Jerusalem a burdensome 38\_ZEC\_12\_03 # And in that day will I make Jerusalem a burdensome stone for all people: all that burden themselves with it shall be cut in pieces, though all the people of the earth be gathered together against it.

Jerusalem a cup <u>38\_ZEC\_12\_02</u># Behold, I will make Jerusalem a cup of trembling unto all the people round about, when they shall be in the siege both against Judah [and] against Jerusalem.

Jerusalem a desolation <u>23\_ISA\_64\_10</u> # Thy holy cities are a wilderness, Zion is a wilderness, Jerusalem a desolation.

Jerusalem A dry 24\_JER\_04\_11# At that time shall it be said to this people and to Jerusalem, A dry wind of the high places in the wilderness toward the daughter of my people, not to fan, nor to cleanse,

Jerusalem a praise 23\_ISA\_62\_07 # And give him no rest, till he establish, and till he make Jerusalem a praise in the earth.

Jerusalem a quiet <u>23\_ISA\_33\_20</u> # Look upon Zion, the city of our solemnities: thine eyes shall see Jerusalem a quiet habitation, a tabernacle [that] shall not be taken down; not one of the stakes thereof shall ever be removed, neither shall any of the cords thereof be broken.

Jerusalem a rejoicing <u>23\_ISA\_65\_18</u># But be ye glad and rejoice for ever [in that] which I create: for, behold, I create Jerusalem a rejoicing, and her people a joy.

Jerusalem a sabbath 44\_ACT\_01\_12 # Then returned they unto Jerusalem from the mount called Olivet, which is from Jerusalem a sabbath day's journey.

Jerusalem about fifteen 43\_JOH\_11\_18# Now Bethany was nigh unto Jerusalem, about fifteen furlongs off:

Jerusalem about threescore 42\_LUK\_24\_13 # And, behold, two of them went that same day to a village called Emmaus, which was from Jerusalem [about] threescore furlongs.

Jerusalem above my 19\_PSA\_137\_06 # If I do not remember thee, let my tongue cleave to the roof of my mouth; if I prefer not Jerusalem above my chief joy.

Jerusalem according to <u>15\_EZR\_07\_09</u># For upon the first [day] of the first month began he to go up from Babylon, and on the first [day] of the fifth month came he to Jerusalem, according to the good hand of his God upon him.

Jerusalem according to <u>15\_EZR\_07\_14</u># Forasmuch as thou art sent of the king, and of his seven counsellors, to inquire concerning Judah and Jerusalem, according to the law of thy God which [is] in thine hand;

Jerusalem after he <u>10\_2SA\_05\_13</u> # And David took [him] more concubines and wives out of Jerusalem, after he was come from Hebron: and there were yet sons and daughters born to David.

Jerusalem after the <u>42\_LUK\_02\_42</u># And when he was twelve years old, they went up to Jerusalem after the custom of the feast.

Jerusalem again <u>38\_ZEC\_02\_12</u># And the LORD shall inherit Judah his portion in the holy land, and shall choose Jerusalem again.

Jerusalem Aha she <u>26\_EZE\_26\_02</u> # Son of man, because that Tyrus hath said against Jerusalem, Aha, she is broken [that was] the gates of the people: she is turned unto me: I shall be replenished, [now] she is laid waste:

Jerusalem Aholibah <u>26\_EZE\_23\_04</u> # And the names of them [were] Aholah the elder, and Aholibah her sister: and they were mine, and they bare sons and daughters. Thus [were] their names; Samaria [is] Aholah, and Jerusalem Aholibah.

Jerusalem all the 24\_JER\_35\_17# Therefore thus saith the LORD God of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will bring upon Judah and upon all the inhabitants of Jerusalem all the evil that I have pronounced against them: because I have spoken unto them, but they have not heard; and I have called unto them, but they have not answered.

Jerusalem all the 40\_MAT\_21\_10# And when he was come into Jerusalem, all the city was moved, saying, Who is this?

Jerusalem all the 19\_PSA\_128\_05 # The LORD shall bless thee out of Zion: and thou shalt see the good of Jerusalem all the days of thy life.

Jerusalem also is <u>16\_NEH\_01\_03</u># And they said unto me, The remnant that are left of the captivity there in the province [are] in great affliction and reproach: the wall of Jerusalem also [is] broken down, and the gates thereof are burned with fire.

Jerusalem also my <u>21\_ECC\_02\_09</u> # So I was great, and increased more than all that were before me in Jerusalem: also my wisdom remained with me.

Jerusalem an horrible <u>24\_JER\_23\_14</u># I have seen also in the prophets of Jerusalem an horrible thing: they commit adultery, and walk in lies: they strengthen also the hands of evildoers, that none doth return from his wickedness: they are all of them unto me as Sodom, and the inhabitants thereof as Gomorrah.

Jerusalem and abode 15\_EZR\_08\_32 # And we came to Jerusalem, and abode there three days.

Jerusalem and against 24\_JER\_01\_15 # For, lo, I will call all the families of the kingdoms of the north, saith the LORD; and they shall come, and they shall set every one his throne at the entering of the gates of Jerusalem, and against all the walls thereof round about, and against all the cities of Judah.

Jerusalem and against 24 JER 34 01 # The word which came unto Jeremiah from the LORD, when Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, and all his army, and all the kingdoms of the earth of his dominion, and all the people, fought against Jerusalem, and against all the cities thereof, saying,

Jerusalem and against <u>24\_JER\_34\_07</u># When the king of Babylon's army fought against Jerusalem, and against all the cities of Judah that were left, against Lachish, and against Azekah: for these defenced cities remained of the cities of Judah.

Jerusalem and Ahithophel <u>10\_2SA\_16\_15</u># And Absalom, and all the people the men of Israel, came to Jerusalem, and Ahithophel with him.

Jerusalem and all <u>14\_2CH\_30\_14</u> # And they arose and took away the altars that [were] in Jerusalem, and all the altars for incense took they away, and cast [them] into the brook Kidron.

Jerusalem and all 12\_2KI\_24\_14 # And he carried away all Jerusalem, and all the princes, and all the mighty men of valour, [even] ten thousand captives, and all the craftsmen and smiths: none remained, save

the poorest sort of the people of the land.

Jerusalem and all <u>26\_EZE\_12\_10</u># Say thou unto them, Thus saith the Lord GOD; This burden [concerneth] the prince in Jerusalem, and all the house of Israel that [are] among them.

Jerusalem and all <u>24\_JER\_52\_13</u># And burned the house of the LORD, and the king's house; and all the houses of Jerusalem, and all the houses of the great [men], burned he with fire:

Jerusalem and all <u>42\_LUK\_18\_31</u> # Then he took [unto him] the twelve, and said unto them, Behold, we go up to Jerusalem, and all things that are written by the prophets concerning the Son of man shall be accomplished.

Jerusalem and all <u>40\_MAT\_03\_05</u># Then went out to him Jerusalem, and all Judaea, and all the region round about Jordan,

Jerusalem and also <u>44\_ACT\_25\_24</u># And Festus said, King Agrippa, and all men which are here present with us, ye see this man, about whom all the multitude of the Jews have dealt with me, both at Jerusalem, and [also] here, crying that he ought not to live any longer.

Jerusalem and appointed <u>15\_EZR\_03\_08</u># Now in the second year of their coming unto the house of God at Jerusalem, in the second month, began Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, and Jeshua the son of Jozadak, and the remnant of their brethren the priests and the Levites, and all they that were come out of the captivity unto Jerusalem; and appointed the Levites, from twenty years old and upward, to set forward the work of the house of the LORD.

Jerusalem and Benjamin <u>14\_2CH\_34\_32</u># And he caused all that were present in Jerusalem and Benjamin to stand [to it]. And the inhabitants of Jerusalem did according to the covenant of God, the God of their fathers.

Jerusalem and besieged <u>27\_DAN\_01\_01</u># In the third year of the reign of Jehoiakim king of Judah came Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon unto Jerusalem, and besieged it.

Jerusalem and blow 24\_JER\_06\_01 # O ye children of Benjamin, gather yourselves to flee out of the midst of Jerusalem, and blow the trumpet in Tekoa, and set up a sign of fire in Bethhaccerem: for evil appeareth out of the north, and great destruction.

Jerusalem and brake 14\_2CH\_25\_23# And Joash the king of Israel took Amaziah king of Judah, the son of Joash, the son of Jehoahaz, at Bethshemesh, and brought him to Jerusalem, and brake down the wall of Jerusalem from the gate of Ephraim to the corner gate, four hundred cubits.

Jerusalem and brake 12\_2KI\_14\_13 # And Jehoash king of Israel took Amaziah king of Judah, the son of Jehoash the son of Ahaziah, at Bethshemesh, and came to Jerusalem, and brake down the wall of Jerusalem

from the gate of Ephraim unto the corner gate, four hundred cubits.

Jerusalem and brought <u>15\_EZR\_05\_14</u># And the vessels also of gold and silver of the house of God, which Nebuchadnezzar took out of the temple that [was] in Jerusalem, and brought them into the temple of Babylon, those did Cyrus the king take out of the temple of Babylon, and they were delivered unto [one], whose name [was] Sheshbazzar, whom he had made governor;

Jerusalem and brought <u>15\_EZR\_06\_05</u># And also let the golden and silver vessels of the house of God, which Nebuchadnezzar took forth out of the temple which [is] at Jerusalem, and brought unto Babylon, be restored, and brought again unto the temple which [is] at Jerusalem, [every one] to his place, and place [them] in the house of God.

Jerusalem and built 14\_2CH\_11\_05# And Rehoboam dwelt in Jerusalem, and built cities for defence in Judah.

Jerusalem and buried 12 2KI 09 28 # And his servants carried him in a chariot to Jerusalem, and buried him in his sepulchre with his fathers in the city of David.

Jerusalem and buried <u>12\_2KI\_23\_30</u> # And his servants carried him in a chariot dead from Megiddo, and brought him to Jerusalem, and buried him in his own sepulchre. And the people of the land took Jehoahaz the son of Josiah, and anointed him, and made him king in his father's stead.

Jerusalem and burnt 14\_2CH\_36\_19 # And they burnt the house of God, and brake down the wall of Jerusalem, and burnt all the palaces thereof with fire, and destroyed all the goodly vessels thereof.

Jerusalem and came <u>44\_ACT\_09\_21</u> # But all that heard [him] were amazed, and said; Is not this he that destroyed them which called on this name in Jerusalem, and came hither for that intent, that he might bring them bound unto the chief priests?

Jerusalem and cast <u>14\_2CH\_33\_15</u># And he took away the strange gods, and the idol out of the house of the LORD, and all the altars that he had built in the mount of the house of the LORD, and in Jerusalem, and cast [them] out of the city.

Jerusalem and cast 24\_JER\_07\_29 # Cut off thine hair, [O Jerusalem], and cast [it] away, and take up a lamentation on high places; for the LORD hath rejected and forsaken the generation of his wrath.

Jerusalem and condemned 14\_2CH\_36\_03 # And the king of Egypt put him down at Jerusalem, and condemned the land in an hundred talents of silver and a talent of gold.

Jerusalem and cry <u>23\_ISA\_40\_02</u># Speak ye comfortably to Jerusalem, and cry unto her, that her warfare is accomplished, that her iniquity is pardoned: for she hath received of the LORD's hand double for all her sins.

Jerusalem and David <u>13\_1CH\_14\_03</u> # And David took more wives at Jerusalem: and David begat more sons and daughters.

Jerusalem and destroyed 14\_2CH\_24\_23 # And it came to pass at the end of the year, [that] the host of Syria came up against him: and they came to Judah and Jerusalem, and destroyed all the princes of the people from among the people, and sent all the spoil of them unto the king of Damascus.

Jerusalem and did 12\_2KI\_16\_02 # Twenty years old [was] Ahaz when he began to reign, and reigned sixteen years in Jerusalem, and did not [that which was] right in the sight of the LORD his God, like David his father.

Jerusalem and drop 26\_EZE\_21\_02 # Son of man, set thy face toward Jerusalem, and drop [thy word]

toward the holy places, and prophesy against the land of Israel,

Jerusalem and dwell <u>11\_1KI\_02\_36</u># And the king sent and called for Shimei, and said unto him, Build thee an house in Jerusalem, and dwell there, and go not forth thence any whither.

Jerusalem and every 12\_2KI\_25\_09 # And he burnt the house of the LORD, and the king's house, and all the houses of Jerusalem, and every great [man's] house burnt he with fire.

Jerusalem and every 38\_ZEC\_08\_04 # Thus saith the LORD of hosts; There shall yet old men and old women dwell in the streets of Jerusalem, and every man with his staff in his hand for very age.

Jerusalem and for 11\_1KI\_11\_07# Then did Solomon build an high place for Chemosh, the abomination of Moab, in the hill that [is] before Jerusalem, and for Molech, the abomination of the children of Ammon.

Jerusalem and for <u>38\_ZEC\_01\_14</u># So the angel that communed with me said unto me, Cry thou, saying, Thus saith the LORD of hosts; I am jealous for Jerusalem and for Zion with a great jealousy.

Jerusalem and found <u>42\_LUK\_24\_33</u># And they rose up the same hour, and returned to Jerusalem, and found the eleven gathered together, and them that were with them,

Jerusalem and from <u>23\_ISA\_03\_01</u> # For, behold, the Lord, the LORD of hosts, doth take away from Jerusalem and from Judah the stay and the staff, the whole stay of bread, and the whole stay of water.

