

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Simon a Cyrenian <u>42\_LUK\_23\_26</u># And as they led him away, they laid hold upon one Simon, a Cyrenian, coming out of the country, and on him they laid the cross, that he might bear [it] after Jesus.

Simon a Cyrenian 41 MAR 15 21 # And they compel one Simon a Cyrenian, who passed by, coming out of the country, the father of Alexander and Rufus, to bear his cross.

Simon a tanner <u>44\_ACT\_09\_43</u> # And it came to pass, that he tarried many days in Joppa with one Simon a tanner.

Simon a tanner <u>44\_ACT\_10\_06</u> # He lodgeth with one Simon a tanner, whose house is by the sea side: he shall tell thee what thou oughtest to do.

Simon a tanner <u>44\_ACT\_10\_32</u># Send therefore to Joppa, and call hither Simon, whose surname is Peter; he is lodged in the house of [one] Simon a tanner by the sea side: who, when he cometh, shall speak unto thee.

Simon and Andrew 41\_MAR\_01\_16 # Now as he walked by the sea of Galilee, he saw Simon and Andrew his brother casting a net into the sea: for they were fishers.

Simon and Andrew 41 MAR 01 29 # And forthwith, when they were come out of the synagogue, they entered into the house of Simon and Andrew, with James and John.

Simon and are <u>41\_MAR\_06\_03</u> # Is not this the carpenter, the son of Mary, the brother of James, and Joses, and of Juda, and Simon? and are not his sisters here with us? And they were offended at him.

Simon And Jesus <u>42\_LUK\_05\_10</u> # And so [was] also James, and John, the sons of Zebedee, which were partners with Simon. And Jesus said unto Simon, Fear not; from henceforth thou shalt catch men.

Simon and Judas <u>40\_MAT\_13\_55</u># Is not this the carpenter's son? is not his mother called Mary? and his brethren, James, and Joses, and Simon, and Judas?

Simon and said <u>44\_ACT\_08\_24</u> # Then answered Simon, and said, Pray ye to the Lord for me, that none of these things which ye have spoken come upon me.

Simon and saith <u>43\_JOH\_01\_41</u> # He first findeth his own brother Simon, and saith unto him, We have found the Messias, which is, being interpreted, the Christ.

Simon and they 41\_MAR\_01\_36 # And Simon and they that were with him followed after him.

Simon answered and <u>42\_LUK\_07\_43</u># Simon answered and said, I suppose that [he], to whom he forgave most. And he said unto him, Thou hast rightly judged.

Simon answering said <u>42\_LUK\_05\_05</u># And Simon answering said unto him, Master, we have toiled all the night, and have taken nothing: nevertheless at thy word I will let down the net.

Simon Barjona for 40\_MAT\_16\_17 # And Jesus answered and said unto him, Blessed art thou, Simon Barjona: for flesh and blood hath not revealed [it] unto thee, but my Father which is in heaven.

Simon behold Satan 42 LUK 22 31 # And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired [to have] you, that he may sift [you] as wheat:

Simon by name <u>40\_MAT\_27\_32</u># And as they came out, they found a man of Cyrene, Simon by name: him they compelled to bear his cross.

Simon called Peter 40\_MAT\_04\_18# And Jesus, walking by the sea of Galilee, saw two brethren, Simon called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea: for they were fishers.

Simon called Zelotes <u>42\_LUK\_06\_15</u> # Matthew and Thomas, James the [son] of Alphaeus, and Simon called Zelotes,

Simon Fear not <u>42\_LUK\_05\_10</u> # And so [was] also James, and John, the sons of Zebedee, which were partners with Simon. And Jesus said unto Simon, Fear not; from henceforth thou shalt catch men.

Simon for he <u>43\_JOH\_06\_71</u> # He spake of Judas Iscariot [the son] of Simon: for he it was that should betray him, being one of the twelve.

Simon he surnamed 41\_MAR\_03\_16 # And Simon he surnamed Peter;

Simon himself believed 44\_ACT\_08\_13 # Then Simon himself believed also: and when he was baptized, he continued with Philip, and wondered, beholding the miracles and signs which were done.

Simon I have <u>42\_LUK\_07\_40</u> # And Jesus answering said unto him, Simon, I have somewhat to say unto thee. And he saith, Master, say on.

Simon Launch out <u>42\_LUK\_05\_04</u> # Now when he had left speaking, he said unto Simon, Launch out into the deep, and let down your nets for a draught.

Simon of whom <u>40\_MAT\_17\_25</u># He saith, Yes. And when he was come into the house, Jesus prevented him, saying, What thinkest thou, Simon? of whom do the kings of the earth take custom or tribute? of their own children, or of strangers?

