of David, that thou chargest me to day with a fault concerning this woman?

Saul thy father <u>10\_2SA\_09\_07</u> # And David said unto him, Fear not: for I will surely show thee kindness for Jonathan thy father's sake, and will restore thee all the land of Saul thy father; and thou shalt eat bread at my table continually.

Saul Thy servant <u>09\_1SA\_17\_34</u> # And David said unto Saul, Thy servant kept his father's sheep, and there came a lion, and a bear, and took a lamb out of the flock:

Saul to battle <u>13\_1CH\_12\_19</u> # And there fell [some] of Manasseh to David, when he came with the Philistines against Saul to battle: but they helped them not: for the lords of the Philistines upon advisement sent him away, saying, He will fall to his master Saul to [the jeopardy of] our heads.

Saul to be <u>09\_1SA\_15\_11</u># It repenteth me that I have set up Saul [to be] king: for he is turned back from following me, and hath not performed my commandments. And it grieved Samuel; and he cried unto the LORD all night.

Saul to feed <u>09\_18A\_17\_15</u># But David went and returned from Saul to feed his father's sheep at Bethlehem.

Saul to Gibeah <u>09\_1SA\_23\_19</u> # Then came up the Ziphites to Saul to Gibeah, saying, Doth not David hide himself with us in strong holds in the wood, in the hill of Hachilah, which [is] on the south of Jeshimon?

Saul to Gibeah <u>09\_1SA\_26\_01</u># And the Ziphites came unto Saul to Gibeah, saying, Doth not David hide himself in the hill of Hachilah, [which is] before Jeshimon?

Saul to Gilgal <u>09\_18A\_13\_04</u># And all Israel heard say [that] Saul had smitten a garrison of the Philistines, and [that] Israel also was had in abomination with the Philistines. And the people were called together after Saul to Gilgal.

Saul to him <u>13\_1CH\_12\_23</u> # And these [are] the numbers of the bands [that were] ready armed to the war, [and] came to David to Hebron, to turn the kingdom of Saul to him, according to the word of the LORD.

Saul to his <u>13\_1CH\_10\_04</u># Then said Saul to his armourbearer, Draw thy sword, and thrust me through therewith; lest these uncircumcised come and abuse me. But his armourbearer would not; for he was sore afraid. So Saul took a sword, and fell upon it.

Saul to his <u>09\_1SA\_09\_07</u># Then said Saul to his servant, But, behold, [if] we go, what shall we bring the man? for the bread is spent in our vessels, and [there is] not a present to bring to the man of God: what have we?

Saul to his <u>09\_1SA\_09\_10</u># Then said Saul to his servant, Well said; come, let us go. So they went unto the city where the man of God [was].

Saul to the <u>13\_1CH\_12\_19</u> # And there fell [some] of Manasseh to David, when he came with the Philistines against Saul to battle: but they helped them not: for the lords of the Philistines upon advisement sent him away, saying, He will fall to his master Saul to [the jeopardy of] our heads.

Saul to the <u>09\_1SA\_09\_26</u># And they arose early: and it came to pass about the spring of the day, that Samuel called Saul to the top of the house, saying, Up, that I may send thee away. And Saul arose, and they went out both of them, he and Samuel, abroad.

Saul to the <u>09\_1SA\_17\_13</u># And the three eldest sons of Jesse went [and] followed Saul to the battle: and the names of his three sons that went to the battle [were] Eliab the firstborn, and next unto him Abinadab, and the third Shammah.

Saul to the <u>09\_1SA\_26\_06</u># Then answered David and said to Ahimelech the Hittite, and to Abishai the son of Zeruiah, brother to Joab, saying, Who will go down with me to Saul to the camp? And Abishai said, I will go down with thee.

Saul told him <u>09\_1SA\_18\_24</u># And the servants of Saul told him, saying, On this manner spake David.

Saul took a <u>13\_1CH\_10\_04</u> # Then said Saul to his armourbearer, Draw thy sword, and thrust me through therewith; lest these uncircumcised come and abuse me. But his armourbearer would not; for he was sore afraid. So Saul took a sword, and fell upon it.

