

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

silver after the <u>03\_LEV\_05\_15</u> # If a soul commit a trespass, and sin through ignorance, in the holy things of the LORD; then he shall bring for his trespass unto the LORD a ram without blemish out of the flocks, with thy estimation by shekels of silver, after the shekel of the sanctuary, for a trespass offering:

silver after the <u>03\_LEV\_27\_03</u># And thy estimation shall be of the male from twenty years old even unto sixty years old, even thy estimation shall be fifty shekels of silver, after the shekel of the sanctuary.

silver also for <u>13\_1CH\_28\_14</u> # [He gave] of gold by weight for [things] of gold, for all instruments of all manner of service; [silver also] for all instruments of silver by weight, for all instruments of every kind of service:

silver and a <u>09\_1SA\_02\_36</u> # And it shall come to pass, [that] every one that is left in thine house shall come [and] crouch to him for a piece of silver and a morsel of bread, and shall say, Put me, I pray thee, into one of the priests' offices, that I may eat a piece of bread.

silver and a <u>14\_2CH\_36\_03</u># And the king of Egypt put him down at Jerusalem, and condemned the land in an hundred talents of silver and a talent of gold.

silver and a 12\_2KI\_23\_33 # And Pharaohnechoh put him in bands at Riblah in the land of Hamath, that he might not reign in Jerusalem; and put the land to a tribute of an hundred talents of silver, and a talent of gold.

silver and a <u>10\_2SA\_18\_11</u># And Joab said unto the man that told him, And, behold, thou sawest [him], and why didst thou not smite him there to the ground? And I would have given thee ten [shekels] of silver, and a girdle.

silver and a 18\_JOB\_28\_01 # Surely there is a vein for the silver, and a place for gold [where] they fine [it].

silver and a <u>06\_JOS\_07\_21</u># When I saw among the spoils a goodly Babylonish garment, and two hundred shekels of silver, and a wedge of gold of fifty shekels weight, then I coveted them, and took them; and, behold, they [are] hid in the earth in the midst of my tent, and the silver under it.

silver and all <u>14\_2CH\_25\_24</u># And [he took] all the gold and the silver, and all the vessels that were found in the house of God with Obededom, and the treasures of the king's house, the hostages also, and returned to Samaria.

silver and all 12\_2KI\_14\_14 # And he took all the gold and silver, and all the vessels that were found in the house of the LORD, and in the treasures of the king's house, and hostages, and returned to Samaria.

silver and all <u>02\_EXO\_38\_17</u># And the sockets for the pillars [were of] brass; the hooks of the pillars and their fillets [of] silver; and the overlaying of their chapiters [of] silver; and all the pillars of the court [were] filleted with silver.

silver and an <u>11\_1KI\_10\_29</u># And a chariot came up and went out of Egypt for six hundred [shekels] of silver, and an horse for an hundred and fifty: and so for all the kings of the Hittites, and for the kings of Syria, did they bring [them] out by their means.

silver and an 14\_2CH\_01\_17 # And they fetched up, and brought forth out of Egypt a chariot for six

hundred [shekels] of silver, and an horse for an hundred and fifty: and so brought they out [horses] for all the kings of the Hittites, and for the kings of Syria, by their means.

silver and apparel 38 ZEC 14 14 # And Judah also shall fight at Jerusalem; and the wealth of all the heathen round about shall be gathered together, gold, and silver, and apparel, in great abundance.

silver and as 23\_ISA\_13\_17\_# Behold, I will stir up the Medes against them, which shall not regard silver; and [as for] gold, they shall not delight in it.

silver and brass 13 1CH 18 10 # He sent Hadoram his son to king David, to inquire of his welfare, and to congratulate him, because he had fought against Hadarezer, and smitten him; [for Hadarezer had war with Tou;] and [with him] all manner of vessels of gold and silver and brass.

silver and brass <u>02\_EXO\_25\_03</u># And this [is] the offering which ye shall take of them; gold, and silver, and brass,

silver and brass <u>02\_EXO\_35\_05</u> # Take ye from among you an offering unto the LORD: whosoever [is] of a willing heart, let him bring it, an offering of the LORD; gold, and silver, and brass,

silver and brass <u>02 EXO 35 24</u> # Every one that did offer an offering of silver and brass brought the LORD's offering: and every man, with whom was found shittim wood for any work of the service, brought [it].

silver and brass <u>26\_EZE\_22\_20</u> # [As] they gather silver, and brass, and iron, and lead, and tin, into the midst of the furnace, to blow the fire upon it, to melt [it]; so will I gather [you] in mine anger and in my fury, and I will leave [you there], and melt you.

