sheep abundantly for <u>13\_1CH\_12\_40</u> # Moreover they that were nigh them, [even] unto Issachar and Zebulun and Naphtali, brought bread on asses, and on camels, and on mules, and on oxen, [and] meat, meal, cakes of figs, and bunches of raisins, and wine, and oil, and oxen, and sheep abundantly: for [there was] joy in Israel.

sheep also fowls <u>16\_NEH\_05\_18</u># Now [that] which was prepared [for me] daily [was] one ox [and] six choice sheep; also fowls were prepared for me, and once in ten days store of all sorts of wine: yet for all this required not I the bread of the governor, because the bondage was heavy upon this people.

sheep and a <u>09\_1SA\_25\_02</u> # And [there was] a man in Maon, whose possessions [were] in Carmel; and the man [was] very great, and he had three thousand sheep, and a thousand goats: and he was shearing his sheep in Carmel.

sheep and a <u>14\_2CH\_30\_24</u> # For Hezekiah king of Judah did give to the congregation a thousand bullocks and seven thousand sheep; and the princes gave to the congregation a thousand bullocks and ten thousand sheep: and a great number of priests sanctified themselves.

sheep and am <u>43\_JOH\_10\_14</u># I am the good shepherd, and know my [sheep], and am known of mine.

sheep and ass <u>06\_JOS\_06\_21</u> # And they utterly destroyed all that [was] in the city, both man and woman, young and old, and ox, and sheep, and ass, with the edge of the sword.

sheep and camels <u>14\_2CH\_14\_15</u> # They smote also the tents of cattle, and carried away sheep and camels in abundance, and returned to Jerusalem.

sheep and cheese <u>10\_2SA\_17\_29</u> # And honey, and butter, and sheep, and cheese of kine, for David, and for the people that [were] with him, to eat: for they said, The people [is] hungry, and weary, and thirsty, in the wilderness.

sheep and do <u>04\_NUM\_32\_24</u># Build you cities for your little ones, and folds for your sheep; and do that which hath proceeded out of your mouth.

sheep and doves <u>43\_JOH\_02\_14</u> # And found in the temple those that sold oxen and sheep and doves, and the changers of money sitting:

sheep and fleeth <u>43\_JOH\_10\_12</u> # But he that is an hireling, and not the shepherd, whose own the sheep are not, seeth the wolf coming, and leaveth the sheep, and fleeth: and the wolf catcheth them, and scattereth the sheep.

sheep and gave <u>01\_GEN\_30\_35</u> # And he removed that day the he goats that were ringstreaked and spotted, and all the she goats that were speckled and spotted, [and] every one that had [some] white in it, and all the brown among the sheep, and gave [them] into the hand of his sons.

sheep and go <u>01\_GEN\_29\_07</u># And he said, Lo, [it is] yet high day, neither [is it] time that the cattle should be gathered together: water ye the sheep, and go [and] feed [them].

sheep and guided <u>19\_PSA\_78\_52</u># But made his own people to go forth like sheep, and guided them in the wilderness like a flock.

sheep and his <u>06\_JOS\_07\_24</u> # And Joshua, and all Israel with him, took Achan the son of Zerah, and the silver, and the garment, and the wedge of gold, and his sons, and his daughters, and his oxen, and his asses, and his sheep, and his tent, and all that he had: and they brought them unto the valley of Achor.

sheep and horses <u>66\_REV\_18\_13</u># And cinnamon, and odours, and ointments, and frankincense, and wine, and oil, and fine flour, and wheat, and beasts, and sheep, and horses, and chariots, and slaves, and souls of men.

sheep and if <u>40\_MAT\_12\_11</u># And he said unto them, What man shall there be among you, that shall have one sheep, and if it fall into a pit on the sabbath day, will he not lay hold on it, and lift [it] out?

sheep and kill <u>02\_EXO\_22\_01</u># If a man shall steal an ox, or a sheep, and kill it, or sell it; he shall restore five oxen for an ox, and four sheep for a sheep.

sheep and of <u>09\_18A\_15\_09</u># But Saul and the people spared Agag, and the best of the sheep, and of the oxen, and of the fatlings, and the lambs, and all [that was] good, and would not utterly destroy them: but every thing [that was] vile and refuse, that they destroyed utterly.

sheep and of <u>09\_18A\_15\_15</u># And Saul said, They have brought them from the Amalekites: for the people spared the best of the sheep and of the oxen, to sacrifice unto the LORD thy God; and the rest we have utterly destroyed.

sheep and one <u>40\_MAT\_18\_12</u># How think ye? if a man have an hundred sheep, and one of them be gone astray, doth he not leave the ninety and nine, and goeth into the mountains, and seeketh that which is gone astray?