Saul took a <u>09\_1SA\_31\_04</u># Then said Saul unto his armourbearer, Draw thy sword, and thrust me through therewith; lest these uncircumcised come and thrust me through, and abuse me. But his armourbearer would not; for he was sore afraid. Therefore Saul took a sword, and fell upon it.

Saul took him <u>09\_1SA\_18\_02</u> # And Saul took him that day, and would let him go no more home to his father's house.

Saul took the <u>09\_1SA\_14\_47</u> # So Saul took the kingdom over Israel, and fought against all his enemies on every side, against Moab, and against the children of Ammon, and against Edom, and against the kings of Zobah, and against the Philistines: and whithersoever he turned himself, he vexed [them].

Saul took three <u>09\_1SA\_24\_02</u> # Then Saul took three thousand chosen men out of all Israel, and went to seek David and his men upon the rocks of the wild goats.

Saul until the <u>09\_1SA\_15\_35</u># And Samuel came no more to see Saul until the day of his death: nevertheless Samuel mourned for Saul: and the LORD repented that he had made Saul king over Israel.

Saul unto his <u>09\_1SA\_28\_07</u> # Then said Saul unto his servants, Seek me a woman that hath a familiar spirit, that I may go to her, and inquire of her. And his servants said to him, Behold, [there is] a woman that hath a familiar spirit at Endor.

Saul unto his <u>09\_1SA\_31\_04</u> # Then said Saul unto his armourbearer, Draw thy sword, and thrust me through therewith; lest these uncircumcised come and thrust me through, and abuse me. But his armourbearer would not; for he was sore afraid. Therefore Saul took a sword, and fell upon it.

Saul unto the <u>09\_1SA\_14\_17</u> # Then said Saul unto the people that [were] with him, Number now, and see

who is gone from us. And when they had numbered, behold, Jonathan and his armourbearer [were] not [there].

Saul upon the <u>09\_1SA\_09\_25</u># And when they were come down from the high place into the city, [Samuel] communed with Saul upon the top of the house.

Saul was afraid <u>09\_1SA\_18\_12</u># And Saul was afraid of David, because the LORD was with him, and was departed from Saul.

Saul was come <u>09\_18A\_23\_15</u># And David saw that Saul was come out to seek his life: and David [was] in the wilderness of Ziph in a wood.

Saul was come <u>09\_1SA\_26\_04</u> # David therefore sent out spies, and understood that Saul was come in very deed.

Saul was come <u>10\_2SA\_09\_06</u> # Now when Mephibosheth, the son of Jonathan, the son of Saul, was come unto David, he fell on his face, and did reverence. And David said, Mephibosheth. And he answered, Behold thy servant!

Saul was come <u>44\_ACT\_09\_26</u> # And when Saul was come to Jerusalem, he assayed to join himself to the disciples: but they were all afraid of him, and believed not that he was a disciple.

Saul was consenting <u>44\_ACT\_08\_01</u> # And Saul was consenting unto his death. And at that time there was a great persecution against the church which was at Jerusalem; and they were all scattered abroad throughout the regions of Judaea and Samaria, except the apostles.

Saul was dead <u>13\_1CH\_10\_05</u># And when his armourbearer saw that Saul was dead, he fell likewise on the sword, and died.

Saul was dead <u>09\_1SA\_31\_05</u># And when his armourbearer saw that Saul was dead, he fell likewise upon his sword, and died with him.

Saul was king <u>13\_1CH\_11\_02</u># And moreover in time past, even when Saul was king, thou [wast] he that leddest out and broughtest in Israel: and the LORD thy God said unto thee, Thou shalt feed my people Israel, and thou shalt be ruler over my people Israel.

Saul was king <u>10\_2SA\_05\_02</u> # Also in time past, when Saul was king over us, thou wast he that leddest out and broughtest in Israel: and the LORD said to thee, Thou shalt feed my people Israel, and thou shalt be a captain over Israel.

Saul was refreshed <u>09\_1SA\_16\_23</u> # And it came to pass, when the [evil] spirit from God was upon Saul, that David took an harp, and played with his hand: so Saul was refreshed, and was well, and the evil spirit departed from him.