silver and brass <u>66\_REV\_09\_20</u># And the rest of the men which were not killed by these plagues yet repented not of the works of their hands, that they should not worship devils, and idols of gold, and silver, and brass, and stone, and of wood: which neither can see, nor hear, nor walk:

silver and built <u>11\_1KI\_16\_24</u># And he bought the hill Samaria of Shemer for two talents of silver, and built on the hill, and called the name of the city which he built, after the name of Shemer, owner of the hill, Samaria.

silver and for 13\_1CH\_29\_05 # The gold for [things] of gold, and the silver for [things] of silver, and for all manner of work [to be made] by the hands of artificers. And who [then] is willing to consecrate his service this day unto the LORD?

silver and for <u>11\_1KI\_20\_07</u># Then the king of Israel called all the elders of the land, and said, Mark, I pray you, and see how this [man] seeketh mischief: for he sent unto me for my wives, and for my children, and for my silver, and for my gold; and I denied him not.

silver and for <a href="14\_2CH\_32\_27">14\_2CH\_32\_27</a> # And Hezekiah had exceeding much riches and honour: and he made himself treasuries for silver, and for gold, and for precious stones, and for spices, and for shields, and for all manner of pleasant jewels;

silver and for 28\_HOS\_03\_02 # So I bought her to me for fifteen [pieces] of silver, and [for] an homer of

barley, and an half homer of barley:

silver and for 23\_ISA\_60\_17\_# For brass I will bring gold, and for iron I will bring silver, and for wood brass, and for stones iron: I will also make thy officers peace, and thine exactors righteousness.

silver and for <u>03\_LEV\_27\_06</u># And if [it be] from a month old even unto five years old, then thy estimation shall be of the male five shekels of silver, and for the female thy estimation [shall be] three shekels of silver.

silver and gave <u>07\_JUD\_17\_04</u># Yet he restored the money unto his mother; and his mother took two hundred [shekels] of silver, and gave them to the founder, who made thereof a graven image and a molten image: and they were in the house of Micah.

silver and give <u>05\_DEU\_22\_19</u># And they shall amerce him in an hundred [shekels] of silver, and give [them] unto the father of the damsel, because he hath brought up an evil name upon a virgin of Israel: and she shall be his wife; he may not put her away all his days.

silver and gold 11\_1KI\_15\_15# And he brought in the things which his father had dedicated, and the things which himself had dedicated, into the house of the LORD, silver, and gold, and vessels.

silver and gold 11\_1KI\_15\_19# [There is] a league between me and thee, [and] between my father and thy father: behold, I have sent unto thee a present of silver and gold; come and break thy league with Baasha king of Israel, that he may depart from me.

silver and gold <u>60\_1PE\_01\_18</u> # Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, [as] silver and gold, from your vain conversation [received] by tradition from your fathers;

silver and gold 14\_2CH\_01\_15 # And the king made silver and gold at Jerusalem [as plenteous] as stones, and cedar trees made he as the sycamore trees that [are] in the vale for abundance.

silver and gold 14\_2CH\_15\_18 # And he brought into the house of God the things that his father had dedicated, and that he himself had dedicated, silver, and gold, and vessels.

silver and gold 14\_2CH\_16\_02 # Then Asa brought out silver and gold out of the treasures of the house of the LORD and of the king's house, and sent to Benhadad king of Syria, that dwelt at Damascus, saying,

silver and gold 14\_2CH\_16\_03# [There is] a league between me and thee, as [there was] between my father and thy father: behold, I have sent thee silver and gold; go, break thy league with Baasha king of Israel, that he may depart from me.

Silver and gold <u>44\_ACT\_03\_06</u># Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk.

silver and gold <u>27\_DAN\_05\_23</u> # But hast lifted up thyself against the Lord of heaven; and they have brought the vessels of his house before thee, and thou, and thy lords, thy wives, and thy concubines, have drunk wine in them; and thou hast praised the gods of silver, and gold, of brass, iron, wood, and stone,

which see not, nor hear, nor know: and the God in whose hand thy breath [is], and whose [are] all thy ways, hast thou not glorified:

silver and gold <u>05\_DEU\_17\_17</u># Neither shall he multiply wives to himself, that his heart turn not away: neither shall he greatly multiply to himself silver and gold.

silver and gold <u>05\_DEU\_29\_17</u># And ye have seen their abominations, and their idols, wood and stone, silver and gold, which [were] among them:]

silver and gold <u>21\_ECC\_02\_08</u># I gathered me also silver and gold, and the peculiar treasure of kings and of the provinces: I gat me men singers and women singers, and the delights of the sons of men, [as] musical instruments, and that of all sorts.

