

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

singers all of <u>14\_2CH\_05\_12</u> # Also the Levites [which were] the singers, all of them of Asaph, of Heman, of Jeduthun, with their sons and their brethren, [being] arrayed in white linen, having cymbals and psalteries and harps, stood at the east end of the altar, and with them an hundred and twenty priests sounding with trumpets:]

singers also Eliashib <u>15\_EZR\_10\_24</u> # Of the singers also; Eliashib: and of the porters; Shallum, and Telem, and Uri.

singers and Chenaniah <u>13\_1CH\_15\_27</u> # And David [was] clothed with a robe of fine linen, and all the Levites that bare the ark, and the singers, and Chenaniah the master of the song with the singers: David also [had] upon him an ephod of linen.

singers and some <u>16\_NEH\_07\_73</u># So the priests, and the Levites, and the porters, and the singers, and [some] of the people, and the Nethinims, and all Israel, dwelt in their cities; and when the seventh month came, the children of Israel [were] in their cities.

singers and songs <u>16\_NEH\_12\_46</u># For in the days of David and Asaph of old [there were] chief of the singers, and songs of praise and thanksgiving unto God.

singers and the <u>21\_ECC\_02\_08</u> # I gathered me also silver and gold, and the peculiar treasure of kings and of the provinces: I gat me men singers and women singers, and the delights of the sons of men, [as] musical instruments, and that of all sorts.

singers and the <u>15\_EZR\_02\_70</u> # So the priests, and the Levites, and [some] of the people, and the singers, and the porters, and the Nethinims, dwelt in their cities, and all Israel in their cities.

singers and the <u>15\_EZR\_07\_07</u> # And there went up [some] of the children of Israel, and of the priests, and the Levites, and the singers, and the porters, and the Nethinims, unto Jerusalem, in the seventh year of Artaxerxes the king.

singers and the <u>16\_NEH\_07\_01</u> # Now it came to pass, when the wall was built, and I had set up the doors, and the porters and the singers and the Levites were appointed,

singers and the <u>16\_NEH\_12\_45</u># And both the singers and the porters kept the ward of their God, and the ward of the purification, according to the commandment of David, [and] of Solomon his son.

singers and the <u>16\_NEH\_12\_47</u> # And all Israel in the days of Zerubbabel, and in the days of Nehemiah, gave the portions of the singers and the porters, every day his portion: and they sanctified [holy things] unto the Levites; and the Levites sanctified [them] unto the children of Aaron.

singers and the <u>16\_NEH\_13\_05</u> # And he had prepared for him a great chamber, where aforetime they laid the meat offerings, the frankincense, and the vessels, and the tithes of the corn, the new wine, and the oil, which was commanded [to be given] to the Levites, and the singers, and the porters; and the offerings of the priests.

singers and there <u>14\_2CH\_09\_11</u># And the king made [of] the algum trees terraces to the house of the LORD, and to the king's palace, and harps and psalteries for singers: and there were none such seen before in the land of Judah.

singers and we <u>16\_NEH\_10\_39</u># For the children of Israel and the children of Levi shall bring the offering of the corn, of the new wine, and the oil, unto the chambers, where [are] the vessels of the sanctuary, and the priests that minister, and the porters, and the singers: and we will not forsake the house of our God.

singers and women <u>21\_ECC\_02\_08</u> # I gathered me also silver and gold, and the peculiar treasure of kings and of the provinces: I gat me men singers and women singers, and the delights of the sons of men, [as] musical instruments, and that of all sorts.

singers as the <u>19\_PSA\_87\_07</u># As well the singers as the players on instruments [shall be there]: all my springs [are] in thee.

singers chief of <u>13\_1CH\_09\_33</u># And these [are] the singers, chief of the fathers of the Levites, [who remaining] in the chambers [were] free: for they were employed in [that] work day and night.

singers David also <u>13\_1CH\_15\_27</u> # And David [was] clothed with a robe of fine linen, and all the Levites that bare the ark, and the singers, and Chenaniah the master of the song with the singers: David also [had] upon him an ephod of linen.

singers due for <u>16\_NEH\_11\_23</u># For [it was] the king's commandment concerning them, that a certain portion should be for the singers, due for every day.