Saul was returned <u>09\_1SA\_24\_01</u> # And it came to pass, when Saul was returned from following the Philistines, that it was told him, saying, Behold, David [is] in the wilderness of Engedi.

Saul was there <u>09\_1SA\_21\_07</u> # Now a certain man of the servants of Saul [was] there that day, detained before the LORD; and his name [was] Doeg, an Edomite, the chiefest of the herdmen that [belonged] to Saul.

Saul was very <u>09\_1SA\_18\_08</u># And Saul was very wroth, and the saying displeased him; and he said, They have ascribed unto David ten thousands, and to me they have ascribed [but] thousands: and [what] can he have more but the kingdom?

Saul was yet <u>09\_1SA\_18\_29</u># And Saul was yet the more afraid of David; and Saul became David's enemy continually.

Saul waxed weaker <u>10\_2SA\_03\_01</u> # Now there was long war between the house of Saul and the house of David: but David waxed stronger and stronger, and the house of Saul waxed weaker and weaker.

Saul went home <u>09\_18A\_24\_22</u># And David sware unto Saul. And Saul went home; but David and his men gat them up unto the hold.

Saul went in <u>09\_1SA\_24\_03</u># And he came to the sheepcotes by the way, where [was] a cave; and Saul went in to cover his feet: and David and his men remained in the sides of the cave.

Saul went on <u>09\_1SA\_23\_26</u># And Saul went on this side of the mountain, and David and his men on that side of the mountain: and David made haste to get away for fear of Saul; for Saul and his men compassed David and his men round about to take them.

Saul went out <u>09\_1SA\_13\_10</u> # And it came to pass, that as soon as he had made an end of offering the burnt offering, behold, Samuel came; and Saul went out to meet him, that he might salute him.

Saul went out <u>10\_2SA\_02\_12</u># And Abner the son of Ner, and the servants of Ishbosheth the son of Saul, went out from Mahanaim to Gibeon.

Saul went up <u>09\_1SA\_14\_46</u># Then Saul went up from following the Philistines: and the Philistines went to their own place.

Saul went up <u>09\_18A\_15\_34</u># Then Samuel went to Ramah; and Saul went up to his house to Gibeah of Saul.

Saul were Jonathan <u>09\_1SA\_14\_49</u> # Now the sons of Saul were Jonathan, and Ishui, and Melchishua: and the names of his two daughters [were these]; the name of the firstborn Merab, and the name of the younger Michal:

Saul when David <u>10\_2SA\_01\_01</u> # Now it came to pass after the death of Saul, when David was returned from the slaughter of the Amalekites, and David had abode two days in Ziklag;

Saul when he <u>09\_1SA\_11\_06</u># And the spirit of God came upon Saul when he heard those tidings, and his anger was kindled greatly.

Saul Wherefore hearest <u>09\_1SA\_24\_09</u> # And David said to Saul, Wherefore hearest thou men's words, saying, Behold, David seeketh thy hurt?

Saul who also <u>44\_ACT\_13\_09</u> # Then Saul, [who also [is called] Paul,] filled with the Holy Ghost, set his eyes on him,

Saul Who am <u>09\_1SA\_18\_18</u># And David said unto Saul, Who [am] I? and what [is] my life, [or] my father's family in Israel, that I should be son in law to the king?

Saul who clothed <u>10\_2SA\_01\_24</u> # Ye daughters of Israel, weep over Saul, who clothed you in scarlet, with [other] delights, who put on ornaments of gold upon your apparel.

Saul whom I <u>10\_2SA\_07\_15</u># But my mercy shall not depart away from him, as I took [it] from Saul, whom I put away before thee.

Saul whom she <u>10\_2SA\_21\_08</u> # But the king took the two sons of Rizpah the daughter of Aiah, whom she bare unto Saul, Armoni and Mephibosheth; and the five sons of Michal the daughter of Saul, whom she

brought up for Adriel the son of Barzillai the Meholathite:

Saul whom the <u>10\_2SA\_21\_06</u> # Let seven men of his sons be delivered unto us, and we will hang them up unto the LORD in Gibeah of Saul, [whom] the LORD did choose. And the king said, I will give [them].

