fellowsoldier and to <u>57\_PHM\_01\_02</u># And to [our] beloved Apphia, and Archippus our fellowsoldier, and to the church in thy house:

fellowsoldier but your <u>50\_PHP\_02\_25</u># Yet I supposed it necessary to send to you Epaphroditus, my brother, and companion in labour, and fellowsoldier, but your messenger, and he that ministered to my wants.

sold a girl 29\_JOE\_03\_03 # And they have cast lots for my people; and have given a boy for an harlot, and sold a girl for wine, that they might drink.

sold a possession <u>44\_ACT\_05\_01</u> # But a certain man named Ananias, with Sapphira his wife, sold a possession,

sold according to <u>03\_LEV\_27\_27</u># And if [it be] of an unclean beast, then he shall redeem [it] according to thine estimation, and shall add a fifth [part] of it thereto: or if it be not redeemed, then it shall be sold according to thy estimation.

sold all that <u>40\_MAT\_13\_46</u># Who, when he had found one pearl of great price, went and sold all that he had, and bought it.

sold although they <u>26\_EZE\_07\_13</u># For the seller shall not return to that which is sold, although they were yet alive: for the vision [is] touching the whole multitude thereof, [which] shall not return; neither shall any strengthen himself in the iniquity of his life.

sold and bought <u>41\_MAR\_11\_15</u># And they come to Jerusalem: and Jesus went into the temple, and began to cast out them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves;

sold and bought <u>40\_MAT\_21\_12</u># And Jesus went into the temple of God, and cast out all them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves,

sold and his <u>40\_MAT\_18\_25</u># But forasmuch as he had not to pay, his lord commanded him to be sold, and his wife, and children, and all that he had, and payment to be made.

sold and the <u>03\_LEV\_25\_33</u> # And if a man purchase of the Levites, then the house that was sold, and the city of his possession, shall go out in [the year of] jubilee: for the houses of the cities of the Levites [are] their possession among the children of Israel.

sold as bondmen <u>03\_LEV\_25\_42</u> # For they [are] my servants, which I brought forth out of the land of Egypt: they shall not be sold as bondmen.

sold away some <u>03\_LEV\_25\_25</u># If thy brother be waxen poor, and hath sold away [some] of his possession, and if any of his kin come to redeem it, then shall he redeem that which his brother sold.

sold doves Take <u>43\_JOH\_02\_16</u> # And said unto them that sold doves, Take these things hence; make not my Father's house an house of merchandise.

sold doves <u>41\_MAR\_11\_15</u># And they come to Jerusalem: and Jesus went into the temple, and began to cast out them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves;

sold doves 40 MAT 21 12 # And Jesus went into the temple of God, and cast out all them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves,

sold every man <u>01\_GEN\_47\_20</u># And Joseph bought all the land of Egypt for Pharaoh; for the Egyptians sold every man his field, because the famine prevailed over them: so the land became Pharaoh's.

sold for a 12\_2KI\_07\_01 # Then Elisha said, Hear ye the word of the LORD; Thus saith the LORD, To morrow about this time [shall] a measure of fine flour [be sold] for a shekel, and two measures of barley for a shekel, in the gate of Samaria.

sold for a <u>12\_2KI\_07\_16</u># And the people went out, and spoiled the tents of the Syrians. So a measure of fine flour was [sold] for a shekel, and two measures of barley for a shekel, according to the word of the LORD.

sold for fourscore 12\_2KI\_06\_25# And there was a great famine in Samaria: and, behold, they besieged it, until an ass's head was [sold] for fourscore [pieces] of silver, and the fourth part of a cab of dove's dung for five [pieces] of silver.

sold for his <u>02\_EXO\_22\_03</u># If the sun be risen upon him, [there shall be] blood [shed] for him; [for] he should make full restitution; if he have nothing, then he shall be sold for his theft.

sold for it <u>03\_LEV\_25\_34</u> # But the field of the suburbs of their cities may not be sold; for it [is] their perpetual possession.

sold for more <u>41\_MAR\_14\_05</u> # For it might have been sold for more than three hundred pence, and have been given to the poor. And they murmured against her.

sold for much 40\_MAT\_26\_09 # For this ointment might have been sold for much, and given to the poor.

sold for three <u>43\_JOH\_12\_05</u># Why was not this ointment sold for three hundred pence, and given to the poor?

sold for two <u>42\_LUK\_12\_06</u># Are not five sparrows sold for two farthings, and not one of them is forgotten before God?

