sang and the <u>14_2CH_29_28</u># And all the congregation worshipped, and the singers sang, and the trumpeters sounded: [and] all [this continued] until the burnt offering was finished.

sang Deborah and <u>07_JUD_05_01</u># Then sang Deborah and Barak the son of Abinoam on that day, saying,

sang his praise <u>19_PSA_106_12</u> # Then believed they his words; they sang his praise.

sang loud with <u>16_NEH_12_42</u> # And Maaseiah, and Shemaiah, and Eleazar, and Uzzi, and Jehohanan, and Malchijah, and Elam, and Ezer. And the singers sang loud, with Jezrahiah [their] overseer.

sang Moses and <u>02_EXO_15_01</u># Then sang Moses and the children of Israel this song unto the LORD, and spake, saying, I will sing unto the LORD, for he hath triumphed gloriously: the horse and his rider hath he thrown into the sea.

sang one to <u>09_1SA_29_05</u># [Is] not this David, of whom they sang one to another in dances, saying, Saul slew his thousands, and David his ten thousands?

sang praises unto <u>44_ACT_16_25</u># And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God: and the prisoners heard them.

sang praises with <u>14_2CH_29_30</u> # Moreover Hezekiah the king and the princes commanded the Levites to sing praise unto the LORD with the words of David, and of Asaph the seer. And they sang praises with gladness, and they bowed their heads and worshipped.

sang this song <u>04_NUM_21_17</u># Then Israel sang this song, Spring up, O well; sing ye unto it:

sang together and <u>18_JOB_38_07</u> # When the morning stars sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for joy?

sang together by <u>15_EZR_03_11</u> # And they sang together by course in praising and giving thanks unto the LORD; because [he is] good, for his mercy [endureth] for ever toward Israel.