silver and gold <u>26\_EZE\_38\_13</u># Sheba, and Dedan, and the merchants of Tarshish, with all the young lions thereof, shall say unto thee, Art thou come to take a spoil? hast thou gathered thy company to take a prey? to carry away silver and gold, to take away cattle and goods, to take a great spoil?

silver and gold <u>15\_EZR\_07\_15</u># And to carry the silver and gold, which the king and his counsellors have freely offered unto the God of Israel, whose habitation [is] in Jerusalem,

silver and gold <u>15\_EZR\_07\_16</u># And all the silver and gold that thou canst find in all the province of Babylon, with the freewill offering of the people, and of the priests, offering willingly for the house of their God which [is] in Jerusalem:

silver and gold <u>01 GEN 24 35 #</u> And the LORD hath blessed my master greatly; and he is become great: and he hath given him flocks, and herds, and silver, and gold, and menservants, and maidservants, and camels, and asses.

silver and gold <u>28\_HOS\_02\_08</u># For she did not know that I gave her corn, and wine, and oil, and multiplied her silver and gold, [which] they prepared for Baal.

silver and gold <u>23\_ISA\_02\_07</u> # Their land also is full of silver and gold, neither [is there any] end of their treasures; their land is also full of horses, neither [is there any] end of their chariots:

silver and gold <u>06\_JOS\_06\_19</u> # But all the silver, and gold, and vessels of brass and iron, [are] consecrated unto the LORD: they shall come into the treasury of the LORD.

silver and gold <u>04\_NUM\_22\_18</u># And Balaam answered and said unto the servants of Balak, If Balak would give me his house full of silver and gold, I cannot go beyond the word of the LORD my God, to do less or more.

silver and gold <u>04\_NUM\_24\_13</u># If Balak would give me his house full of silver and gold, I cannot go beyond the commandment of the LORD, to do [either] good or bad of mine own mind; [but] what the LORD saith, that will I speak?

silver and gold <u>20\_PRO\_22\_01</u> # A [good] name [is] rather to be chosen than great riches, [and] loving favour rather than silver and gold.

silver and gold 19\_PSA\_105\_37 # He brought them forth also with silver and gold: and [there was] not one feeble [person] among their tribes.

silver and gold 19\_PSA\_115\_04 # Their idols [are] silver and gold, the work of men's hands.

silver and gold 19\_PSA\_135\_15 # The idols of the heathen [are] silver and gold, the work of men's hands.

silver and gold <u>38\_ZEC\_06\_11</u># Then take silver and gold, and make crowns, and set [them] upon the head of Joshua the son of Josedech, the high priest;

silver and he <u>39\_MAL\_03\_03</u># And he shall sit [as] a refiner and purifier of silver: and he shall purify the sons of Levi, and purge them as gold and silver, that they may offer unto the LORD an offering in righteousness.

silver and her 19 PSA 68 13 # Though ye have lien among the pots, [yet shall ye be as] the wings of a dove covered with silver, and her feathers with yellow gold.

silver and his <u>23\_ISA\_02\_20</u># In that day a man shall cast his idols of silver, and his idols of gold, which they made [each one] for himself to worship, to the moles and to the bats;

silver and his 23\_ISA\_31\_07 # For in that day every man shall cast away his idols of silver, and his idols of gold, which your own hands have made unto you [for] a sin.

silver and idols <u>28\_HOS\_13\_02</u># And now they sin more and more, and have made them molten images of their silver, [and] idols according to their own understanding, all of it the work of the craftsmen: they say of them, Let the men that sacrifice kiss the calves.

silver and if <u>22\_SON\_08\_09</u> # If she [be] a wall, we will build upon her a palace of silver: and if she [be] a door, we will enclose her with boards of cedar.

silver and in <u>14\_2CH\_02\_07</u> # Send me now therefore a man cunning to work in gold, and in silver, and in brass, and in iron, and in purple, and crimson, and blue, and that can skill to grave with the cunning men that [are] with me in Judah and in Jerusalem, whom David my father did provide.

silver and in 02\_EXO\_31\_04 # To devise cunning works, to work in gold, and in silver, and in brass,

silver and in 02\_EXO\_35\_32 # And to devise curious works, to work in gold, and in silver, and in brass,

silver and in 01\_GEN\_13\_02 # And Abram [was] very rich in cattle, in silver, and in gold.

silver and it <u>06\_JOS\_24\_32</u># And the bones of Joseph, which the children of Israel brought up out of Egypt, buried they in Shechem, in a parcel of ground which Jacob bought of the sons of Hamor the father of Shechem for an hundred pieces of silver: and it became the inheritance of the children of Joseph.

