Salute all them <u>58_HEB_13_24</u># Salute all them that have the rule over you, and all the saints. They of Italy salute you.

Salute Andronicus and <u>45_ROM_16_07</u> # Salute Andronicus and Junia, my kinsmen, and my fellowprisoners, who are of note among the apostles, who also were in Christ before me.

Salute Apelles approved <u>45_ROM_16_10</u> # Salute Apelles approved in Christ. Salute them which are of Aristobulus' [household].

Salute Asyncritus Phlegon <u>45_ROM_16_14</u> # Salute Asyncritus, Phlegon, Hermas, Patrobas, Hermes, and the brethren which are with them.

Salute every saint <u>50_PHP_04_21</u># Salute every saint in Christ Jesus. The brethren which are with me greet you.

salute Festus <u>44_ACT_25_13</u> # And after certain days king Agrippa and Bernice came unto Caesarea to salute Festus.

Salute Herodion my <u>45_ROM_16_11</u># Salute Herodion my kinsman. Greet them that be of the [household] of Narcissus, which are in the Lord.

salute him and <u>10_2SA_08_10</u> # Then Toi sent Joram his son unto king David, to salute him, and to bless him, because he had fought against Hadadezer, and smitten him: for Hadadezer had wars with Toi. And [Joram] brought with him vessels of silver, and vessels of gold, and vessels of brass:

Salute Rufus chosen <u>45_ROM_16_13</u># Salute Rufus chosen in the Lord, and his mother and mine.

Salute the beloved <u>45_ROM_16_12</u># Salute Tryphena and Tryphosa, who labour in the Lord. Salute the beloved Persis, which laboured much in the Lord.

Salute the brethren <u>51_COL_04_15</u># Salute the brethren which are in Laodicea, and Nymphas, and the church which is in his house.

salute the children <u>12_2KI_10_13</u> # Jehu met with the brethren of Ahaziah king of Judah, and said, Who [are] ye? And they answered, We [are] the brethren of Ahaziah; and we go down to salute the children of the king and the children of the queen.

salute thee and <u>09_1SA_10_04</u># And they will salute thee, and give thee two [loaves] of bread; which thou shalt receive of their hands.
