somewhat against any [03 LEV 04 13](#) # And if the whole congregation of Israel sin through ignorance, and the thing be hid from the eyes of the assembly, and they have done [somewhat against] any of the commandments of the LORD [concerning things] which should not be done, and are guilty;

somewhat against any [03 LEV 04 27](#) # And if any one of the common people sin through ignorance, while he doeth [somewhat against] any of the commandments of the LORD [concerning things] which ought not to be done, and be guilty;

somewhat against thee [66 REV 02 04](#) # Nevertheless I have [somewhat] against thee, because thou hast left thy first love.

somewhat also to [58 HEB 08 03](#) # For every high priest is ordained to offer gifts and sacrifices: wherefore [it is] of necessity that this man have somewhat also to offer.

somewhat dark after [03 LEV 13 56](#) # And if the priest look, and, behold, the plague [be] somewhat dark after the washing of it; then he shall rend it out of the garment, or out of the skin, or out of the warp, or out of the woof:

somewhat dark and [03 LEV 13 06](#) # And the priest shall look on him again the seventh day: and, behold, [if] the plague [be] somewhat dark, [and] the plague spread not in the skin, the priest shall pronounce him clean: it [is but] a scab: and he shall wash his clothes, and be clean.

somewhat dark it [03 LEV 13 28](#) # And if the bright spot stay in his place, [and] spread not in the skin, but it [be] somewhat dark; it [is] a rising of the burning, and the priest shall pronounce him clean: for it [is] an inflammation of the burning.

somewhat dark then [03 LEV 13 21](#) # But if the priest look on it, and, behold, [there be] no white hairs therein, and [if] it [be] not lower than the skin, but [be] somewhat dark; then the priest shall shut him up seven days:

somewhat dark then [03 LEV 13 26](#) # But if the priest look on it, and, behold, [there be] no white hair in the bright spot, and it [be] no lower than the [other] skin, but [be] somewhat dark; then the priest shall shut him up seven days:

somewhat filled with [45 ROM 15 24](#) # Whosoever I take my journey into Spain, I will come to you: for I trust to see you in my journey, and to be brought on my way thitherward by you, if first I be somewhat filled with your [company].

somewhat in conference [48 GAL 02 06](#) # But of these who seemed to be somewhat, [whatsoever they were, it maketh no matter to me: God accepteth no man's person:] for they who seemed [to be somewhat] in conference added nothing to me:

somewhat lighter for [14 2CH 10 10](#) # And the young men that were brought up with him spake unto him, saying, Thus shalt thou answer the people that spake unto thee, saying, Thy father made our yoke heavy, but make thou [it] somewhat lighter for us; thus shalt thou say unto them, My little [finger] shall be thicker than my father's loins.

somewhat more of [47 2CO 10 08](#) # For though I should boast somewhat more of our authority, which the Lord hath given us for edification, and not for your destruction, I should not be ashamed:

somewhat of him [12 2KI 05 20](#) # But Gehazi, the servant of Elisha the man of God, said, Behold, my master hath spared Naaman this Syrian, in not receiving at his hands that which he brought: but, [as] the LORD liveth, I will run after him, and take somewhat of him.

somewhat of him [44 ACT 23 20](#) # And he said, The Jews have agreed to desire thee that thou wouldest bring down Paul to morrow into the council, as though they would inquire somewhat of him more perfectly.

somewhat reddish and [03 LEV 13 19](#) # And in the place of the boil there be a white rising, or a bright spot, white, and somewhat reddish, and it be showed to the priest;

somewhat reddish or [03 LEV 13 24](#) # Or if there be [any] flesh, in the skin whereof [there is] a hot burning, and the quick [flesh] that burneth have a white bright spot, somewhat reddish, or white;

somewhat the grievous [14 2CH 10 04](#) # Thy father made our yoke grievous: now therefore ease thou somewhat the grievous servitude of thy father, and his heavy yoke that he put upon us, and we will serve thee.

somewhat the yoke [14 2CH 10 09](#) # And he said unto them, What advice give ye that we may return answer to this people, which have spoken to me, saying, Ease somewhat the yoke that thy father did put upon us?

somewhat through ignorance [03 LEV 04 22](#) # When a ruler hath sinned, and done [somewhat] through ignorance [against] any of the commandments of the LORD his God [concerning things] which should not be done, and is guilty;

somewhat to answer [47 2CO 05 12](#) # For we commend not ourselves again unto you, but give you occasion to glory on our behalf, that ye may have somewhat to [answer] them which glory in appearance, and not in heart.

somewhat to say [11 1KI 02 14](#) # He said moreover, I have somewhat to say unto thee. And she said, Say on.

somewhat to say [42 LUK 07 40](#) # And Jesus answering said unto him, Simon, I have somewhat to say unto thee. And he saith, Master, say on.

somewhat to write [44 ACT 25 26](#) # Of whom I have no certain thing to write unto my lord. Wherefore I have brought him forth before you, and specially before thee, O king Agrippa, that, after examination had, I might have somewhat to write.
