Salute Andronicus and [45 ROM 16 07](#) # Salute Andronicus and Junia, my kinsmen, and my fellowprisoners, who are of note among the apostles, who also were in Christ before me.

Salute Apelles approved [45 ROM 16 10](#) # Salute Apelles approved in Christ. Salute them which are of Aristobulus' [household].

Salute Asyncritus Phlegon [45 ROM 16 14](#) # Salute Asyncritus, Phlegon, Hermas, Patrobas, Hermes, and the brethren which are with them.
