seventh and the <u>38\_ZEC\_08\_19</u> # Thus saith the LORD of hosts; The fast of the fourth [month], and the fast of the fifth, and the fast of the seventh, and the fast of the tenth, shall be to the house of Judah joy and gladness, and cheerful feasts; therefore love the truth and peace.

seventh angel poured <u>66\_REV\_16\_17</u> # And the seventh angel poured out his vial into the air; and there came a great voice out of the temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, It is done.

seventh angel sounded <u>66\_REV\_11\_15</u># And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become [the kingdoms] of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever.

seventh angel when <u>66\_REV\_10\_07</u># But in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he shall begin to sound, the mystery of God should be finished, as he hath declared to his servants the prophets.

seventh captain for <u>13\_1CH\_27\_10</u># The seventh [captain] for the seventh month [was] Helez the Pelonite, of the children of Ephraim: and in his course [were] twenty and four thousand.

seventh chrysolyte the <u>66\_REV\_21\_20</u># The fifth, sardonyx; the sixth, sardius; the seventh, chrysolyte; the eighth, beryl; the ninth, a topaz; the tenth, a chrysoprasus; the eleventh, a jacinth; the twelfth, an amethyst.

seventh day and <u>01\_GEN\_02\_03</u># And God blessed the seventh day, and sanctified it: because that in it he had rested from all his work which God created and made.

seventh day and <u>03\_LEV\_13\_05</u># And the priest shall look on him the seventh day: and, behold, [if] the plague in his sight be at a stay, [and] the plague spread not in the skin; then the priest shall shut him up seven days more:

seventh day and <u>03\_LEV\_13\_06</u> # And the priest shall look on him again the seventh day: and, behold, [if] the plague [be] somewhat dark, [and] the plague spread not in the skin, the priest shall pronounce him clean: it [is but] a scab: and he shall wash his clothes, and be clean.

seventh day and <u>03\_LEV\_13\_27</u> # And the priest shall look upon him the seventh day: [and] if it be spread much abroad in the skin, then the priest shall pronounce him unclean: it [is] the plague of leprosy.

seventh day and <u>03\_LEV\_14\_39</u># And the priest shall come again the seventh day, and shall look: and, behold, [if] the plague be spread in the walls of the house;

seventh day and <u>04\_NUM\_19\_19</u># And the clean [person] shall sprinkle upon the unclean on the third day, and on the seventh day: and on the seventh day he shall purify himself, and wash his clothes, and bathe himself in water, and shall be clean at even.

seventh day and <u>04\_NUM\_31\_24</u> # And ye shall wash your clothes on the seventh day, and ye shall be clean, and afterward ye shall come into the camp.

seventh day before <u>07\_JUD\_14\_18</u># And the men of the city said unto him on the seventh day before the sun went down, What [is] sweeter than honey? and what [is] stronger than a lion? And he said unto them, If ye had not plowed with my heifer, ye had not found out my riddle.

seventh day Elishama <u>04\_NUM\_07\_48</u> # On the seventh day Elishama the son of Ammihud, prince of the children of Ephraim, [offered]:

seventh day for <u>02\_EXO\_16\_27</u># And it came to pass, [that] there went out [some] of the people on the seventh day for to gather, and they found none.

seventh day from <u>01\_GEN\_02\_02</u> # And on the seventh day God ended his work which he had made; and he rested on the seventh day from all his work which he had made.

seventh day from <u>58\_HEB\_04\_04</u> # For he spake in a certain place of the seventh [day] on this wise, And God did rest the seventh day from all his works.

seventh day God <u>01\_GEN\_02\_02</u># And on the seventh day God ended his work which he had made; and he rested on the seventh day from all his work which he had made.

seventh day he <u>02\_EXO\_24\_16</u># And the glory of the LORD abode upon mount Sinai, and the cloud covered it six days: and the seventh day he called unto Moses out of the midst of the cloud.

