herself a place <u>23\_ISA\_34\_14</u> # The wild beasts of the desert shall also meet with the wild beasts of the island, and the satyr shall cry to his fellow; the screech owl also shall rest there, and find for herself a place of rest.

herself a prophetess <u>66\_REV\_02\_20</u># Notwithstanding I have a few things against thee, because thou sufferest that woman Jezebel, which calleth herself a prophetess, to teach and to seduce my servants to commit fornication, and to eat things sacrificed unto idols.

herself a strong 38\_ZEC\_09\_03 # And Tyrus did build herself a strong hold, and heaped up silver as the dust, and fine gold as the mire of the streets.

herself and lived <u>66\_REV\_18\_07</u># How much she hath glorified herself, and lived deliciously, so much torment and sorrow give her: for she saith in her heart, I sit a queen, and am no widow, and shall see no sorrow.

herself and opened <u>23\_ISA\_05\_14</u> # Therefore hell hath enlarged herself, and opened her mouth without measure: and their glory, and their multitude, and their pomp, and he that rejoiceth, shall descend into it.

herself and saith <u>43\_JOH\_20\_16</u># Jesus saith unto her, Mary. She turned herself, and saith unto him, Rabboni; which is to say, Master.

herself and sat <u>01\_GEN\_38\_14</u># And she put her widow's garments off from her, and covered her with a veil, and wrapped herself, and sat in an open place, which [is] by the way to Timnath; for she saw that Shelah was grown, and she was not given unto him to wife.

herself and the <u>10\_2SA\_11\_02</u># And it came to pass in an eveningtide, that David arose from off his bed, and walked upon the roof of the king's house: and from the roof he saw a woman washing herself; and the woman [was] very beautiful to look upon.

herself and travailed <u>09\_1SA\_04\_19</u> # And his daughter in law, Phinehas' wife, was with child, [near] to be delivered: and when she heard the tidings that the ark of God was taken, and that her father in law and her husband were dead, she bowed herself and travailed; for her pains came upon her.

herself at the <u>02\_EXO\_02\_05</u># And the daughter of Pharaoh came down to wash [herself] at the river; and her maidens walked along by the river's side; and when she saw the ark among the flags, she sent her maid to fetch it.

herself back and 43\_JOH\_20\_14 # And when she had thus said, she turned herself back, and saw Jesus standing, and knew not that it was Jesus.

herself by a <u>04\_NUM\_30\_03</u># If a woman also vow a vow unto the LORD, and bind [herself] by a bond, [being] in her father's house in her youth;

herself by playing <u>03\_LEV\_21\_09</u># And the daughter of any priest, if she profane herself by playing the whore, she profaneth her father: she shall be burnt with fire.

herself coverings of <u>20\_PRO\_31\_22</u># She maketh herself coverings of tapestry; her clothing [is] silk and purple.

herself first the <u>41\_MAR\_04\_28</u># For the earth bringeth forth fruit of herself; first the blade, then the ear, after that the full corn in the ear.

herself five months <u>42\_LUK\_01\_24</u># And after those days his wife Elisabeth conceived, and hid herself five months, saying,

herself If I 40\_MAT\_09\_21 # For she said within herself, If I may but touch his garment, I shall be whole.

herself more than 24\_JER\_03\_11 # And the LORD said unto me, The backsliding Israel hath justified herself more than treacherous Judah.

herself on her <u>09\_1SA\_25\_41</u># And she arose, and bowed herself on [her] face to the earth, and said, Behold, [let] thine handmaid [be] a servant to wash the feet of the servants of my lord.

herself on high <u>18\_JOB\_39\_18</u> # What time she lifteth up herself on high, she scorneth the horse and his rider.

herself ready <u>66\_REV\_19\_07</u> # Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and his wife hath made herself ready.

herself received strength <u>58\_HEB\_11\_11</u># Through faith also Sara herself received strength to conceive seed, and was delivered of a child when she was past age, because she judged him faithful who had promised.