sheep and oxen <u>11\_1KI\_01\_09</u># And Adonijah slew sheep and oxen and fat cattle by the stone of Zoheleth, which [is] by Enrogel, and called all his brethren the king's sons, and all the men of Judah the king's servants:

sheep and oxen <u>11\_1KI\_08\_05</u># And king Solomon, and all the congregation of Israel, that were assembled unto him, [were] with him before the ark, sacrificing sheep and oxen, that could not be told nor numbered for multitude.

sheep and oxen <u>09\_1SA\_14\_32</u># And the people flew upon the spoil, and took sheep, and oxen, and calves, and slew [them] on the ground: and the people did eat [them] with the blood.

sheep and oxen <u>09\_1SA\_15\_21</u> # But the people took of the spoil, sheep and oxen, the chief of the things which should have been utterly destroyed, to sacrifice unto the LORD thy God in Gilgal.

sheep and oxen <u>14\_2CH\_05\_06</u># Also king Solomon, and all the congregation of Israel that were assembled unto him before the ark, sacrificed sheep and oxen, which could not be told nor numbered for multitude.

sheep and oxen <u>14\_2CH\_18\_02</u> # And after [certain] years he went down to Ahab to Samaria. And Ahab killed sheep and oxen for him in abundance, and for the people that [he had] with him, and persuaded him to go up [with him] to Ramothgilead.

sheep and oxen <u>12\_2KI\_05\_26</u># And he said unto him, Went not mine heart [with thee], when the man turned again from his chariot to meet thee? [Is it] a time to receive money, and to receive garments, and oliveyards, and vineyards, and sheep, and oxen, and menservants, and maidservants?

sheep and oxen <u>01\_GEN\_12\_16</u> # And he entreated Abram well for her sake: and he had sheep, and oxen, and he asses, and menservants, and maidservants, and she asses, and camels.

sheep and oxen <u>01\_GEN\_20\_14</u> # And Abimelech took sheep, and oxen, and menservants, and womenservants, and gave [them] unto Abraham, and restored him Sarah his wife.

sheep and oxen <u>01\_GEN\_21\_27</u># And Abraham took sheep and oxen, and gave them unto Abimelech; and both of them made a covenant.

sheep and oxen <u>19\_PSA\_08\_07</u># All sheep and oxen, yea, and the beasts of the field;

sheep and put <u>01\_GEN\_29\_03</u># And thither were all the flocks gathered: and they rolled the stone from the well's mouth, and watered the sheep, and put the stone again upon the well's mouth in his place.

sheep and Rachel <u>01\_GEN\_31\_19</u># And Laban went to shear his sheep: and Rachel had stolen the images that [were] her father's.

sheep And Samuel <u>09\_1SA\_16\_11</u> # And Samuel said unto Jesse, Are here all [thy] children? And he said, There remaineth yet the youngest, and, behold, he keepeth the sheep. And Samuel said unto Jesse, Send and fetch him: for we will not sit down till he come hither.

sheep and seek <u>26 EZE 34 11</u># For thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I, [even] I, will both search my sheep, and seek them out.

sheep and sent <u>04\_NUM\_22\_40</u> # And Balak offered oxen and sheep, and sent to Balaam, and to the princes that [were] with him.

sheep and six <u>18\_JOB\_42\_12</u># So the LORD blessed the latter end of Job more than his beginning: for he had fourteen thousand sheep, and six thousand camels, and a thousand yoke of oxen, and a thousand she asses.

sheep and slay <u>09\_1SA\_14\_34</u># And Saul said, Disperse yourselves among the people, and say unto them, Bring me hither every man his ox, and every man his sheep, and slay [them] here, and eat; and sin not against the LORD in eating with the blood. And all the people brought every man his ox with him that night, and slew [them] there.

sheep and the <u>09\_1SA\_27\_09</u> # And David smote the land, and left neither man nor woman alive, and took away the sheep, and the oxen, and the asses, and the camels, and the apparel, and returned, and came to Achish.

sheep and the <u>14\_2CH\_30\_24</u> # For Hezekiah king of Judah did give to the congregation a thousand bullocks and seven thousand sheep; and the princes gave to the congregation a thousand bullocks and ten thousand sheep: and a great number of priests sanctified themselves.

sheep and the <u>14\_2CH\_31\_06</u> # And [concerning] the children of Israel and Judah, that dwelt in the cities of Judah, they also brought in the tithe of oxen and sheep, and the tithe of holy things which were consecrated unto the LORD their God, and laid [them] by heaps.