Simon Peter a <u>61\_2PE\_01\_01</u># Simon Peter, a servant and an apostle of Jesus Christ, to them that have obtained like precious faith with us through the righteousness of God and our Saviour Jesus Christ:

Simon Peter and 43\_JOH\_13\_06 # Then cometh he to Simon Peter: and Peter saith unto him, Lord, dost thou wash my feet?

Simon Peter and <u>43\_JOH\_20\_02</u># Then she runneth, and cometh to Simon Peter, and to the other disciple, whom Jesus loved, and saith unto them, They have taken away the Lord out of the sepulchre, and we know not where they have laid him.

Simon Peter and 43\_JOH\_21\_02 # There were together Simon Peter, and Thomas called Didymus, and Nathanael of Cana in Galilee, and the [sons] of Zebedee, and two other of his disciples.

Simon Peter answered 43\_JOH\_06\_68 # Then Simon Peter answered him, Lord, to whom shall we go? thou hast the words of eternal life.

Simon Peter answered 40\_MAT\_16\_16# And Simon Peter answered and said, Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God.

Simon Peter followed <u>43\_JOH\_18\_15</u> # And Simon Peter followed Jesus, and [so did] another disciple: that disciple was known unto the high priest, and went in with Jesus into the palace of the high priest.

Simon Peter following 43\_JOH\_20\_06 # Then cometh Simon Peter following him, and went into the sepulchre, and seeth the linen clothes lie,

Simon Peter having 43\_JOH\_18\_10 # Then Simon Peter having a sword drew it, and smote the high priest's servant, and cut off his right ear. The servant's name was Malchus.

Simon Peter heard <u>43\_JOH\_21\_07</u> # Therefore that disciple whom Jesus loved saith unto Peter, It is the Lord. Now when Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he girt [his] fisher's coat [unto him], [for he was naked,] and did cast himself into the sea.

Simon Peter said <u>43\_JOH\_13\_36</u># Simon Peter said unto him, Lord, whither goest thou? Jesus answered him, Whither I go, thou canst not follow me now; but thou shalt follow me afterwards.

Simon Peter saith <u>43\_JOH\_13\_09</u> # Simon Peter saith unto him, Lord, not my feet only, but also [my] hands and [my] head.

Simon Peter saith <u>43\_JOH\_21\_03</u> # Simon Peter saith unto them, I go a fishing. They say unto him, We also go with thee. They went forth, and entered into a ship immediately; and that night they caught nothing.

Simon Peter saw <u>42\_LUK\_05\_08</u># When Simon Peter saw [it], he fell down at Jesus' knees, saying, Depart from me; for I am a sinful man, O Lord.

Simon Peter Simon <u>43\_JOH\_21\_15</u> # So when they had dined, Jesus saith to Simon Peter, Simon, [son] of Jonas, lovest thou me more than these? He saith unto him, Yea, Lord; thou knowest that I love thee. He saith unto him, Feed my lambs.

Simon Peter stood 43\_JOH\_18\_25 # And Simon Peter stood and warmed himself. They said therefore unto him, Art not thou also [one] of his disciples? He denied [it], and said, I am not.

Simon Peter therefore 43\_JOH\_13\_24 # Simon Peter therefore beckoned to him, that he should ask who it should be of whom he spake.

Simon Peter went <u>43\_JOH\_21\_11</u># Simon Peter went up, and drew the net to land full of great fishes, an hundred and fifty and three: and for all there were so many, yet was not the net broken.

Simon Peter's brother <u>43\_JOH\_01\_40</u> # One of the two which heard John [speak], and followed him, was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother.

Simon Peter's brother <u>43\_JOH\_06\_08</u># One of his disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, saith unto him,

Simon saw that <u>44\_ACT\_08\_18</u># And when Simon saw that through laying on of the apostles' hands the Holy Ghost was given, he offered them money,

Simon Seest thou <u>42\_LUK\_07\_44</u># And he turned to the woman, and said unto Simon, Seest thou this woman? I entered into thine house, thou gavest me no water for my feet: but she hath washed my feet with tears, and wiped [them] with the hairs of her head.

Simon Simon behold <u>42\_LUK\_22\_31</u> # And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired [to have] you, that he may sift [you] as wheat:

Simon sleepest thou <u>41\_MAR\_14\_37</u> # And he cometh, and findeth them sleeping, and saith unto Peter, Simon, sleepest thou? couldest not thou watch one hour?

Simon son of 43 JOH 21 15 # So when they had dined, Jesus saith to Simon Peter, Simon, [son] of Jonas,

lovest thou me more than these? He saith unto him, Yea, Lord; thou knowest that I love thee. He saith unto him, Feed my lambs.