herself said He <u>01\_GEN\_20\_05</u># Said he not unto me, She [is] my sister? and she, even she herself said, He [is] my brother: in the integrity of my heart and innocency of my hands have I done this.

herself saying After <u>01\_GEN\_18\_12</u> # Therefore Sarah laughed within herself, saying, After I am waxed old shall I have pleasure, my lord being old also?

herself seven days <u>03\_LEV\_15\_28</u> # But if she be cleansed of her issue, then she shall number to herself seven days, and after that she shall be clean.

herself that spreadeth <u>24\_JER\_04\_31</u># For I have heard a voice as of a woman in travail, [and] the anguish as of her that bringeth forth her first child, the voice of the daughter of Zion, [that] bewaileth herself, [that] spreadeth her hands, [saying], Woe [is] me now! for my soul is wearied because of murderers.

herself to be <u>11\_1KI\_14\_05</u># And the LORD said unto Ahijah, Behold, the wife of Jeroboam cometh to ask a thing of thee for her son; for he [is] sick: thus and thus shalt thou say unto her: for it shall be, when she cometh in, that she shall feign herself [to be] another [woman].

herself to defile <u>26\_EZE\_22\_03</u> # Then say thou, Thus saith the Lord GOD, The city sheddeth blood in the midst of it, that her time may come, and maketh idols against herself to defile herself.

herself to flee 24\_JER\_49\_24 # Damascus is waxed feeble, [and] turneth herself to flee, and fear hath seized on [her]: anguish and sorrows have taken her, as a woman in travail.

herself to the <u>09\_1SA\_25\_23</u># And when Abigail saw David, she hasted, and lighted off the ass, and fell before David on her face, and bowed herself to the ground,

herself to the 12\_2KI\_04\_37 # Then she went in, and fell at his feet, and bowed herself to the ground, and took up her son, and went out.

herself to the 08\_RUT\_02\_10 # Then she fell on her face, and bowed herself to the ground, and said unto

him, Why have I found grace in thine eyes, that thou shouldest take knowledge of me, seeing I [am] a stranger?

herself unto the <u>04\_NUM\_22\_25</u># And when the ass saw the angel of the LORD, she thrust herself unto the wall, and crushed Balaam's foot against the wall: and he smote her again.

herself where she 19\_PSA\_84\_03 # Yea, the sparrow hath found an house, and the swallow a nest for herself, where she may lay her young, [even] thine altars, O LORD of hosts, my King, and my God.

herself with her <u>28\_HOS\_02\_13</u> # And I will visit upon her the days of Baalim, wherein she burned incense to them, and she decked herself with her earrings and her jewels, and she went after her lovers, and forgat me, saith the LORD.

herself with her <u>23\_ISA\_61\_10</u># I will greatly rejoice in the LORD, my soul shall be joyful in my God; for he hath clothed me with the garments of salvation, he hath covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decketh [himself] with ornaments, and as a bride adorneth [herself] with her jewels.

herself with lies <u>26\_EZE\_24\_12</u> # She hath wearied [herself] with lies, and her great scum went not forth out of her: her scum [shall be] in the fire.

herself <u>26\_EZE\_22\_03</u># Then say thou, Thus saith the Lord GOD, The city sheddeth blood in the midst of it, that her time may come, and maketh idols against herself to defile herself.

herself <u>26\_EZE\_23\_07</u> # Thus she committed her whoredoms with them, with all them [that were] the chosen men of Assyria, and with all on whom she doted: with all their idols she defiled herself.

herself <u>01\_GEN\_24\_65</u> # For she [had] said unto the servant, What man [is] this that walketh in the field to meet us? And the servant [had] said, It [is] my master: therefore she took a veil, and covered herself.

herself <u>07\_JUD\_05\_29</u> # Her wise ladies answered her, yea, she returned answer to herself,

herself <u>42 LUK\_13\_11</u># And, behold, there was a woman which had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years, and was bowed together, and could in no wise lift up [herself].