sheep and the <u>05\_DEU\_14\_04</u># These [are] the beasts which ye shall eat: the ox, the sheep, and the goat,

sheep and the <u>01\_GEN\_30\_32</u># I will pass through all thy flock to day, removing from thence all the speckled and spotted cattle, and all the brown cattle among the sheep, and the spotted and speckled among the goats: and [of such] shall be my hire.

sheep and the <u>18\_JOB\_01\_16</u> # While he [was] yet speaking, there came also another, and said, The fire of God is fallen from heaven, and hath burned up the sheep, and the servants, and consumed them; and I only am escaped alone to tell thee.

sheep and the <u>43\_JOH\_02\_15</u> # And when he had made a scourge of small cords, he drove them all out of the temple, and the sheep, and the oxen; and poured out the changers' money, and overthrew the tables;

sheep and their <u>01\_GEN\_34\_28</u> # They took their sheep, and their oxen, and their asses, and that which [was] in the city, and that which [was] in the field,

sheep and there <u>09\_1SA\_17\_34</u> # And David said unto Saul, Thy servant kept his father's sheep, and there came a lion, and a bear, and took a lamb out of the flock:

sheep and they <u>05\_DEU\_18\_03</u> # And this shall be the priest's due from the people, from them that offer a sacrifice, whether [it be] ox or sheep; and they shall give unto the priest the shoulder, and the two cheeks, and the maw.

sheep and thine <u>02\_EXO\_20\_24</u># An altar of earth thou shalt make unto me, and shalt sacrifice thereon thy burnt offerings, and thy peace offerings, thy sheep, and thine oxen: in all places where I record my name I will come unto thee, and I will bless thee.

sheep and three <u>18\_JOB\_01\_03</u> # His substance also was seven thousand sheep, and three thousand camels, and five hundred yoke of oxen, and five hundred she asses, and a very great household; so that this man was the greatest of all the men of the east.

sheep and will <u>26\_EZE\_34\_12</u># As a shepherd seeketh out his flock in the day that he is among his sheep [that are] scattered; so will I seek out my sheep, and will deliver them out of all places where they have been scattered in the cloudy and dark day.

sheep and ye <u>09\_1SA\_08\_17</u># He will take the tenth of your sheep: and ye shall be his servants.

sheep appointed for <u>19\_PSA\_44\_11</u># Thou hast given us like sheep [appointed] for meat; and hast scattered us among the heathen.

sheep are made <u>29\_JOE\_01\_18</u> # How do the beasts groan! the herds of cattle are perplexed, because they have no pasture; yea, the flocks of sheep are made desolate.

sheep are not <u>43\_JOH\_10\_12</u> # But he that is an hireling, and not the shepherd, whose own the sheep are not, seeth the wolf coming, and leaveth the sheep, and fleeth: and the wolf catcheth them, and scattereth the sheep.

sheep as I <u>43\_JOH\_10\_26</u> # But ye believe not, because ye are not of my sheep, as I said unto you.

sheep at Bethlehem <u>09\_1SA\_17\_15</u># But David went and returned from Saul to feed his father's sheep at Bethlehem.

sheep before her <u>23\_ISA\_53\_07</u> # He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth.

sheep beside harts <u>11\_1KI\_04\_23</u># Ten fat oxen, and twenty oxen out of the pastures, and an hundred sheep, beside harts, and roebucks, and fallowdeer, and fatted fowl.

sheep but Cain <u>01\_GEN\_04\_02</u> # And she again bare his brother Abel. And Abel was a keeper of sheep, but Cain was a tiller of the ground.

sheep by name <u>43\_JOH\_10\_03</u> # To him the porter openeth; and the sheep hear his voice: and he calleth his own sheep by name, and leadeth them out.

sheep camel and <u>09\_1SA\_15\_03</u># Now go and smite Amalek, and utterly destroy all that they have, and spare them not; but slay both man and woman, infant and suckling, ox and sheep, camel and ass.

sheep did not <u>43\_JOH\_10\_08</u> # All that ever came before me are thieves and robbers: but the sheep did not hear them.

sheep eating flesh <u>23\_ISA\_22\_13</u> # And behold joy and gladness, slaying oxen, and killing sheep, eating flesh, and drinking wine: let us eat and drink; for to morrow we shall die.

sheep follow him <u>43\_JOH\_10\_04</u> # And when he putteth forth his own sheep, he goeth before them, and the sheep follow him: for they know his voice.

sheep for a <u>02\_EXO\_22\_01</u> # If a man shall steal an ox, or a sheep, and kill it, or sell it; he shall restore five oxen for an ox, and four sheep for a sheep.

