smitten a garrison <u>09_1SA_13_04</u> # And all Israel heard say [that] Saul had smitten a garrison of the Philistines, and [that] Israel also was had in abomination with the Philistines. And the people were called together after Saul to Gilgal.

smitten all mine <u>19_PSA_03_07</u> # Arise, O LORD; save me, O my God: for thou hast smitten all mine enemies [upon] the cheek bone; thou hast broken the teeth of the ungodly.

smitten all the <u>13_1CH_18_09</u># Now when Tou king of Hamath heard how David had smitten all the host of Hadarezer king of Zobah;

smitten all the <u>10_2SA_08_09</u> # When Toi king of Hamath heard that David had smitten all the host of Hadadezer,

smitten among them <u>04_NUM_33_04</u> # For the Egyptians buried all [their] firstborn, which the LORD had smitten among them: upon their gods also the LORD executed judgments.

smitten and die <u>10_2SA_11_15</u># And he wrote in the letter, saying, Set ye Uriah in the forefront of the hottest battle, and retire ye from him, that he may be smitten, and die.

smitten and he <u>28_HOS_06_01</u> # Come, and let us return unto the LORD: for he hath torn, and he will heal us; he hath smitten, and he will bind us up.

smitten and the <u>66_REV_08_12</u> # And the fourth angel sounded, and the third part of the sun was smitten, and the third part of the moon, and the third part of the stars; so as the third part of them was darkened, and the day shone not for a third part of it, and the night likewise.

smitten and they <u>09_1SA_04_10</u># And the Philistines fought, and Israel was smitten, and they fled every man into his tent: and there was a very great slaughter; for there fell of Israel thirty thousand footmen.

smitten and they <u>19_PSA_69_26</u> # For they persecute [him] whom thou hast smitten; and they talk to the grief of those whom thou hast wounded.

smitten and withered <u>19_PSA_102_04</u> # My heart is smitten, and withered like grass; so that I forget to eat my bread.

smitten before Israel <u>09_1SA_07_10</u> # And as Samuel was offering up the burnt offering, the Philistines drew near to battle against Israel: but the LORD thundered with a great thunder on that day upon the Philistines, and discomfited them; and they were smitten before Israel.

smitten before Israel <u>10_28A_10_15</u># And when the Syrians saw that they were smitten before Israel, they gathered themselves together.

smitten before Israel <u>10_2SA_10_19</u># And when all the kings [that were] servants to Hadarezer saw that they were smitten before Israel, they made peace with Israel, and served them. So the Syrians feared to help the children of Ammon any more.

smitten before the <u>09_1SA_04_02</u> # And the Philistines put themselves in array against Israel: and when they joined battle, Israel was smitten before the Philistines: and they slew of the army in the field about

four thousand men.

smitten before thy <u>05_DEU_28_07</u> # The LORD shall cause thine enemies that rise up against thee to be smitten before thy face: they shall come out against thee one way, and flee before thee seven ways.

smitten before your <u>05_DEU_01_42</u> # And the LORD said unto me, Say unto them, Go not up, neither fight; for I [am] not among you; lest ye be smitten before your enemies.

smitten before your <u>04_NUM_14_42</u> # Go not up, for the LORD [is] not among you; that ye be not smitten before your enemies.

smitten contrary to <u>44_ACT_23_03</u> # Then said Paul unto him, God shall smite thee, [thou] whited wall: for sittest thou to judge me after the law, and commandest me to be smitten contrary to the law?

smitten down before <u>11_1KI_08_33</u># When thy people Israel be smitten down before the enemy, because they have sinned against thee, and shall turn again to thee, and confess thy name, and pray, and make supplication unto thee in this house:

smitten down before <u>07_JUD_20_32</u> # And the children of Benjamin said, They [are] smitten down before us, as at the first. But the children of Israel said, Let us flee, and draw them from the city unto the highways.

smitten down before <u>07_JUD_20_39</u> # And when the men of Israel retired in the battle, Benjamin began to smite [and] kill of the men of Israel about thirty persons: for they said, Surely they are smitten down before us, as [in] the first battle.

