soft answer turneth 20 PRO 15 01 # A soft answer turneth away wrath: but grievous words stir up anger.

soft clothing are 40 MAT 11 08# But what went ve out for to see? A man clothed in soft raiment? behold, they that wear soft [clothing] are in kings' houses.

soft raiment Behold 42 LUK 07 25 # But what went ye out for to see? A man clothed in soft raiment? Behold, they which are gorgeously apparelled, and live delicately, are in kings' courts.

soft raiment behold 40 MAT 11 08# But what went ye out for to see? A man clothed in soft raiment? behold, they that wear soft [clothing] are in kings' houses.

soft tongue breaketh 20 PRO 25 15 # By long forbearing is a prince persuaded, and a soft tongue breaketh the bone.

soft with showers 19 PSA 65 10 # Thou waterest the ridges thereof abundantly: thou settlest the furrows thereof: thou makest it soft with showers: thou blessest the springing thereof.

soft words unto 18 JOB 41 03 # Will he make many supplications unto thee? will he speak soft [words] unto thee?

softer than oil 19 PSA 55 21 # [The words] of his mouth were smoother than butter, but war [was] in his heart; his words were softer than oil, yet [were] they drawn swords.

softly according as 01 GEN 33 14 # Let my lord, I pray thee, pass over before his servant: and I will lead on softly, according as the cattle that goeth before me and the children be able to endure, until I come unto my lord unto Seir.

softly all my 23 ISA 38 15 # What shall I say? he hath both spoken unto me, and himself hath done [it]: I shall go softly all my years in the bitterness of my soul.

softly and rejoice 23 ISA 08 06 # Forasmuch as this people refuseth the waters of Shiloah that go softly, and rejoice in Rezin and Remaliah's son;

softly and uncovered 08 RUT 03 07 # And when Boaz had eaten and drunk, and his heart was merry, he went to lie down at the end of the heap of corn: and she came softly, and uncovered his feet, and laid her down.

softly supposing that 44 ACT 27 13 # And when the south wind blew softly, supposing that they had obtained [their] purpose, loosing [thence], they sailed close by Crete.

softly unto him 07 JUD 04 21 # Then Jael Heber's wife took a nail of the tent, and took an hammer in her hand, and went softly unto him, and smote the nail into his temples, and fastened it into the ground: for he was fast asleep and weary. So he died.
