accuseth you even 43 JOH 05 45 # Do not think that I will accuse you to the Father: there is [one] that accuseth you, [even] Moses, in whom ye trust.

appeaseth strife <u>20\_PRO\_15\_18</u> # A wrathful man stirreth up strife: but [he that is] slow to anger appeaseth strife.

ariseth a little 11 1KI 18 44 # And it came to pass at the seventh time, that he said, Behold, there ariseth a little cloud out of the sea, like a man's hand. And he said, Go up, say unto Ahab, Prepare [thy chariot], and get thee down, that the rain stop thee not.

ariseth and the <u>21\_ECC\_01\_05</u># The sun also ariseth, and the sun goeth down, and hasteth to his place where he arose.

beset the house <u>07\_JUD\_20\_05</u> # And the men of Gibeah rose against me, and beset the house round about upon me by night, [and] thought to have slain me: and my concubine have they forced, that she is dead.

ceaseth from raising <u>28\_HOS\_07\_04</u> # They [are] all adulterers, as an oven heated by the baker, [who] ceaseth from raising after he hath kneaded the dough, until it be leavened.

ceaseth he hath <u>23\_ISA\_33\_08</u> # The highways lie waste, the wayfaring man ceaseth: he hath broken the covenant, he hath despised the cities, he regardeth no man.

ceaseth not to 44\_ACT\_06\_13# And set up false witnesses, which said, This man ceaseth not to speak blasphemous words against this holy place, and the law:

deviseth wicked devices 23\_ISA\_32\_07 # The instruments also of the churl [are] evil: he deviseth wicked devices to destroy the poor with lying words, even when the needy speaketh right.

deviseth wicked imaginations <u>20\_PRO\_06\_18</u># An heart that deviseth wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to mischief,

disguiseth his face 18\_JOB\_24\_15 # The eye also of the adulterer waiteth for the twilight, saying, No eye shall see me: and disguiseth [his] face.

dresseth the lamps <u>02\_EXO\_30\_07</u> # And Aaron shall burn thereon sweet incense every morning: when he dresseth the lamps, he shall burn incense upon it.

set forward the <u>15\_EZR\_03\_09</u> # Then stood Jeshua [with] his sons and his brethren, Kadmiel and his sons, the sons of Judah, together, to set forward the workmen in the house of God: the sons of Henadad, [with] their sons and their brethren the Levites.

set forward which <u>04\_NUM\_10\_25</u># And the standard of the camp of the children of Dan set forward, [which was] the rereward of all the camps throughout their hosts: and over his host [was] Ahiezer the son of Ammishaddai.

set forward with <u>04\_NUM\_02\_17</u># Then the tabernacle of the congregation shall set forward with the camp of the Levites in the midst of the camp: as they encamp, so shall they set forward, every man in his place by their standards.

set forward <u>04\_NUM\_10\_28</u># Thus [were] the journeyings of the children of Israel according to their armies, when they set forward.

set garrisons in 14\_2CH\_17\_02 # And he placed forces in all the fenced cities of Judah, and set garrisons in the land of Judah, and in the cities of Ephraim, which Asa his father had taken.

set gins for 19\_PSA\_140\_05 # The proud have hid a snare for me, and cords; they have spread a net by the wayside; they have set gins for me. Selah.

set glistering stones 13\_1CH\_29\_02 # Now I have prepared with all my might for the house of my God the gold for [things to be made] of gold, and the silver for [things] of silver, and the brass for [things] of brass, the iron for [things] of iron, and wood for [things] of wood; onyx stones, and [stones] to be set, glistering stones, and of divers colours, and all manner of precious stones, and marble stones in abundance.

set glory in <u>26\_EZE\_26\_20</u># When I shall bring thee down with them that descend into the pit, with the people of old time, and shall set thee in the low parts of the earth, in places desolate of old, with them that go down to the pit, that thou be not inhabited; and I shall set glory in the land of the living;

set God before 19\_PSA\_54\_03 # For strangers are risen up against me, and oppressors seek after my soul: they have not set God before them. Selah.