himself a blot <u>20\_PRO\_09\_07</u> # He that reprove h a scorner getteth to himself shame: and he that rebuketh a wicked [man getteth] himself a blot.

himself a chariot 22\_SON\_03\_09 # King Solomon made himself a chariot of the wood of Lebanon.

himself a glorious 49\_EPH\_05\_27 # That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.

himself a king 43\_JOH\_19\_12 # And from thenceforth Pilate sought to release him: but the Jews cried out, saying, If thou let this man go, thou art not Caesar's friend: whosoever maketh himself a king speaketh against Caesar.

himself a kingdom <u>42\_LUK\_19\_12</u> # He said therefore, A certain nobleman went into a far country to receive for himself a kingdom, and to return.

himself a lamb <u>01\_GEN\_22\_08</u> # And Abraham said, My son, God will provide himself a lamb for a burnt offering: so they went both of them together.

himself a peculiar <u>56\_TIT\_02\_14</u> # Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.

himself a pillar <u>10 2SA 18 18 # Now Absalom</u> in his lifetime had taken and reared up for himself a pillar, which [is] in the king's dale: for he said, I have no son to keep my name in remembrance: and he called the pillar after his own name: and it is called unto this day, Absalom's place.

himself a prey 23\_ISA\_59\_15 # Yea, truth faileth; and he [that] departeth from evil maketh himself a prey: and the LORD saw [it], and it displeased him that [there was] no judgment.

himself a prophet 24\_JER\_29\_26 # The LORD hath made thee priest in the stead of Jehoiada the priest, that ye should be officers in the house of the LORD, for every man [that is] mad, and maketh himself a prophet, that thou shouldest put him in prison, and in the stocks.

himself a prophet <u>24\_JER\_29\_27</u> # Now therefore why hast thou not reproved Jeremiah of Anathoth, which maketh himself a prophet to you?

himself a ransom 54\_1TI\_02\_06 # Who gave himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time.

himself a worthy 11\_1KI\_01\_52 # And Solomon said, If he will show himself a worthy man, there shall not an hair of him fall to the earth: but if wickedness shall be found in him, he shall die.

himself about from <u>01\_GEN\_42\_24</u># And he turned himself about from them, and wept; and returned to them again, and communed with them, and took from them Simeon, and bound him before their eyes.

himself above all <u>53\_2TH\_02\_04</u> # Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; so that he as God sitteth in the temple of God, showing himself that he is God.

himself above all <u>27\_DAN\_11\_37</u> # Neither shall he regard the God of his fathers, nor the desire of women, nor regard any god: for he shall magnify himself above all.

himself above all <u>05\_DEU\_07\_06</u># For thou [art] an holy people unto the LORD thy God: the LORD thy God hath chosen thee to be a special people unto himself, above all people that [are] upon the face of the earth.

himself above all <u>05\_DEU\_14\_02</u> # For thou [art] an holy people unto the LORD thy God, and the LORD hath chosen thee to be a peculiar people unto himself, above all the nations that [are] upon the earth.

himself above every <u>27\_DAN\_11\_36</u># And the king shall do according to his will; and he shall exalt himself, and magnify himself above every god, and shall speak marvellous things against the God of gods, and shall prosper till the indignation be accomplished: for that that is determined shall be done.

himself according to <u>49\_EPH\_01\_05</u># Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will,

himself according to <u>28\_HOS\_10\_01</u> # Israel [is] an empty vine, he bringeth forth fruit unto himself: according to the multitude of his fruit he hath increased the altars; according to the goodness of his land they have made goodly images.

himself again to <u>43\_JOH\_21\_01</u> # After these things Jesus showed himself again to the disciples at the sea of Tiberias; and on this wise showed he [himself].

himself against him <u>18\_JOB\_09\_04</u> # [He is] wise in heart, and mighty in strength: who hath hardened [himself] against him, and hath prospered?

himself against Israel <u>14\_2CH\_17\_01</u># And Jehoshaphat his son reigned in his stead, and strengthened himself against Israel.