sheep for raiment <u>02\_EXO\_22\_09</u># For all manner of trespass, [whether it be] for ox, for ass, for sheep, for raiment, [or] for any manner of lost thing, which [another] challengeth to be his, the cause of both parties shall come before the judges; [and] whom the judges shall condemn, he shall pay double unto his neighbour.

sheep for she <u>01\_GEN\_29\_09</u> # And while he yet spake with them, Rachel came with her father's sheep: for she kept them.

sheep for the <u>24\_JER\_12\_03</u># But thou, O LORD, knowest me: thou hast seen me, and tried mine heart toward thee: pull them out like sheep for the slaughter, and prepare them for the day of slaughter.

sheep for the <u>19\_PSA\_44\_22</u> # Yea, for thy sake are we killed all the day long; we are counted as sheep for the slaughter.

sheep for the <u>45\_ROM\_08\_36</u> # As it is written, For thy sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter.

sheep from the <u>40\_MAT\_25\_32</u># And before him shall be gathered all nations: and he shall separate them one from another, as a shepherd divideth [his] sheep from the goats:

sheep gate and <u>16\_NEH\_12\_39</u> # And from above the gate of Ephraim, and above the old gate, and above the fish gate, and the tower of Hananeel, and the tower of Meah, even unto the sheep gate: and they stood still in the prison gate.

sheep gate repaired <u>16\_NEH\_03\_32</u># And between the going up of the corner unto the sheep gate repaired the goldsmiths and the merchants.

sheep gate they <u>16\_NEH\_03\_01</u> # Then Eliashib the high priest rose up with his brethren the priests, and they builded the sheep gate; they sanctified it, and set up the doors of it; even unto the tower of Meah they sanctified it, unto the tower of Hananeel.

sheep go astray <u>05\_DEU\_22\_01</u> # Thou shalt not see thy brother's ox or his sheep go astray, and hide thyself from them: thou shalt in any case bring them again unto thy brother.

sheep going astray <u>60\_1PE\_02\_25</u> # For ye were as sheep going astray; but are now returned unto the Shepherd and Bishop of your souls.

sheep have gone <u>23\_ISA\_53\_06</u># All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.

sheep having no <u>40\_MAT\_09\_36</u># But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd.

sheep he goeth <u>43\_JOH\_10\_04</u> # And when he putteth forth his own sheep, he goeth before them, and the sheep follow him: for they know his voice.

sheep he shall <u>02\_EXO\_22\_04</u> # If the theft be certainly found in his hand alive, whether it be ox, or ass, or sheep; he shall restore double.

sheep hear his <u>43\_JOH\_10\_03</u> # To him the porter openeth; and the sheep hear his voice: and he calleth his own sheep by name, and leadeth them out.

sheep hear my <u>43\_JOH\_10\_27</u> # My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:

sheep I have <u>43\_JOH\_10\_16</u> # And other sheep I have, which are not of this fold: them also I must bring, and they shall hear my voice; and there shall be one fold, [and] one shepherd.

sheep if he <u>42\_LUK\_15\_04</u> # What man of you, having an hundred sheep, if he lose one of them, doth not leave the ninety and nine in the wilderness, and go after that which is lost, until he find it?

sheep in abundance <u>11\_1KI\_01\_19</u># And he hath slain oxen and fat cattle and sheep in abundance, and hath called all the sons of the king, and Abiathar the priest, and Joab the captain of the host: but Solomon thy servant hath he not called.

sheep in abundance <u>11\_1KI\_01\_25</u># For he is gone down this day, and hath slain oxen and fat cattle and sheep in abundance, and hath called all the king's sons, and the captains of the host, and Abiathar the priest; and, behold, they eat and drink before him, and say, God save king Adonijah.

sheep in Carmel <u>09\_1SA\_25\_02</u> # And [there was] a man in Maon, whose possessions [were] in Carmel; and the man [was] very great, and he had three thousand sheep, and a thousand goats: and he was shearing his sheep in Carmel.

sheep in mine <u>09\_18A\_15\_14</u> # And Samuel said, What [meaneth] then this bleating of the sheep in mine ears, and the lowing of the oxen which I hear?

sheep in the <u>09\_1SA\_17\_28</u> # And Eliab his eldest brother heard when he spake unto the men; and Eliab's anger was kindled against David, and he said, Why camest thou down hither? and with whom hast thou left those few sheep in the wilderness? I know thy pride, and the naughtiness of thine heart; for thou art come down that thou mightest see the battle.