seventh day he <u>02\_EXO\_31\_17</u># It [is] a sign between me and the children of Israel for ever: for [in] six days the LORD made heaven and earth, and on the seventh day he rested, and was refreshed.

seventh day he <u>04\_NUM\_19\_12</u> # He shall purify himself with it on the third day, and on the seventh day he shall be clean: but if he purify not himself the third day, then the seventh day he shall not be clean.

seventh day he <u>04\_NUM\_19\_12</u> # He shall purify himself with it on the third day, and on the seventh day he shall be clean: but if he purify not himself the third day, then the seventh day he shall not be clean.

seventh day he <u>04\_NUM\_19\_19</u> # And the clean [person] shall sprinkle upon the unclean on the third day, and on the seventh day: and on the seventh day he shall purify himself, and wash his clothes, and bathe himself in water, and shall be clean at even.

seventh day if <u>03\_LEV\_13\_51</u># And he shall look on the plague on the seventh day: if the plague be spread in the garment, either in the warp, or in the woof, or in a skin, [or] in any work that is made of skin; the plague [is] a fretting leprosy; it [is] unclean.

seventh day is <u>05\_DEU\_05\_14</u> # But the seventh day [is] the sabbath of the LORD thy God: [in it] thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, nor thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thine ox, nor thine ass, nor any of thy cattle, nor thy stranger that [is] within thy gates; that thy manservant and thy maidservant may rest as well as thou.

seventh day is <u>02\_EXO\_20\_10</u># But the seventh day [is] the sabbath of the LORD thy God: [in it] thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that [is] within thy gates:

seventh day is <u>03\_LEV\_23\_03</u># Six days shall work be done: but the seventh day [is] the sabbath of rest, an holy convocation; ye shall do no work [therein]: it [is] the sabbath of the LORD in all your dwellings.

seventh day is <u>03\_LEV\_23\_08</u># But ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD seven days: in the seventh day [is] an holy convocation: ye shall do no servile work [therein].

seventh day of <u>12\_2KI\_25\_08</u> # And in the fifth month, on the seventh [day] of the month, which [is] the nineteenth year of king Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, came Nebuzaradan, captain of the guard, a servant of the king of Babylon, unto Jerusalem:

seventh day of <u>26\_EZE\_30\_20</u># And it came to pass in the eleventh year, in the first [month], in the seventh

[day] of the month, [that] the word of the LORD came unto me, saying,

seventh day on <u>58\_HEB\_04\_04</u> # For he spake in a certain place of the seventh [day] on this wise, And God did rest the seventh day from all his works.

seventh day seven <u>04\_NUM\_29\_32</u> # And on the seventh day seven bullocks, two rams, [and] fourteen lambs of the first year without blemish:

seventh day shall <u>05\_DEU\_16\_08</u> # Six days thou shalt eat unleavened bread: and on the seventh day [shall be] a solemn assembly to the LORD thy God: thou shalt do no work [therein].

seventh day shall <u>02\_EXO\_13\_06</u># Seven days thou shalt eat unleavened bread, and in the seventh day [shall be] a feast to the LORD.

seventh day shall <u>04\_NUM\_06\_09</u># And if any man die very suddenly by him, and he hath defiled the head of his consecration; then he shall shave his head in the day of his cleansing, on the seventh day shall he shave it.

seventh day that <u>10\_2SA\_12\_18</u> # And it came to pass on the seventh day, that the child died. And the servants of David feared to tell him that the child was dead: for they said, Behold, while the child was yet alive, we spake unto him, and he would not hearken unto our voice: how will he then vex himself, if we tell him that the child is dead?

seventh day that <u>02\_EXO\_12\_15</u> # Seven days shall ye eat unleavened bread; even the first day ye shall put away leaven out of your houses: for whosoever eateth leavened bread from the first day until the seventh day, that soul shall be cut off from Israel.

seventh day that <u>06\_JOS\_06\_15</u> # And it came to pass on the seventh day, that they rose early about the dawning of the day, and compassed the city after the same manner seven times: only on that day they compassed the city seven times.

