Shushan and fast [17 EST 04 16](#) # Go, gather together all the Jews that are present in Shushan, and fast ye for me, and neither eat nor drink three days, night or day: I also and my maidens will fast likewise; and so will I go in unto the king, which [is] not according to the law: and if I perish, I perish.

Shushan and they [17 EST 09 14](#) # And the king commanded it so to be done: and the decree was given at Shushan; and they hanged Haman's ten sons.

Shushan assembled together [17 EST 09 18](#) # But the Jews that [were] at Shushan assembled together on the thirteenth [day] thereof, and on the fourteenth thereof; and on the fifteenth [day] of the same they rested, and made it a day of feasting and gladness.

Shushan rejoiced and [17 EST 08 15](#) # And Mordecai went out from the presence of the king in royal apparel of blue and white, and with a great crown of gold, and with a garment of fine linen and purple: and the city of Shushan rejoiced and was glad.

Shushan the palace [17 EST 01 02](#) # [That] in those days, when the king Abasuerus sat on the throne of his kingdom, which [was] in Shushan the palace,

Shushan the palace [17 EST 01 05](#) # And when these days were expired, the king made a feast unto all the people that were present in Shushan the palace, both unto great and small, seven days, in the court of the garden of the king's palace;

Shushan the palace [17 EST 02 08](#) # So it came to pass, when the king's commandment and his decree was heard, and when many maidens were gathered together unto Shushan the palace, to the custody of Hegai, that Esther was brought also unto the king's house, to the custody of Hegai, keeper of the women.

Shushan the palace [17 EST 03 15](#) # The posts went out, being hastened by the king's commandment, and the decree was given in Shushan the palace. And the king and Haman sat down to drink; but the city Shushan was perplexed.
