

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

savour a sacrifice <u>04\_NUM\_28\_06</u># [It is] a continual burnt offering, which was ordained in mount Sinai for a sweet savour, a sacrifice made by fire unto the LORD.

savour a sacrifice <u>04\_NUM\_28\_13</u># And a several tenth deal of flour mingled with oil [for] a meat offering unto one lamb; [for] a burnt offering of a sweet savour, a sacrifice made by fire unto the LORD.

savour a sacrifice <u>04\_NUM\_29\_06</u> # Beside the burnt offering of the month, and his meat offering, and the daily burnt offering, and his meat offering, and their drink offerings, according unto their manner, for a sweet savour, a sacrifice made by fire unto the LORD.

savour all the <u>03\_LEV\_03\_16</u> # And the priest shall burn them upon the altar: [it is] the food of the offering made by fire for a sweet savour: all the fat [is] the LORD'S.

savour an offering <u>02\_EXO\_29\_18</u># And thou shalt burn the whole ram upon the altar: it [is] a burnt offering unto the LORD: it [is] a sweet savour, an offering made by fire unto the LORD.

savour an offering <u>02\_EXO\_29\_41</u># And the other lamb thou shalt offer at even, and shalt do thereto according to the meat offering of the morning, and according to the drink offering thereof, for a sweet savour, an offering made by fire unto the LORD.

savour and an <u>03\_LEV\_08\_21</u># And he washed the inwards and the legs in water; and Moses burnt the whole ram upon the altar: it [was] a burnt sacrifice for a sweet savour, [and] an offering made by fire unto the LORD; as the LORD commanded Moses.

savour and poured <u>26\_EZE\_20\_28</u># [For] when I had brought them into the land, [for] the which I lifted up mine hand to give it to them, then they saw every high hill, and all the thick trees, and they offered there their sacrifices, and there they presented the provocation of their offering: there also they made their sweet savour, and poured out there their drink offerings.

savour and the <u>01\_GEN\_08\_21</u># And the LORD smelled a sweet savour; and the LORD said in his heart, I will not again curse the ground any more for man's sake; for the imagination of man's heart [is] evil from his youth; neither will I again smite any more every thing living, as I have done.

savour and the <u>03\_LEV\_23\_13</u># And the meat offering thereof [shall be] two tenth deals of fine flour mingled with oil, an offering made by fire unto the LORD [for] a sweet savour: and the drink offering thereof [shall be] of wine, the fourth [part] of an hin.

savour and thus <u>26\_EZE\_16\_19</u> # My meat also which I gave thee, fine flour, and oil, and honey, [wherewith] I fed thee, thou hast even set it before them for a sweet savour: and [thus] it was, saith the Lord GOD.

savour before the <u>02\_EXO\_29\_25</u># And thou shalt receive them of their hands, and burn [them] upon the altar for a burnt offering, for a sweet savour before the LORD: it [is] an offering made by fire unto the LORD.

savour even the <u>03\_LEV\_06\_15</u># And he shall take of it his handful, of the flour of the meat offering, and of the oil thereof, and all the frankincense which [is] upon the meat offering, and shall burn [it] upon the altar [for] a sweet savour, [even] the memorial of it, unto the LORD.

savour it is <u>03 LEV\_08\_28</u># And Moses took them from off their hands, and burnt [them] on the altar upon the burnt offering: they [were] consecrations for a sweet savour: it [is] an offering made by fire unto the LORD.

savour of Christ <u>47\_2CO\_02\_15</u># For we are unto God a sweet savour of Christ, in them that are saved, and in them that perish:

savour of death <u>47\_2CO\_02\_16</u> # To the one [we are] the savour of death unto death; and to the other the savour of life unto life. And who [is] sufficient for these things?

savour of his <u>47\_2CO\_02\_14</u> # Now thanks [be] unto God, which always causeth us to triumph in Christ, and maketh manifest the savour of his knowledge by us in every place.

savour of life <u>47\_2CO\_02\_16</u> # To the one [we are] the savour of death unto death; and to the other the savour of life unto life. And who [is] sufficient for these things?

savour of thy <u>22\_SON\_01\_03</u> # Because of the savour of thy good ointments thy name [is as] ointment poured forth, therefore do the virgins love thee.

savour of your <u>03\_LEV\_26\_31</u># And I will make your cities waste, and bring your sanctuaries unto desolation, and I will not smell the savour of your sweet odours.