smitten Edom and <u>12_2KI_14_10</u># Thou hast indeed smitten Edom, and thine heart hath lifted thee up: glory [of this], and tarry at home: for why shouldest thou meddle to [thy] hurt, that thou shouldest fall, [even] thou, and Judah with thee?

smitten every male <u>11_1KI_11_15</u># For it came to pass, when David was in Edom, and Joab the captain of the host was gone up to bury the slain, after he had smitten every male in Edom;

smitten five or <u>12_2KI_13_19</u># And the man of God was wroth with him, and said, Thou shouldest have smitten five or six times; then hadst thou smitten Syria till thou hadst consumed [it]: whereas now thou shalt smite Syria [but] thrice.

smitten for the <u>02_EXO_09_31</u># And the flax and the barley was smitten: for the barley [was] in the ear, and the flax [was] bolled.

smitten for the <u>07_JUD_20_36</u># So the children of Benjamin saw that they were smitten: for the men of Israel gave place to the Benjamites, because they trusted unto the liers in wait which they had set beside Gibeah.

smitten for they <u>02_EXO_09_32</u> # But the wheat and the rie were not smitten: for they [were] not grown up.

smitten him as 23_ISA_27_07 # Hath he smitten him, as he smote those that smote him? [or] is he slain according to the slaughter of them that are slain by him?

smitten him for <u>13_1CH_18_10</u># He sent Hadoram his son to king David, to inquire of his welfare, and to

congratulate him, because he had fought against Hadarezer, and smitten him; [for Hadarezer had war with Tou;] and [with him] all manner of vessels of gold and silver and brass.

smitten him for <u>10_2SA_08_10</u># Then Toi sent Joram his son unto king David, to salute him, and to bless him, because he had fought against Hadadezer, and smitten him: for Hadadezer had wars with Toi. And [Joram] brought with him vessels of silver, and vessels of gold, and vessels of brass:

smitten him <u>14_2CH_26_20</u> # And Azariah the chief priest, and all the priests, looked upon him, and, behold, he [was] leprous in his forehead, and they thrust him out from thence; yea, himself hasted also to go out, because the LORD had smitten him.

smitten in the <u>26_EZE_40_01</u> # In the five and twentieth year of our captivity, in the beginning of the year, in the tenth [day] of the month, in the fourteenth year after that the city was smitten, in the selfsame day the hand of the LORD was upon me, and brought me thither.

smitten it with <u>07_JUD_01_08</u># Now the children of Judah had fought against Jerusalem, and had taken it, and smitten it with the edge of the sword, and set the city on fire.

smitten Judah and <u>14_2CH_28_17</u># For again the Edomites had come and smitten Judah, and carried away captives.

smitten many of <u>09_1SA_06_19</u> # And he smote the men of Bethshemesh, because they had looked into the ark of the LORD, even he smote of the people fifty thousand and threescore and ten men: and the people lamented, because the LORD had smitten [many] of the people with a great slaughter.

smitten me these <u>04_NUM_22_28</u> # And the LORD opened the mouth of the ass, and she said unto Balaam, What have I done unto thee, that thou hast smitten me these three times?

smitten me upon <u>18_JOB_16_10</u># They have gaped upon me with their mouth; they have smitten me upon the cheek reproachfully; they have gathered themselves together against me.

smitten mine hand <u>26_EZE_22_13</u># Behold, therefore I have smitten mine hand at thy dishonest gain which thou hast made, and at thy blood which hath been in the midst of thee.

smitten my life <u>19_PSA_143_03</u> # For the enemy hath persecuted my soul; he hath smitten my life down to the ground; he hath made me to dwell in darkness, as those that have been long dead.

smitten of Benjamin <u>10_2SA_02_31</u> # But the servants of David had smitten of Benjamin, and of Abner's men, [so that] three hundred and threescore men died.

smitten of God <u>23_ISA_53_04</u># Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.

smitten one another <u>12_2KI_03_23</u># And they said, This [is] blood: the kings are surely slain, and they have smitten one another: now therefore, Moab, to the spoil.