sold he may <u>03\_LEV\_25\_48</u># After that he is sold he may be redeemed again; one of his brethren may redeem him:

sold him into 01\_GEN\_37\_36 # And the Midianites sold him into Egypt unto Potiphar, an officer of

Pharaoh's, [and] captain of the guard.

sold his birthright <u>01\_GEN\_25\_33</u># And Jacob said, Swear to me this day; and he sware unto him: and he sold his birthright unto Jacob.

sold his birthright <u>58\_HEB\_12\_16</u> # Lest there [be] any fornicator, or profane person, as Esau, who for one morsel of meat sold his birthright.

sold I and <u>17\_EST\_07\_04</u># For we are sold, I and my people, to be destroyed, to be slain, and to perish. But if we had been sold for bondmen and bondwomen, I had held my tongue, although the enemy could not countervail the king's damage.

sold in the <u>46\_1CO\_10\_25</u># Whatsoever is sold in the shambles, [that] eat, asking no question for conscience sake:

sold into Egypt <u>01\_GEN\_45\_04</u># And Joseph said unto his brethren, Come near to me, I pray you. And they came near. And he said, I [am] Joseph your brother, whom ye sold into Egypt.

sold it and 44\_ACT\_04\_37 # Having land, sold [it], and brought the money, and laid [it] at the apostles' feet.

sold it that <u>03\_LEV\_25\_27</u> # Then let him count the years of the sale thereof, and restore the overplus unto the man to whom he sold it; that he may return unto his possession.

sold Joseph into <u>44\_ACT\_07\_09</u># And the patriarchs, moved with envy, sold Joseph into Egypt: but God was with him,

sold Joseph to <u>01\_GEN\_37\_28</u> # Then there passed by Midianites merchantmen; and they drew and lifted up Joseph out of the pit, and sold Joseph to the Ishmeelites for twenty [pieces] of silver: and they brought Joseph into Egypt.

sold me hither <u>01\_GEN\_45\_05</u># Now therefore be not grieved, nor angry with yourselves, that ye sold me hither: for God did send me before you to preserve life.

sold not their <u>01\_GEN\_47\_22</u> # Only the land of the priests bought he not; for the priests had a portion [assigned them] of Pharaoh, and did eat their portion which Pharaoh gave them: wherefore they sold not their lands.

sold on the <u>16\_NEH\_13\_16</u># There dwelt men of Tyre also therein, which brought fish, and all manner of ware, and sold on the sabbath unto the children of Judah, and in Jerusalem.

sold or redeemed <u>03\_LEV\_27\_28</u># Notwithstanding no devoted thing, that a man shall devote unto the LORD of all that he hath, [both] of man and beast, and of the field of his possession, shall be sold or redeemed: every devoted thing [is] most holy unto the LORD.

sold oxen and <u>43\_JOH\_02\_14</u> # And found in the temple those that sold oxen and sheep and doves, and the changers of money sitting:

sold shall remain <u>03\_LEV\_25\_28</u># But if he be not able to restore [it] to him, then that which is sold shall remain in the hand of him that hath bought it until the year of jubilee: and in the jubilee it shall go out, and he shall return unto his possession.

sold the field <u>03\_LEV\_27\_20</u># And if he will not redeem the field, or if he have sold the field to another man, it shall not be redeemed any more.

sold the land 44\_ACT\_05\_08 # And Peter answered unto her, Tell me whether ye sold the land for so much?

And she said, Yea, for so much.

sold the righteous <u>30\_AMO\_02\_06</u># Thus saith the LORD; For three transgressions of Israel, and for four, I will not turn away [the punishment] thereof; because they sold the righteous for silver, and the poor for a pair of shoes;

sold their possessions <u>44\_ACT\_02\_45</u># And sold their possessions and goods, and parted them to all [men], as every man had need.

sold them and <u>44\_ACT\_04\_34</u># Neither was there any among them that lacked: for as many as were possessors of lands or houses sold them, and brought the prices of the things that were sold,

sold them and <u>05\_DEU\_32\_30</u># How should one chase a thousand, and two put ten thousand to flight, except their Rock had sold them, and the LORD had shut them up?

sold them and <u>29\_JOE\_03\_07</u> # Behold, I will raise them out of the place whither ye have sold them, and will return your recompense upon your own head:

sold them into <u>09\_1SA\_12\_09</u># And when they forgat the LORD their God, he sold them into the hand of Sisera, captain of the host of Hazor, and into the hand of the Philistines, and into the hand of the king of Moab, and they fought against them.

sold them into <u>07\_JUD\_02\_14</u># And the anger of the LORD was hot against Israel, and he delivered them into the hands of spoilers that spoiled them, and he sold them into the hands of their enemies round about, so that they could not any longer stand before their enemies.

