sickle and gather <u>66\_REV\_14\_18</u># And another angel came out from the altar, which had power over fire; and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth; for her grapes are fully ripe.

sickle and reap <u>66\_REV\_14\_15</u># And another angel came out of the temple, crying with a loud voice to him that sat on the cloud, Thrust in thy sickle, and reap: for the time is come for thee to reap; for the harvest of the earth is ripe.

sickle because the <u>41\_MAR\_04\_29</u># But when the fruit is brought forth, immediately he putteth in the sickle, because the harvest is come.

sickle for the 29\_JOE\_03\_13 # Put ye in the sickle, for the harvest is ripe: come, get you down; for the press is full, the vats overflow; for their wickedness [is] great.

sickle in the <u>24\_JER\_50\_16</u># Cut off the sower from Babylon, and him that handleth the sickle in the time of harvest: for fear of the oppressing sword they shall turn every one to his people, and they shall flee every one to his own land.

sickle into the <u>66\_REV\_14\_19</u> # And the angel thrust in his sickle into the earth, and gathered the vine of the earth, and cast [it] into the great winepress of the wrath of God.

sickle on the <u>66\_REV\_14\_16</u># And he that sat on the cloud thrust in his sickle on the earth; and the earth was reaped.

sickle saying Thrust <u>66\_REV\_14\_18</u> # And another angel came out from the altar, which had power over fire; and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth; for her grapes are fully ripe.

sickle to the <u>05\_DEU\_16\_09</u> # Seven weeks shalt thou number unto thee: begin to number the seven weeks from [such time as] thou beginnest [to put] the sickle to the corn.

sickle unto thy <u>05\_DEU\_23\_25</u># When thou comest into the standing corn of thy neighbour, then thou mayest pluck the ears with thine hand; but thou shalt not move a sickle unto thy neighbour's standing corn.

sickle <u>66\_REV\_14\_14</u> # And I looked, and behold a white cloud, and upon the cloud [one] sat like unto the Son of man, having on his head a golden crown, and in his hand a sharp sickle.

sickle <u>66\_REV\_14\_17</u># And another angel came out of the temple which is in heaven, he also having a sharp sickle.