seventh day that <u>07\_JUD\_14\_15</u> # And it came to pass on the seventh day, that they said unto Samson's wife, Entice thy husband, that he may declare unto us the riddle, lest we burn thee and thy father's house with fire: have ye called us to take that we have? [is it] not [so]?

seventh day that <u>07\_JUD\_14\_17</u> # And she wept before him the seven days, while their feast lasted: and it came to pass on the seventh day, that he told her, because she lay sore upon him: and she told the riddle to the children of her people.

seventh day that <u>03\_LEV\_14\_09</u> # But it shall be on the seventh day, that he shall shave all his hair off his head and his beard and his eyebrows, even all his hair he shall shave off: and he shall wash his clothes, also he shall wash his flesh in water, and he shall be clean.

seventh day the <u>11\_1KI\_20\_29</u># And they pitched one over against the other seven days. And [so] it was, that in the seventh day the battle was joined: and the children of Israel slew of the Syrians an hundred thousand footmen in one day.

seventh day the <u>03\_LEV\_13\_32</u> # And in the seventh day the priest shall look on the plague: and, behold, [if] the scall spread not, and there be in it no yellow hair, and the scall [be] not in sight deeper than the skin;

seventh day the <u>03\_LEV\_13\_34</u> # And in the seventh day the priest shall look on the scall: and, behold, [if] the scall be not spread in the skin, nor [be] in sight deeper than the skin; then the priest shall pronounce

him clean: and he shall wash his clothes, and be clean.

seventh day there <u>02\_EXO\_12\_16</u># And in the first day [there shall be] an holy convocation, and in the seventh day there shall be an holy convocation to you; no manner of work shall be done in them, save [that] which every man must eat, that only may be done of you.

seventh day there <u>02\_EXO\_35\_02</u># Six days shall work be done, but on the seventh day there shall be to you an holy day, a sabbath of rest to the LORD: whosoever doeth work therein shall be put to death.

seventh day thou <u>02\_EXO\_23\_12</u># Six days thou shalt do thy work, and on the seventh day thou shalt rest: that thine ox and thine ass may rest, and the son of thy handmaid, and the stranger, may be refreshed.

seventh day thou <u>02\_EXO\_34\_21</u> # Six days thou shalt work, but on the seventh day thou shalt rest: in earing time and in harvest thou shalt rest.

seventh day when <u>17\_EST\_01\_10</u> # On the seventh day, when the heart of the king was merry with wine, he commanded Mehuman, Biztha, Harbona, Bigtha, and Abagtha, Zethar, and Carcas, the seven chamberlains that served in the presence of Ahasuerus the king,

seventh day wherefore <u>02\_EXO\_20\_11</u># For [in] six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them [is], and rested the seventh day: wherefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it.

seventh day which  $02_EXO_{16_26}$  # Six days ye shall gather it; but on the seventh day, [which is] the sabbath, in it there shall be none.

seventh day ye <u>06\_JOS\_06\_04</u> # And seven priests shall bear before the ark seven trumpets of rams' horns: and the seventh day ye shall compass the city seven times, and the priests shall blow with the trumpets.

seventh day ye <u>04\_NUM\_28\_25</u> # And on the seventh day ye shall have an holy convocation; ye shall do no servile work.

seventh day <u>02\_EXO\_16\_29</u># See, for that the LORD hath given you the sabbath, therefore he giveth you on the sixth day the bread of two days; abide ye every man in his place, let no man go out of his place on the seventh day.

seventh day <u>02\_EXO\_16\_30</u> # So the people rested on the seventh day.

seventh day <u>04\_NUM\_31\_19</u> # And do ye abide without the camp seven days: whosoever hath killed any person, and whosoever hath touched any slain, purify [both] yourselves and your captives on the third day, and on the seventh day.

seventh from Adam <u>65\_JDE\_01\_14</u> # And Enoch also, the seventh from Adam, prophesied of these, saying, Behold, the Lord cometh with ten thousands of his saints,

seventh he shall <u>02\_EXO\_21\_02</u> # If thou buy an Hebrew servant, six years he shall serve: and in the seventh he shall go out free for nothing.

