

KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Shaphan and Abdon <u>14_2CH_34_20</u> # And the king commanded Hilkiah, and Ahikam the son of Shaphan, and Abdon the son of Micah, and Shaphan the scribe, and Asaiah a servant of the king's, saying,

Shaphan and Achbor <u>12_2KI_22_12</u> # And the king commanded Hilkiah the priest, and Ahikam the son of Shaphan, and Achbor the son of Michaiah, and Shaphan the scribe, and Asahiah a servant of the king's, saying,

Shaphan and Asahiah <u>12_2KI_22_14</u> # So Hilkiah the priest, and Ahikam, and Achbor, and Shaphan, and Asahiah, went unto Huldah the prophetess, the wife of Shallum the son of Tikvah, the son of Harhas, keeper of the wardrobe; [now she dwelt in Jerusalem in the college;] and they communed with her.

Shaphan and Gemariah <u>24_JER_29_03</u> # By the hand of Elasah the son of Shaphan, and Gemariah the son of Hilkiah, [whom Zedekiah king of Judah sent unto Babylon to Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon] saying,

Shaphan and he <u>12_2KI_22_08</u> # And Hilkiah the high priest said unto Shaphan the scribe, I have found the book of the law in the house of the LORD. And Hilkiah gave the book to Shaphan, and he read it.

Shaphan and Jeremiah <u>24_JER_43_06</u> # [Even] men, and women, and children, and the king's daughters, and every person that Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard had left with Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan, and Jeremiah the prophet, and Baruch the son of Neriah.

Shaphan and Zedekiah <u>24_JER_36_12</u> # Then he went down into the king's house, into the scribe's chamber: and, lo, all the princes sat there, [even] Elishama the scribe, and Delaiah the son of Shemaiah, and Elnathan the son of Achbor, and Gemariah the son of Shaphan, and Zedekiah the son of Hananiah, and all the princes.

Shaphan carried the <u>14_2CH_34_16</u># And Shaphan carried the book to the king, and brought the king word back again, saying, All that was committed to thy servants, they do [it].

Shaphan had heard <u>24_JER_36_11</u># When Michaiah the son of Gemariah, the son of Shaphan, had heard out of the book all the words of the LORD,

Shaphan read it <u>14_2CH_34_18</u> # Then Shaphan the scribe told the king, saying, Hilkiah the priest hath given me a book. And Shaphan read it before the king.

Shaphan read it <u>12_2KI_22_10</u># And Shaphan the scribe showed the king, saying, Hilkiah the priest hath delivered me a book. And Shaphan read it before the king.

Shaphan ruler <u>12_2KI_25_22</u> # And [as for] the people that remained in the land of Judah, whom Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon had left, even over them he made Gedaliah the son of Ahikam, the son of Shaphan, ruler.

Shaphan sware unto 24_JER_40_09 # And Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan sware unto them and to their men, saying, Fear not to serve the Chaldeans: dwell in the land, and serve the king of Babylon, and it shall be well with you.

Shaphan that he <u>24_JER_39_14</u># Even they sent, and took Jeremiah out of the court of the prison, and committed him unto Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan, that he should carry him home: so he

Shaphan the scribe <u>12_2KI_22_12</u> # And the king commanded Hilkiah the priest, and Ahikam the son of Shaphan, and Achbor the son of Michaiah, and Shaphan the scribe, and Asahiah a servant of the king's, saying,

Shaphan the scribe 24_JER_36_10 # Then read Baruch in the book the words of Jeremiah in the house of the LORD, in the chamber of Gemariah the son of Shaphan the scribe, in the higher court, at the entry of the new gate of the LORD'S house, in the ears of all the people.

Shaphan the son <u>14_2CH_34_08</u> # Now in the eighteenth year of his reign, when he had purged the land, and the house, he sent Shaphan the son of Azaliah, and Maaseiah the governor of the city, and Joah the son of Joahaz the recorder, to repair the house of the LORD his God.

Shaphan the son <u>12_2KI_22_03</u> # And it came to pass in the eighteenth year of king Josiah, [that] the king sent Shaphan the son of Azaliah, the son of Meshullam, the scribe, to the house of the LORD, saying,

Shaphan was with <u>24_JER_26_24</u> # Nevertheless the hand of Ahikam the son of Shaphan was with Jeremiah, that they should not give him into the hand of the people to put him to death.

Shaphan whom the 24_JER_40_05 # Now while he was not yet gone back, [he said], Go back also to Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan, whom the king of Babylon hath made governor over the cities of Judah, and dwell with him among the people: or go wheresoever it seemeth convenient unto thee to go. So the captain of the guard gave him victuals and a reward, and let him go.

Shaphan with every <u>26_EZE_08_11</u> # And there stood before them seventy men of the ancients of the house of Israel, and in the midst of them stood Jaazaniah the son of Shaphan, with every man his censer in his hand; and a thick cloud of incense went up.

Shaphan with the <u>24_JER_41_02</u> # Then arose Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, and the ten men that were with him, and smote Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan with the sword, and slew him, whom the king of Babylon had made governor over the land.

Shaphan <u>14_2CH_34_15</u># And Hilkiah answered and said to Shaphan the scribe, I have found the book of the law in the house of the LORD. And Hilkiah delivered the book to Shaphan.