savour one young <u>04\_NUM\_29\_08</u># But ye shall offer a burnt offering unto the LORD [for] a sweet savour; one young bullock, one ram, [and] seven lambs of the first year; they shall be unto you without blemish:

savour shall come 29 JOE 02 20 # But I will remove far off from you the northern [army], and will drive him into a land barren and desolate, with his face toward the east sea, and his hinder part toward the utmost sea, and his stink shall come up, and his ill savour shall come up, because he hath done great things.

savour so doth <u>21\_ECC\_10\_01</u> # Dead flies cause the ointment of the apothecary to send forth a stinking savour: [so doth] a little folly him that is in reputation for wisdom [and] honour.

savour to all <u>26\_EZE\_06\_13</u> # Then shall ye know that I [am] the LORD, when their slain [men] shall be among their idols round about their altars, upon every high hill, in all the tops of the mountains, and under every green tree, and under every thick oak, the place where they did offer sweet savour to all their idols.

savour to be <u>02\_EXO\_05\_21</u> # And they said unto them, The LORD look upon you, and judge; because ye have made our savour to be abhorred in the eyes of Pharaoh, and in the eyes of his servants, to put a sword in their hand to slay us.

savour unto me <u>04\_NUM\_28\_02</u> # Command the children of Israel, and say unto them, My offering, [and] my bread for my sacrifices made by fire, [for] a sweet savour unto me, shall ye observe to offer unto me in their due season.

savour unto the <u>03\_LEV\_01\_09</u> # But his inwards and his legs shall he wash in water: and the priest shall burn all on the altar, [to be] a burnt sacrifice, an offering made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD.

savour unto the <u>03\_LEV\_01\_13</u># But he shall wash the inwards and the legs with water: and the priest shall bring [it] all, and burn [it] upon the altar: it [is] a burnt sacrifice, an offering made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD.

savour unto the <u>03\_LEV\_01\_17</u># And he shall cleave it with the wings thereof, [but] shall not divide [it] asunder: and the priest shall burn it upon the altar, upon the wood that [is] upon the fire: it [is] a burnt

sacrifice, an offering made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD.

savour unto the <u>03\_LEV\_02\_02</u># And he shall bring it to Aaron's sons the priests: and he shall take thereout his handful of the flour thereof, and of the oil thereof, with all the frankincense thereof; and the priest shall burn the memorial of it upon the altar, [to be] an offering made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD:

savour unto the <u>03\_LEV\_02\_09</u> # And the priest shall take from the meat offering a memorial thereof, and shall burn [it] upon the altar: [it is] an offering made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD.

savour unto the <u>03\_LEV\_03\_05</u># And Aaron's sons shall burn it on the altar upon the burnt sacrifice, which [is] upon the wood that [is] on the fire: [it is] an offering made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD.

savour unto the <u>03\_LEV\_04\_31</u> # And he shall take away all the fat thereof, as the fat is taken away from off the sacrifice of peace offerings; and the priest shall burn [it] upon the altar for a sweet savour unto the LORD; and the priest shall make an atonement for him, and it shall be forgiven him.

savour unto the <u>03\_LEV\_06\_21</u> # In a pan it shall be made with oil; [and when it is] baken, thou shalt bring it in: [and] the baken pieces of the meat offering shalt thou offer [for] a sweet savour unto the LORD.

savour unto the <u>03\_LEV\_17\_06</u># And the priest shall sprinkle the blood upon the altar of the LORD [at] the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, and burn the fat for a sweet savour unto the LORD.

savour unto the <u>03\_LEV\_23\_18</u># And ye shall offer with the bread seven lambs without blemish of the first year, and one young bullock, and two rams: they shall be [for] a burnt offering unto the LORD, with their meat offering, and their drink offerings, [even] an offering made by fire, of sweet savour unto the LORD.

savour unto the <u>04\_NUM\_15\_03</u># And will make an offering by fire unto the LORD, a burnt offering, or a sacrifice in performing a vow, or in a freewill offering, or in your solemn feasts, to make a sweet savour unto the LORD, of the herd, or of the flock:

savour unto the <u>04\_NUM\_15\_07</u># And for a drink offering thou shalt offer the third [part] of an hin of wine, [for] a sweet savour unto the LORD.

savour unto the <u>04\_NUM\_15\_10</u># And thou shalt bring for a drink offering half an hin of wine, [for] an offering made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD.

savour unto the <u>04\_NUM\_15\_13</u># All that are born of the country shall do these things after this manner, in offering an offering made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD.