seventh hour the <u>43\_JOH\_04\_52</u> # Then inquired he of them the hour when he began to amend. And they said unto him, Yesterday at the seventh hour the fever left him.

seventh is the <u>02\_EXO\_31\_15</u># Six days may work be done; but in the seventh [is] the sabbath of rest, holy to the LORD: whoseever doeth [any] work in the sabbath day, he shall surely be put to death.

seventh lot came <u>06\_JOS\_19\_40</u> # [And] the seventh lot came out for the tribe of the children of Dan

according to their families.

seventh month an <u>04\_NUM\_29\_07</u> # And ye shall have on the tenth [day] of this seventh month an holy convocation; and ye shall afflict your souls: ye shall not do any work [therein]:

seventh month began <u>15 EZR 03 06</u> # From the first day of the seventh month began they to offer burnt offerings unto the LORD. But the foundation of the temple of the LORD was not [yet] laid.

seventh month came <u>16\_NEH\_07\_73</u># So the priests, and the Levites, and the porters, and the singers, and [some] of the people, and the Nethinims, and all Israel, dwelt in their cities; and when the seventh month came, the children of Israel [were] in their cities.

seventh month even <u>38\_ZEC\_07\_05</u># Speak unto all the people of the land, and to the priests, saying, When ye fasted and mourned in the fifth and seventh [month], even those seventy years, did ye at all fast unto me, [even] to me?

seventh month he <u>14\_2CH\_07\_10</u># And on the three and twentieth day of the seventh month he sent the people away into their tents, glad and merry in heart for the goodness that the LORD had showed unto David, and to Solomon, and to Israel his people.

seventh month in <u>26\_EZE\_45\_25</u># In the seventh [month], in the fifteenth day of the month, shall he do the like in the feast of the seven days, according to the sin offering, according to the burnt offering, and according to the meat offering, and according to the oil.

seventh month in <u>37\_HAG\_02\_01</u> # In the seventh [month], in the one and twentieth [day] of the month, came the word of the LORD by the prophet Haggai, saying,

seventh month in <u>03\_LEV\_23\_24</u> # Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, In the seventh month, in the first [day] of the month, shall ye have a sabbath, a memorial of blowing of trumpets, an holy convocation.

seventh month in <u>03 LEV 25 09</u> # Then shalt thou cause the trumpet of the jubilee to sound on the tenth [day] of the seventh month, in the day of atonement shall ye make the trumpet sound throughout all your land.

seventh month on <u>01\_GEN\_08\_04</u> # And the ark rested in the seventh month, on the seventeenth day of the month, upon the mountains of Ararat.

seventh month on <u>03\_LEV\_16\_29</u> # And [this] shall be a statute for ever unto you: [that] in the seventh month, on the tenth [day] of the month, ye shall afflict your souls, and do no work at all, [whether it be] one of your own country, or a stranger that sojourneth among you:

seventh month on <u>04\_NUM\_29\_01</u> # And in the seventh month, on the first [day] of the month, ye shall have an holy convocation; ye shall do no servile work: it is a day of blowing the trumpets unto you.

seventh month shall <u>03\_LEV\_23\_34</u># Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, The fifteenth day of this seventh month [shall be] the feast of tabernacles [for] seven days unto the LORD.

seventh month that <u>12\_2KI\_25\_25</u># But it came to pass in the seventh month, that Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, the son of Elishama, of the seed royal, came, and ten men with him, and smote Gedaliah, that he died, and the Jews and the Chaldees that were with him at Mizpah.

seventh month that <u>24\_JER\_41\_01</u> # Now it came to pass in the seventh month, [that] Ishmael the son of Nethaniah the son of Elishama, of the seed royal, and the princes of the king, even ten men with him, came unto Gedaliah the son of Ahikam to Mizpah; and there they did eat bread together in Mizpah.

