sluggard consider her 20_PRO_06_06 # Go to the ant, thou sluggard; consider her ways, and be wise:

sluggard desireth and <u>20_PRO_13_04</u># The soul of the sluggard desireth, and [hath] nothing: but the soul of the diligent shall be made fat.

sluggard is wiser <u>20_PRO_26_16</u># The sluggard [is] wiser in his own conceit than seven men that can render a reason.

sluggard to them <u>20_PRO_10_26</u># As vinegar to the teeth, and as smoke to the eyes, so [is] the sluggard to them that send him.

sluggard when wilt <u>20_PRO_06_09</u> # How long wilt thou sleep, O sluggard? when wilt thou arise out of thy sleep?

sluggard will not <u>20_PRO_20_04</u># The sluggard will not plow by reason of the cold; [therefore] shall he beg in harvest, and [have] nothing.