sheep in the <u>05\_DEU\_07\_13</u># And he will love thee, and bless thee, and multiply thee: he will also bless the fruit of thy womb, and the fruit of thy land, thy corn, and thy wine, and thine oil, the increase of thy kine, and the flocks of thy sheep, in the land which he sware unto thy fathers to give thee.

sheep in the <u>40\_MAT\_10\_16</u># Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore wise as serpents, and harmless as doves.

sheep it is <u>03\_LEV\_27\_26</u># Only the firstling of the beasts, which should be the LORD'S firstling, no man shall sanctify it; whether [it be] ox, or sheep: it [is] the LORD'S.

sheep it shall <u>03\_LEV\_22\_21</u># And whosoever offereth a sacrifice of peace offerings unto the LORD to accomplish [his] vow, or a freewill offering in beeves or sheep, it shall be perfect to be accepted; there shall be no blemish therein.

sheep lying by <u>01\_GEN\_29\_02</u># And he looked, and behold a well in the field, and, lo, there [were] three

flocks of sheep lying by it; for out of that well they watered the flocks: and a great stone [was] upon the well's mouth.

sheep market a <u>43\_JOH\_05\_02</u> # Now there is at Jerusalem by the sheep [market] a pool, which is called in the Hebrew tongue Bethesda, having five porches.

sheep may bring <u>19\_PSA\_144\_13</u> # [That] our garners [may be] full, affording all manner of store: [that] our sheep may bring forth thousands and ten thousands in our streets:

sheep nor ox <u>07\_JUD\_06\_04</u> # And they encamped against them, and destroyed the increase of the earth, till thou come unto Gaza, and left no sustenance for Israel, neither sheep, nor ox, nor ass.

sheep not having <u>41\_MAR\_06\_34</u> # And Jesus, when he came out, saw much people, and was moved with compassion toward them, because they were as sheep not having a shepherd: and he began to teach them many things.

sheep of Bozrah <u>33\_MIC\_02\_12</u> # I will surely assemble, O Jacob, all of thee; I will surely gather the remnant of Israel; I will put them together as the sheep of Bozrah, as the flock in the midst of their fold: they shall make great noise by reason of [the multitude of] men.

sheep of his <u>19\_PSA\_100\_03</u> # Know ye that the LORD he [is] God: [it is] he [that] hath made us, and not we ourselves; [we are] his people, and the sheep of his pasture.

sheep of his <u>19\_PSA\_95\_07</u># For he [is] our God; and we [are] the people of his pasture, and the sheep of his hand. To day if ye will hear his voice,

sheep of Laban <u>01\_GEN\_29\_10</u># And it came to pass, when Jacob saw Rachel the daughter of Laban his mother's brother, and the sheep of Laban his mother's brother, that Jacob went near, and rolled the stone from the well's mouth, and watered the flock of Laban his mother's brother.

sheep of my <u>24\_JER\_23\_01</u> # Woe be unto the pastors that destroy and scatter the sheep of my pasture! saith the LORD.

sheep of the <u>40\_MAT\_10\_06</u># But go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.

sheep of the <u>40\_MAT\_15\_24</u># But he answered and said, I am not sent but unto the lost sheep of the house of Israel.

sheep of the <u>40\_MAT\_26\_31</u># Then saith Jesus unto them, All ye shall be offended because of me this night: for it is written, I will smite the shepherd, and the sheep of the flock shall be scattered abroad.

sheep of thy <u>19\_PSA\_74\_01</u> # Maschil of Asaph. O God, why hast thou cast [us] off for ever? [why] doth thine anger smoke against the sheep of thy pasture?

sheep of thy <u>19\_PSA\_79\_13</u># So we thy people and sheep of thy pasture will give thee thanks for ever: we will show forth thy praise to all generations.

sheep on his <u>40\_MAT\_25\_33</u># And he shall set the sheep on his right hand, but the goats on the left.

sheep or a <u>03\_LEV\_22\_27</u># When a bullock, or a sheep, or a goat, is brought forth, then it shall be seven days under the dam; and from the eighth day and thenceforth it shall be accepted for an offering made by fire unto the LORD.

sheep or any <u>02\_EXO\_22\_10</u> # If a man deliver unto his neighbour an ass, or an ox, or a sheep, or any beast, to keep; and it die, or be hurt, or driven away, no man seeing [it]:

sheep or for <u>05\_DEU\_14\_26</u># And thou shalt bestow that money for whatsoever thy soul lusteth after, for oxen, or for sheep, or for wine, or for strong drink, or for whatsoever thy soul desireth: and thou shalt eat there before the LORD thy God, and thou shalt rejoice, thou, and thine household,

sheep or from <u>02\_EXO\_12\_05</u># Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year: ye shall take [it] out from the sheep, or from the goats:

sheep or of <u>03\_LEV\_01\_10</u># And if his offering [be] of the flocks, [namely], of the sheep, or of the goats, for a burnt sacrifice; he shall bring it a male without blemish.