seventh month there <u>03\_LEV\_23\_27</u># Also on the tenth [day] of this seventh month [there shall be] a day of atonement: it shall be an holy convocation unto you; and ye shall afflict your souls, and offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD.

seventh month was <u>13\_1CH\_27\_10</u># The seventh [captain] for the seventh month [was] Helez the Pelonite, of the children of Ephraim: and in his course [were] twenty and four thousand.

seventh month was <u>15\_EZR\_03\_01</u> # And when the seventh month was come, and the children of Israel [were] in the cities, the people gathered themselves together as one man to Jerusalem.

seventh month when <u>03\_LEV\_23\_39</u> # Also in the fifteenth day of the seventh month, when ye have gathered in the fruit of the land, ye shall keep a feast unto the LORD seven days: on the first day [shall be] a sabbath, and on the eighth day [shall be] a sabbath.

seventh month ye <u>04\_NUM\_29\_12</u> # And on the fifteenth day of the seventh month ye shall have an holy convocation; ye shall do no servile work, and ye shall keep a feast unto the LORD seven days:

seventh month <u>11\_1KI\_08\_02</u># And all the men of Israel assembled themselves unto king Solomon at the feast in the month Ethanim, which [is] the seventh month.

seventh month <u>14\_2CH\_05\_03</u># Wherefore all the men of Israel assembled themselves unto the king in the feast which [was] in the seventh month.

seventh month <u>14\_2CH\_31\_07</u> # In the third month they began to lay the foundation of the heaps, and finished [them] in the seventh month.

seventh month <u>24\_JER\_28\_17</u> # So Hananiah the prophet died the same year in the seventh month.

seventh month <u>03\_LEV\_23\_41</u> # And ye shall keep it a feast unto the LORD seven days in the year. [It shall be] a statute for ever in your generations: ye shall celebrate it in the seventh month.

seventh month <u>16\_NEH\_08\_02</u> # And Ezra the priest brought the law before the congregation both of men and women, and all that could hear with understanding, upon the first day of the seventh month.

seventh month <u>16\_NEH\_08\_14</u> # And they found written in the law which the LORD had commanded by Moses, that the children of Israel should dwell in booths in the feast of the seventh month:

seventh Peulthai the <u>13\_1CH\_26\_05</u># Ammiel the sixth, Issachar the seventh, Peulthai the eighth: for God blessed him.

seventh sabbath shall <u>03\_LEV\_23\_16</u># Even unto the morrow after the seventh sabbath shall ye number fifty days; and ye shall offer a new meat offering unto the LORD.

seventh seal there <u>66\_REV\_08\_01</u> # And when he had opened the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven about the space of half an hour.

seventh time that <u>11\_1KI\_18\_44</u># And it came to pass at the seventh time, that he said, Behold, there ariseth a little cloud out of the sea, like a man's hand. And he said, Go up, say unto Ahab, Prepare [thy chariot], and get thee down, that the rain stop thee not.

seventh time when <u>06\_JOS\_06\_16</u># And it came to pass at the seventh time, when the priests blew with the trumpets, Joshua said unto the people, Shout; for the LORD hath given you the city.

seventh to Hakkoz <u>13\_1CH\_24\_10</u> # The seventh to Hakkoz, the eighth to Abijah,

seventh to Jesharelah <u>13\_1CH\_25\_14</u> # The seventh to Jesharelah, [he], his sons, and his brethren, [were] twelve:

seventh year and <u>16\_NEH\_10\_31</u># And [if] the people of the land bring ware or any victuals on the sabbath day to sell, [that] we would not buy it of them on the sabbath, or on the holy day: and [that] we would leave the seventh year, and the exaction of every debt.

seventh year behold <u>03\_LEV\_25\_20</u># And if ye shall say, What shall we eat the seventh year? behold, we shall not sow, nor gather in our increase:

seventh year in <u>26\_EZE\_20\_01</u># And it came to pass in the seventh year, in the fifth [month], the tenth [day] of the month, [that] certain of the elders of Israel came to inquire of the LORD, and sat before me.