set hair baldness <u>23\_ISA\_03\_24</u> # And it shall come to pass, [that] instead of sweet smell there shall be stink; and instead of a girdle a rent; and instead of well set hair baldness; and instead of a stomacher a girding of sackcloth; [and] burning instead of beauty.

set her a <u>26\_EZE\_32\_25</u># They have set her a bed in the midst of the slain with all her multitude: her graves [are] round about him: all of them uncircumcised, slain by the sword: though their terror was caused in the land of the living, yet have they borne their shame with them that go down to the pit: he is put in the midst of [them that be] slain.

set him thereon <u>40\_MAT\_21\_07</u># And brought the ass, and the colt, and put on them their clothes, and they set [him] thereon.

set him up <u>09\_1SA\_15\_12</u># And when Samuel rose early to meet Saul in the morning, it was told Samuel, saying, Saul came to Carmel, and, behold, he set him up a place, and is gone about, and passed on, and gone down to Gilgal.

set the city <u>06\_JOS\_08\_08</u> # And it shall be, when ye have taken the city, [that] ye shall set the city on fire: according to the commandment of the LORD shall ye do. See, I have commanded you.

set the city <u>06\_JOS\_08\_19</u># And the ambush arose quickly out of their place, and they ran as soon as he had stretched out his hand: and they entered into the city, and took it, and hasted and set the city on fire.

set the city 07\_JUD\_01\_08 # Now the children of Judah had fought against Jerusalem, and had taken it,

and smitten it with the edge of the sword, and set the city on fire.

set the dominion <u>18\_JOB\_38\_33</u> # Knowest thou the ordinances of heaven? canst thou set the dominion thereof in the earth?

set the Egyptians 23 ISA 19 02 # And I will set the Egyptians against the Egyptians: and they shall fight every one against his brother, and every one against his neighbour; city against city, [and] kingdom against kingdom.

set the faces <u>01\_GEN\_30\_40</u># And Jacob did separate the lambs, and set the faces of the flocks toward the ringstreaked, and all the brown in the flock of Laban; and he put his own flocks by themselves, and put them not unto Laban's cattle.

set the field <u>10\_2SA\_14\_30</u> # Therefore he said unto his servants, See, Joab's field is near mine, and he hath barley there; go and set it on fire. And Absalom's servants set the field on fire.

set the LORD 19\_PSA\_16\_08 # I have set the LORD always before me: because [he is] at my right hand, I shall not be moved.

set the members <u>46\_1CO\_12\_18</u># But now hath God set the members every one of them in the body, as it hath pleased him.

set the one 11\_1KI\_12\_29 # And he set the one in Bethel, and the other put he in Dan.

set the one 21\_ECC\_07\_14 # In the day of prosperity be joyful, but in the day of adversity consider: God

also hath set the one over against the other, to the end that man should find nothing after him.

set the people <u>14\_2CH\_02\_18</u># And he set threescore and ten thousand of them [to be] bearers of burdens, and fourscore thousand [to be] hewers in the mountain, and three thousand and six hundred overseers to set the people a work.

set the people <u>06\_JOS\_08\_13</u> # And when they had set the people, [even] all the host that [was] on the north of the city, and their liers in wait on the west of the city, Joshua went that night into the midst of the valley.

set the people 16\_NEH\_04\_13 # Therefore set I in the lower places behind the wall, [and] on the higher places, I even set the people after their families with their swords, their spears, and their bows.

set the point <u>26\_EZE\_21\_15</u> # I have set the point of the sword against all their gates, that [their] heart may faint, and [their] ruins be multiplied: ah! [it is] made bright, [it is] wrapped up for the slaughter.

set the sole <u>05\_DEU\_28\_56</u># The tender and delicate woman among you, which would not adventure to set the sole of her foot upon the ground for delicateness and tenderness, her eye shall be evil toward the husband of her bosom, and toward her son, and toward her daughter,

set the staves <u>02\_EXO\_40\_20</u> # And he took and put the testimony into the ark, and set the staves on the ark, and put the mercy seat above upon the ark:

set the table <u>02\_EXO\_26\_35</u> # And thou shalt set the table without the veil, and the candlestick over against the table on the side of the tabernacle toward the south: and thou shalt put the table on the north side.