sheep or of <u>03\_LEV\_07\_23</u># Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, Ye shall eat no manner of fat, of ox, or of sheep, or of goat.

sheep or of <u>03\_LEV\_22\_19</u># [Ye shall offer] at your own will a male without blemish, of the beeves, of the sheep, or of the goats.

sheep or the <u>04\_NUM\_18\_17</u> # But the firstling of a cow, or the firstling of a sheep, or the firstling of a goat, thou shalt not redeem; they [are] holy: thou shalt sprinkle their blood upon the altar, and shalt burn their fat [for] an offering made by fire, for a sweet savour unto the LORD.

sheep ready dressed <u>09\_1SA\_25\_18</u> # Then Abigail made haste, and took two hundred loaves, and two bottles of wine, and five sheep ready dressed, and five measures of parched [corn], and an hundred clusters of raisins, and two hundred cakes of figs, and laid [them] on asses.

sheep seek thy <u>19\_PSA\_119\_176</u> # I have gone astray like a lost sheep; seek thy servant; for I do not forget thy commandments.

sheep seven days <u>02\_EXO\_22\_30</u> # Likewise shalt thou do with thine oxen, [and] with thy sheep: seven days it shall be with his dam; on the eighth day thou shalt give it me.

sheep shall be <u>05\_DEU\_28\_31</u># Thine ox [shall be] slain before thine eyes, and thou shalt not eat thereof: thine ass [shall be] violently taken away from before thy face, and shall not be restored to thee: thy sheep [shall be] given unto thine enemies, and thou shalt have none to rescue [them].

sheep shall be <u>41\_MAR\_14\_27</u> # And Jesus saith unto them, All ye shall be offended because of me this night: for it is written, I will smite the shepherd, and the sheep shall be scattered.

sheep shall be <u>38\_ZEC\_13\_07</u> # Awake, O sword, against my shepherd, and against the man [that is] my fellow, saith the LORD of hosts: smite the shepherd, and the sheep shall be scattered: and I will turn mine hand upon the little ones.

sheep shalt thou <u>05\_DEU\_18\_04</u># The firstfruit [also] of thy corn, of thy wine, and of thine oil, and the first of the fleece of thy sheep, shalt thou give him.

sheep So the <u>11\_1KI\_08\_63</u># And Solomon offered a sacrifice of peace offerings, which he offered unto the LORD, two and twenty thousand oxen, and an hundred and twenty thousand sheep. So the king and all the children of Israel dedicated the house of the LORD.

sheep so the <u>14\_2CH\_07\_05</u># And king Solomon offered a sacrifice of twenty and two thousand oxen, and an hundred and twenty thousand sheep: so the king and all the people dedicated the house of God.

sheep than of <u>40\_MAT\_18\_13</u># And if so be that he find it, verily I say unto you, he rejoiceth more of that [sheep], than of the ninety and nine which went not astray.

sheep that are <u>26\_EZE\_34\_12</u> # As a shepherd seeketh out his flock in the day that he is among his sheep [that are] scattered; so will I seek out my sheep, and will deliver them out of all places where they have been scattered in the cloudy and dark day.

sheep that are <u>22\_SON\_04\_02</u># Thy teeth [are] like a flock [of sheep that are even] shorn, which came up from the washing; whereof every one bear twins, and none [is] barren among them.

sheep that no <u>23\_ISA\_13\_14</u> # And it shall be as the chased roe, and as a sheep that no man taketh up: they shall every man turn to his own people, and flee every one into his own land.

sheep that shall <u>01\_GEN\_30\_33</u># So shall my righteousness answer for me in time to come, when it shall come for my hire before thy face: every one that [is] not speckled and spotted among the goats, and brown among the sheep, that shall be counted stolen with me.

sheep that thou <u>13\_1CH\_17\_07</u> # Now therefore thus shalt thou say unto my servant David, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, I took thee from the sheepcote, [even] from following the sheep, that thou shouldest be ruler over my people Israel:

sheep the lions <u>24\_JER\_50\_17</u> # Israel [is] a scattered sheep; the lions have driven [him] away: first the king of Assyria hath devoured him; and last this Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon hath broken his bones.

sheep there shall <u>02\_EXO\_09\_03</u> # Behold, the hand of the LORD is upon thy cattle which [is] in the field, upon the horses, upon the asses, upon the camels, upon the oxen, and upon the sheep: [there shall be] a very grievous murrain.