sold them into <u>07\_JUD\_03\_08</u># Therefore the anger of the LORD was hot against Israel, and he sold them into the hand of Chushanrishathaim king of Mesopotamia: and the children of Israel served Chushanrishathaim eight years.

sold them into <u>07\_JUD\_04\_02</u> # And the LORD sold them into the hand of Jabin king of Canaan, that reigned in Hazor; the captain of whose host [was] Sisera, which dwelt in Harosheth of the Gentiles.

sold themselves to <u>12\_2KI\_17\_17</u># And they caused their sons and their daughters to pass through the fire, and used divination and enchantments, and sold themselves to do evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger.

sold therein and <u>42\_LUK\_19\_45</u># And he went into the temple, and began to cast out them that sold therein, and them that bought;

sold they planted <u>42\_LUK\_17\_28</u># Likewise also as it was in the days of Lot; they did eat, they drank, they bought, they sold, they planted, they builded;

sold thyself to 11\_1KI\_21\_20# And Ahab said to Elijah, hast thou found me, O mine enemy? And he answered, I have found [thee]; because thou hast sold thyself to work evil in the sight of the LORD.

sold to all <u>01\_GEN\_42\_06</u># And Joseph [was] the governor over the land, [and] he [it was] that sold to all the people of the land: and Joseph's brethren came, and bowed down themselves before him [with] their faces to the earth.

sold to him <u>03\_LEV\_25\_50</u># And he shall reckon with him that bought him from the year that he was sold to him unto the year of jubilee: and the price of his sale shall be according unto the number of years,

according to the time of an hired servant shall it be with him.

sold under sin 45\_ROM\_07\_14 # For we know that the law is spiritual: but I am carnal, sold under sin.

sold unto the <u>01\_GEN\_41\_56</u># And the famine was over all the face of the earth: And Joseph opened all the storehouses, and sold unto the Egyptians; and the famine waxed sore in the land of Egypt.

sold unto the <u>29\_JOE\_03\_06</u> # The children also of Judah and the children of Jerusalem have ye sold unto the Grecians, that ye might remove them far from their border.

sold unto thee <u>24 JER\_34\_14</u># At the end of seven years let ye go every man his brother an Hebrew, which hath been sold unto thee; and when he hath served thee six years, thou shalt let him go free from thee: but your fathers hearkened not unto me, neither inclined their ear.

sold unto thee <u>03\_LEV\_25\_39</u> # And if thy brother [that dwelleth] by thee be waxen poor, and be sold unto thee; thou shalt not compel him to serve as a bondservant:

sold unto us 25\_LAM\_05\_04 # We have drunken our water for money; our wood is sold unto us.

sold unto us <u>16\_NEH\_05\_08</u> # And I said unto them, We after our ability have redeemed our brethren the Jews, which were sold unto the heathen; and will ye even sell your brethren? or shall they be sold unto us? Then held they their peace, and found nothing [to answer].

sold unto your <u>05\_DEU\_28\_68</u># And the LORD shall bring thee into Egypt again with ships, by the way whereof I spake unto thee, Thou shalt see it no more again: and there ye shall be sold unto your enemies for bondmen and bondwomen, and no man shall buy [you].

sold us and <u>01\_GEN\_31\_15</u> # Are we not counted of him strangers? for he hath sold us, and hath quite devoured also our money.

sold victuals 16\_NEH\_13\_15 # In those days saw I in Judah [some] treading wine presses on the sabbath, and bringing in sheaves, and lading asses; as also wine, grapes, and figs, and all [manner of] burdens, which they brought into Jerusalem on the sabbath day: and I testified [against them] in the day wherein they sold victuals.

sold yourselves for <u>23\_ISA\_52\_03</u># For thus saith the LORD, Ye have sold yourselves for nought; and ye shall be redeemed without money.

sold <u>44\_ACT\_04\_34</u> # Neither was there any among them that lacked: for as many as were possessors of lands or houses sold them, and brought the prices of the things that were sold,

sold <u>03\_LEV\_25\_25</u> # If thy brother be waxen poor, and hath sold away [some] of his possession, and if any of his kin come to redeem it, then shall he redeem that which his brother sold.

soldering and he <u>23\_ISA\_41\_07</u> # So the carpenter encouraged the goldsmith, [and] he that smootheth [with] the hammer him that smote the anvil, saying, It [is] ready for the soldering: and he fastened it with nails, [that] it should not be moved.