Jerusalem and had <u>15\_EZR\_01\_07</u># Also Cyrus the king brought forth the vessels of the house of the LORD, which Nebuchadnezzar had brought forth out of Jerusalem, and had put them in the house of his gods;

Jerusalem and had 24 JER 24 01 # The LORD showed me, and, behold, two baskets of figs [were] set before the temple of the LORD, after that Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon had carried away captive Jeconiah the son of Jehoiakim king of Judah, and the princes of Judah, with the carpenters and smiths, from Jerusalem, and had brought them to Babylon.

Jerusalem and had <u>07\_JUD\_01\_08</u> # Now the children of Judah had fought against Jerusalem, and had taken it, and smitten it with the edge of the sword, and set the city on fire.

Jerusalem and Hazor 11 1KI 09 15 # And this [is] the reason of the levy which king Solomon raised; for to build the house of the LORD, and his own house, and Millo, and the wall of Jerusalem, and Hazor, and Megiddo, and Gezer.

Jerusalem and he 14\_2CH\_19\_04 # And Jehoshaphat dwelt at Jerusalem: and he went out again through the people from Beersheba to mount Ephraim, and brought them back unto the LORD God of their fathers.

Jerusalem and he <u>14\_2CH\_25\_27</u># Now after the time that Amaziah did turn away from following the LORD they made a conspiracy against him in Jerusalem; and he fled to Lachish: but they sent to Lachish after him, and slew him there.

Jerusalem and he 14\_2CH\_29\_08 # Wherefore the wrath of the LORD was upon Judah and Jerusalem, and he hath delivered them to trouble, to astonishment, and to hissing, as we see with your eyes.

Jerusalem and he <u>14\_2CH\_35\_24</u># His servants therefore took him out of that chariot, and put him in the second chariot that he had; and they brought him to Jerusalem, and he died, and was buried in [one of] the sepulchres of his fathers. And all Judah and Jerusalem mourned for Josiah.

Jerusalem and he 12 2KI 14 19 # Now they made a conspiracy against him in Jerusalem: and he fled to Lachish; but they sent after him to Lachish, and slew him there.

Jerusalem and he <u>38\_ZEC\_12\_08</u># In that day shall the LORD defend the inhabitants of Jerusalem; and he that is feeble among them at that day shall be as David; and the house of David [shall be] as God, as the angel of the LORD before them.

Jerusalem and her <u>23\_ISA\_10\_11</u># Shall I not, as I have done unto Samaria and her idols, so do to Jerusalem and her idols?

Jerusalem And his <u>11\_1KI\_15\_02</u># Three years reigned he in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Maachah, the daughter of Abishalom.

Jerusalem And his 14\_2CH\_25\_01 # Amaziah [was] twenty and five years old [when] he began to reign, and he reigned twenty and nine years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Jehoaddan of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem And his <u>14\_2CH\_29\_01</u># Hezekiah began to reign [when he was] five and twenty years old, and he reigned nine and twenty years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Abijah, the daughter of Zechariah.

Jerusalem And his 12\_2KI\_08\_26 # Two and twenty years old [was] Ahaziah when he began to reign; and he reigned one year in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Athaliah, the daughter of Omri king of Israel.

Jerusalem And his 12 2KI 12 01 # In the seventh year of Jehu Jehoash began to reign; and forty years reigned he in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Zibiah of Beersheba.

Jerusalem And his 12\_2KI\_14\_02 # He was twenty and five years old when he began to reign, and reigned twenty and nine years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Jehoaddan of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem And his 12\_2KI\_15\_02 # Sixteen years old was he when he began to reign, and he reigned two and fifty years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Jecholiah of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem And his 12\_2KI\_15\_33 # Five and twenty years old was he when he began to reign, and he reigned sixteen years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Jerusha, the daughter of Zadok.

Jerusalem And his 12\_2KI\_23\_31 # Jehoahaz [was] twenty and three years old when he began to reign; and he reigned three months in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Hamutal, the daughter of Jeremiah of Libnah.

Jerusalem And his 12\_2KI\_23\_36 # Jehoiakim [was] twenty and five years old when he began to reign; and he reigned eleven years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Zebudah, the daughter of Pedaiah of Rumah.

Jerusalem And his <u>12\_2KI\_24\_18</u># Zedekiah [was] twenty and one years old when he began to reign, and he reigned eleven years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Hamutal, the daughter of Jeremiah of Libnah.

Jerusalem And his <u>24\_JER\_52\_01</u># Zedekiah [was] one and twenty years old when he began to reign, and he reigned eleven years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Hamutal the daughter of Jeremiah of Libnah.

Jerusalem and I <u>36\_ZEP\_01\_04</u># I will also stretch out mine hand upon Judah, and upon all the inhabitants of Jerusalem; and I will cut off the remnant of Baal from this place, [and] the name of the Chemarims with the priests;

Jerusalem and it <u>24\_JER\_17\_27</u># But if ye will not hearken unto me to hallow the sabbath day, and not to bear a burden, even entering in at the gates of Jerusalem on the sabbath day; then will I kindle a fire in the gates thereof, and it shall devour the palaces of Jerusalem, and it shall not be quenched.

Jerusalem and it <u>38\_ZEC\_14\_10</u># All the land shall be turned as a plain from Geba to Rimmon south of Jerusalem: and it shall be lifted up, and inhabited in her place, from Benjamin's gate unto the place of the first gate, unto the corner gate, and [from] the tower of Hananeel unto the king's winepresses.

Jerusalem and Judah 12 2KI 21 12 # Therefore thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Behold, I [am] bringing [such] evil upon Jerusalem and Judah, that whosoever heareth of it, both his ears shall tingle.

Jerusalem and Judah <u>12\_2KI\_24\_20</u> # For through the anger of the LORD it came to pass in Jerusalem and Judah, until he had cast them out from his presence, that Zedekiah rebelled against the king of Babylon.

Jerusalem and Judah <u>15\_EZR\_02\_01</u> # Now these [are] the children of the province that went up out of the captivity, of those which had been carried away, whom Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon had carried away unto Babylon, and came again unto Jerusalem and Judah, every one unto his city;

Jerusalem and they <u>24\_JER\_39\_01</u># In the ninth year of Zedekiah king of Judah, in the tenth month, came Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon and all his army against Jerusalem, and they besieged it.

Jerusalem be holy <u>29\_JOE\_03\_17</u> # So shall ye know that I [am] the LORD your God dwelling in Zion, my holy mountain: then shall Jerusalem be holy, and there shall no strangers pass through her any more.

Jerusalem be opened <u>16\_NEH\_07\_03</u># And I said unto them, Let not the gates of Jerusalem be opened until the sun be hot; and while they stand by, let them shut the doors, and bar [them]: and appoint watches of the inhabitants of Jerusalem, every one in his watch, and every one [to be] over against his house.

Jerusalem be pleasant <u>39\_MAL\_03\_04</u> # Then shall the offering of Judah and Jerusalem be pleasant unto the LORD, as in the days of old, and as in former years.

Jerusalem be this <u>44\_ACT\_02\_14</u> # But Peter, standing up with the eleven, lifted up his voice, and said unto them, Ye men of Judaea, and all [ye] that dwell at Jerusalem, be this known unto you, and hearken to my words:

Jerusalem because of <u>14\_2CH\_12\_05</u># Then came Shemaiah the prophet to Rehoboam, and [to] the princes of Judah, that were gathered together to Jerusalem because of Shishak, and said unto them, Thus saith the LORD, Ye have forsaken me, and therefore have I also left you in the hand of Shishak.

Jerusalem because of 24\_JER\_14\_16\_# And the people to whom they prophesy shall be cast out in the streets of Jerusalem because of the famine and the sword; and they shall have none to bury them, their wives, nor their sons, nor their daughters: for I will pour their wickedness upon them.

Jerusalem because they <u>14\_2CH\_12\_02</u># And it came to pass, [that] in the fifth year of king Rehoboam Shishak king of Egypt came up against Jerusalem, because they had transgressed against the LORD,

Jerusalem before the 43\_JOH\_11\_55# And the Jews' passover was nigh at hand: and many went out of the country up to Jerusalem before the passover, to purify themselves.

Jerusalem began to <u>16\_NEH\_13\_19</u># And it came to pass, that when the gates of Jerusalem began to be dark before the sabbath, I commanded that the gates should be shut, and charged that they should not be opened till after the sabbath: and [some] of my servants set I at the gates, [that] there should no burden be brought in on the sabbath day.

Jerusalem behold thy <u>11\_1KI\_12\_28</u># Whereupon the king took counsel, and made two calves [of] gold, and said unto them, It is too much for you to go up to Jerusalem: behold thy gods, O Israel, which brought thee up out of the land of Egypt.

Jerusalem behold thy <u>38\_ZEC\_09\_09</u># Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: he [is] just, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass.

Jerusalem Believe in 14\_2CH\_20\_20 # And they rose early in the morning, and went forth into the wilderness of Tekoa: and as they went forth, Jehoshaphat stood and said, Hear me, O Judah, and ye inhabitants of Jerusalem; Believe in the LORD your God, so shall ye be established; believe his prophets, so shall ye prosper.

Jerusalem bind the 44\_ACT\_21\_11# And when he was come unto us, he took Paul's girdle, and bound his own hands and feet, and said, Thus saith the Holy Ghost, So shall the Jews at Jerusalem bind the man that owneth this girdle, and shall deliver [him] into the hands of the Gentiles.

Jerusalem Break up <u>24\_JER\_04\_03</u> # For thus saith the LORD to the men of Judah and Jerusalem, Break up your fallow ground, and sow not among thorns.

Jerusalem bringing sick <u>44\_ACT\_05\_16</u># There came also a multitude [out] of the cities round about unto Jerusalem, bringing sick folks, and them which were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed every one.

Jerusalem building the <u>15\_EZR\_04\_12</u># Be it known unto the king, that the Jews which came up from thee to us are come unto Jerusalem, building the rebellious and the bad city, and have set up the walls [thereof], and joined the foundations.

Jerusalem but he <u>09\_1SA\_17\_54</u># And David took the head of the Philistine, and brought it to Jerusalem; but he put his armour in his tent.

Jerusalem but he 14\_2CH\_28\_01 # Ahaz [was] twenty years old when he began to reign, and he reigned

sixteen years in Jerusalem: but he did not [that which was] right in the sight of the LORD, like David his father:

Jerusalem but he <u>14\_2CH\_32\_09</u># After this did Sennacherib king of Assyria send his servants to Jerusalem, [but he [himself laid siege] against Lachish, and all his power with him,] unto Hezekiah king of Judah, and unto all Judah that [were] at Jerusalem, saying,

Jerusalem but I <u>44\_ACT\_18\_21</u> # But bade them farewell, saying, I must by all means keep this feast that cometh in Jerusalem: but I will return again unto you, if God will. And he sailed from Ephesus.

Jerusalem but in <u>16 NEH 11 03 # Now these [are]</u> the chief of the province that dwelt in Jerusalem: but in the cities of Judah dwelt every one in his possession in their cities, [to wit], Israel, the priests, and the Levites, and the Nethinims, and the children of Solomon's servants.

Jerusalem but the <u>07\_JUD\_01\_21</u># And the children of Benjamin did not drive out the Jebusites that inhabited Jerusalem; but the Jebusites dwell with the children of Benjamin in Jerusalem unto this day.

Jerusalem but they <u>14\_2CH\_28\_27</u># And Ahaz slept with his fathers, and they buried him in the city, [even] in Jerusalem: but they brought him not into the sepulchres of the kings of Israel: and Hezekiah his son reigned in his stead.

Jerusalem but they 12 2KI 23 09 # Nevertheless the priests of the high places came not up to the altar of the LORD in Jerusalem, but they did eat of the unleavened bread among their brethren.

Jerusalem but wait 44\_ACT\_01\_04 # And, being assembled together with [them], commanded them that they should not depart from Jerusalem, but wait for the promise of the Father, which, [saith he], ye have heard of me.

Jerusalem by the <u>13\_1CH\_06\_15</u># And Jehozadak went [into captivity], when the LORD carried away Judah and Jerusalem by the hand of Nebuchadnezzar.

Jerusalem by the <a href="#">14\_2CH\_12\_07</a># And when the LORD saw that they humbled themselves, the word of the LORD came to Shemaiah, saying, They have humbled themselves; [therefore] I will not destroy them, but I will grant them some deliverance; and my wrath shall not be poured out upon Jerusalem by the hand of Shishak.

Jerusalem by the 24\_JER\_44\_13 # For I will punish them that dwell in the land of Egypt, as I have punished Jerusalem, by the sword, by the famine, and by the pestilence:

Jerusalem by the <u>43\_JOH\_05\_02</u> # Now there is at Jerusalem by the sheep [market] a pool, which is called in the Hebrew tongue Bethesda, having five porches.

Jerusalem by the 22\_SON\_02\_07 # I charge you, O ye daughters of Jerusalem, by the roes, and by the hinds of the field, that ye stir not up, nor awake [my] love, till he please.

Jerusalem by the <u>22\_SON\_03\_05</u> # I charge you, O ye daughters of Jerusalem, by the roes, and by the hinds of the field, that ye stir not up, nor awake [my] love, till he please.