sheep they are <u>19\_PSA\_49\_14</u># Like sheep they are laid in the grave; death shall feed on them; and the upright shall have dominion over them in the morning; and their beauty shall consume in the grave from their dwelling.

sheep through the <u>58\_HEB\_13\_20</u># Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant,

sheep to be <u>10\_2SA\_07\_08</u> # Now therefore so shalt thou say unto my servant David, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, I took thee from the sheepcote, from following the sheep, to be ruler over my people, over Israel:

sheep to the <u>44\_ACT\_08\_32</u># The place of the scripture which he read was this, He was led as a sheep to the slaughter; and like a lamb dumb before his shearer, so opened he not his mouth:

sheep was six <u>04\_NUM\_31\_37</u># And the LORD'S tribute of the sheep was six hundred and threescore and fifteen.

sheep what have <u>13\_1CH\_21\_17</u># And David said unto God, [Is it] not I [that] commanded the people to be numbered? even I it is that have sinned and done evil indeed; but [as for] these sheep, what have they done? let thine hand, I pray thee, O LORD my God, be on me, and on my father's house; but not on thy people, that they should be plagued.

sheep what have <u>10\_2SA\_24\_17</u> # And David spake unto the LORD when he saw the angel that smote the people, and said, Lo, I have sinned, and I have done wickedly: but these sheep, what have they done? let thine hand, I pray thee, be against me, and against my father's house.

sheep Wherefore it <u>40\_MAT\_12\_12</u># How much then is a man better than a sheep? Wherefore it is lawful to do well on the sabbath days.

sheep wherein is <u>05\_DEU\_17\_01</u> # Thou shalt not sacrifice unto the LORD thy God [any] bullock, or sheep, wherein is blemish, [or] any evilfavouredness: for that [is] an abomination unto the LORD thy God.

sheep which go <u>22\_SON\_06\_06</u># Thy teeth [are] as a flock of sheep which go up from the washing, whereof every one beareth twins, and [there is] not one barren among them.

sheep which have <u>04\_NUM\_27\_17</u># Which may go out before them, and which may go in before them, and which may lead them out, and which may bring them in; that the congregation of the LORD be not as sheep which have no shepherd.

sheep which was <u>42\_LUK\_15\_06</u> # And when he cometh home, he calleth together [his] friends and neighbours, saying unto them, Rejoice with me; for I have found my sheep which was lost.

sheep who if <u>33\_MIC\_05\_08</u> # And the remnant of Jacob shall be among the Gentiles in the midst of many people as a lion among the beasts of the forest, as a young lion among the flocks of sheep: who, if he go through, both treadeth down, and teareth in pieces, and none can deliver.

sheep with a <u>09\_1SA\_17\_20</u> # And David rose up early in the morning, and left the sheep with a keeper, and took, and went, as Jesse had commanded him; and he came to the trench, as the host was going forth to the fight, and shouted for the battle.

sheep with fat <u>05\_DEU\_32\_14</u> # Butter of kine, and milk of sheep, with fat of lambs, and rams of the breed of Bashan, and goats, with the fat of kidneys of wheat; and thou didst drink the pure blood of the grape.

sheep <u>09\_1SA\_25\_04</u># And David heard in the wilderness that Nabal did shear his sheep.

sheep <u>09\_18A\_25\_16</u># They were a wall unto us both by night and day, all the while we were with them keeping the sheep.

sheep <u>14\_2CH\_15\_11</u># And they offered unto the LORD the same time, of the spoil [which] they had brought, seven hundred oxen and seven thousand sheep.

sheep <u>14\_2CH\_29\_33</u> # And the consecrated things [were] six hundred oxen and three thousand sheep.

sheep <u>05\_DEU\_15\_19</u># All the firstling males that come of thy herd and of thy flock thou shalt sanctify unto the LORD thy God: thou shalt do no work with the firstling of thy bullock, nor shear the firstling of thy sheep.

sheep <u>05\_DEU\_28\_04</u> # Blessed [shall be] the fruit of thy body, and the fruit of thy ground, and the fruit of thy cattle, the increase of thy kine, and the flocks of thy sheep.

sheep <u>02\_EXO\_22\_01</u># If a man shall steal an ox, or a sheep, and kill it, or sell it; he shall restore five oxen for an ox, and four sheep for a sheep.

sheep <u>01\_GEN\_29\_06</u># And he said unto them, [Is] he well? And they said, [He is] well: and, behold, Rachel his daughter cometh with the sheep.

sheep <u>01\_GEN\_29\_08</u># And they said, We cannot, until all the flocks be gathered together, and [till] they roll the stone from the well's mouth; then we water the sheep.