smitten Syria till <u>12_2KI_13_19</u># And the man of God was wroth with him, and said, Thou shouldest have smitten five or six times; then hadst thou smitten Syria till thou hadst consumed [it]: whereas now thou shalt smite Syria [but] thrice.

smitten that he <u>02_EXO_22_02</u># If a thief be found breaking up, and be smitten that he die, [there shall] no blood [be shed] for him.

smitten the Edomites <u>14_2CH_25_19</u># Thou sayest, Lo, thou hast smitten the Edomites; and thine heart lifteth thee up to boast: abide now at home; why shouldest thou meddle to [thine] hurt, that thou shouldest

smitten the waters <u>12_2KI_02_14</u> # And he took the mantle of Elijah that fell from him, and smote the waters, and said, Where [is] the LORD God of Elijah? and when he also had smitten the waters, they parted hither and thither: and Elisha went over.

smitten the whole <u>24_JER_37_10</u># For though ye had smitten the whole army of the Chaldeans that fight against you, and there remained [but] wounded men among them, [yet] should they rise up every man in his tent, and burn this city with fire.

smitten their root <u>28_HOS_09_16</u> # Ephraim is smitten, their root is dried up, they shall bear no fruit: yea, though they bring forth, yet will I slay [even] the beloved [fruit] of their womb.

smitten them and <u>23_ISA_05_25</u># Therefore is the anger of the LORD kindled against his people, and he hath stretched forth his hand against them, and hath smitten them: and the hills did tremble, and their carcases [were] torn in the midst of the streets. For all this his anger is not turned away, but his hand [is] stretched out still.

smitten Then the <u>14_2CH_25_16</u> # And it came to pass, as he talked with him, that [the king] said unto him, Art thou made of the king's counsel? forbear; why shouldest thou be smitten? Then the prophet forbare, and said, I know that God hath determined to destroy thee, because thou hast done this, and hast not hearkened unto my counsel.

smitten thine ass <u>04_NUM_22_32</u> # And the angel of the LORD said unto him, Wherefore hast thou smitten thine ass these three times? behold, I went out to withstand thee, because [thy] way is perverse before me:

smitten us and <u>24_JER_14_19</u> # Hast thou utterly rejected Judah? hath thy soul loathed Zion? why hast thou smitten us, and [there is] no healing for us? we looked for peace, and [there is] no good; and for the time of healing, and behold trouble!

smitten us to <u>09_1SA_04_03</u> # And when the people were come into the camp, the elders of Israel said, Wherefore hath the LORD smitten us to day before the Philistines? Let us fetch the ark of the covenant of the LORD out of Shiloh unto us, that, when it cometh among us, it may save us out of the hand of our enemies.

smitten with destruction 23_ISA_24_12 # In the city is left desolation, and the gate is smitten with destruction.

smitten with the <u>09_1SA_05_12</u> # And the men that died not were smitten with the emerods: and the cry of the city went up to heaven.

smitten you with <u>30_AMO_04_09</u> # I have smitten you with blasting and mildew: when your gardens and your vineyards and your fig trees and your olive trees increased, the palmerworm devoured [them]: yet have ye not returned unto me, saith the LORD.

smitten your children <u>24_JER_02_30</u> # In vain have I smitten your children; they received no correction: your own sword hath devoured your prophets, like a destroying lion.

smitten Ziklag and <u>09_1SA_30_01</u># And it came to pass, when David and his men were come to Ziklag on the third day, that the Amalekites had invaded the south, and Ziklag, and smitten Ziklag, and burned it with fire;

smitten <u>14_2CH_20_22</u> # And when they began to sing and to praise, the LORD set ambushments against the children of Ammon, Moab, and mount Seir, which were come against Judah; and they were smitten.

smitten <u>26_EZE_33_21</u> # And it came to pass in the twelfth year of our captivity, in the tenth [month], in the fifth [day] of the month, [that] one that had escaped out of Jerusalem came unto me, saying, The city is smitten.
