dishonest gain which <u>26_EZE_22_13</u># Behold, therefore I have smitten mine hand at thy dishonest gain which thou hast made, and at thy blood which hath been in the midst of thee.

dishonest gain <u>26_EZE_22_27</u># Her princes in the midst thereof [are] like wolves ravening the prey, to shed blood, [and] to destroy souls, to get dishonest gain.

dishonesty not walking <u>47_2CO_04_02</u> # But have renounced the hidden things of dishonesty, not walking in craftiness, nor handling the word of God deceitfully; but by manifestation of the truth commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God.

shone and Moses <u>02_EXO_34_35</u> # And the children of Israel saw the face of Moses, that the skin of Moses' face shone: and Moses put the veil upon his face again, until he went in to speak with him.

shone and they <u>02_EXO_34_30</u># And when Aaron and all the children of Israel saw Moses, behold, the skin of his face shone; and they were afraid to come nigh him.

shone from heaven <u>44_ACT_22_06</u># And it came to pass, that, as I made my journey, and was come nigh unto Damascus about noon, suddenly there shone from heaven a great light round about me.

shone not for <u>66_REV_08_12</u> # And the fourth angel sounded, and the third part of the sun was smitten, and the third part of the moon, and the third part of the stars; so as the third part of them was darkened, and the day shone not for a third part of it, and the night likewise.

shone round about <u>42_LUK_02_09</u> # And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them, and the glory of the Lord shone round about them: and they were sore afraid.

shone upon the <u>12_2KI_03_22</u> # And they rose up early in the morning, and the sun shone upon the water, and the Moabites saw the water on the other side [as] red as blood:

shone while he <u>02_EXO_34_29</u> # And it came to pass, when Moses came down from mount Sinai with the two tables of testimony in Moses' hand, when he came down from the mount, that Moses wist not that the skin of his face shone while he talked with him.