Jerusalem came unto <u>26\_EZE\_33\_21</u># And it came to pass in the twelfth year of our captivity, in the tenth [month], in the fifth [day] of the month, [that] one that had escaped out of Jerusalem came unto me, saying, The city is smitten.

Jerusalem captive in <u>24\_JER\_01\_03</u># It came also in the days of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah king of Judah, unto the end of the eleventh year of Zedekiah the son of Josiah king of Judah, unto the carrying away of Jerusalem captive in the fifth month.

Jerusalem come into <u>24\_JER\_51\_50</u># Ye that have escaped the sword, go away, stand not still: remember the LORD afar off, and let Jerusalem come into your mind.

Jerusalem coming down <u>66\_REV\_21\_02</u># And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

Jerusalem compassed with <u>42\_LUK\_21\_20</u># And when ye shall see Jerusalem compassed with armies, then know that the desolation thereof is nigh.

Jerusalem defending also 23\_ISA\_31\_05 # As birds flying, so will the LORD of hosts defend Jerusalem; defending also he will deliver [it; and] passing over he will preserve it.

Jerusalem descending out <u>66\_REV\_21\_10</u># And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and showed me that great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God,

Jerusalem did according 14\_2CH\_34\_32 # And he caused all that were present in Jerusalem and Benjamin to stand [to it]. And the inhabitants of Jerusalem did according to the covenant of God, the God of their fathers.

Jerusalem did him <u>14\_2CH\_32\_33</u> # And Hezekiah slept with his fathers, and they buried him in the chiefest of the sepulchres of the sons of David: and all Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem did him honour at his death. And Manasseh his son reigned in his stead.

Jerusalem did Jehoshaphat <u>14\_2CH\_19\_08</u># Moreover in Jerusalem did Jehoshaphat set of the Levites, and [of] the priests, and of the chief of the fathers of Israel, for the judgment of the LORD, and for controversies, when they returned to Jerusalem.

Jerusalem did Josiah 12 2KI 23 24 # Moreover the [workers with] familiar spirits, and the wizards, and the images, and the idols, and all the abominations that were spied in the land of Judah and in Jerusalem, did Josiah put away, that he might perform the words of the law which were written in the book that Hilkiah the priest found in the house of the LORD.

Jerusalem do not 38\_ZEC\_12\_07 # The LORD also shall save the tents of Judah first, that the glory of the house of David and the glory of the inhabitants of Jerusalem do not magnify [themselves] against Judah.

Jerusalem dwelt certain <u>16\_NEH\_11\_04</u># And at Jerusalem dwelt [certain] of the children of Judah, and of the children of Benjamin. Of the children of Judah; Athaiah the son of Uzziah, the son of Zechariah, the son of Shephatiah, the son of Mahalaleel, of the children of Perez;

Jerusalem dwelt of 13 1CH 09 03 # And in Jerusalem dwelt of the children of Judah, and of the children of Benjamin, and of the children of Ephraim, and Manasseh;

Jerusalem eight hundred <u>24\_JER\_52\_29</u># In the eighteenth year of Nebuchadrezzar he carried away captive from Jerusalem eight hundred thirty and two persons:

Jerusalem eight years <u>14\_2CH\_21\_20</u># Thirty and two years old was he when he began to reign, and he reigned in Jerusalem eight years, and departed without being desired. Howbeit they buried him in the city of David, but not in the sepulchres of the kings.

Jerusalem engines invented <u>14\_2CH\_26\_15</u> # And he made in Jerusalem engines, invented by cunning men, to be on the towers and upon the bulwarks, to shoot arrows and great stones withal. And his name spread far abroad; for he was marvellously helped, till he was strong.

Jerusalem even concerning 26 EZE 14 22 # Yet, behold, therein shall be left a remnant that shall be

brought forth, [both] sons and daughters: behold, they shall come forth unto you, and ye shall see their way and their doings: and ye shall be comforted concerning the evil that I have brought upon Jerusalem, [even] concerning all that I have brought upon it.

Jerusalem even thou <u>31\_OBA\_01\_11</u># In the day that thou stoodest on the other side, in the day that the strangers carried away captive his forces, and foreigners entered into his gates, and cast lots upon Jerusalem, even thou [wast] as one of them.

Jerusalem even while 44\_ACT\_22\_17 # And it came to pass, that, when I was come again to Jerusalem, even while I prayed in the temple, I was in a trance;

Jerusalem every one <u>15\_EZR\_06\_05</u># And also let the golden and silver vessels of the house of God, which Nebuchadnezzar took forth out of the temple which [is] at Jerusalem, and brought unto Babylon, be restored, and brought again unto the temple which [is] at Jerusalem, [every one] to his place, and place [them] in the house of God.

Jerusalem every one <u>16\_NEH\_07\_03</u># And I said unto them, Let not the gates of Jerusalem be opened until the sun be hot; and while they stand by, let them shut the doors, and bar [them]: and appoint watches of the inhabitants of Jerusalem, every one in his watch, and every one [to be] over against his house.

Jerusalem every year 42\_LUK\_02\_41 # Now his parents went to Jerusalem every year at the feast of the passover.

Jerusalem fear not 14\_2CH\_20\_17 # Ye shall not [need] to fight in this [battle]: set yourselves, stand ye [still], and see the salvation of the LORD with you, O Judah and Jerusalem: fear not, nor be dismayed; to morrow go out against them: for the LORD [will be] with you.

Jerusalem Fear thou <u>36\_ZEP\_03\_16</u># In that day it shall be said to Jerusalem, Fear thou not: [and to] Zion, Let not thine hands be slack.

Jerusalem fell before 14\_2CH\_20\_18 # And Jehoshaphat bowed his head with [his] face to the ground: and all Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem fell before the LORD, worshipping the LORD.

Jerusalem for bondmen <u>14\_2CH\_28\_10</u> # And now ye purpose to keep under the children of Judah and Jerusalem for bondmen and bondwomen unto you: [but are there] not with you, even with you, sins against the LORD your God?

Jerusalem for ever <u>13\_1CH\_23\_25</u> # For David said, The LORD God of Israel hath given rest unto his people, that they may dwell in Jerusalem for ever:

Jerusalem for fear <u>24\_JER\_35\_11</u># But it came to pass, when Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon came up into the land, that we said, Come, and let us go to Jerusalem for fear of the army of the Chaldeans, and for fear of the army of the Syrians: so we dwell at Jerusalem.

Jerusalem for fear 24\_JER\_37\_11# And it came to pass, that when the army of the Chaldeans was broken up from Jerusalem for fear of Pharaoh's army,

Jerusalem for he <u>10\_2SA\_09\_13</u># So Mephibosheth dwelt in Jerusalem: for he did eat continually at the king's table; and was lame on both his feet.

Jerusalem for he <u>10\_2SA\_16\_03</u># And the king said, And where [is] thy master's son? And Ziba said unto the king, Behold, he abideth at Jerusalem: for he said, To day shall the house of Israel restore me the kingdom of my father.

Jerusalem for he 16\_NEH\_07\_02 # That I gave my brother Hanani, and Hananiah the ruler of the palace,

charge over Jerusalem: for he [was] a faithful man, and feared God above many.

Jerusalem for in <u>16\_NEH\_13\_06</u># But in all this [time] was not I at Jerusalem: for in the two and thirtieth year of Artaxerxes king of Babylon came I unto the king, and after certain days obtained I leave of the king:

Jerusalem for it <u>40\_MAT\_05\_35</u># Nor by the earth; for it is his footstool: neither by Jerusalem; for it is the city of the great King.

Jerusalem for Jeroboam <u>14\_2CH\_11\_14</u># For the Levites left their suburbs and their possession, and came to Judah and Jerusalem: for Jeroboam and his sons had cast them off from executing the priest's office unto the LORD:

Jerusalem for Judah <u>39\_MAL\_02\_11</u># Judah hath dealt treacherously, and an abomination is committed in Israel and in Jerusalem; for Judah hath profaned the holiness of the LORD which he loved, and hath married the daughter of a strange god.

Jerusalem for sin <u>38\_ZEC\_13\_01</u># In that day there shall be a fountain opened to the house of David and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem for sin and for uncleanness.

Jerusalem for since 14\_2CH\_30\_26 # So there was great joy in Jerusalem: for since the time of Solomon the son of David king of Israel [there was] not the like in Jerusalem.

Jerusalem for the 44\_ACT\_21\_13 # Then Paul answered, What mean ye to weep and to break mine heart? for I am ready not to be bound only, but also to die at Jerusalem for the name of the Lord Jesus.

Jerusalem for the <u>23\_ISA\_52\_09</u> # Break forth into joy, sing together, ye waste places of Jerusalem: for the LORD hath comforted his people, he hath redeemed Jerusalem.

Jerusalem for then 24\_JER\_44\_17# But we will certainly do whatsoever thing goeth forth out of our own mouth, to burn incense unto the queen of heaven, and to pour out drink offerings unto her, as we have done, we, and our fathers, our kings, and our princes, in the cities of Judah, and in the streets of Jerusalem: for [then] had we plenty of victuals, and were well, and saw no evil.

Jerusalem for they <u>14\_2CH\_30\_05</u># So they established a decree to make proclamation throughout all Israel, from Beersheba even to Dan, that they should come to keep the passover unto the LORD God of Israel at Jerusalem: for they had not done [it] of a long [time in such sort] as it was written.

Jerusalem for they <u>44\_ACT\_22\_18</u> # And saw him saying unto me, Make haste, and get thee quickly out of Jerusalem: for they will not receive thy testimony concerning me.

Jerusalem for this 14\_2CH\_24\_18 # And they left the house of the LORD God of their fathers, and served groves and idols: and wrath came upon Judah and Jerusalem for this their trespass.

Jerusalem for to <u>44\_ACT\_08\_27</u># And he arose and went: and, behold, a man of Ethiopia, an eunuch of great authority under Candace queen of the Ethiopians, who had the charge of all her treasure, and had come to Jerusalem for to worship,

Jerusalem for to <u>44\_ACT\_22\_05</u># As also the high priest doth bear me witness, and all the estate of the elders: from whom also I received letters unto the brethren, and went to Damascus, to bring them which were there bound unto Jerusalem, for to be punished.

Jerusalem for to <u>44\_ACT\_24\_11</u> # Because that thou mayest understand, that there are yet but twelve days since I went up to Jerusalem for to worship.

Jerusalem from before 14\_2CH\_01\_13 # Then Solomon came [from his journey] to the high place that [was] at Gibeon to Jerusalem, from before the tabernacle of the congregation, and reigned over Israel.

Jerusalem from generation 29\_JOE\_03\_20 # But Judah shall dwell for ever, and Jerusalem from generation to generation.

Jerusalem from one 12 2KI 21 16 # Moreover Manasseh shed innocent blood very much, till he had filled Jerusalem from one end to another; beside his sin wherewith he made Judah to sin, in doing [that which was] evil in the sight of the LORD.

Jerusalem from the 14\_2CH\_25\_23 # And Joash the king of Israel took Amaziah king of Judah, the son of Joash, the son of Jehoahaz, at Bethshemesh, and brought him to Jerusalem, and brake down the wall of Jerusalem from the gate of Ephraim to the corner gate, four hundred cubits.

Jerusalem from the <u>14\_2CH\_32\_22</u># Thus the LORD saved Hezekiah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem from the hand of Sennacherib the king of Assyria, and from the hand of all [other], and guided them on every side.

Jerusalem from the <u>14\_2CH\_34\_03</u> # For in the eighth year of his reign, while he was yet young, he began to seek after the God of David his father: and in the twelfth year he began to purge Judah and Jerusalem from the high places, and the groves, and the carved images, and the molten images.

Jerusalem from the 12\_2KI\_14\_13 # And Jehoash king of Israel took Amaziah king of Judah, the son of Jehoash the son of Ahaziah, at Bethshemesh, and came to Jerusalem, and brake down the wall of Jerusalem from the gate of Ephraim unto the corner gate, four hundred cubits.

Jerusalem from the 44\_ACT\_01\_12 # Then returned they unto Jerusalem from the mount called Olivet, which is from Jerusalem a sabbath day's journey.

Jerusalem from the <u>23\_ISA\_04\_04</u> # When the Lord shall have washed away the filth of the daughters of Zion, and shall have purged the blood of Jerusalem from the midst thereof by the spirit of judgment, and by the spirit of burning.

Jerusalem Gibeath and <u>06\_JOS\_18\_28</u># And Zelah, Eleph, and Jebusi, which [is] Jerusalem, Gibeath, [and] Kirjath; fourteen cities with their villages. This [is] the inheritance of the children of Benjamin according to their families.

Jerusalem go and 24\_JER\_11\_12# Then shall the cities of Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem go, and cry unto the gods unto whom they offer incense: but they shall not save them at all in the time of their trouble.

Jerusalem go not 24 JER 27 18 # But if they [be] prophets, and if the word of the LORD be with them, let them now make intercession to the LORD of hosts, that the vessels which are left in the house of the LORD, and [in] the house of the king of Judah, and at Jerusalem, go not to Babylon.

Jerusalem go with <u>15\_EZR\_07\_13</u># I make a decree, that all they of the people of Israel, and [of] his priests and Levites, in my realm, which are minded of their own freewill to go up to Jerusalem, go with thee.