silver and jewels <u>02\_EXO\_03\_22</u> # But every woman shall borrow of her neighbour, and of her that sojourneth in her house, jewels of silver, and jewels of gold, and raiment: and ye shall put [them] upon your sons, and upon your daughters; and ye shall spoil the Egyptians.

silver and jewels <u>02\_EXO\_11\_02</u># Speak now in the ears of the people, and let every man borrow of his neighbour, and every woman of her neighbour, jewels of silver, and jewels of gold.

silver and jewels <u>02\_EXO\_12\_35</u> # And the children of Israel did according to the word of Moses; and they borrowed of the Egyptians jewels of silver, and jewels of gold, and raiment:

silver and jewels <u>01\_GEN\_24\_53</u># And the servant brought forth jewels of silver, and jewels of gold, and raiment, and gave [them] to Rebekah: he gave also to her brother and to her mother precious things.

silver and knowledge <u>20\_PRO\_08\_10</u> # Receive my instruction, and not silver; and knowledge rather than choice gold.

silver and my <u>29\_JOE\_03\_05</u># Because ye have taken my silver and my gold, and have carried into your temples my goodly pleasant things:

silver and of <u>13\_1CH\_22\_14</u> # Now, behold, in my trouble I have prepared for the house of the LORD an hundred thousand talents of gold, and a thousand thousand talents of silver; and of brass and iron without weight; for it is in abundance: timber also and stone have I prepared; and thou mayest add thereto.

silver and of 14\_2CH\_21\_03 # And their father gave them great gifts of silver, and of gold, and of precious things, with fenced cities in Judah: but the kingdom gave he to Jehoram; because he [was] the firstborn.

silver and of <u>27\_DAN\_11\_08</u># And shall also carry captives into Egypt their gods, with their princes, [and] with their precious vessels of silver and of gold; and he shall continue [more] years than the king of the north.

silver and over <u>27\_DAN\_11\_43</u> # But he shall have power over the treasures of gold and of silver, and over all the precious things of Egypt: and the Libyans and the Ethiopians [shall be] at his steps.

silver and precious <u>66\_REV\_18\_12</u># The merchandise of gold, and silver, and precious stones, and of pearls, and fine linen, and purple, and silk, and scarlet, and all thyine wood, and all manner vessels of ivory, and all manner vessels of most precious wood, and of brass, and iron, and marble,

silver and searchest <u>20\_PRO\_02\_04</u># If thou seekest her as silver, and searchest for her as [for] hid treasures;

silver and she <u>05\_DEU\_22\_29</u># Then the man that lay with her shall give unto the damsel's father fifty [shekels] of silver, and she shall be his wife; because he hath humbled her, he may not put her away all his days.

silver and silver <u>15\_EZR\_08\_26</u> # I even weighed unto their hand six hundred and fifty talents of silver, and silver vessels an hundred talents, [and] of gold an hundred talents;

silver and six <u>12\_2KI\_05\_05</u># And the king of Syria said, Go to, go, and I will send a letter unto the king of Israel. And he departed, and took with him ten talents of silver, and six thousand [pieces] of gold, and ten changes of raiment.

silver and ten 14\_2CH\_27\_05 # He fought also with the king of the Ammonites, and prevailed against them. And the children of Ammon gave him the same year an hundred talents of silver, and ten thousand measures of wheat, and ten thousand of barley. silver and the <u>13\_1CH\_29\_02</u># Now I have prepared with all my might for the house of my God the gold for [things to be made] of gold, and the silver for [things] of silver, and the brass for [things] of brass, the iron for [things] of iron, and wood for [things] of wood; onyx stones, and [stones] to be set, glistering stones, and of divers colours, and all manner of precious stones, and marble stones in abundance.

silver and the <u>11\_1KI\_07\_51</u># So was ended all the work that king Solomon made for the house of the LORD. And Solomon brought in the things which David his father had dedicated; [even] the silver, and the

silver and the <u>15\_EZR\_08\_25</u> # And weighed unto them the silver, and the gold, and the vessels, [even] the offering of the house of our God, which the king, and his counsellors, and his lords, and all Israel [there] present, had offered:

Silver spread into 24 JER 10 09 # Silver spread into plates is brought from Tarshish, and gold from Uphaz, the work of the workman, and of the hands of the founder: blue and purple [is] their clothing: they [are] all the work of cunning [men].

silver take the <u>34\_NAH\_02\_09</u># Take ye the spoil of silver, take the spoil of gold: for [there is] none end of the store [and] glory out of all the pleasant furniture.

silver ten thousand <u>13\_1CH\_29\_07</u> # And gave for the service of the house of God of gold five thousand talents and ten thousand drams, and of silver ten thousand talents, and of brass eighteen thousand talents, and one hundred thousand talents of iron.
