Silas and departed 44_ACT_15_40\# And Paul chose Silas, and departed, being recommended by the brethren unto the grace of God.

Silas and drew 44_ACT_16_19\# And when her masters saw that the hope of their gains was gone, they caught Paul and Silas, and drew [them] into the marketplace unto the rulers,

Silas and of $44 \_$ACT_17_04 \# And some of them believed, and consorted with Paul and Silas; and of the devout Greeks a great multitude, and of the chief women not a few.

Silas and Timotheus 44_ACT_17_14 \# And then immediately the brethren sent away Paul to go as it were to the sea: but Silas and Timotheus abode there still.

Silas and Timotheus 44_ACT_17_15\# And they that conducted Paul brought him unto Athens: and receiving a commandment unto Silas and Timotheus for to come to him with all speed, they departed.

Silas and Timotheus 44_ACT_18_05 \# And when Silas and Timotheus were come from Macedonia, Paul was pressed in the spirit, and testified to the Jews [that] Jesus [was] Christ.

Silas being prophets 44 _ACT_15_32 \# And Judas and Silas, being prophets also themselves, exhorted the brethren with many words, and confirmed [them].

Silas by night 44_ACT_17_10\# And the brethren immediately sent away Paul and Silas by night unto Berea: who coming [thither] went into the synagogue of the Jews.

Silas chief men 44_ACT_15_22 \# Then pleased it the apostles and elders, with the whole church, to send chosen men of their own company to Antioch with Paul and Barnabas; [namely], Judas surnamed Barsabas, and Silas, chief men among the brethren:

Silas prayed and 44_ACT_16_25 \# And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God: and the prisoners heard them.

Silas to abide 44_ACT_15_34 \# Notwithstanding it pleased Silas to abide there still.
Silas who shall 44_ACT_15_27 \# We have sent therefore Judas and Silas, who shall also tell [you] the same things by mouth.

Silas 44_ACT_16_29\# Then he called for a light, and sprang in, and came trembling, and fell down before Paul and Silas,