Jerusalem greatly and 44\_ACT\_06\_07 # And the word of God increased; and the number of the disciples multiplied in Jerusalem greatly; and a great company of the priests were obedient to the faith.

Jerusalem had heard <a href="Model of JoS\_10\_01">Model of JoS\_10\_01</a> # Now it came to pass, when Adonizedek king of Jerusalem had heard how Joshua had taken Ai, and had utterly destroyed it; as he had done to Jericho and her king, so he had done to Ai and her king; and how the inhabitants of Gibeon had made peace with Israel, and were among them;

Jerusalem half of <u>38\_ZEC\_14\_08</u># And it shall be in that day, [that] living waters shall go out from Jerusalem; half of them toward the former sea, and half of them toward the hinder sea: in summer and in winter shall it be.

Jerusalem hang down 25 LAM 02 10 # The elders of the daughter of Zion sit upon the ground, [and] keep silence: they have cast up dust upon their heads; they have girded themselves with sackcloth: the virgins of Jerusalem hang down their heads to the ground.

Jerusalem hath grievously <u>25\_LAM\_01\_08</u># Jerusalem hath grievously sinned; therefore she is removed: all that honoured her despise her, because they have seen her nakedness: yea, she sigheth, and turneth backward.

Jerusalem hath shaken 12 2KI 19 21 # This [is] the word that the LORD hath spoken concerning him; The virgin the daughter of Zion hath despised thee, [and] laughed thee to scorn; the daughter of Jerusalem hath shaken her head at thee.

Jerusalem hath shaken 23 ISA 37 22 # This [is] the word which the LORD hath spoken concerning him; The virgin, the daughter of Zion, hath despised thee, [and] laughed thee to scorn; the daughter of Jerusalem hath shaken her head at thee.

Jerusalem have said <u>26\_EZE\_11\_15</u># Son of man, thy brethren, [even] thy brethren, the men of thy kindred, and all the house of Israel wholly, [are] they unto whom the inhabitants of Jerusalem have said, Get you far from the LORD: unto us is this land given in possession.

Jerusalem have ye <u>24\_JER\_11\_13</u># For [according to] the number of thy cities were thy gods, O Judah; and [according to] the number of the streets of Jerusalem have ye set up altars to [that] shameful thing, [even] altars to burn incense unto Baal.

Jerusalem have ye 29\_JOE\_03\_06 # The children also of Judah and the children of Jerusalem have ye sold unto the Grecians, that ye might remove them far from their border.

Jerusalem he and <u>16\_NEH\_03\_12</u> # And next unto him repaired Shallum the son of Halohesh, the ruler of the half part of Jerusalem, he and his daughters.

Jerusalem he assayed 44\_ACT\_09\_26 # And when Saul was come to Jerusalem, he assayed to join himself to the disciples: but they were all afraid of him, and believed not that he was a disciple.

Jerusalem he assembled <a href="mailto:11\_1KI\_12\_21">11\_1KI\_12\_21</a> And when Rehoboam was come to Jerusalem, he assembled all the house of Judah, with the tribe of Benjamin, an hundred and fourscore thousand chosen men, which were warriors, to fight against the house of Israel, to bring the kingdom again to Rehoboam the son of Solomon.

Jerusalem he gathered <u>14\_2CH\_11\_01</u># And when Rehoboam was come to Jerusalem, he gathered of the house of Judah and Benjamin an hundred and fourscore thousand chosen [men], which were warriors, to fight against Israel, that he might bring the kingdom again to Rehoboam.

Jerusalem he gathereth 19\_PSA\_147\_02 # The LORD doth build up Jerusalem: he gathereth together the outcasts of Israel.

Jerusalem he kneeled <u>27\_DAN\_06\_10</u># Now when Daniel knew that the writing was signed, he went into his house; and his windows being open in his chamber toward Jerusalem, he kneeled upon his knees three times a day, and prayed, and gave thanks before his God, as he did aforetime.

Jerusalem he reigned 13\_1CH\_03\_04 # [These] six were born unto him in Hebron; and there he reigned seven years and six months: and in Jerusalem he reigned thirty and three years.

Jerusalem he reigned <u>10\_2SA\_05\_05</u> # In Hebron he reigned over Judah seven years and six months: and in Jerusalem he reigned thirty and three years over all Israel and Judah.

Jerusalem heaps and 24\_JER\_09\_11 # And I will make Jerusalem heaps, [and] a den of dragons; and I will make the cities of Judah desolate, without an inhabitant.

Jerusalem heard that 44\_ACT\_08\_14 # Now when the apostles which were at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the word of God, they sent unto them Peter and John:

Jerusalem heard tidings <u>24\_JER\_37\_05</u> # Then Pharaoh's army was come forth out of Egypt: and when the Chaldeans that besieged Jerusalem heard tidings of them, they departed from Jerusalem.

Jerusalem His mother's 14\_2CH\_13\_02 # He reigned three years in Jerusalem. His mother's name also [was] Michaiah the daughter of Uriel of Gibeah. And there was war between Abijah and Jeroboam.

Jerusalem His mother's 14\_2CH\_22\_02 # Forty and two years old [was] Ahaziah when he began to reign, and he reigned one year in Jerusalem. His mother's name also [was] Athaliah the daughter of Omri.

Jerusalem His mother's <u>14\_2CH\_24\_01</u># Joash [was] seven years old when he began to reign, and he reigned forty years in Jerusalem. His mother's name also [was] Zibiah of Beersheba.

Jerusalem His mother's 14\_2CH\_26\_03 # Sixteen years old [was] Uzziah when he began to reign, and he reigned fifty and two years in Jerusalem. His mother's name also [was] Jecoliah of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem His mother's 14\_2CH\_27\_01 # Jotham [was] twenty and five years old when he began to reign, and he reigned sixteen years in Jerusalem. His mother's name also [was] Jerushah, the daughter of Zadok.

Jerusalem His mother's 12\_2KI\_18\_02 # Twenty and five years old was he when he began to reign; and he reigned twenty and nine years in Jerusalem. His mother's name also [was] Abi, the daughter of Zachariah.

Jerusalem I Darius <u>15\_EZR\_06\_12</u># And the God that hath caused his name to dwell there destroy all kings and people, that shall put to their hand to alter [and] to destroy this house of God which [is] at Jerusalem. I Darius have made a decree; let it be done with speed.

Jerusalem I have <u>26\_EZE\_05\_05</u> # Thus saith the Lord GOD; This [is] Jerusalem: I have set it in the midst of the nations and countries [that are] round about her.

Jerusalem I will <u>23\_ISA\_10\_12</u> # Wherefore it shall come to pass, [that] when the Lord hath performed his whole work upon mount Zion and on Jerusalem, I will punish the fruit of the stout heart of the king of Assyria, and the glory of his high looks.

Jerusalem if ye <u>22\_SON\_05\_08</u> # I charge you, O daughters of Jerusalem, if ye find my beloved, that ye tell him, that I [am] sick of love.

Jerusalem in her <u>26\_EZE\_36\_38</u> # As the holy flock, as the flock of Jerusalem in her solemn feasts; so shall the waste cities be filled with flocks of men: and they shall know that I [am] the LORD.

Jerusalem in mount 14\_2CH\_03\_01 # Then Solomon began to build the house of the LORD at Jerusalem in mount Moriah, where [the Lord] appeared unto David his father, in the place that David had prepared in the threshingfloor of Ornan the Jebusite.

Jerusalem in the <u>14\_2CH\_15\_10</u> # So they gathered themselves together at Jerusalem in the third month, in the fifteenth year of the reign of Asa.

Jerusalem in the <u>14\_2CH\_20\_05</u> # And Jehoshaphat stood in the congregation of Judah and Jerusalem, in the house of the LORD, before the new court,

Jerusalem in the <u>14\_2CH\_34\_22</u> # And Hilkiah, and [they] that the king [had appointed], went to Huldah the prophetess, the wife of Shallum the son of Tikvath, the son of Hasrah, keeper of the wardrobe; [now she dwelt in Jerusalem in the college:] and they spake to her to that [effect].

Jerusalem in the 12\_2KI\_22\_14 # So Hilkiah the priest, and Ahikam, and Achbor, and Shaphan, and Asahiah, went unto Huldah the prophetess, the wife of Shallum the son of Tikvah, the son of Harhas, keeper of the wardrobe; [now she dwelt in Jerusalem in the college;] and they communed with her.

Jerusalem in the 12\_2KI\_23\_04 # And the king commanded Hilkiah the high priest, and the priests of the second order, and the keepers of the door, to bring forth out of the temple of the LORD all the vessels that were made for Baal, and for the grove, and for all the host of heaven: and he burned them without Jerusalem in the fields of Kidron, and carried the ashes of them unto Bethel.

Jerusalem in the <u>15\_EZR\_03\_08</u># Now in the second year of their coming unto the house of God at Jerusalem, in the second month, began Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, and Jeshua the son of Jozadak, and the remnant of their brethren the priests and the Levites, and all they that were come out of the captivity unto Jerusalem; and appointed the Levites, from twenty years old and upward, to set forward the work of the house of the LORD.

Jerusalem in the <u>23\_ISA\_01\_01</u> # The vision of Isaiah the son of Amoz, which he saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem in the days of Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz, [and] Hezekiah, kings of Judah.

Jerusalem in this 24\_JER\_19\_07 # And I will make void the counsel of Judah and Jerusalem in this place; and I will cause them to fall by the sword before their enemies, and by the hands of them that seek their lives: and their carcases will I give to be meat for the fowls of the heaven, and for the beasts of the earth.

Jerusalem insomuch as <u>44\_ACT\_01\_19</u># And it was known unto all the dwellers at Jerusalem; insomuch as that field is called in their proper tongue, Aceldama, that is to say, The field of blood.

Jerusalem is as <u>25 LAM\_01\_17</u> # Zion spreadeth forth her hands, [and there is] none to comfort her: the LORD hath commanded concerning Jacob, [that] his adversaries [should be] round about him: Jerusalem is as a menstruous woman among them.

Jerusalem is builded 19\_PSA\_122\_03 # Jerusalem is builded as a city that is compact together:

Jerusalem is gone 24\_JER\_14\_02 # Judah mourneth, and the gates thereof languish; they are black unto the ground; and the cry of Jerusalem is gone up.

Jerusalem Is not 43\_JOH\_07\_25 # Then said some of them of Jerusalem, Is not this he, whom they seek to kill?

Jerusalem is profaneness 24 JER 23 15 # Therefore thus saith the LORD of hosts concerning the prophets; Behold, I will feed them with wormwood, and make them drink the water of gall: for from the prophets of Jerusalem is profaneness gone forth into all the land.

Jerusalem is ruined <u>23\_ISA\_03\_08</u># For Jerusalem is ruined, and Judah is fallen: because their tongue and their doings [are] against the LORD, to provoke the eyes of his glory.

Jerusalem is the <u>43\_JOH\_04\_20</u> # Our fathers worshipped in this mountain; and ye say, that in Jerusalem is the place where men ought to worship.

Jerusalem Jerusalem thou 40 MAT 23 37 # O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, [thou] that killest the prophets, and stonest them which are sent unto thee, how often would I have gathered thy children together, even as a hen gathereth her chickens under [her] wings, and ye would not!

Jerusalem Jerusalem which <u>42\_LUK\_13\_34</u> # O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, which killest the prophets, and stonest them that are sent unto thee; how often would I have gathered thy children together, as a hen [doth gather] her brood under [her] wings, and ye would not!

Jerusalem Jews devout <u>44\_ACT\_02\_05</u># And there were dwelling at Jerusalem Jews, devout men, out of every nation under heaven.

Jerusalem kept the <a href="#">14\_2CH\_30\_21</a># And the children of Israel that were present at Jerusalem kept the feast of unleavened bread seven days with great gladness: and the Levites and the priests praised the LORD day by day, [singing] with loud instruments unto the LORD.

Jerusalem know all <u>44\_ACT\_26\_04</u> # My manner of life from my youth, which was at the first among mine own nation at Jerusalem, know all the Jews;

Jerusalem laying wait <u>44\_ACT\_25\_03</u># And desired favour against him, that he would send for him to Jerusalem, laying wait in the way to kill him.

Jerusalem lest my 24\_JER\_04\_04 # Circumcise yourselves to the LORD, and take away the foreskins of your heart, ye men of Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem: lest my fury come forth like fire, and burn that none can quench [it], because of the evil of your doings.

Jerusalem lest my <u>24\_JER\_06\_08</u> # Be thou instructed, O Jerusalem, lest my soul depart from thee; lest I make thee desolate, a land not inhabited.

Jerusalem let it <u>15\_EZR\_06\_09</u> # And that which they have need of, both young bullocks, and rams, and lambs, for the burnt offerings of the God of heaven, wheat, salt, wine, and oil, according to the appointment of the priests which [are] at Jerusalem, let it be given them day by day without fail:

Jerusalem loose thyself 23\_ISA\_52\_02 # Shake thyself from the dust; arise, [and] sit down, O Jerusalem: loose thyself from the bands of thy neck, O captive daughter of Zion.

Jerusalem made Ahaziah <u>14 2CH 22 01</u> # And the inhabitants of Jerusalem made Ahaziah his youngest son king in his stead: for the band of men that came with the Arabians to the camp had slain all the eldest. So Ahaziah the son of Jehoram king of Judah reigned.