seventh year Jehoiada <u>14\_2CH\_23\_01</u> # And in the seventh year Jehoiada strengthened himself, and took the captains of hundreds, Azariah the son of Jeroham, and Ishmael the son of Jehohanan, and Azariah the son of Obed, and Maaseiah the son of Adaiah, and Elishaphat the son of Zichri, into covenant with him.

seventh year Jehoiada <u>12\_2KI\_11\_04</u># And the seventh year Jehoiada sent and fetched the rulers over hundreds, with the captains and the guard, and brought them to him into the house of the LORD, and made a covenant with them, and took an oath of them in the house of the LORD, and showed them the king's son.

seventh year of <u>11\_1KI\_16\_10</u># And Zimri went in and smote him, and killed him, in the twenty and seventh year of Asa king of Judah, and reigned in his stead.

seventh year of <u>11\_1KI\_16\_15</u># In the twenty and seventh year of Asa king of Judah did Zimri reign seven days in Tirzah. And the people [were] encamped against Gibbethon, which [belonged] to the Philistines.

seventh year of <u>12\_2KI\_12\_01</u># In the seventh year of Jehu Jehoash began to reign; and forty years reigned he in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Zibiah of Beersheba.

seventh year of <u>12\_2KI\_13\_10</u> # In the thirty and seventh year of Joash king of Judah began Jehoash the son of Jehoahaz to reign over Israel in Samaria, [and reigned] sixteen years.

seventh year of <u>12\_2KI\_15\_01</u># In the twenty and seventh year of Jeroboam king of Israel began Azariah son of Amaziah king of Judah to reign.

seventh year of <u>12\_2KI\_18\_09</u> # And it came to pass in the fourth year of king Hezekiah, which [was] the seventh year of Hoshea son of Elah king of Israel, [that] Shalmaneser king of Assyria came up against Samaria, and besieged it.

seventh year of <u>17\_EST\_02\_16</u># So Esther was taken unto king Ahasuerus into his house royal in the tenth month, which [is] the month Tebeth, in the seventh year of his reign.

seventh year of <u>15\_EZR\_07\_07</u> # And there went up [some] of the children of Israel, and of the priests, and the Levites, and the singers, and the porters, and the Nethinims, unto Jerusalem, in the seventh year of Artaxerxes the king.

seventh year of <u>15\_EZR\_07\_08</u># And he came to Jerusalem in the fifth month, which [was] in the seventh year of the king.

seventh year shall <u>03\_LEV\_25\_04</u># But in the seventh year shall be a sabbath of rest unto the land, a sabbath for the LORD: thou shalt neither sow thy field, nor prune thy vineyard.

seventh year the <u>05\_DEU\_15\_09</u> # Beware that there be not a thought in thy wicked heart, saying, The

seventh year, the year of release, is at hand; and thine eye be evil against thy poor brother, and thou givest him nought; and he cry unto the LORD against thee, and it be sin unto thee.

seventh year thou <u>05\_DEU\_15\_12</u># [And] if thy brother, an Hebrew man, or an Hebrew woman, be sold unto thee, and serve thee six years; then in the seventh year thou shalt let him go free from thee.

seventh year thou <u>02\_EXO\_23\_11</u># But the seventh [year] thou shalt let it rest and lie still; that the poor of thy people may eat: and what they leave the beasts of the field shall eat. In like manner thou shalt deal with thy vineyard, [and] with thy oliveyard.

seventh year three <u>24\_JER\_52\_28</u># This [is] the people whom Nebuchadrezzar carried away captive: in the seventh year three thousand Jews and three and twenty:

seventh <u>13\_1CH\_02\_15</u> # Ozem the sixth, David the seventh:

seventh <u>13\_1CH\_12\_11</u># Attai the sixth, Eliel the seventh,

seventh <u>13\_1CH\_26\_03</u> # Elam the fifth, Jehohanan the sixth, Elioenai the seventh.

seventh <u>40\_MAT\_22\_26</u># Likewise the second also, and the third, unto the seventh.