himself against Jerusalem <u>26\_EZE\_24\_02</u># Son of man, write thee the name of the day, [even] of this same day: the king of Babylon set himself against Jerusalem this same day.

himself against me 19 PSA 55 12 # For [it was] not an enemy [that] reproached me; then I could have borne [it]: neither [was it] he that hated me [that] did magnify [himself] against me; then I would have hid myself from him:

himself against the <u>24\_JER\_48\_26</u> # Make ye him drunken: for he magnified [himself] against the LORD: Moab also shall wallow in his vomit, and he also shall be in derision.

himself against the 24\_JER\_48\_42 # And Moab shall be destroyed from [being] a people, because he hath magnified [himself] against the LORD.

himself against the <u>18\_JOB\_15\_25</u># For he stretcheth out his hand against God, and strengtheneth himself against the Almighty.

himself against the <u>18\_JOB\_17\_08</u># Upright [men] shall be astonied at this, and the innocent shall stir up himself against the hypocrite.

himself against them <u>01\_GEN\_14\_15</u> # And he divided himself against them, he and his servants, by night, and smote them, and pursued them unto Hobah, which [is] on the left hand of Damascus.

himself alive after 44 ACT 01 03 # To whom also he showed himself alive after his passion by many infallible proofs, being seen of them forty days, and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God:

himself alone and <u>48\_GAL\_06\_04</u> # But let every man prove his own work, and then shall he have rejoicing in himself alone, and not in another.

himself alone And <u>07\_JUD\_03\_20</u># And Ehud came unto him; and he was sitting in a summer parlour, which he had for himself alone. And Ehud said, I have a message from God unto thee. And he arose out of [his] seat.

himself alone <u>43\_JOH\_06\_15</u> # When Jesus therefore perceived that they would come and take him by force, to make him a king, he departed again into a mountain himself alone.

himself also is <u>58\_HEB\_05\_02</u># Who can have compassion on the ignorant, and on them that are out of the way; for that he himself also is compassed with infirmity.

himself also so <u>62\_1JO\_02\_06</u># He that saith he abideth in him ought himself also so to walk, even as he walked.

himself also was <u>42\_LUK\_23\_07</u># And as soon as he knew that he belonged unto Herod's jurisdiction, he sent him to Herod, who himself also was at Jerusalem at that time.

himself among the <u>09\_1SA\_10\_22</u># Therefore they inquired of the LORD further, if the man should yet come thither. And the LORD answered, Behold, he hath hid himself among the stuff.

himself among the <u>28\_HOS\_07\_08</u># Ephraim, he hath mixed himself among the people; Ephraim is a cake not turned.

himself among the <u>23\_ISA\_44\_14</u># He heweth him down cedars, and taketh the cypress and the oak, which he strengtheneth for himself among the trees of the forest: he planteth an ash, and the rain doth nourish [it].

himself an everlasting 23\_ISA\_63\_12 # That led [them] by the right hand of Moses with his glorious arm, dividing the water before them, to make himself an everlasting name?

himself and be <u>41\_MAR\_03\_26</u> # And if Satan rise up against himself, and be divided, he cannot stand, but hath an end.

himself and became <u>50\_PHP\_02\_08</u> # And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

himself and behold <u>08\_RUT\_03\_08</u># And it came to pass at midnight, that the man was afraid, and turned himself: and, behold, a woman lay at his feet.

himself and brought 40\_MAT\_27\_03# Then Judas, which had betrayed him, when he saw that he was condemned, repented himself, and brought again the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders,

himself and built <u>14\_2CH\_32\_05</u># Also he strengthened himself, and built up all the wall that was broken, and raised [it] up to the towers, and another wall without, and repaired Millo [in] the city of David, and made darts and shields in abundance.

himself and changed <u>10\_2SA\_12\_20</u> # Then David arose from the earth, and washed, and anointed [himself], and changed his apparel, and came into the house of the LORD, and worshipped: then he came to his own house; and when he required, they set bread before him, and he did eat.