Set the trumpet <u>28\_HOS\_08\_01</u> # [Set] the trumpet to thy mouth. [He shall come] as an eagle against the house of the LORD, because they have transgressed my covenant, and trespassed against my law.

set the watch <u>07\_JUD\_07\_19</u># So Gideon, and the hundred men that [were] with him, came unto the outside of the camp in the beginning of the middle watch; and they had but newly set the watch: and they blew the trumpets, and brake the pitchers that [were] in their hands.

set the woman <u>04\_NUM\_05\_18</u># And the priest shall set the woman before the LORD, and uncover the woman's head, and put the offering of memorial in her hands, which [is] the jealousy offering: and the priest shall have in his hand the bitter water that causeth the curse:

set their hearts 14\_2CH\_11\_16# And after them out of all the tribes of Israel such as set their hearts to seek the LORD God of Israel came to Jerusalem, to sacrifice unto the LORD God of their fathers.

set their hope 19\_PSA\_78\_07 # That they might set their hope in God, and not forget the works of God, but keep his commandments:

set their minds <u>26 EZE 24 25 #</u> Also, thou son of man, [shall it] not [be] in the day when I take from them their strength, the joy of their glory, the desire of their eyes, and that whereupon they set their minds, their sons and their daughters,

set their mouth 19\_PSA\_73\_09 # They set their mouth against the heavens, and their tongue walketh through the earth.

set their palaces <u>26\_EZE\_25\_04</u># Behold, therefore I will deliver thee to the men of the east for a possession, and they shall set their palaces in thee, and make their dwellings in thee: they shall eat thy fruit, and they shall drink thy milk.

set themselves in <u>13\_1CH\_11\_14</u># And they set themselves in the midst of [that] parcel, and delivered it, and slew the Philistines; and the LORD saved [them] by a great deliverance.

set themselves in <u>13\_1CH\_19\_11</u># And the rest of the people he delivered unto the hand of Abishai his brother, and they set [themselves] in array against the children of Ammon.

set themselves in <u>11\_1KI\_20\_12</u># And it came to pass, when [Benhadad] heard this message, as he [was] drinking, he and the kings in the pavilions, that he said unto his servants, Set [yourselves in array]. And they set [themselves in array] against the city.

set themselves in <u>10\_2SA\_10\_17</u># And when it was told David, he gathered all Israel together, and passed over Jordan, and came to Helam. And the Syrians set themselves in array against David, and fought with him.

set themselves in 23 ISA 22 07 # And it shall come to pass, [that] thy choicest valleys shall be full of chariots, and the horsemen shall set themselves in array at the gate.

set themselves in <u>24\_JER\_50\_09</u> # For, lo, I will raise and cause to come up against Babylon an assembly of great nations from the north country: and they shall set themselves in array against her; from thence she shall be taken: their arrows [shall be] as of a mighty expert man; none shall return in vain.

set themselves in <u>18\_JOB\_06\_04</u># For the arrows of the Almighty [are] within me, the poison whereof drinketh up my spirit: the terrors of God do set themselves in array against me.

set this before 12 2KI 04 43 # And his servitor said, What, should I set this before an hundred men? He said again, Give the people, that they may eat: for thus saith the LORD, They shall eat, and shall leave [thereof].

Set thou a 19\_PSA\_109\_06 # Set thou a wicked man over him: and let Satan stand at his right hand.

set three days' <u>01\_GEN\_30\_36</u># And he set three days' journey betwixt himself and Jacob: and Jacob fed the rest of Laban's flocks.

set threescore and <u>14\_2CH\_02\_18</u># And he set threescore and ten thousand of them [to be] bearers of burdens, and fourscore thousand [to be] hewers in the mountain, and three thousand and six hundred overseers to set the people a work.

set thrones of 19\_PSA\_122\_05 # For there are set thrones of judgment, the thrones of the house of David.