sheep <u>01\_GEN\_38\_13</u># And it was told Tamar, saying, Behold thy father in law goeth up to Timnath to shear his sheep.

sheep <u>28\_HOS\_12\_12</u> # And Jacob fled into the country of Syria, and Israel served for a wife, and for a wife he kept [sheep].

sheep <u>23\_ISA\_07\_21</u> # And it shall come to pass in that day, [that] a man shall nourish a young cow, and two sheep;

sheep <u>18\_JOB\_31\_20</u> # If his loins have not blessed me, and [if] he were [not] warmed with the fleece of my sheep;

sheep <u>43\_JOH\_10\_02</u> # But he that entereth in by the door is the shepherd of the sheep.

sheep <u>43\_JOH\_10\_07</u># Then said Jesus unto them again, Verily, verily, I say unto you, I am the door of the sheep.

sheep <u>43\_JOH\_10\_11</u> # I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep.

sheep <u>43\_JOH\_10\_12</u> # But he that is an hireling, and not the shepherd, whose own the sheep are not, seeth the wolf coming, and leaveth the sheep, and fleeth: and the wolf catcheth them, and scattereth the sheep.

sheep <u>43\_JOH\_10\_13</u> # The hireling fleeth, because he is an hireling, and careth not for the sheep.

sheep <u>43\_JOH\_10\_15</u># As the Father knoweth me, even so know I the Father: and I lay down my life for the sheep.

sheep <u>43\_JOH\_21\_16</u> # He saith to him again the second time, Simon, [son] of Jonas, lovest thou me? He

saith unto him, Yea, Lord; thou knowest that I love thee. He saith unto him, Feed my sheep.

sheep <u>43\_JOH\_21\_17</u> # He saith unto him the third time, Simon, [son] of Jonas, lovest thou me? Peter was grieved because he said unto him the third time, Lovest thou me? And he said unto him, Lord, thou knowest all things; thou knowest that I love thee. Jesus saith unto him, Feed my sheep.

sheep <u>04\_NUM\_31\_28</u> # And levy a tribute unto the LORD of the men of war which went out to battle: one soul of five hundred, [both] of the persons, and of the beeves, and of the asses, and of the sheep:

sheep <u>04\_NUM\_31\_32</u> # And the booty, [being] the rest of the prey which the men of war had caught, was six hundred thousand and seventy thousand and five thousand sheep,

sheep <u>04\_NUM\_31\_36</u> # And the half, [which was] the portion of them that went out to war, was in number three hundred thousand and seven and thirty thousand and five hundred sheep:

sheep <u>04\_NUM\_31\_43</u> # [Now the half [that pertained unto] the congregation was three hundred thousand and thirty thousand [and] seven thousand and five hundred sheep,

sheep <u>04\_NUM\_32\_36</u> # And Bethnimrah, and Bethharan, fenced cities: and folds for sheep.

sheep's clothing but <u>40\_MAT\_07\_15</u># Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.

sheepcote even from <u>13\_1CH\_17\_07</u> # Now therefore thus shalt thou say unto my servant David, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, I took thee from the sheepcote, [even] from following the sheep, that thou shouldest be ruler over my people Israel:

sheepcote from following <u>10\_2SA\_07\_08</u># Now therefore so shalt thou say unto my servant David, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, I took thee from the sheepcote, from following the sheep, to be ruler over my people, over Israel:

sheepcotes by the <u>09\_1SA\_24\_03</u> # And he came to the sheepcotes by the way, where [was] a cave; and Saul went in to cover his feet: and David and his men remained in the sides of the cave.

sheepfold but climbeth <u>43\_JOH\_10\_01</u> # Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that entereth not by the door into the sheepfold, but climbeth up some other way, the same is a thief and a robber.

sheepfolds here for <u>04\_NUM\_32\_16</u># And they came near unto him, and said, We will build sheepfolds here for our cattle, and cities for our little ones:

sheepfolds to hear <u>07\_JUD\_05\_16</u># Why abodest thou among the sheepfolds, to hear the bleatings of the flocks? For the divisions of Reuben [there were] great searchings of heart.

sheepshearers to Timnath 01\_GEN\_38\_12 # And in process of time the daughter of Shuah Judah's wife

died; and Judah was comforted, and went up unto his sheepshearers to Timnath, he and his friend Hirah the Adullamite.

sheepskins and goatskins <u>58\_HEB\_11\_37</u># They were stoned, they were sawn asunder, were tempted, were slain with the sword: they wandered about in sheepskins and goatskins; being destitute, afflicted, tormented;