himself and changed <u>01\_GEN\_41\_14</u> # Then Pharaoh sent and called Joseph, and they brought him hastily out of the dungeon: and he shaved [himself], and changed his raiment, and came in unto Pharaoh.

himself and come <u>09\_1SA\_23\_23</u># See therefore, and take knowledge of all the lurking places where he hideth himself, and come ye again to me with the certainty, and I will go with you: and it shall come to pass, if he be in the land, that I will search him out throughout all the thousands of Judah.

himself and died <u>10\_2SA\_17\_23</u># And when Ahithophel saw that his counsel was not followed, he saddled [his] ass, and arose, and gat him home to his house, to his city, and put his household in order, and hanged himself, and died, and was buried in the sepulchre of his father.

himself and discover <u>20\_PRO\_25\_09</u> # Debate thy cause with thy neighbour [himself]; and discover not a secret to another:

himself and for <u>26\_EZE\_45\_22</u> # And upon that day shall the prince prepare for himself and for all the people of the land a bullock [for] a sin offering.

himself and for <u>01\_GEN\_43\_32</u># And they set on for him by himself, and for them by themselves, and for the Egyptians, which did eat with him, by themselves: because the Egyptians might not eat bread with the Hebrews; for that [is] an abomination unto the Egyptians.

himself and for <u>58\_HEB\_09\_07</u># But into the second [went] the high priest alone once every year, not without blood, which he offered for himself, and [for] the errors of the people:

himself and for <u>03\_LEV\_16\_06</u># And Aaron shall offer his bullock of the sin offering, which [is] for himself, and make an atonement for himself, and for his house.

himself and for <u>03\_LEV\_16\_24</u># And he shall wash his flesh with water in the holy place, and put on his garments, and come forth, and offer his burnt offering, and the burnt offering of the people, and make an atonement for himself, and for the people.

himself and God <u>53\_2TH\_02\_16</u> # Now our Lord Jesus Christ himself, and God, even our Father, which hath loved us, and hath given [us] everlasting consolation and good hope through grace,

himself and goeth <u>59\_JAM\_01\_24</u> # For he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was.

himself and he <u>20\_PRO\_05\_22</u> # His own iniquities shall take the wicked himself, and he shall be holden with the cords of his sins.

himself and his <u>09\_1SA\_30\_31</u> # And to [them] which [were] in Hebron, and to all the places where David himself and his men were wont to haunt.

himself and his <u>43\_JOH\_04\_12</u> # Art thou greater than our father Jacob, which gave us the well, and drank thereof himself, and his children, and his cattle?

himself and is 42\_LUK\_12\_21\_# So [is] he that layeth up treasure for himself, and is not rich toward God.

himself and Israel 19\_PSA\_135\_04 # For the LORD hath chosen Jacob unto himself, [and] Israel for his peculiar treasure.

himself and Jacob <u>01\_GEN\_30\_36</u># And he set three days' journey betwixt himself and Jacob: and Jacob fed the rest of Laban's flocks.

himself and lacketh <u>20\_PRO\_12\_09</u> # [He that is] despised, and hath a servant, [is] better than he that honoureth himself, and lacketh bread.

himself and led <u>14\_2CH\_25\_11</u># And Amaziah strengthened himself, and led forth his people, and went to the valley of salt, and smote of the children of Seir ten thousand.

himself and let <u>23\_ISA\_08\_13</u> # Sanctify the LORD of hosts himself; and [let] him [be] your fear, and [let] him [be] your dread.

himself and magnify <u>27\_DAN\_11\_36</u># And the king shall do according to his will; and he shall exalt himself, and magnify himself above every god, and shall speak marvellous things against the God of gods, and shall prosper till the indignation be accomplished: for that that is determined shall be done.

himself and make <u>03\_LEV\_16\_06</u> # And Aaron shall offer his bullock of the sin offering, which [is] for himself, and make an atonement for himself, and for his house.

himself and make <u>42\_LUK\_12\_37</u> # Blessed [are] those servants, whom the lord when he cometh shall find watching: verily I say unto you, that he shall gird himself, and make them to sit down to meat, and will come forth and serve them.