Simon son of <u>43\_JOH\_21\_16</u># He saith to him again the second time, Simon, [son] of Jonas, lovest thou me? He saith unto him, Yea, Lord; thou knowest that I love thee. He saith unto him, Feed my sheep.

Simon son of <u>43\_JOH\_21\_17</u># He saith unto him the third time, Simon, [son] of Jonas, lovest thou me? Peter was grieved because he said unto him the third time, Lovest thou me? And he said unto him, Lord, thou knowest all things; thou knowest that I love thee. Jesus saith unto him, Feed my sheep.

Simon the Canaanite <u>41\_MAR\_03\_18</u> # And Andrew, and Philip, and Bartholomew, and Matthew, and Thomas, and James the [son] of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus, and Simon the Canaanite,

Simon the Canaanite 40 MAT\_10\_04 # Simon the Canaanite, and Judas Iscariot, who also betrayed him.

Simon the leper <u>41\_MAR\_14\_03</u># And being in Bethany in the house of Simon the leper, as he sat at meat, there came a woman having an alabaster box of ointment of spikenard very precious; and she brake the box, and poured [it] on his head.

Simon the leper 40\_MAT\_26\_06# Now when Jesus was in Bethany, in the house of Simon the leper,

Simon the son 43\_JOH\_01\_42 # And he brought him to Jesus. And when Jesus beheld him, he said, Thou art Simon the son of Jona: thou shalt be called Cephas, which is by interpretation, A stone.

Simon which beforetime <u>44\_ACT\_08\_09</u># But there was a certain man, called Simon, which beforetime in the same city used sorcery, and bewitched the people of Samaria, giving out that himself was some great one:

Simon which was 44\_ACT\_10\_18 # And called, and asked whether Simon, which was surnamed Peter, were lodged there.

Simon who is <u>40\_MAT\_10\_02</u># Now the names of the twelve apostles are these; The first, Simon, who is called Peter, and Andrew his brother; James [the son] of Zebedee, and John his brother;

Simon whom he <u>42\_LUK\_06\_14</u> # Simon, [whom he also named Peter,] and Andrew his brother, James and John, Philip and Bartholomew,

Simon whose surname <u>44\_ACT\_10\_05</u># And now send men to Joppa, and call for [one] Simon, whose surname is Peter:

Simon whose surname <u>44\_ACT\_10\_32</u> # Send therefore to Joppa, and call hither Simon, whose surname is Peter; he is lodged in the house of [one] Simon a tanner by the sea side: who, when he cometh, shall speak unto thee.

Simon whose surname <u>44\_ACT\_11\_13</u># And he showed us how he had seen an angel in his house, which stood and said unto him, Send men to Joppa, and call for Simon, whose surname is Peter;

Simon Zelotes and <u>44\_ACT\_01\_13</u># And when they were come in, they went up into an upper room, where abode both Peter, and James, and John, and Andrew, Philip, and Thomas, Bartholomew, and Matthew, James [the son] of Alphaeus, and Simon Zelotes, and Judas [the brother] of James.

Simon 43\_JOH\_13\_26# Jesus answered, He it is, to whom I shall give a sop, when I have dipped [it]. And when he had dipped the sop, he gave [it] to Judas Iscariot, [the son] of Simon.

Simon 42 LUK 24 34 # Saying, The Lord is risen indeed, and hath appeared to Simon.

Simon's and prayed <u>42\_LUK\_05\_03</u># And he entered into one of the ships, which was Simon's, and prayed him that he would thrust out a little from the land. And he sat down, and taught the people out of the ship.

Simon's house and <u>44\_ACT\_10\_17</u># Now while Peter doubted in himself what this vision which he had seen should mean, behold, the men which were sent from Cornelius had made inquiry for Simon's house, and stood before the gate,

Simon's house And <u>42\_LUK\_04\_38</u> # And he arose out of the synagogue, and entered into Simon's house. And Simon's wife's mother was taken with a great fever; and they besought him for her.

Simon's son to 43 JOH 13 02 # And supper being ended, the devil having now put into the heart of Judas Iscariot, Simon's [son], to betray him;

Simon's son which 43\_JOH\_12\_04 # Then saith one of his disciples, Judas Iscariot, Simon's [son], which should betray him,

Simon's wife's mother 42\_LUK\_04\_38 # And he arose out of the synagogue, and entered into Simon's house. And Simon's wife's mother was taken with a great fever; and they be sought him for her.

Simon's wife's mother <u>41\_MAR\_01\_30</u># But Simon's wife's mother lay sick of a fever, and anon they tell him of her.