Jerusalem many days 11\_1KI\_02\_38 # And Shimei said unto the king, The saying [is] good: as my lord the king hath said, so will thy servant do. And Shimei dwelt in Jerusalem many days.

Jerusalem may be 45\_ROM\_15\_31 # That I may be delivered from them that do not believe in Judaea; and that my service which [I have] for Jerusalem may be accepted of the saints;

Jerusalem mourned for 14\_2CH\_35\_24 # His servants therefore took him out of that chariot, and put him in the second chariot that he had; and they brought him to Jerusalem, and he died, and was buried in [one of] the sepulchres of his fathers. And all Judah and Jerusalem mourned for Josiah.

Jerusalem much people 14\_2CH\_30\_13 # And there assembled at Jerusalem much people to keep the feast of unleavened bread in the second month, a very great congregation.

Jerusalem neither shall 24 JER\_03 17 # At that time they shall call Jerusalem the throne of the LORD; and all the nations shall be gathered unto it, to the name of the LORD, to Jerusalem: neither shall they walk any more after the imagination of their evil heart.

Jerusalem neither was 16\_NEH\_02\_12 # And I arose in the night, I and some few men with me; neither told I [any] man what my God had put in my heart to do at Jerusalem: neither [was there any] beast with me, save the beast that I rode upon.

Jerusalem one the <u>06\_JOS\_12\_10</u> # The king of Jerusalem, one; the king of Hebron, one;

Jerusalem or who <u>24\_JER\_15\_05</u># For who shall have pity upon thee, O Jerusalem? or who shall bemoan thee? or who shall go aside to ask how thou doest?

Jerusalem out of 12 2KI 18 35 # Who [are] they among all the gods of the countries, that have delivered their country out of mine hand, that the LORD should deliver Jerusalem out of mine hand?

Jerusalem out of <u>23\_ISA\_36\_20</u> # Who [are they] among all the gods of these lands, that have delivered their land out of my hand, that the LORD should deliver Jerusalem out of my hand?

Jerusalem out of <u>24\_JER\_08\_01</u> # At that time, saith the LORD, they shall bring out the bones of the kings of Judah, and the bones of his princes, and the bones of the prophets, and the bones of the inhabitants of Jerusalem, out of their graves:

Jerusalem praise thy 19\_PSA\_147\_12 # Praise the LORD, O Jerusalem; praise thy God, O Zion.

Jerusalem Praise ye 19 PSA 116 19 # In the courts of the LORD's house, in the midst of thee, O Jerusalem. Praise ye the LORD.

Jerusalem Praise ye <u>19\_PSA\_135\_21</u># Blessed be the LORD out of Zion, which dwelleth at Jerusalem. Praise ye the LORD.

Jerusalem rebuke thee <u>38\_ZEC\_03\_02</u># And the LORD said unto Satan, The LORD rebuke thee, O Satan; even the LORD that hath chosen Jerusalem rebuke thee: [is] not this a brand plucked out of the fire?

Jerusalem round about 12 2KI 25 10 # And all the army of the Chaldees, that [were with] the captain of the guard, brake down the walls of Jerusalem round about.

Jerusalem round about 24\_JER\_52\_14 # And all the army of the Chaldeans, that [were] with the captain of the guard, brake down all the walls of Jerusalem round about.

Jerusalem said He 41\_MAR\_03\_22 # And the scribes which came down from Jerusalem said, He hath Beelzebub, and by the prince of the devils casteth he out devils.

Jerusalem saith the 23\_ISA\_66\_20 # And they shall bring all your brethren [for] an offering unto the LORD out of all nations upon horses, and in chariots, and in litters, and upon mules, and upon swift beasts, to my holy mountain Jerusalem, saith the LORD, as the children of Israel bring an offering in a clean vessel into the house of the LORD.

Jerusalem say 24\_JER\_51\_35 # The violence done to me and to my flesh [be] upon Babylon, shall the inhabitant of Zion say; and my blood upon the inhabitants of Chaldea, shall Jerusalem say.

Jerusalem saying After 44 ACT 19 21 # After these things were ended, Paul purposed in the spirit, when he had passed through Macedonia and Achaia, to go to Jerusalem, saying, After I have been there, I must also see Rome.

Jerusalem saying Go <u>16\_NEH\_08\_15</u># And that they should publish and proclaim in all their cities, and in Jerusalem, saying, Go forth unto the mount, and fetch olive branches, and pine branches, and myrtle branches, and palm branches, and branches of thick trees, to make booths, as [it is] written.

Jerusalem saying Hear <u>24\_JER\_11\_06</u># Then the LORD said unto me, Proclaim all these words in the cities of Judah, and in the streets of Jerusalem, saying, Hear ye the words of this covenant, and do them.

Jerusalem sent unto <u>06\_JOS\_10\_03</u># Wherefore Adonizedek king of Jerusalem sent unto Hoham king of Hebron, and unto Piram king of Jarmuth, and unto Japhia king of Lachish, and unto Debir king of Eglon, saying,

Jerusalem shall be <u>23\_ISA\_04\_03</u> # And it shall come to pass, [that he that is] left in Zion, and [he that] remaineth in Jerusalem, shall be called holy, [even] every one that is written among the living in Jerusalem:

Jerusalem shall kings 19 PSA 68 29 # Because of thy temple at Jerusalem shall kings bring presents unto thee.

Jerusalem shall my 14\_2CH\_33\_04 # Also he built altars in the house of the LORD, whereof the LORD had said, In Jerusalem shall my name be for ever.

Jerusalem shall not 12\_2KI\_19\_10 # Thus shall ye speak to Hezekiah king of Judah, saying, Let not thy God in whom thou trustest deceive thee, saying, Jerusalem shall not be delivered into the hand of the king of Assyria.

Jerusalem shall not 23\_ISA\_37\_10 # Thus shall ye speak to Hezekiah king of Judah, saying, Let not thy God, in whom thou trustest, deceive thee, saying, Jerusalem shall not be given into the hand of the king of Assyria.

Jerusalem Shammua and <u>13\_1CH\_14\_04</u># Now these [are] the names of [his] children which he had in Jerusalem; Shammua, and Shobab, Nathan, and Solomon,

Jerusalem Shammuah and 10\_2SA\_05\_14 # And these [be] the names of those that were born unto him in Jerusalem; Shammuah, and Shobab, and Nathan, and Solomon,

Jerusalem Shimea and <u>13\_1CH\_03\_05</u># And these were born unto him in Jerusalem; Shimea, and Shobab, and Nathan, and Solomon, four, of Bathshua the daughter of Ammiel:

Jerusalem slidden back <u>24\_JER\_08\_05</u> # Why [then] is this people of Jerusalem slidden back by a perpetual backsliding? they hold fast deceit, they refuse to return.

Jerusalem So it 15\_EZR\_04\_24 # Then ceased the work of the house of God which [is] at Jerusalem. So it ceased unto the second year of the reign of Darius king of Persia.

Jerusalem so must <u>44\_ACT\_23\_11</u> # And the night following the Lord stood by him, and said, Be of good cheer, Paul: for as thou hast testified of me in Jerusalem, so must thou bear witness also at Rome.

Jerusalem so shall 24\_JER\_42\_18 # For thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; As mine anger and my fury hath been poured forth upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem; so shall my fury be poured forth upon you, when ye shall enter into Egypt: and ye shall be an execration, and an astonishment, and a curse, and a reproach; and ye shall see this place no more.

Jerusalem so that <u>14\_2CH\_32\_26</u># Notwithstanding Hezekiah humbled himself for the pride of his heart, [both] he and the inhabitants of Jerusalem, so that the wrath of the LORD came not upon them in the days of Hezekiah.

Jerusalem so the 19\_PSA\_125\_02 # As the mountains [are] round about Jerusalem, so the LORD [is] round

about his people from henceforth even for ever.

Jerusalem stood round <u>44\_ACT\_25\_07</u># And when he was come, the Jews which came down from Jerusalem stood round about, and laid many and grievous complaints against Paul, which they could not prove.

Jerusalem terrible as 22\_SON\_06\_04 # Thou [art] beautiful, O my love, as Tirzah, comely as Jerusalem, terrible as [an army] with banners.

Jerusalem that are 24\_JER\_33\_10 # Thus saith the LORD; Again there shall be heard in this place, which ye say [shall be] desolate without man and without beast, [even] in the cities of Judah, and in the streets of Jerusalem, that are desolate, without man, and without inhabitant, and without beast,

Jerusalem that bringest 23\_ISA\_40\_09 # O Zion, that bringest good tidings, get thee up into the high mountain; O Jerusalem, that bringest good tidings, lift up thy voice with strength; lift [it] up, be not afraid; say unto the cities of Judah, Behold your God!

Jerusalem that day <u>10\_2SA\_11\_12</u># And David said to Uriah, Tarry here to day also, and to morrow I will let thee depart. So Uriah abode in Jerusalem that day, and the morrow.

Jerusalem that enter <u>24\_JER\_17\_20</u> # And say unto them, Hear ye the word of the LORD, ye kings of Judah, and all Judah, and all the inhabitants of Jerusalem, that enter in by these gates:

Jerusalem that he <u>42\_LUK\_17\_11</u># And it came to pass, as he went to Jerusalem, that he passed through the midst of Samaria and Galilee.

Jerusalem that in 16\_NEH\_04\_22 # Likewise at the same time said I unto the people, Let every one with his servant lodge within Jerusalem, that in the night they may be a guard to us, and labour on the day.

Jerusalem that my 14\_2CH\_06\_06 # But I have chosen Jerusalem, that my name might be there; and have chosen David to be over my people Israel.

Jerusalem that remain 24\_JER\_24\_08 # And as the evil figs, which cannot be eaten, they are so evil; surely thus saith the LORD, So will I give Zedekiah the king of Judah, and his princes, and the residue of Jerusalem, that remain in this land, and them that dwell in the land of Egypt:

Jerusalem that the <u>11\_1KI\_11\_29</u># And it came to pass at that time when Jeroboam went out of Jerusalem, that the prophet Ahijah the Shilonite found him in the way; and he had clad himself with a new garment; and they two [were] alone in the field:

Jerusalem that the <u>10\_2SA\_19\_19</u># And said unto the king, Let not my lord impute iniquity unto me, neither do thou remember that which thy servant did perversely the day that my lord the king went out of Jerusalem, that the king should take it to his heart.

Jerusalem that the <u>27\_DAN\_05\_02</u> # Belshazzar, whiles he tasted the wine, commanded to bring the golden and silver vessels which his father Nebuchadnezzar had taken out of the temple which [was] in Jerusalem; that the king, and his princes, his wives, and his concubines, might drink therein.

Jerusalem that they <u>11\_1KI\_08\_01</u> # Then Solomon assembled the elders of Israel, and all the heads of the tribes, the chief of the fathers of the children of Israel, unto king Solomon in Jerusalem, that they might bring up the ark of the covenant of the LORD out of the city of David, which [is] Zion.

Jerusalem that watchers <u>24\_JER\_04\_16</u> # Make ye mention to the nations; behold, publish against Jerusalem, [that] watchers come from a far country, and give out their voice against the cities of Judah.

Jerusalem that we 16 NEH 02 17 # Then said I unto them, Ye see the distress that we [are] in, how Jerusalem [lieth] waste, and the gates thereof are burned with fire: come, and let us build up the wall of Jerusalem, that we be no more a reproach.

Jerusalem that were 14\_2CH\_32\_18 # Then they cried with a loud voice in the Jews' speech unto the people of Jerusalem that [were] on the wall, to affright them, and to trouble them; that they might take the city.

Jerusalem that were 10\_28A\_15\_11# And with Absalom went two hundred men out of Jerusalem, [that were] called; and they went in their simplicity, and they knew not any thing.

Jerusalem that ye <u>22\_SON\_08\_04</u> # I charge you, O daughters of Jerusalem, that ye stir not up, nor awake [my] love, until he please.

Jerusalem the brethren <u>44\_ACT\_21\_17</u># And when we were come to Jerusalem, the brethren received us gladly.

Jerusalem the chief <u>44\_ACT\_25\_15</u> # About whom, when I was at Jerusalem, the chief priests and the elders of the Jews informed [me], desiring [to have] judgment against him.

Jerusalem the children <u>06\_JOS\_15\_63</u> # As for the Jebusites the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the children of Judah could not drive them out: but the Jebusites dwell with the children of Judah at Jerusalem unto this day.

Jerusalem the city <u>11\_1KI\_11\_36</u># And unto his son will I give one tribe, that David my servant may have a light alway before me in Jerusalem, the city which I have chosen me to put my name there.

Jerusalem the city 11 1KI 14 21 # And Rehoboam the son of Solomon reigned in Judah. Rehoboam [was] forty and one years old when he began to reign, and he reigned seventeen years in Jerusalem, the city which the LORD did choose out of all the tribes of Israel, to put his name there. And his mother's name [was] Naamah an Ammonitess.

Jerusalem the city 14\_2CH\_12\_13# So king Rehoboam strengthened himself in Jerusalem, and reigned: for Rehoboam [was] one and forty years old when he began to reign, and he reigned seventeen years in Jerusalem, the city which the LORD had chosen out of all the tribes of Israel, to put his name there. And his mother's name [was] Naamah an Ammonitess.