Saul whose name <u>10\_2SA\_16\_05</u> # And when king David came to Bahurim, behold, thence came out a man of the family of the house of Saul, whose name [was] Shimei, the son of Gera: he came forth, and cursed still as he came.

Saul Why hast <u>09\_1SA\_28\_15</u> # And Samuel said to Saul, Why hast thou disquieted me, to bring me up? And Saul answered, I am sore distressed; for the Philistines make war against me, and God is departed from me, and answereth me no more, neither by prophets, nor by dreams: therefore I have called thee, that thou mayest make known unto me what I shall do.

Saul why persecutest <u>44\_ACT\_09\_04</u># And he fell to the earth, and heard a voice saying unto him, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me?

Saul why persecutest <u>44\_ACT\_22\_07</u> # And I fell unto the ground, and heard a voice saying unto me, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me?

Saul why persecutest <u>44\_ACT\_26\_14</u> # And when we were all fallen to the earth, I heard a voice speaking unto me, and saying in the Hebrew tongue, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me? [it is] hard for thee to kick against the pricks.

Saul with his <u>10\_2SA\_01\_02</u> # It came even to pass on the third day, that, behold, a man came out of the camp from Saul with his clothes rent, and earth upon his head: and [so] it was, when he came to David, that he fell to the earth, and did obeisance.

Saul with tabrets <u>09\_1SA\_18\_06</u> # And it came to pass as they came, when David was returned from the slaughter of the Philistine, that the women came out of all cities of Israel, singing and dancing, to meet king Saul, with tabrets, with joy, and with instruments of music.

Saul with the <u>09\_1SA\_17\_57</u> # And as David returned from the slaughter of the Philistine, Abner took him, and brought him before Saul with the head of the Philistine in his hand.

Saul worshipped the <u>09\_1SA\_15\_31</u># So Samuel turned again after Saul; and Saul worshipped the LORD.

Saul yet breathing <u>44\_ACT\_09\_01</u> # And Saul, yet breathing out threatenings and slaughter against the disciples of the Lord, went unto the high priest,

Saul <u>13\_1CH\_10\_02</u> # And the Philistines followed hard after Saul, and after his sons; and the Philistines slew Jonathan, and Abinadab, and Malchishua, the sons of Saul.

Saul <u>13\_1CH\_10\_11</u> # And when all Jabeshgilead heard all that the Philistines had done to Saul,

Saul <u>13\_1CH\_12\_29</u> # And of the children of Benjamin, the kindred of Saul, three thousand: for hitherto the greatest part of them had kept the ward of the house of Saul.

Saul <u>13\_1CH\_13\_03</u># And let us bring again the ark of our God to us: for we inquired not at it in the days of Saul.

Saul <u>09\_1SA\_15\_34</u># Then Samuel went to Ramah; and Saul went up to his house to Gibeah of Saul.

Saul <u>09\_1SA\_16\_20</u># And Jesse took an ass [laden] with bread, and a bottle of wine, and a kid, and sent [them] by David his son unto Saul.

Saul <u>09\_1SA\_17\_12</u># Now David [was] the son of that Ephrathite of Bethlehemjudah, whose name [was] Jesse; and he had eight sons: and the man went among men [for] an old man in the days of Saul.

Saul <u>09\_1SA\_17\_14</u># And David [was] the youngest: and the three eldest followed Saul.

Saul <u>09\_1SA\_18\_12</u># And Saul was afraid of David, because the LORD was with him, and was departed from Saul.

Saul <u>09\_1SA\_21\_07</u> # Now a certain man of the servants of Saul [was] there that day, detained before the LORD; and his name [was] Doeg, an Edomite, the chiefest of the herdmen that [belonged] to Saul.

Saul <u>09\_1SA\_28\_12</u># And when the woman saw Samuel, she cried with a loud voice: and the woman spake to Saul, saying, Why hast thou deceived me? for thou [art] Saul.

