shoe and gave [08 RUT 04 07](#) # Now this [was the manner] in former time in Israel concerning redeeming and concerning changing, for to confirm all things; a man plucked off his shoe, and gave [it] to his neighbour: and this [was] a testimony in Israel.

shoe from off [05 DEU 25 09](#) # Then shall his brother's wife come unto him in the presence of the elders, and loose his shoe from off his foot, and spit in his face, and shall answer and say, So shall it be done unto that man that will not build up his brother's house.

shoe from off [06 JOS 05 15](#) # And the captain of the LORD'S host said unto Joshua, Loose thy shoe from off thy foot; for the place whereon thou standest [is] holy. And Joshua did so.

shoe from thy [23 ISA 20 02](#) # At the same time spake the LORD by Isaiah the son of Amoz, saying, Go and loose the sackcloth from off thy loins, and put off thy shoe from thy foot. And he did so, walking naked and barefoot.

shoe is not [05 DEU 29 05](#) # And I have led you forty years in the wilderness: your clothes are not waxen old upon you, and thy shoe is not waxen old upon thy foot.

shoe loosed [05 DEU 25 10](#) # And his name shall be called in Israel, The house of him that hath his shoe loosed.

shoe over Philistia [19 PSA 108 09](#) # Moab [is] my washpot; over Edom will I cast out my shoe; over Philistia will I triumph.

shoe Philistia triumph [19 PSA 60 08](#) # Moab [is] my washpot; over Edom will I cast out my shoe: Philistia, triumph thou because of me.

shoe [08 RUT 04 08](#) # Therefore the kinsman said unto Boaz, Buy [it] for thee. So he drew off his shoe.

shoe's latchet I [43 JOH 01 27](#) # He it is, who coming after me is preferred before me, whose shoe's latchet I am not worthy to unloose.

shoelatchet and that [01 GEN 14 23](#) # That I will not [take] from a thread even to a shoelatchet, and that I will not take any thing that [is] thine, lest thou shouldst say, I have made Abram rich:

shoes and clouted [06 JOS 09 05](#) # And old shoes and clouted upon their feet, and old garments upon them; and all the bread of their provision was dry [and] mouldy.

shoes and salute [42 LUK 10 04](#) # Carry neither purse, nor scrip, nor shoes: and salute no man by the way.

shoes are become [06 JOS 09 13](#) # And these bottles of wine, which we filled, [were] new; and, behold, they be rent: and these our garments and our shoes are become old by reason of the very long journey.

shoes be broken [23 ISA 05 27](#) # None shall be weary nor stumble among them; none shall slumber nor sleep; neither shall the girdle of their loins be loosed, nor the latchet of their shoes be broken:

shoes from off [02 EXO 03 05](#) # And he said, Draw not nigh hither: put off thy shoes from off thy feet, for the place whereon thou standest [is] holy ground.

shoes from thy [44 ACT 07 33](#) # Then said the Lord to him, Put off thy shoes from thy feet: for the place where thou standest is holy ground.

shoes I am [42 LUK 03 16](#) # John answered, saying unto [them] all, I indeed baptize you with water; but one mightier than I cometh, the latchet of whose shoes I am not worthy to unloose: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost and with fire:

shoes I am [41 MAR 01 07](#) # And preached, saying, There cometh one mightier than I after me, the latchet of whose shoes I am not worthy to stoop down and unloose.

shoes I am [40 MAT 03 11](#) # I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and [with] fire:

shoes lacked ye [42 LUK 22 35](#) # And he said unto them, When I sent you without purse, and scrip, and shoes, lacked ye any thing? And they said, Nothing.

shoes nor yet [40 MAT 10 10](#) # Nor scrip for [your] journey, neither two coats, neither shoes, nor yet staves: for the workman is worthy of his meat.

shoes O prince's [22 SON 07 01](#) # How beautiful are thy feet with shoes, O prince's daughter! the joints of thy thighs [are] like jewels, the work of the hands of a cunning workman.

shoes of his [44 ACT 13 25](#) # And as John fulfilled his course, he said, Whom think ye that I am? I am not [he]. But, behold, there cometh one after me, whose shoes of [his] feet I am not worthy to loose.

shoes on his [42 LUK 15 22](#) # But the father said to his servants, Bring forth the best robe, and put [it] on him; and put a ring on his hand, and shoes on [his] feet:

shoes on your [02 EXO 12 11](#) # And thus shall ye eat it; [with] your loins girded, your shoes on your feet, and your staff in your hand; and ye shall eat it in haste: it [is] the LORD'S passover.

shoes shall be [05 DEU 33 25](#) # Thy shoes [shall be] iron and brass; and as thy days, [so shall] thy strength [be].

shoes that were [11 1KI 02 05](#) # Moreover thou knowest also what Joab the son of Zeruiah did to me, [and] what he did to the two captains of the hosts of Israel, unto Abner the son of Ner, and unto Amasa the son of Jether, whom he slew, and shed the blood of war in peace, and put the blood of war upon his girdle that [was] about his loins, and in his shoes that [were] on his feet.

shoes upon thy [26 EZE 24 17](#) # Forbear to cry, make no mourning for the dead, bind the tire of thine head upon thee, and put on thy shoes upon thy feet, and cover not [thy] lips, and eat not the bread of men.

shoes upon your [26 EZE 24 23](#) # And your tires [shall be] upon your heads, and your shoes upon your feet: ye shall not mourn nor weep; but ye shall pine away for your iniquities, and mourn one toward another.

shoes yea and [30 AMO 08 06](#) # That we may buy the poor for silver, and the needy for a pair of shoes; [yea], and sell the refuse of the wheat?

shoes [30 AMO 02 06](#) # Thus saith the LORD; For three transgressions of Israel, and for four, I will not turn away [the punishment] thereof; because they sold the righteous for silver, and the poor for a pair of shoes;