Jerusalem the collection 14\_2CH\_24\_06 # And the king called for Jehoiada the chief, and said unto him, Why hast thou not required of the Levites to bring in out of Judah and out of Jerusalem the collection, [according to the commandment] of Moses the servant of the LORD, and of the congregation of Israel, for the tabernacle of witness?

Jerusalem the day <u>44\_ACT\_20\_16</u># For Paul had determined to sail by Ephesus, because he would not spend the time in Asia: for he hasted, if it were possible for him, to be at Jerusalem the day of Pentecost.

Jerusalem the defenced <u>26\_EZE\_21\_20</u># Appoint a way, that the sword may come to Rabbath of the Ammonites, and to Judah in Jerusalem the defenced.

Jerusalem the eunuchs 24\_JER\_34\_19 # The princes of Judah, and the princes of Jerusalem, the eunuchs, and the priests, and all the people of the land, which passed between the parts of the calf;

Jerusalem the feast 43\_JOH\_10\_22 # And it was at Jerusalem the feast of the dedication, and it was winter.

Jerusalem the holy <u>23\_ISA\_52\_01</u> # Awake, awake; put on thy strength, O Zion; put on thy beautiful garments, O Jerusalem, the holy city: for henceforth there shall no more come into thee the uncircumcised and the unclean.

Jerusalem the holy <u>16 NEH 11 01</u> # And the rulers of the people dwelt at Jerusalem: the rest of the people also cast lots, to bring one of ten to dwell in Jerusalem the holy city, and nine parts [to dwell] in [other] cities.

Jerusalem the king <u>06\_JOS\_10\_05</u> # Therefore the five kings of the Amorites, the king of Jerusalem, the king of Hebron, the king of Jarmuth, the king of Lachish, the king of Eglon, gathered themselves together, and went up, they and all their hosts, and encamped before Gibeon, and made war against it.

Jerusalem the king <u>06\_JOS\_10\_23</u># And they did so, and brought forth those five kings unto him out of the cave, the king of Jerusalem, the king of Hebron, the king of Jarmuth, the king of Lachish, [and] the king of Eglon.

Jerusalem the line 12 2KI 21 13 # And I will stretch over Jerusalem the line of Samaria, and the plummet of the house of Ahab: and I will wipe Jerusalem as [a man] wipeth a dish, wiping [it], and turning [it] upside down.

Jerusalem the rest 16\_NEH\_11\_01 # And the rulers of the people dwelt at Jerusalem: the rest of the people also cast lots, to bring one of ten to dwell in Jerusalem the holy city, and nine parts [to dwell] in [other] cities.

Jerusalem the spirit <u>38\_ZEC\_12\_10</u># And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications: and they shall look upon me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for him, as one mourneth for [his] only [son], and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for [his] firstborn.

Jerusalem the throne 24\_JER\_03\_17 # At that time they shall call Jerusalem the throne of the LORD; and all the nations shall be gathered unto it, to the name of the LORD, to Jerusalem: neither shall they walk any more after the imagination of their evil heart.

Jerusalem the voice 24\_JER\_07\_34 # Then will I cause to cease from the cities of Judah, and from the streets of Jerusalem, the voice of mirth, and the voice of gladness, the voice of the bridegroom, and the voice of the bride; for the land shall be desolate.

Jerusalem Their flesh 38\_ZEC\_14\_12 # And this shall be the plague wherewith the LORD will smite all the people that have fought against Jerusalem; Their flesh shall consume away while they stand upon their feet, and their eyes shall consume away in their holes, and their tongue shall consume away in their mouth.

Jerusalem them also 12\_2KI\_23\_05 # And he put down the idolatrous priests, whom the kings of Judah had ordained to burn incense in the high places in the cities of Judah, and in the places round about Jerusalem; them also that burned incense unto Baal, to the sun, and to the moon, and to the planets, and to all the host of heaven.

Jerusalem Then David <u>13\_1CH\_21\_16</u> # And David lifted up his eyes, and saw the angel of the LORD stand between the earth and the heaven, having a drawn sword in his hand stretched out over Jerusalem. Jerusalem then I <u>10\_2SA\_15\_08</u># For thy servant vowed a vow while I abode at Geshur in Syria, saying, If the LORD shall bring me again indeed to Jerusalem, then I will serve the LORD.

Jerusalem then shall 11\_1KI\_12\_27 # If this people go up to do sacrifice in the house of the LORD at

Jerusalem, then shall the heart of this people turn again unto their lord, [even] unto Rehoboam king of Judah, and they shall kill me, and go again to Rehoboam king of Judah.

Jerusalem they shall 19\_PSA\_122\_06 # Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: they shall prosper that love thee.

Jerusalem they sought <u>16\_NEH\_12\_27</u># And at the dedication of the wall of Jerusalem they sought the Levites out of all their places, to bring them to Jerusalem, to keep the dedication with gladness, both with thanksgivings, and with singing, [with] cymbals, psalteries, and with harps.

Jerusalem they that <u>44\_ACT\_11\_02</u># And when Peter was come up to Jerusalem, they that were of the circumcision contended with him,

Jerusalem they were 44\_ACT\_15\_04 # And when they were come to Jerusalem, they were received of the church, and [of] the apostles and elders, and they declared all things that God had done with them.

Jerusalem this is <u>24\_JER\_06\_06</u># For thus hath the LORD of hosts said, Hew ye down trees, and cast a mount against Jerusalem: this [is] the city to be visited; she [is] wholly oppression in the midst of her.

Jerusalem this same <u>26\_EZE\_24\_02</u> # Son of man, write thee the name of the day, [even] of this same day: the king of Babylon set himself against Jerusalem this same day.

Jerusalem thou shalt 23\_ISA\_30\_19 # For the people shall dwell in Zion at Jerusalem: thou shalt weep no more: he will be very gracious unto thee at the voice of thy cry; when he shall hear it, he will answer thee.

Jerusalem Thou shalt <u>23\_ISA\_44\_26</u># That confirmeth the word of his servant, and performeth the counsel of his messengers; that saith to Jerusalem, Thou shalt be inhabited; and to the cities of Judah, Ye shall be built, and I will raise up the decayed places thereof:

Jerusalem Thou shalt 23\_ISA\_44\_28 # That saith of Cyrus, [He is] my shepherd, and shall perform all my pleasure: even saying to Jerusalem, Thou shalt be built; and to the temple, Thy foundation shall be laid.

Jerusalem thou that <u>40 MAT\_23\_37</u># O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, [thou] that killest the prophets, and stonest them which are sent unto thee, how often would I have gathered thy children together, even as a hen gathereth her chickens under [her] wings, and ye would not!

Jerusalem three months <u>12 2KI 24 08 #</u> Jehoiachin [was] eighteen years old when he began to reign, and he reigned in Jerusalem three months. And his mother's name [was] Nehushta, the daughter of Elnathan of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem Thus saith <u>24\_JER\_19\_03</u># And say, Hear ye the word of the LORD, O kings of Judah, and inhabitants of Jerusalem; Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will bring evil upon this place, the which whosoever heareth, his ears shall tingle.

Jerusalem Thy birth <u>26\_EZE\_16\_03</u># And say, Thus saith the Lord GOD unto Jerusalem; Thy birth and thy nativity [is] of the land of Canaan; thy father [was] an Amorite, and thy mother an Hittite.

Jerusalem thy holy <u>27\_DAN\_09\_16</u># O Lord, according to all thy righteousness, I beseech thee, let thine anger and thy fury be turned away from thy city Jerusalem, thy holy mountain: because for our sins, and for the iniquities of our fathers, Jerusalem and thy people [are become] a reproach to all [that are] about us.

Jerusalem to appoint <u>26\_EZE\_21\_22</u># At his right hand was the divination for Jerusalem, to appoint captains, to open the mouth in the slaughter, to lift up the voice with shouting, to appoint [battering] rams against the gates, to cast a mount, [and] to build a fort.

Jerusalem to Artaxerxes <u>15\_EZR\_04\_08</u> # Rehum the chancellor and Shimshai the scribe wrote a letter against Jerusalem to Artaxerxes the king in this sort:

Jerusalem to ask <u>43\_JOH\_01\_19</u> # And this is the record of John, when the Jews sent priests and Levites from Jerusalem to ask him, Who art thou?

Jerusalem to Babylon <u>12 2KI 24 15 #</u> And he carried away Jehoiachin to Babylon, and the king's mother, and the king's wives, and his officers, and the mighty of the land, [those] carried he into captivity from Jerusalem to Babylon.

Jerusalem to Babylon <u>24\_JER\_27\_20</u># Which Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon took not, when he carried away captive Jeconiah the son of Jehoiakim king of Judah from Jerusalem to Babylon, and all the nobles of Judah and Jerusalem;

Jerusalem to Babylon 24\_JER\_29\_01 # Now these [are] the words of the letter that Jeremiah the prophet sent from Jerusalem unto the residue of the elders which were carried away captives, and to the priests, and to the prophets, and to all the people whom Nebuchadnezzar had carried away captive from Jerusalem to Babylon;

Jerusalem to Babylon <u>24\_JER\_29\_20</u># Hear ye therefore the word of the LORD, all ye of the captivity, whom I have sent from Jerusalem to Babylon:

Jerusalem to battle <u>38\_ZEC\_14\_02</u># For I will gather all nations against Jerusalem to battle; and the city shall be taken, and the houses rifled, and the women ravished; and half of the city shall go forth into captivity, and the residue of the people shall not be cut off from the city.

Jerusalem to bring 13\_1CH\_15\_03 # And David gathered all Israel together to Jerusalem, to bring up the ark of the LORD unto his place, which he had prepared for it.

Jerusalem to bring 14\_2CH\_05\_02 # Then Solomon assembled the elders of Israel, and all the heads of the tribes, the chief of the fathers of the children of Israel, unto Jerusalem, to bring up the ark of the covenant of the LORD out of the city of David, which [is] Zion.

Jerusalem to bring 14\_2CH\_24\_09 # And they made a proclamation through Judah and Jerusalem, to bring in to the LORD the collection [that] Moses the servant of God [laid] upon Israel in the wilderness.

Jerusalem to commit 14\_2CH\_21\_11 # Moreover he made high places in the mountains of Judah, and caused the inhabitants of Jerusalem to commit fornication, and compelled Judah [thereto].

Jerusalem to destroy 13\_1CH\_21\_15 # And God sent an angel unto Jerusalem to destroy it: and as he was destroying, the LORD beheld, and he repented him of the evil, and said to the angel that destroyed, It is enough, stay now thine hand. And the angel of the LORD stood by the threshingfloor of Ornan the Jebusite.

Jerusalem to destroy 10\_2SA\_24\_16 # And when the angel stretched out his hand upon Jerusalem to destroy it, the LORD repented him of the evil, and said to the angel that destroyed the people, It is enough: stay now thine hand. And the angel of the LORD was by the threshingplace of Araunah the Jebusite.

Jerusalem to err 14\_2CH\_33\_09 # So Manasseh made Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem to err, [and] to do worse than the heathen, whom the LORD had destroyed before the children of Israel.

Jerusalem to Gath <u>11\_1KI\_02\_41</u># And it was told Solomon that Shimei had gone from Jerusalem to Gath, and was come again.

Jerusalem to give 14\_2CH\_31\_04 # Moreover he commanded the people that dwelt in Jerusalem to give the

portion of the priests and the Levites, that they might be encouraged in the law of the LORD.

Jerusalem to go 14 2CH 21 13 # But hast walked in the way of the kings of Israel, and hast made Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem to go a whoring, like to the whoredoms of the house of Ahab, and also hast slain thy brethren of thy father's house, [which were] better than thyself:

Jerusalem to go 24\_JER\_37\_12 # Then Jeremiah went forth out of Jerusalem to go into the land of Benjamin, to separate himself thence in the midst of the people.

Jerusalem to Jericho <u>42\_LUK\_10\_30</u># And Jesus answering said, A certain [man] went down from Jerusalem to Jericho, and fell among thieves, which stripped him of his raiment, and wounded [him], and departed, leaving [him] half dead.

Jerusalem to keep <a href="14">14</a> 2CH 30 01</a> # And Hezekiah sent to all Israel and Judah, and wrote letters also to Ephraim and Manasseh, that they should come to the house of the LORD at Jerusalem, to keep the passover unto the LORD God of Israel.

Jerusalem to keep 14\_2CH\_30\_02 # For the king had taken counsel, and his princes, and all the congregation in Jerusalem, to keep the passover in the second month.

Jerusalem to keep <u>16\_NEH\_12\_27</u> # And at the dedication of the wall of Jerusalem they sought the Levites out of all their places, to bring them to Jerusalem, to keep the dedication with gladness, both with thanksgivings, and with singing, [with] cymbals, psalteries, and with harps.

Jerusalem to know 26\_EZE\_16\_02 # Son of man, cause Jerusalem to know her abominations,

Jerusalem to meet 10\_2SA\_19\_25 # And it came to pass, when he was come to Jerusalem to meet the king, that the king said unto him, Wherefore wentest not thou with me, Mephibosheth?

Jerusalem to minister 45\_ROM\_15\_25 # But now I go unto Jerusalem to minister unto the saints.