Saul <u>09\_1SA\_31\_11</u># And when the inhabitants of Jabeshgilead heard of that which the Philistines had done to Saul;

Saul <u>10\_2SA\_02\_04</u># And the men of Judah came, and there they anointed David king over the house of Judah. And they told David, saying, [That] the men of Jabeshgilead [were they] that buried Saul.

Saul <u>10\_2SA\_03\_06</u># And it came to pass, while there was war between the house of Saul and the house of David, that Abner made himself strong for the house of Saul.

Saul <u>10\_2SA\_12\_07</u># And Nathan said to David, Thou [art] the man. Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, I anointed thee king over Israel, and I delivered thee out of the hand of Saul;

Saul <u>10\_2SA\_21\_07</u># But the king spared Mephibosheth, the son of Jonathan the son of Saul, because of the LORD'S oath that [was] between them, between David and Jonathan the son of Saul.

Saul <u>10\_2SA\_22\_01</u> # And David spake unto the LORD the words of this song in the day [that] the LORD had delivered him out of the hand of all his enemies, and out of the hand of Saul:

Saul <u>44\_ACT\_07\_58</u> # And cast [him] out of the city, and stoned [him]: and the witnesses laid down their clothes at a young man's feet, whose name was Saul.

Saul <u>44\_ACT\_11\_25</u> # Then departed Barnabas to Tarsus, for to seek Saul:

Saul <u>44\_ACT\_11\_30</u># Which also they did, and sent it to the elders by the hands of Barnabas and Saul.

Saul <u>44\_ACT\_13\_01</u> # Now there were in the church that was at Antioch certain prophets and teachers; as Barnabas, and Simeon that was called Niger, and Lucius of Cyrene, and Manaen, which had been brought up with Herod the tetrarch, and Saul.

Saul's anger was <u>09\_1SA\_20\_30</u> # Then Saul's anger was kindled against Jonathan, and he said unto him, Thou son of the perverse rebellious [woman], do not I know that thou hast chosen the son of Jesse to thine own confusion, and unto the confusion of thy mother's nakedness?

Saul's bolster and <u>09\_1SA\_26\_12</u> # So David took the spear and the cruse of water from Saul's bolster; and they gat them away, and no man saw [it], nor knew [it], neither awaked: for they [were] all asleep; because a deep sleep from the LORD was fallen upon them.

Saul's brethren of <u>13\_1CH\_12\_02</u># [They were] armed with bows, and could use both the right hand and the left in [hurling] stones and [shooting] arrows out of a bow, [even] of Saul's brethren of Benjamin.

Saul's daughter looked <u>10\_2SA\_06\_16</u> # And as the ark of the LORD came into the city of David, Michal Saul's daughter looked through a window, and saw king David leaping and dancing before the LORD; and she despised him in her heart.

Saul's daughter loved <u>09\_1SA\_18\_20</u> # And Michal Saul's daughter loved David: and they told Saul, and the thing pleased him.

Saul's daughter loved <u>09\_1SA\_18\_28</u> # And Saul saw and knew that the LORD [was] with David, and [that] Michal Saul's daughter loved him.

Saul's daughter should <u>09\_1SA\_18\_19</u># But it came to pass at the time when Merab Saul's daughter should have been given to David, that she was given unto Adriel the Meholathite to wife.

Saul's daughter when <u>10\_2SA\_03\_13</u> # And he said, Well; I will make a league with thee: but one thing I require of thee, that is, Thou shalt not see my face, except thou first bring Michal Saul's daughter, when thou comest to see my face.

Saul's father were <u>09\_1SA\_09\_03</u> # And the asses of Kish Saul's father were lost. And Kish said to Saul his son, Take now one of the servants with thee, and arise, go seek the asses.

Saul's hand <u>09\_1SA\_18\_10</u># And it came to pass on the morrow, that the evil spirit from God came upon Saul, and he prophesied in the midst of the house: and David played with his hand, as at other times: and [there was] a javelin in Saul's hand.

Saul's host took <u>10\_2SA\_02\_08</u> # But Abner the son of Ner, captain of Saul's host, took Ishbosheth the son of Saul, and brought him over to Mahanaim;

Saul's presence and <u>09\_1SA\_19\_10</u># And Saul sought to smite David even to the wall with the javelin; but he slipped away out of Saul's presence, and he smote the javelin into the wall: and David fled, and escaped that night.

