seemeth convenient unto 24 JER 40 05 # Now while he was not yet gone back, [he said], Go back also to Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan, whom the king of Babylon hath made governor over the cities of Judah, and dwell with him among the people: or go wheresoever it seemeth convenient unto thee to go. So the captain of the guard gave him victuals and a reward, and let him go.

seemeth good and 24 JER 26 14 # As for me, behold, I [am] in your hand: do with me as seemeth good and meet unto you.

seemeth good and 24 JER 40 04 # And now, behold, I loose thee this day from the chains which [were] upon thine hand.