himself and no 45\_ROM\_14\_07 # For none of us liveth to himself, and no man dieth to himself.

himself and Obadiah <u>11\_1KI\_18\_06</u># So they divided the land between them to pass throughout it: Ahab went one way by himself, and Obadiah went another way by himself.

himself and our <u>52\_1TH\_03\_11</u># Now God himself and our Father, and our Lord Jesus Christ, direct our way unto you.

himself and put <u>09\_1SA\_28\_08</u># And Saul disguised himself, and put on other raiment, and he went, and two men with him, and they came to the woman by night: and he said, I pray thee, divine unto me by the familiar spirit, and bring me [him] up, whom I shall name unto thee.

himself and said 10\_2SA\_09\_08 # And he bowed himself, and said, What [is] thy servant, that thou shouldest look upon such a dead dog as I [am]?

himself and said <u>01\_GEN\_43\_31</u># And he washed his face, and went out, and refrained himself, and said, Set on bread.

himself and said <u>43\_JOH\_08\_07</u> # So when they continued asking him, he lifted up himself, and said unto them, He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her.

himself and saith <u>23\_ISA\_44\_16</u># He burneth part thereof in the fire; with part thereof he eateth flesh; he roasteth roast, and is satisfied: yea, he warmeth [himself], and saith, Aha, I am warm, I have seen the fire:

himself and sat <u>01\_GEN\_48\_02</u> # And [one] told Jacob, and said, Behold, thy son Joseph cometh unto thee: and Israel strengthened himself, and sat upon the bed.

himself and saw 43\_JOH\_08\_10 # When Jesus had lifted up himself, and saw none but the woman, he said unto her, Woman, where are those thine accusers? hath no man condemned thee?

himself and set <u>27\_DAN\_06\_14</u># Then the king, when he heard [these] words, was sore displeased with himself, and set [his] heart on Daniel to deliver him: and he laboured till the going down of the sun to deliver him.

himself and shall 43\_JOH\_13\_32\_# If God be glorified in him, God shall also glorify him in himself, and shall straightway glorify him.

himself and shall <u>03\_LEV\_16\_11</u># And Aaron shall bring the bullock of the sin offering, which [is] for himself, and shall make an atonement for himself, and for his house, and shall kill the bullock of the sin offering which [is] for himself:

himself and slew <u>14\_2CH\_21\_04</u> # Now when Jehoram was risen up to the kingdom of his father, he strengthened himself, and slew all his brethren with the sword, and [divers] also of the princes of Israel.

himself and so <u>46\_1CO\_11\_28</u># But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of [that] bread, and drink of [that] cup.

himself and take <u>42\_LUK\_09\_23</u> # And he said to [them] all, If any [man] will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow me.

himself and take <u>41\_MAR\_08\_34</u> # And when he had called the people [unto him] with his disciples also, he said unto them, Whosoever will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me.

himself and take <u>40\_MAT\_16\_24</u># Then said Jesus unto his disciples, If any [man] will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me.

himself and thanked <u>10\_2SA\_14\_22</u> # And Joab fell to the ground on his face, and bowed himself, and thanked the king: and Joab said, To day thy servant knoweth that I have found grace in thy sight, my lord, O king, in that the king hath fulfilled the request of his servant.

himself and that <u>62\_1JO\_05\_18</u> # We know that whosoever is born of God sinneth not; but he that is begotten of God keepeth himself, and that wicked one toucheth him not.

himself and that <u>05 DEU 29 13</u> # That he may establish thee to day for a people unto himself, and [that] he may be unto thee a God, as he hath said unto thee, and as he hath sworn unto thy fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob.

himself and the <u>27\_DAN\_09\_26</u># And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary; and the end thereof [shall be] with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined.

himself and the <u>49\_EPH\_05\_33</u> # Nevertheless let every one of you in particular so love his wife even as himself; and the wife [see] that she reverence [her] husband.