Saul's robe privily <u>09\_1SA\_24\_04</u> # And the men of David said unto him, Behold the day of which the LORD said unto thee, Behold, I will deliver thine enemy into thine hand, that thou mayest do to him as it shall seem good unto thee. Then David arose, and cut off the skirt of Saul's robe privily.

Saul's servant and <u>10\_2SA\_09\_09</u># Then the king called to Ziba, Saul's servant, and said unto him, I have given unto thy master's son all that pertained to Saul and to all his house.

Saul's servants said <u>09\_1SA\_16\_15</u># And Saul's servants said unto him, Behold now, an evil spirit from God troubleth thee.

Saul's servants spake <u>09\_1SA\_18\_23</u> # And Saul's servants spake those words in the ears of David. And David said, Seemeth it to you [a] light [thing] to be a king's son in law, seeing that I [am] a poor man, and lightly esteemed?

Saul's servants <u>09\_1SA\_18\_05</u> # And David went out whithersoever Saul sent him, [and] behaved himself wisely: and Saul set him over the men of war, and he was accepted in the sight of all the people, and also in the sight of Saul's servants.

Saul's side and <u>09\_1SA\_20\_25</u> # And the king sat upon his seat, as at other times, [even] upon a seat by the wall: and Jonathan arose, and Abner sat by Saul's side, and David's place was empty.

Saul's skirt <u>09\_1SA\_24\_05</u> # And it came to pass afterward, that David's heart smote him, because he had cut off Saul's skirt.

Saul's son arose <u>09\_18A\_23\_16</u># And Jonathan Saul's son arose, and went to David into the wood, and strengthened his hand in God.

Saul's son delighted <u>09\_1SA\_19\_02</u> # But Jonathan Saul's son delighted much in David: and Jonathan told David, saying, Saul my father seeketh to kill thee: now therefore, I pray thee, take heed to thyself until the morning, and abide in a secret [place], and hide thyself:

Saul's son had <u>10\_2SA\_04\_02</u># And Saul's son had two men [that were] captains of bands: the name of the one [was] Baanah, and the name of the other Rechab, the sons of Rimmon a Beerothite, of the children of Benjamin: [for Beeroth also was reckoned to Benjamin.

Saul's son had <u>10\_2SA\_04\_04</u> # And Jonathan, Saul's son, had a son [that was] lame of [his] feet. He was five years old when the tidings came of Saul and Jonathan out of Jezreel, and his nurse took him up, and fled: and it came to pass, as she made haste to flee, that he fell, and became lame. And his name [was] Mephibosheth.

Saul's son heard <u>10\_2SA\_04\_01</u> # And when Saul's son heard that Abner was dead in Hebron, his hands were feeble, and all the Israelites were troubled.

Saul's son saying <u>10\_2SA\_03\_14</u> # And David sent messengers to Ishbosheth Saul's son, saying, Deliver [me] my wife Michal, which I espoused to me for an hundred foreskins of the Philistines.

Saul's son was <u>10\_2SA\_02\_10</u> # Ishbosheth Saul's son [was] forty years old when he began to reign over Israel, and reigned two years. But the house of Judah followed David.

Saul's sons <u>09\_1SA\_31\_02</u> # And the Philistines followed hard upon Saul and upon his sons; and the Philistines slew Jonathan, and Abinadab, and Melchishua, Saul's sons.

Saul's uncle said <u>09\_1SA\_10\_14</u> # And Saul's uncle said unto him and to his servant, Whither went ye? And he said, To seek the asses: and when we saw that [they were] no where, we came to Samuel.

Saul's uncle said <u>09\_1SA\_10\_15</u># And Saul's uncle said, Tell me, I pray thee, what Samuel said unto you.

Saul's uncle <u>09\_1SA\_14\_50</u> # And the name of Saul's wife [was] Ahinoam, the daughter of Ahimaaz: and the name of the captain of his host [was] Abner, the son of Ner, Saul's uncle.