Jerusalem to present <u>42\_LUK\_02\_22</u># And when the days of her purification according to the law of Moses were accomplished, they brought him to Jerusalem, to present [him] to the Lord;

Jerusalem to proclaim 24\_JER\_34\_08 # [This is] the word that came unto Jeremiah from the LORD, after that the king Zedekiah had made a covenant with all the people which [were] at Jerusalem, to proclaim liberty unto them;

Jerusalem to pursue <u>10\_2SA\_20\_07</u># And there went out after him Joab's men, and the Cherethites, and the Pelethites, and all the mighty men: and they went out of Jerusalem, to pursue after Sheba the son of Bichri.

Jerusalem to sacrifice 14\_2CH\_11\_16# And after them out of all the tribes of Israel such as set their hearts to seek the LORD God of Israel came to Jerusalem, to sacrifice unto the LORD God of their fathers.

Jerusalem to see <u>48\_GAL\_01\_18</u># Then after three years I went up to Jerusalem to see Peter, and abode with him fifteen days.

Jerusalem to see 38\_ZEC\_02\_02 # Then said I, Whither goest thou? And he said unto me, To measure Jerusalem, to see what [is] the breadth thereof, and what [is] the length thereof.

Jerusalem to set <u>11\_1KI\_15\_04</u># Nevertheless for David's sake did the LORD his God give him a lamp in Jerusalem, to set up his son after him, and to establish Jerusalem:

Jerusalem to the 26\_EZE\_08\_03 # And he put forth the form of an hand, and took me by a lock of mine

head; and the spirit lifted me up between the earth and the heaven, and brought me in the visions of God to Jerusalem, to the door of the inner gate that looketh toward the north; where [was] the seat of the image of jealousy, which provoketh to jealousy.

Jerusalem to them <u>48\_GAL\_01\_17</u># Neither went I up to Jerusalem to them which were apostles before me; but I went into Arabia, and returned again unto Damascus.

Jerusalem to war 12\_2KI\_16\_05 # Then Rezin king of Syria and Pekah son of Remaliah king of Israel came up to Jerusalem to war: and they besieged Ahaz, but could not overcome [him].

Jerusalem to war 23\_ISA\_07\_01 # And it came to pass in the days of Ahaz the son of Jotham, the son of Uzziah, king of Judah, [that] Rezin the king of Syria, and Pekah the son of Remaliah, king of Israel, went up toward Jerusalem to war against it, but could not prevail against it.

Jerusalem to worship 38\_ZEC\_14\_17 # And it shall be, [that] whoso will not come up of [all] the families of the earth unto Jerusalem to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, even upon them shall be no rain.

Jerusalem took the <u>40\_MAT\_20\_17</u># And Jesus going up to Jerusalem took the twelve disciples apart in the way, and said unto them,

Jerusalem until ye <u>42\_LUK\_24\_49</u> # And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high.

Jerusalem unto all <u>15\_EZR\_10\_07</u> # And they made proclamation throughout Judah and Jerusalem unto all the children of the captivity, that they should gather themselves together unto Jerusalem;

Jerusalem unto Antioch 44\_ACT\_11\_27 # And in these days came prophets from Jerusalem unto Antioch.

Jerusalem unto Babylon <u>24\_JER\_29\_04</u> # Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, unto all that are carried away captives, whom I have caused to be carried away from Jerusalem unto Babylon;

Jerusalem unto Bethphage 41\_MAR\_11\_01 # And when they came nigh to Jerusalem, unto Bethphage and Bethany, at the mount of Olives, he sendeth forth two of his disciples,

Jerusalem unto Gaza <u>44\_ACT\_08\_26</u> # And the angel of the Lord spake unto Philip, saying, Arise, and go toward the south unto the way that goeth down from Jerusalem unto Gaza, which is desert.

Jerusalem wash thine 24\_JER\_04\_14 # O Jerusalem, wash thine heart from wickedness, that thou mayest

Jerusalem weep not <u>42\_LUK\_23\_28</u> # But Jesus turning unto them said, Daughters of Jerusalem, weep not for me, but weep for yourselves, and for your children.

Jerusalem were four <u>16\_NEH\_11\_06</u># All the sons of Perez that dwelt at Jerusalem [were] four hundred threescore and eight valiant men.

Jerusalem were made <u>16\_NEH\_04\_07</u> # But it came to pass, [that] when Sanballat, and Tobiah, and the Arabians, and the Ammonites, and the Ashdodites, heard that the walls of Jerusalem were made up, [and] that the breaches began to be stopped, then they were very wroth,

Jerusalem with candles <u>36\_ZEP\_01\_12</u># And it shall come to pass at that time, [that] I will search Jerusalem with candles, and punish the men that are settled on their lees: that say in their heart, The LORD will not do good, neither will he do evil.

Jerusalem with drunkenness 24\_JER\_13\_13 # Then shalt thou say unto them, Thus saith the LORD, Behold, I will fill all the inhabitants of this land, even the kings that sit upon David's throne, and the priests, and the prophets, and all the inhabitants of Jerusalem, with drunkenness.

Jerusalem 14\_2CH\_21\_05 # Jehoram [was] thirty and two years old when he began to reign, and he reigned eight years in Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_23\_02</u> # And they went about in Judah, and gathered the Levites out of all the cities of Judah, and the chief of the fathers of Israel, and they came to Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 14\_2CH\_25\_01 # Amaziah [was] twenty and five years old [when] he began to reign, and he reigned twenty and nine years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Jehoaddan of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 14\_2CH\_26\_03 # Sixteen years old [was] Uzziah when he began to reign, and he reigned fifty and two years in Jerusalem. His mother's name also [was] Jecoliah of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_27\_08</u># He was five and twenty years old when he began to reign, and reigned sixteen years in Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_28\_24</u> # And Ahaz gathered together the vessels of the house of God, and cut in pieces the vessels of the house of God, and shut up the doors of the house of the LORD, and he made him altars in every corner of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_30\_03</u># For they could not keep it at that time, because the priests had not sanctified themselves sufficiently, neither had the people gathered themselves together to Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 14\_2CH\_34\_09 # And when they came to Hilkiah the high priest, they delivered the money that was brought into the house of God, which the Levites that kept the doors had gathered of the hand of Manasseh and Ephraim, and of all the remnant of Israel, and of all Judah and Benjamin; and they returned to Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_34\_29</u> # Then the king sent and gathered together all the elders of Judah and Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_35\_18</u> # And there was no passover like to that kept in Israel from the days of Samuel the prophet; neither did all the kings of Israel keep such a passover as Josiah kept, and the priests, and the Levites, and all Judah and Israel that were present, and the inhabitants of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 14\_2CH\_36\_01 # Then the people of the land took Jehoahaz the son of Josiah, and made him king in his father's stead in Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_36\_02</u> # Jehoahaz [was] twenty and three years old when he began to reign, and he reigned three months in Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_36\_10</u> # And when the year was expired, king Nebuchadnezzar sent, and brought him to Babylon, with the goodly vessels of the house of the LORD, and made Zedekiah his brother king over Judah and Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_36\_11</u> # Zedekiah [was] one and twenty years old when he began to reign, and reigned eleven years in Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_36\_14</u> # Moreover all the chief of the priests, and the people, transgressed very much after all the abominations of the heathen; and polluted the house of the LORD which he had hallowed in Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 12\_2KI\_08\_17 # Thirty and two years old was he when he began to reign; and he reigned eight years in Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 12\_2KI\_12\_17 # Then Hazael king of Syria went up, and fought against Gath, and took it: and Hazael set his face to go up to Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 12\_2KI\_12\_18 # And Jehoash king of Judah took all the hallowed things that Jehoshaphat, and Jehoram, and Ahaziah, his fathers, kings of Judah, had dedicated, and his own hallowed things, and all the gold [that was] found in the treasures of the house of the LORD, and in the king's house, and sent [it] to Hazael king of Syria: and he went away from Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 12\_2KI\_14\_02 # He was twenty and five years old when he began to reign, and reigned twenty and nine years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Jehoaddan of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 12\_2KI\_15\_02 # Sixteen years old was he when he began to reign, and he reigned two and fifty years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Jecholiah of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>12\_2KI\_18\_22</u> # But if ye say unto me, We trust in the LORD our God: [is] not that he, whose high places and whose altars Hezekiah hath taken away, and hath said to Judah and Jerusalem, Ye shall worship before this altar in Jerusalem?

Jerusalem 12\_2KI\_23\_01 # And the king sent, and they gathered unto him all the elders of Judah and of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 12\_2KI\_23\_20 # And he slew all the priests of the high places that [were] there upon the altars, and burned men's bones upon them, and returned to Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 12\_2KI\_23\_23 # But in the eighteenth year of king Josiah, [wherein] this passover was holden to the LORD in Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 12\_2KI\_24\_08 # Jehoiachin [was] eighteen years old when he began to reign, and he reigned in Jerusalem three months. And his mother's name [was] Nehushta, the daughter of Elnathan of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>12\_2KI\_25\_08</u># And in the fifth month, on the seventh [day] of the month, which [is] the nineteenth year of king Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, came Nebuzaradan, captain of the guard, a servant of the king of Babylon, unto Jerusalem:

Jerusalem <u>10\_2SA\_08\_07</u> # And David took the shields of gold that were on the servants of Hadadezer, and brought them to Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>10\_2SA\_10\_14</u># And when the children of Ammon saw that the Syrians were fled, then fled they also before Abishai, and entered into the city. So Joab returned from the children of Ammon, and came to Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>10\_2SA\_11\_01</u># And it came to pass, after the year was expired, at the time when kings go forth [to battle], that David sent Joab, and his servants with him, and all Israel; and they destroyed the children of Ammon, and besieged Rabbah. But David tarried still at Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 10\_2SA\_12\_31 # And he brought forth the people that [were] therein, and put [them] under saws, and under harrows of iron, and under axes of iron, and made them pass through the brickkiln: and thus did he unto all the cities of the children of Ammon. So David and all the people returned unto Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 10\_2SA\_14\_23 # So Joab arose and went to Geshur, and brought Absalom to Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 10\_2SA\_15\_37 # So Hushai David's friend came into the city, and Absalom came into Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>10\_2SA\_17\_20</u> # And when Absalom's servants came to the woman to the house, they said, Where [is] Ahimaaz and Jonathan? And the woman said unto them, They be gone over the brook of water. And when they had sought and could not find [them], they returned to Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 10\_28A\_19\_33 # And the king said unto Barzillai, Come thou over with me, and I will feed thee with me in Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 10\_28A\_19\_34 # And Barzillai said unto the king, How long have I to live, that I should go up with the king unto Jerusalem?

Jerusalem <u>10\_2SA\_20\_02</u> # So every man of Israel went up from after David, [and] followed Sheba the son of Bichri: but the men of Judah clave unto their king, from Jordan even to Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>44\_ACT\_04\_06</u># And Annas the high priest, and Caiaphas, and John, and Alexander, and as many as were of the kindred of the high priest, were gathered together at Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>44\_ACT\_09\_02</u> # And desired of him letters to Damascus to the synagogues, that if he found any of this way, whether they were men or women, he might bring them bound unto Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>44\_ACT\_09\_13</u> # Then Ananias answered, Lord, I have heard by many of this man, how much evil he hath done to thy saints at Jerusalem:

Jerusalem 44\_ACT\_09\_28 # And he was with them coming in and going out at Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>44\_ACT\_13\_13</u> # Now when Paul and his company loosed from Paphos, they came to Perga in Pamphylia: and John departing from them returned to Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 44\_ACT\_16\_04 # And as they went through the cities, they delivered them the decrees for to

keep, that were ordained of the apostles and elders which were at Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 44\_ACT\_21\_04 # And finding disciples, we tarried there seven days: who said to Paul through the Spirit, that he should not go up to Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>44\_ACT\_21\_12</u> # And when we heard these things, both we, and they of that place, besought him not to go up to Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 44\_ACT\_21\_15 # And after those days we took up our carriages, and went up to Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>44\_ACT\_25\_01</u> # Now when Festus was come into the province, after three days he ascended from Caesarea to Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>30\_AMO\_02\_05</u> # But I will send a fire upon Judah, and it shall devour the palaces of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>27\_DAN\_09\_02</u> # In the first year of his reign I Daniel understood by books the number of the years, whereof the word of the LORD came to Jeremiah the prophet, that he would accomplish seventy years in the desolations of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>27\_DAN\_09\_12</u> # And he hath confirmed his words, which he spake against us, and against our judges that judged us, by bringing upon us a great evil: for under the whole heaven hath not been done as hath been done upon Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 21\_ECC\_01\_01 # The words of the Preacher, the son of David, king in Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 21\_ECC\_01\_12 # I the Preacher was king over Israel in Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>26\_EZE\_04\_01</u> # Thou also, son of man, take thee a tile, and lay it before thee, and portray upon it the city, [even] Jerusalem:

Jerusalem <u>26\_EZE\_09\_08</u># And it came to pass, while they were slaying them, and I was left, that I fell upon my face, and cried, and said, Ah Lord GOD! wilt thou destroy all the residue of Israel in thy pouring out of thy fury upon Jerusalem?

