cherisheth her children [52_1TH_02_07](#) # But we were gentle among you, even as a nurse cherisheth her children:

cherisheth it even [49_EPH_05_29](#) # For no man ever yet hated his own flesh; but nourisheth and cherisheth it, even as the Lord the church:

Dabbasheth and reached [06_JOS_19_11](#) # And their border went up toward the sea, and Maralah, and reached to Dabbasheth, and reached to the river that [is] before Jokneam;

dasheth in pieces [34_NAH_02_01](#) # He that dasheth in pieces is come up before thy face: keep the munition, watch the way, make [thy] loins strong, fortify [thy] power mightily.

dasheth thy little [19_PSA_137_09](#) # Happy [shall he be], that taketh and dasheth thy little ones against the stones.

gnasheth upon him [19_PSA_37_12](#) # The wicked plotteth against the just, and gnasheth upon him with his teeth.

gnasheth upon me [18_JOB_16_09](#) # He teareth [me] in his wrath, who hateth me: he gnasheth upon me with his teeth; mine enemy sharpeneth his eyes upon me.

gnasheth with his [41_MAR_09_18](#) # And wheresoever he taketh him, he teareth him: and he foameth, and gnasheth with his teeth, and pineth away: and I spake to thy disciples that they should cast him out; and they could not.

languisheth Lebanon is [23 ISA 33 09](#) # The earth mourneth [and] languisheth: Lebanon is ashamed [and] hewn down: Sharon is like a wilderness; and Bashan and Carmel shake off [their fruits].

languisheth she hath [24 JER 15 09](#) # She that hath borne seven languisheth: she hath given up the ghost; her sun is gone down while [it was] yet day: she hath been ashamed and confounded: and the residue of them will I deliver to the sword before their enemies, saith the LORD.

languisheth the pomegranate [29 JOE 01 12](#) # The vine is dried up, and the fig tree languisheth; the pomegranate tree, the palm tree also, and the apple tree, [even] all the trees of the field, are withered: because joy is withered away from the sons of men.

languisheth [29 JOE 01 10](#) # The field is wasted, the land mourneth; for the corn is wasted: the new wine is dried up, the oil languisheth.