singers gathered themselves <u>16\_NEH\_12\_28</u># And the sons of the singers gathered themselves together, both out of the plain country round about Jerusalem, and from the villages of Netophathi;

singers had builded <u>16\_NEH\_12\_29</u># Also from the house of Gilgal, and out of the fields of Geba and Azmaveth: for the singers had builded them villages round about Jerusalem.

singers Heman Asaph <u>13\_1CH\_15\_19</u># So the singers, Heman, Asaph, and Ethan, [were appointed] to sound with cymbals of brass;

singers in the <u>26\_EZE\_40\_44</u> # And without the inner gate [were] the chambers of the singers in the inner court, which [was] at the side of the north gate; and their prospect [was] toward the south: one at the side of the east gate [having] the prospect toward the north.

singers porters Nethinims <u>15\_EZR\_07\_24</u> # Also we certify you, that touching any of the priests and Levites, singers, porters, Nethinims, or ministers of this house of God, it shall not be lawful to impose toll, tribute, or custom, upon them.

singers sang and <u>14\_2CH\_29\_28</u> # And all the congregation worshipped, and the singers sang, and the trumpeters sounded: [and] all [this continued] until the burnt offering was finished.

singers sang loud <u>16\_NEH\_12\_42</u># And Maaseiah, and Shemaiah, and Eleazar, and Uzzi, and Jehohanan, and Malchijah, and Elam, and Ezer. And the singers sang loud, with Jezrahiah [their] overseer.

singers that did <u>16\_NEH\_13\_10</u> # And I perceived that the portions of the Levites had not been given [them]: for the Levites and the singers, that did the work, were fled every one to his field.

singers the children <u>15\_EZR\_02\_41</u> # The singers: the children of Asaph, an hundred twenty and eight.

singers the children <u>16\_NEH\_07\_44</u># The singers: the children of Asaph, an hundred forty and eight.

singers the Nethinims <u>16\_NEH\_10\_28</u># And the rest of the people, the priests, the Levites, the porters, the singers, the Nethinims, and all they that had separated themselves from the people of the lands unto the law of God, their wives, their sons, and their daughters, every one having knowledge, and having

## understanding;

singers the sons <u>14\_2CH\_35\_15</u> # And the singers the sons of Asaph [were] in their place, according to the commandment of David, and Asaph, and Heman, and Jeduthun the king's seer; and the porters [waited] at every gate; they might not depart from their service; for their brethren the Levites prepared for them.

singers there came <u>11\_1KI\_10\_12</u># And the king made of the almug trees pillars for the house of the LORD, and for the king's house, harps also and psalteries for singers: there came no such almug trees, nor were seen unto this day.

singers unto the <u>14\_2CH\_20\_21</u> # And when he had consulted with the people, he appointed singers unto the LORD, and that should praise the beauty of holiness, as they went out before the army, and to say, Praise the LORD; for his mercy [endureth] for ever.

singers went before <u>19\_PSA\_68\_25</u># The singers went before, the players on instruments [followed] after; among [them were] the damsels playing with timbrels.

singers were as <u>14\_2CH\_05\_13</u># It came even to pass, as the trumpeters and singers [were] as one, to make one sound to be heard in praising and thanking the LORD; and when they lifted up [their] voice with the trumpets and cymbals and instruments of music, and praised the LORD, [saying], For [he is] good; for his mercy [endureth] for ever: that [then] the house was filled with a cloud, [even] the house of the LORD;

singers were over <u>16\_NEH\_11\_22</u># The overseer also of the Levites at Jerusalem [was] Uzzi the son of Bani, the son of Hashabiah, the son of Mattaniah, the son of Micha. Of the sons of Asaph, the singers [were] over the business of the house of God.

singers with instruments <u>13\_1CH\_15\_16</u> # And David spake to the chief of the Levites to appoint their brethren [to be] the singers with instruments of music, psalteries and harps and cymbals, sounding, by lifting up the voice with joy.

singers with instruments <u>14\_2CH\_23\_13</u> # And she looked, and, behold, the king stood at his pillar at the entering in, and the princes and the trumpets by the king: and all the people of the land rejoiced, and sounded with trumpets, also the singers with instruments of music, and such as taught to sing praise. Then Athaliah rent her clothes, and said, Treason, Treason.