savour unto the <u>04\_NUM\_15\_14</u># And if a stranger sojourn with you, or whosoever [be] among you in your generations, and will offer an offering made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD; as ye do, so he shall do.

savour unto the <u>04\_NUM\_15\_24</u># Then it shall be, if [ought] be committed by ignorance without the knowledge of the congregation, that all the congregation shall offer one young bullock for a burnt offering, for a sweet savour unto the LORD, with his meat offering, and his drink offering, according to the manner, and one kid of the goats for a sin offering.

savour unto the <u>04\_NUM\_18\_17</u> # But the firstling of a cow, or the firstling of a sheep, or the firstling of a goat, thou shalt not redeem; they [are] holy: thou shalt sprinkle their blood upon the altar, and shalt burn their fat [for] an offering made by fire, for a sweet savour unto the LORD.

savour unto the 04 NUM 28 08 # And the other lamb shalt thou offer at even: as the meat offering of the

morning, and as the drink offering thereof, thou shalt offer [it], a sacrifice made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD.

savour unto the <u>04\_NUM\_28\_24</u># After this manner ye shall offer daily, throughout the seven days, the meat of the sacrifice made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD: it shall be offered beside the continual burnt offering, and his drink offering.

savour unto the <u>04\_NUM\_28\_27</u># But ye shall offer the burnt offering for a sweet savour unto the LORD; two young bullocks, one ram, seven lambs of the first year;

savour unto the <u>04\_NUM\_29\_02</u> # And ye shall offer a burnt offering for a sweet savour unto the LORD; one young bullock, one ram, [and] seven lambs of the first year without blemish:

savour unto the <u>04\_NUM\_29\_13</u># And ye shall offer a burnt offering, a sacrifice made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD; thirteen young bullocks, two rams, [and] fourteen lambs of the first year; they shall be without blemish:

savour unto the <u>04\_NUM\_29\_36</u># But ye shall offer a burnt offering, a sacrifice made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD: one bullock, one ram, seven lambs of the first year without blemish:

savour when I <u>26\_EZE\_20\_41</u> # I will accept you with your sweet savour, when I bring you out from the people, and gather you out of the countries wherein ye have been scattered; and I will be sanctified in you before the heathen.

savour wherewith shall <u>42\_LUK\_14\_34</u> # Salt [is] good: but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be seasoned?

savour wherewith shall <u>40\_MAT\_05\_13</u># Ye are the salt of the earth: but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be salted? it is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out, and to be trodden under foot of men.

savour <u>49\_EPH\_05\_02</u> # And walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweetsmelling savour.

savour <u>03\_LEV\_02\_12</u> # As for the oblation of the firstfruits, ye shall offer them unto the LORD: but they shall not be burnt on the altar for a sweet savour.

savourest not the <u>41\_MAR\_08\_33</u> # But when he had turned about and looked on his disciples, he rebuked Peter, saying, Get thee behind me, Satan: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but the things that be of men.

savourest not the <u>40\_MAT\_16\_23</u># But he turned, and said unto Peter, Get thee behind me, Satan: thou art an offence unto me: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but those that be of men.

savours unto the <u>15\_EZR\_06\_10</u> # That they may offer sacrifices of sweet savours unto the God of heaven, and pray for the life of the king, and of his sons.

savoury meat and <u>01\_GEN\_27\_17</u># And she gave the savoury meat and the bread, which she had prepared, into the hand of her son Jacob.

savoury meat and <u>01\_GEN\_27\_31</u># And he also had made savoury meat, and brought it unto his father, and said unto his father, Let my father arise, and eat of his son's venison, that thy soul may bless me.

savoury meat for <u>01\_GEN\_27\_09</u># Go now to the flock, and fetch me from thence two good kids of the goats; and I will make them savoury meat for thy father, such as he loveth:

savoury meat such <u>01\_GEN\_27\_04</u># And make me savoury meat, such as I love, and bring [it] to me, that I may eat; that my soul may bless thee before I die.

savoury meat such <u>01\_GEN\_27\_14</u> # And he went, and fetched, and brought [them] to his mother: and his mother made savoury meat, such as his father loved.

savoury meat that <u>01\_GEN\_27\_07</u> # Bring me venison, and make me savoury meat, that I may eat, and bless thee before the LORD before my death.

unsavoury be eaten <u>18\_JOB\_06\_06</u> # Can that which is unsavoury be eaten without salt? or is there [any] taste in the white of an egg?

unsavoury 10\_2SA\_22\_27 # With the pure thou wilt show thyself pure; and with the froward thou wilt show thyself unsavoury.
