besiege a city <u>05_DEU_20_19</u># When thou shalt besiege a city a long time, in making war against it to take it, thou shalt not destroy the trees thereof by forcing an ax against them: for thou mayest eat of them, and thou shalt not cut them down [for the tree of the field [is] man's [life]] to employ [them] in the siege:

besiege David and <u>09_1SA_23_08</u># And Saul called all the people together to war, to go down to Keilah, to besiege David and his men.

besiege it 12_2KI_24_11 # And Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon came against the city, and his servants did besiege it.

besiege it <u>05_DEU_20_12</u># And if it will make no peace with thee, but will make war against thee, then thou shalt besiege it:

besiege O Media <u>23_ISA_21_02</u># A grievous vision is declared unto me; the treacherous dealer dealeth treacherously, and the spoiler spoileth. Go up, O Elam: besiege, O Media; all the sighing thereof have I made to cease.

besiege you he 24_JER_21_09 # He that abideth in this city shall die by the sword, and by the famine, and by the pestilence: but he that goeth out, and falleth to the Chaldeans that besiege you, he shall live, and his life shall be unto him for a prey.

besiege you without 24_JER_21_04 # Thus saith the LORD God of Israel; Behold, I will turn back the weapons of war that [are] in your hands, wherewith ye fight against the king of Babylon, and [against] the Chaldeans, which besiege you without the walls, and I will assemble them into the midst of this city.

besieged Ahaz but 12_2KI_16_05 # Then Rezin king of Syria and Pekah son of Remaliah king of Israel came up to Jerusalem to war: and they besieged Ahaz, but could not overcome [him].

besieged and thou <u>26_EZE_04_03</u> # Moreover take thou unto thee an iron pan, and set it [for] a wall of iron between thee and the city: and set thy face against it, and it shall be besieged, and thou shalt lay siege against it. This [shall be] a sign to the house of Israel.

besieged it <u>27_DAN_01_01</u># In the third year of the reign of Jehoiakim king of Judah came Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon unto Jerusalem, and besieged it.

besieged it <u>24_JER_39_01</u># In the ninth year of Zedekiah king of Judah, in the tenth month, came Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon and all his army against Jerusalem, and they besieged it.

besieged Jerusalem and 24_JER_32_02 # For then the king of Babylon's army besieged Jerusalem: and Jeremiah the prophet was shut up in the court of the prison, which [was] in the king of Judah's house.

besieged Jerusalem heard <u>24_JER_37_05</u> # Then Pharaoh's army was come forth out of Egypt: and when the Chaldeans that besieged Jerusalem heard tidings of them, they departed from Jerusalem.

besieged places 12_2KI_19_24 # I have digged and drunk strange waters, and with the sole of my feet have I dried up all the rivers of besieged places.

besieged places 23 ISA 37_25 # I have digged, and drunk water; and with the sole of my feet have I dried up all the rivers of the besieged places.

besieged Rabbah But 13_1CH_20_01# And it came to pass, that after the year was expired, at the time that kings go out [to battle], Joab led forth the power of the army, and wasted the country of the children of Ammon, and came and besieged Rabbah. But David tarried at Jerusalem. And Joab smote Rabbah, and destroyed it.

besieged Rabbah But 10_2SA_11_01# And it came to pass, after the year was expired, at the time when kings go forth [to battle], that David sent Joab, and his servants with him, and all Israel; and they destroyed the children of Ammon, and besieged Rabbah. But David tarried still at Jerusalem.

besieged Samaria and <u>11_1KI_20_01</u># And Benhadad the king of Syria gathered all his host together: and [there were] thirty and two kings with him, and horses, and chariots: and he went up and besieged Samaria, and warred against it.