myself should be 46\_1CO\_09\_27 # But I keep under my body, and bring [it] into subjection: lest that by any means, when I have preached to others, I myself should be a castaway.

myself so that <u>44 ACT 20 24 #</u> But none of these things move me, neither count I my life dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with joy, and the ministry, which I have received of the Lord Jesus, to testify the gospel of the grace of God.

myself that I <u>47\_2CO\_02\_01</u> # But I determined this with myself, that I would not come again to you in heaviness.

myself that I <u>44\_ACT\_26\_09</u> # I verily thought with myself, that I ought to do many things contrary to the name of Jesus of Nazareth.

myself that I <u>35\_HAB\_03\_16</u># When I heard, my belly trembled; my lips quivered at the voice: rottenness entered into my bones, and I trembled in myself, that I might rest in the day of trouble: when he cometh up unto the people, he will invade them with his troops.

myself that they <u>43\_JOH\_17\_19</u> # And for their sakes I sanctify myself, that they also might be sanctified through the truth.

myself that where 43\_JOH\_14\_03 # And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, [there] ye may be also.

myself they shall 23\_ISA\_43\_21 # This people have I formed for myself; they shall show forth my praise.

myself this day <u>44\_ACT\_26\_02</u> # I think myself happy, king Agrippa, because I shall answer for myself this day before thee touching all the things whereof I am accused of the Jews:

myself to behold <u>21\_ECC\_02\_12</u># And I turned myself to behold wisdom, and madness, and folly: for what [can] the man [do] that cometh after the king? [even] that which hath been already done.

myself to have <u>44\_ACT\_24\_16</u> # And herein do I exercise myself, to have always a conscience void of offence toward God, and [toward] men.

myself to have <u>50\_PHP\_03\_13</u># Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but [this] one thing [I do], forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before,

myself unto him 11 1KI 18 15 # And Elijah said, [As] the LORD of hosts liveth, before whom I stand, I will surely show myself unto him to day.

myself unto prayer 19\_PSA\_109\_04 # For my love they are my adversaries: but I [give myself unto] prayer.

myself unto wine 21 ECC 02 03 # I sought in mine heart to give myself unto wine, yet acquainting mine heart with wisdom; and to lay hold on folly, till I might see what [was] that good for the sons of men, which they should do under the heaven all the days of their life.

myself was not <u>47\_2CO\_12\_13</u> # For what is it wherein ye were inferior to other churches, except [it be] that I myself was not burdensome to you? forgive me this wrong.

myself were accursed <u>45\_ROM\_09\_03</u> # For I could wish that myself were accursed from Christ for my brethren, my kinsmen according to the flesh:

myself when evil <u>18\_JOB\_31\_29</u> # If I rejoiced at the destruction of him that hated me, or lifted up myself when evil found him:

myself will awake 19\_PSA\_108\_02 # Awake, psaltery and harp: I [myself] will awake early.

myself will awake 19\_PSA\_57\_08 # Awake up, my glory; awake, psaltery and harp: I [myself] will awake early.

myself will fight <u>24\_JER\_21\_05</u> # And I myself will fight against you with an outstretched hand and with a strong arm, even in anger, and in fury, and in great wrath.

myself wise under 21\_ECC\_02\_19 # And who knoweth whether he shall be a wise [man] or a fool? yet shall he have rule over all my labour wherein I have laboured, and wherein I have showed myself wise under the sun. This [is] also vanity.

myself wisely in 19 PSA 101 02 # I will behave myself wisely in a perfect way. O when wilt thou come unto me? I will walk within my house with a perfect heart.

myself with mine <u>09\_1SA\_25\_33</u># And blessed [be] thy advice, and blessed [be] thou, which hast kept me this day from coming to [shed] blood, and from avenging myself with mine own hand.

myself with snow 18\_JOB\_09\_30 # If I wash myself with snow water, and make my hands never so clean;

myself worthy to <u>42\_LUK\_07\_07</u># Wherefore neither thought I myself worthy to come unto thee: but say in a word, and my servant shall be healed.