soldier a part <u>43\_JOH\_19\_23</u># Then the soldiers, when they had crucified Jesus, took his garments, and made four parts, to every soldier a part; and also [his] coat: now the coat was without seam, woven from the top throughout.

soldier of Jesus 55\_2TI\_02\_03 # Thou therefore endure hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ.

soldier of them <u>44\_ACT\_10\_07</u> # And when the angel which spake unto Cornelius was departed, he called two of his household servants, and a devout soldier of them that waited on him continually;

soldier that kept <u>44\_ACT\_28\_16</u> # And when we came to Rome, the centurion delivered the prisoners to the captain of the guard: but Paul was suffered to dwell by himself with a soldier that kept him.

soldier <u>55\_2TI\_02\_04</u> # No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of [this] life; that he may please him who hath chosen him to be a soldier.

soldiers also mocked <u>42\_LUK\_23\_36</u># And the soldiers also mocked him, coming to him, and offering him vinegar,

soldiers and brake 43\_JOH\_19\_32 # Then came the soldiers, and brake the legs of the first, and of the other which was crucified with him.

soldiers and centurions <u>44\_ACT\_21\_32</u> # Who immediately took soldiers and centurions, and ran down unto them: and when they saw the chief captain and the soldiers, they left beating of Paul.

soldiers and horsemen <u>15\_EZR\_08\_22</u> # For I was ashamed to require of the king a band of soldiers and horsemen to help us against the enemy in the way: because we had spoken unto the king, saying, The hand of our God [is] upon all them for good that seek him; but his power and his wrath [is] against all them that forsake him.

soldiers and I <u>42\_LUK\_07\_08</u># For I also am a man set under authority, having under me soldiers, and I say unto one, Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth [it].

soldiers as it <u>44\_ACT\_23\_31</u># Then the soldiers, as it was commanded them, took Paul, and brought [him] by night to Antipatris.

soldiers bound with <u>44\_ACT\_12\_06</u># And when Herod would have brought him forth, the same night Peter was sleeping between two soldiers, bound with two chains: and the keepers before the door kept the prison.

soldiers counsel was <u>44\_ACT\_27\_42</u># And the soldiers' counsel was to kill the prisoners, lest any of them should swim out, and escape.

soldiers cut off 44 ACT 27 32 # Then the soldiers cut off the ropes of the boat, and let her fall off.

soldiers did <u>43\_JOH\_19\_24</u> # They said therefore among themselves, Let us not rend it, but cast lots for it, whose it shall be: that the scripture might be fulfilled, which saith, They parted my raiment among them, and for my vesture they did cast lots. These things therefore the soldiers did.

soldiers Except these <u>44\_ACT\_27\_31</u> # Paul said to the centurion and to the soldiers, Except these abide in the ship, ye cannot be saved.

soldiers fit to 13\_1CH\_07\_11# All these the sons of Jediael, by the heads of their fathers, mighty men of valour, [were] seventeen thousand and two hundred [soldiers], fit to go out for war [and] battle.

soldiers for the <u>44\_ACT\_21\_35</u># And when he came upon the stairs, so it was, that he was borne of the soldiers for the violence of the people.

soldiers for war 13\_1CH\_07\_04 # And with them, by their generations, after the house of their fathers, [were] bands of soldiers for war, six and thirty thousand [men]: for they had many wives and sons.

soldiers led him <u>41\_MAR\_15\_16</u># And the soldiers led him away into the hall, called Praetorium; and they call together the whole band.

soldiers likewise demanded <u>42 LUK\_03\_14</u># And the soldiers likewise demanded of him, saying, And what shall we do? And he said unto them, Do violence to no man, neither accuse [any] falsely; and be content with your wages.

soldiers of Moab <u>23\_ISA\_15\_04</u> # And Heshbon shall cry, and Elealeh: their voice shall be heard [even] unto Jahaz: therefore the armed soldiers of Moab shall cry out; his life shall be grievous unto him.

soldiers when they <u>43\_JOH\_19\_23</u># Then the soldiers, when they had crucified Jesus, took his garments, and made four parts, to every soldier a part; and also [his] coat: now the coat was without seam, woven from the top throughout.

soldiers with a <u>43\_JOH\_19\_34</u> # But one of the soldiers with a spear pierced his side, and forthwith came there out blood and water.

soldiers <u>40\_MAT\_27\_27</u># Then the soldiers of the governor took Jesus into the common hall, and gathered unto him the whole band [of soldiers].

soldiers <u>40\_MAT\_28\_12</u># And when they were assembled with the elders, and had taken counsel, they gave large money unto the soldiers,