Jerusalem <u>26\_EZE\_15\_06</u># Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; As the vine tree among the trees of the forest, which I have given to the fire for fuel, so will I give the inhabitants of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>26\_EZE\_22\_19</u> # Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Because ye are all become dross, behold, therefore I will gather you into the midst of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>15\_EZR\_01\_03</u> # Who [is there] among you of all his people? his God be with him, and let him go up to Jerusalem, which [is] in Judah, and build the house of the LORD God of Israel, [he [is] the God,] which [is] in Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>15\_EZR\_01\_04</u> # And whosoever remaineth in any place where he sojourneth, let the men of his place help him with silver, and with gold, and with goods, and with beasts, beside the freewill offering for the house of God that [is] in Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>15\_EZR\_01\_05</u># Then rose up the chief of the fathers of Judah and Benjamin, and the priests, and the Levites, with all [them] whose spirit God had raised, to go up to build the house of the LORD which [is] in Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>15\_EZR\_01\_11</u># All the vessels of gold and of silver [were] five thousand and four hundred. All [these] did Sheshbazzar bring up with [them of] the captivity that were brought up from Babylon unto

Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>15\_EZR\_03\_01</u># And when the seventh month was come, and the children of Israel [were] in the cities, the people gathered themselves together as one man to Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>15\_EZR\_04\_06</u># And in the reign of Ahasuerus, in the beginning of his reign, wrote they [unto him] an accusation against the inhabitants of Judah and Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>15\_EZR\_07\_15</u># And to carry the silver and gold, which the king and his counsellors have freely offered unto the God of Israel, whose habitation [is] in Jerusalem,

Jerusalem <u>15\_EZR\_07\_16</u> # And all the silver and gold that thou canst find in all the province of Babylon, with the freewill offering of the people, and of the priests, offering willingly for the house of their God which [is] in Jerusalem:

Jerusalem <u>15\_EZR\_07\_17</u> # That thou mayest buy speedily with this money bullocks, rams, lambs, with their meat offerings and their drink offerings, and offer them upon the altar of the house of your God which [is] in Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>15\_EZR\_07\_19</u> # The vessels also that are given thee for the service of the house of thy God, [those] deliver thou before the God of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>15\_EZR\_07\_27</u> # Blessed [be] the LORD God of our fathers, which hath put [such a thing] as this in the king's heart, to beautify the house of the LORD which [is] in Jerusalem:

Jerusalem <u>15\_EZR\_09\_09</u> # For we [were] bondmen; yet our God hath not forsaken us in our bondage, but hath extended mercy unto us in the sight of the kings of Persia, to give us a reviving, to set up the house of our God, and to repair the desolations thereof, and to give us a wall in Judah and in Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>15\_EZR\_10\_07</u> # And they made proclamation throughout Judah and Jerusalem unto all the children of the captivity, that they should gather themselves together unto Jerusalem;

Jerusalem 23\_ISA\_02\_01 # The word that Isaiah the son of Amoz saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>23\_ISA\_02\_03</u># And many people shall go and say, Come ye, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the house of the God of Jacob; and he will teach us of his ways, and we will walk in his paths: for out of Zion shall go forth the law, and the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 23\_ISA\_04\_03 # And it shall come to pass, [that he that is] left in Zion, and [he that] remaineth in Jerusalem, shall be called holy, [even] every one that is written among the living in Jerusalem:

Jerusalem <u>23\_ISA\_08\_14</u> # And he shall be for a sanctuary; but for a stone of stumbling and for a rock of offence to both the houses of Israel, for a gin and for a snare to the inhabitants of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>23\_ISA\_10\_32</u> # As yet shall he remain at Nob that day: he shall shake his hand [against] the mount of the daughter of Zion, the hill of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>23\_ISA\_27\_13</u> # And it shall come to pass in that day, [that] the great trumpet shall be blown, and they shall come which were ready to perish in the land of Assyria, and the outcasts in the land of Egypt, and shall worship the LORD in the holy mount at Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>23\_ISA\_28\_14</u> # Wherefore hear the word of the LORD, ye scornful men, that rule this people which [is] in Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 23\_ISA\_31\_09 # And he shall pass over to his strong hold for fear, and his princes shall be afraid

of the ensign, saith the LORD, whose fire [is] in Zion, and his furnace in Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>23\_ISA\_52\_09</u> # Break forth into joy, sing together, ye waste places of Jerusalem: for the LORD hath comforted his people, he hath redeemed Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>23\_ISA\_66\_13</u> # As one whom his mother comforteth, so will I comfort you; and ye shall be comforted in Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>24\_JER\_07\_17</u> # Seest thou not what they do in the cities of Judah and in the streets of Jerusalem?

Jerusalem <u>24\_JER\_11\_02</u># Hear ye the words of this covenant, and speak unto the men of Judah, and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem;

Jerusalem <u>24\_JER\_11\_09</u># And the LORD said unto me, A conspiracy is found among the men of Judah, and among the inhabitants of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>24\_JER\_13\_09</u> # Thus saith the LORD, After this manner will I mar the pride of Judah, and the great pride of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>24\_JER\_15\_04</u> # And I will cause them to be removed into all kingdoms of the earth, because of Manasseh the son of Hezekiah king of Judah, for [that] which he did in Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>24\_JER\_17\_19</u> # Thus said the LORD unto me; Go and stand in the gate of the children of the people, whereby the kings of Judah come in, and by the which they go out, and in all the gates of Jerusalem;

Jerusalem 24\_JER\_17\_21 # Thus saith the LORD; Take heed to yourselves, and bear no burden on the sabbath day, nor bring [it] in by the gates of Jerusalem;

Jerusalem <u>24\_JER\_22\_19</u> # He shall be buried with the burial of an ass, drawn and cast forth beyond the gates of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>24\_JER\_27\_20</u> # Which Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon took not, when he carried away captive Jeconiah the son of Jehoiakim king of Judah from Jerusalem to Babylon, and all the nobles of Judah and Jerusalem;

Jerusalem <u>24\_JER\_27\_21</u> # Yea, thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, concerning the vessels that remain [in] the house of the LORD, and [in] the house of the king of Judah and of Jerusalem;

Jerusalem <u>24\_JER\_29\_02</u> # [After that Jeconiah the king, and the queen, and the eunuchs, the princes of Judah and Jerusalem, and the carpenters, and the smiths, were departed from Jerusalem;]

Jerusalem <u>24\_JER\_32\_32</u> # Because of all the evil of the children of Israel and of the children of Judah, which they have done to provoke me to anger, they, their kings, their princes, their priests, and their prophets, and the men of Judah, and the inhabitants of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>24\_JER\_34\_06</u> # Then Jeremiah the prophet spake all these words unto Zedekiah king of Judah in Jerusalem,

Jerusalem <u>24\_JER\_35\_11</u># But it came to pass, when Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon came up into the land, that we said, Come, and let us go to Jerusalem for fear of the army of the Chaldeans, and for fear of the army of the Syrians: so we dwell at Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 24\_JER\_36\_09 # And it came to pass in the fifth year of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah king of

Judah, in the ninth month, [that] they proclaimed a fast before the LORD to all the people in Jerusalem, and to all the people that came from the cities of Judah unto Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>24\_JER\_37\_05</u> # Then Pharaoh's army was come forth out of Egypt: and when the Chaldeans that besieged Jerusalem heard tidings of them, they departed from Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 24\_JER\_39\_08 # And the Chaldeans burned the king's house, and the houses of the people, with fire, and brake down the walls of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>24\_JER\_44\_09</u># Have ye forgotten the wickedness of your fathers, and the wickedness of the kings of Judah, and the wickedness of their wives, and your own wickedness, and the wickedness of your wives, which they have committed in the land of Judah, and in the streets of Jerusalem?

Jerusalem <u>24\_JER\_52\_12</u> # Now in the fifth month, in the tenth [day] of the month, which [was] the nineteenth year of Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon, came Nebuzaradan, captain of the guard, [which] served the king of Babylon, into Jerusalem,

Jerusalem <u>29\_JOE\_03\_01</u># For, behold, in those days, and in that time, when I shall bring again the captivity of Judah and Jerusalem,

Jerusalem 43\_JOH\_02\_13 # And the Jews' passover was at hand, and Jesus went up to Jerusalem,

Jerusalem 43\_JOH\_05\_01 # After this there was a feast of the Jews; and Jesus went up to Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>43\_JOH\_12\_12</u> # On the next day much people that were come to the feast, when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem,

Jerusalem <u>25\_LAM\_04\_12</u> # The kings of the earth, and all the inhabitants of the world, would not have believed that the adversary and the enemy should have entered into the gates of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>42\_LUK\_02\_38</u> # And she coming in that instant gave thanks likewise unto the Lord, and spake of him to all them that looked for redemption in Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>42\_LUK\_09\_31</u> # Who appeared in glory, and spake of his decease which he should accomplish at Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>42\_LUK\_09\_51</u> # And it came to pass, when the time was come that he should be received up, he stedfastly set his face to go to Jerusalem,

Jerusalem <u>42\_LUK\_09\_53</u># And they did not receive him, because his face was as though he would go to Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>42\_LUK\_13\_04</u> # Or those eighteen, upon whom the tower in Siloam fell, and slew them, think ye that they were sinners above all men that dwelt in Jerusalem?

Jerusalem <u>42\_LUK\_13\_22</u> # And he went through the cities and villages, teaching, and journeying toward Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>42\_LUK\_13\_33</u> # Nevertheless I must walk to day, and to morrow, and the [day] following: for it cannot be that a prophet perish out of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 42\_LUK\_19\_28 # And when he had thus spoken, he went before, ascending up to Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>42\_LUK\_24\_47</u># And that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in his name among all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>41\_MAR\_07\_01</u> # Then came together unto him the Pharisees, and certain of the scribes, which came from Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 41\_MAR\_15\_41 # [Who also, when he was in Galilee, followed him, and ministered unto him;] and many other women which came up with him unto Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 40\_MAT\_02\_01 # Now when Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judaea in the days of Herod the king, behold, there came wise men from the east to Jerusalem,

Jerusalem <u>33\_MIC\_01\_01</u> # The word of the LORD that came to Micah the Morasthite in the days of Jotham, Ahaz, [and] Hezekiah, kings of Judah, which he saw concerning Samaria and Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>33\_MIC\_01\_05</u> # For the transgression of Jacob [is] all this, and for the sins of the house of Israel. What [is] the transgression of Jacob? [is it] not Samaria? and what [are] the high places of Judah? [are they] not Jerusalem?

Jerusalem <u>33\_MIC\_01\_09</u> # For her wound [is] incurable; for it is come unto Judah; he is come unto the gate of my people, [even] to Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 33\_MIC\_01\_12 # For the inhabitant of Maroth waited carefully for good: but evil came down from the LORD unto the gate of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 33\_MIC\_04\_02 # And many nations shall come, and say, Come, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, and to the house of the God of Jacob; and he will teach us of his ways, and we will walk in his paths: for the law shall go forth of Zion, and the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>33\_MIC\_04\_08</u># And thou, O tower of the flock, the strong hold of the daughter of Zion, unto thee shall it come, even the first dominion; the kingdom shall come to the daughter of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>16\_NEH\_01\_02</u> # That Hanani, one of my brethren, came, he and [certain] men of Judah; and I asked them concerning the Jews that had escaped, which were left of the captivity, and concerning Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>16\_NEH\_02\_20</u># Then answered I them, and said unto them, The God of heaven, he will prosper us; therefore we his servants will arise and build: but ye have no portion, nor right, nor memorial, in Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>16\_NEH\_03\_09</u># And next unto them repaired Rephaiah the son of Hur, the ruler of the half part of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>16\_NEH\_11\_02</u># And the people blessed all the men, that willingly offered themselves to dwell at Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>16\_NEH\_12\_29</u> # Also from the house of Gilgal, and out of the fields of Geba and Azmaveth: for the singers had builded them villages round about Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>16\_NEH\_13\_16</u> # There dwelt men of Tyre also therein, which brought fish, and all manner of ware, and sold on the sabbath unto the children of Judah, and in Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 19\_PSA\_102\_21 # To declare the name of the LORD in Zion, and his praise in Jerusalem;

Jerusalem 19\_PSA\_122\_02 # Our feet shall stand within thy gates, O Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 19\_PSA\_51\_18 # Do good in thy good pleasure unto Zion: build thou the walls of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>45\_ROM\_15\_26</u> # For it hath pleased them of Macedonia and Achaia to make a certain contribution for the poor saints which are at Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>22\_SON\_03\_10</u># He made the pillars thereof [of] silver, the bottom thereof [of] gold, the covering of it [of] purple, the midst thereof being paved [with] love, for the daughters of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>22\_SON\_05\_16</u> # His mouth [is] most sweet: yea, he [is] altogether lovely. This [is] my beloved, and this [is] my friend, O daughters of Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>38\_ZEC\_01\_16</u> # Therefore thus saith the LORD; I am returned to Jerusalem with mercies: my house shall be built in it, saith the LORD of hosts, and a line shall be stretched forth upon Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>38\_ZEC\_01\_17</u> # Cry yet, saying, Thus saith the LORD of hosts; My cities through prosperity shall yet be spread abroad; and the LORD shall yet comfort Zion, and shall yet choose Jerusalem.

Jerusalem 38\_ZEC\_01\_19 # And I said unto the angel that talked with me, What [be] these? And he answered me, These [are] the horns which have scattered Judah, Israel, and Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>38\_ZEC\_12\_02</u> # Behold, I will make Jerusalem a cup of trembling unto all the people round about, when they shall be in the siege both against Judah [and] against Jerusalem.

Jerusalem <u>38\_ZEC\_12\_06</u> # In that day will I make the governors of Judah like an hearth of fire among the wood, and like a torch of fire in a sheaf; and they shall devour all the people round about, on the right hand and on the left: and Jerusalem shall be inhabited again in her own place, [even] in Jerusalem.