myself yet am <u>46\_1CO\_04\_04</u> # For I know nothing by myself; yet am I not hereby justified: but he that judgeth me is the Lord.

myself yet my <u>43\_JOH\_08\_14</u> # Jesus answered and said unto them, Though I bear record of myself, [yet] my record is true: for I know whence I came, and whither I go; but ye cannot tell whence I come, and whither I go.

thyself within thine <u>26\_EZE\_03\_24</u> # Then the spirit entered into me, and set me upon my feet, and spake with me, and said unto me, Go, shut thyself within thine house.

thyself wouldest have <u>10\_2SA\_18\_13</u># Otherwise I should have wrought falsehood against mine own life: for there is no matter hid from the king, and thou thyself wouldest have set thyself against [me].

thyself wrath against <u>45\_ROM\_02\_05</u># But after thy hardness and impenitent heart treasurest up unto thyself wrath against the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God;

thyself ye do <u>59\_JAM\_02\_08</u># If ye fulfil the royal law according to the scripture, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself, ye do well:

thyself <u>11\_1KI\_02\_03</u># And keep the charge of the LORD thy God, to walk in his ways, to keep his statutes, and his commandments, and his judgments, and his testimonies, as it is written in the law of Moses, that thou mayest prosper in all that thou doest, and whithersoever thou turnest thyself:

thyself <u>09\_1SA\_19\_02</u># But Jonathan Saul's son delighted much in David: and Jonathan told David, saying, Saul my father seeketh to kill thee: now therefore, I pray thee, take heed to thyself until the morning, and abide in a secret [place], and hide thyself:

thyself <u>54\_1TI\_06\_05</u> # Perverse disputings of men of corrupt minds, and destitute of the truth, supposing that gain is godliness: from such withdraw thyself.

thyself <u>14\_2CH\_18\_24</u> # And Micaiah said, Behold, thou shalt see on that day when thou shalt go into an inner chamber to hide thyself.

thyself <u>14\_2CH\_21\_13</u># But hast walked in the way of the kings of Israel, and hast made Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem to go a whoring, like to the whoredoms of the house of Ahab, and also hast slain thy brethren of thy father's house, [which were] better than thyself:

thyself 01\_GEN\_33\_09 # And Esau said, I have enough, my brother; keep that thou hast unto thyself.

thyself <u>24\_JER\_47\_05</u> # Baldness is come upon Gaza; Ashkelon is cut off [with] the remnant of their valley: how long wilt thou cut thyself?

thyself 18\_JOB\_15\_08 # Hast thou heard the secret of God? and dost thou restrain wisdom to thyself?

thyself <u>43\_JOH\_01\_22</u> # Then said they unto him, Who art thou? that we may give an answer to them that sent us. What sayest thou of thyself?

thyself <u>43\_JOH\_08\_53</u> # Art thou greater than our father Abraham, which is dead? and the prophets are dead: whom makest thou thyself?

thyself <u>42\_LUK\_10\_27</u> # And he answering said, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbour as thyself.

thyself 42\_LUK\_23\_37 # And saying, If thou be the king of the Jews, save thyself.

thyself <u>40\_MAT\_19\_19</u># Honour thy father and [thy] mother: and, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

thyself 40\_MAT\_22\_39 # And the second [is] like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

thyself 19 PSA 49 18 # Though while he lived he blessed his soul: and [men] will praise thee, when thou doest well to thyself.

thyself <u>19\_PSA\_80\_15</u># And the vineyard which thy right hand hath planted, and the branch [that] thou madest strong for thyself.

thyself <u>19\_PSA\_80\_17</u> # Let thy hand be upon the man of thy right hand, upon the son of man [whom] thou madest strong for thyself.

thyself 19\_PSA\_94\_01 # O LORD God, to whom vengeance belongeth; O God, to whom vengeance belongeth, show thyself.

thyself <u>45\_ROM\_13\_09</u> # For this, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not kill, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Thou shalt not covet; and if [there be] any other commandment, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.
