slip not <u>19_PSA_17_05</u># Hold up my goings in thy paths, [that] my footsteps slip not.

slip with his <u>18_JOB_12_05</u># He that is ready to slip with [his] feet [is as] a lamp despised in the thought of him that is at ease.

slip <u>10_2SA_22_37</u> # Thou hast enlarged my steps under me; so that my feet did not slip.

slip <u>58_HEB_02_01</u> # Therefore we ought to give the more earnest heed to the things which we have heard, lest at any time we should let [them] slip.

slip <u>19_PSA_18_36</u> # Thou hast enlarged my steps under me, that my feet did not slip.

slipped away out <u>09_1SA_19_10</u># And Saul sought to smite David even to the wall with the javelin; but he slipped away out of Saul's presence, and he smote the javelin into the wall: and David fled, and escaped that night.

slipped <u>19_PSA_73_02</u> # But as for me, my feet were almost gone; my steps had well nigh slipped.

slippery and let <u>19_PSA_35_06</u># Let their way be dark and slippery: and let the angel of the LORD persecute them.

slippery places thou <u>19_PSA_73_18</u># Surely thou didst set them in slippery places: thou castedst them down into destruction.

slippery ways in <u>24_JER_23_12</u># Wherefore their way shall be unto them as slippery [ways] in the darkness: they shall be driven on, and fall therein: for I will bring evil upon them, [even] the year of their visitation, saith the LORD.

slippeth from the <u>05_DEU_19_05</u> # As when a man goeth into the wood with his neighbour to hew wood, and his hand fetcheth a stroke with the ax to cut down the tree, and the head slippeth from the helve, and lighteth upon his neighbour, that he die; he shall flee unto one of those cities, and live:

slippeth they magnify <u>19_PSA_38_16</u># For I said, [Hear me], lest [otherwise] they should rejoice over me: when my foot slippeth, they magnify [themselves] against me.

slippeth thy mercy <u>19_PSA_94_18</u># When I said, My foot slippeth; thy mercy, O LORD, held me up.

slips <u>23_ISA_17_10</u># Because thou hast forgotten the God of thy salvation, and hast not been mindful of the rock of thy strength, therefore shalt thou plant pleasant plants, and shalt set it with strange slips:
