sound a trumpet <u>40_MAT_06_02</u># Therefore when thou doest [thine] alms, do not sound a trumpet before thee, as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and in the streets, that they may have glory of men. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward.

sound an alarm <u>29_JOE_02_01</u> # Blow ye the trumpet in Zion, and sound an alarm in my holy mountain: let all the inhabitants of the land tremble: for the day of the LORD cometh, for [it is] nigh at hand;

sound an alarm <u>04_NUM_10_07</u># But when the congregation is to be gathered together, ye shall blow, but ye shall not sound an alarm.

sound and the <u>46_1CO_15_52</u> # In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

sound and with <u>13_1CH_16_42</u> # And with them Heman and Jeduthun with trumpets and cymbals for those that should make a sound, and with musical instruments of God. And the sons of Jeduthun [were] porters.

sound doctrine both <u>56_TIT_01_09</u> # Holding fast the faithful word as he hath been taught, that he may be able by sound doctrine both to exhort and to convince the gainsayers.

sound doctrine but <u>55_2TI_04_03</u># For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears;

sound doctrine <u>54_1TI_01_10</u> # For whoremongers, for them that defile themselves with mankind, for menstealers, for liars, for perjured persons, and if there be any other thing that is contrary to sound doctrine;

sound doctrine <u>56_TIT_02_01</u># But speak thou the things which become sound doctrine:

sound for Moab <u>24_JER_48_36</u> # Therefore mine heart shall sound for Moab like pipes, and mine heart shall sound like pipes for the men of Kirheres: because the riches [that] he hath gotten are perished.

sound from heaven <u>44_ACT_02_02</u> # And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting.

sound heart is <u>20_PRO_14_30</u> # A sound heart [is] the life of the flesh: but envy the rottenness of the bones.

sound in faith <u>56_TIT_02_02</u> # That the aged men be sober, grave, temperate, sound in faith, in charity, in patience.

sound in the <u>56_TIT_01_13</u># This witness is true. Wherefore rebuke them sharply, that they may be sound in the faith;

sound in thy <u>19_PSA_119_80</u># Let my heart be sound in thy statutes; that I be not ashamed.

sound is in <u>18_JOB_15_21</u> # A dreadful sound [is] in his ears: in prosperity the destroyer shall come upon him.

sound like an <u>23_ISA_16_11</u># Wherefore my bowels shall sound like an harp for Moab, and mine inward parts for Kirharesh.

sound like pipes <u>24_JER_48_36</u># Therefore mine heart shall sound for Moab like pipes, and mine heart shall sound like pipes for the men of Kirheres: because the riches [that] he hath gotten are perished.

sound mind <u>55_2TI_01_07</u># For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

sound of a <u>10_2SA_05_24</u># And let it be, when thou hearest the sound of a going in the tops of the mulberry trees, that then thou shalt bestir thyself: for then shall the LORD go out before thee, to smite the host of the Philistines.

sound of a <u>58_HEB_12_19</u> # And the sound of a trumpet, and the voice of words; which [voice] they that heard entreated that the word should not be spoken to them any more:

sound of a <u>24_JER_51_54</u># A sound of a cry [cometh] from Babylon, and great destruction from the land of the Chaldeans:

sound of a <u>03_LEV_26_36</u> # And upon them that are left [alive] of you I will send a faintness into their hearts in the lands of their enemies; and the sound of a shaken leaf shall chase them; and they shall flee, as fleeing from a sword; and they shall fall when none pursueth.

sound of a <u>40_MAT_24_31</u># And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.

sound of a <u>19_PSA_47_05</u># God is gone up with a shout, the LORD with the sound of a trumpet.

sound of a <u>66_REV_18_22</u># And the voice of harpers, and musicians, and of pipers, and trumpeters, shall be heard no more at all in thee; and no craftsman, of whatsoever craft [he be], shall be found any more in thee; and the sound of a millstone shall be heard no more at all in thee;

sound of abundance <u>11_1KI_18_41</u># And Elijah said unto Ahab, Get thee up, eat and drink; for [there is] a sound of abundance of rain.

sound of battle <u>24_JER_50_22</u> # A sound of battle [is] in the land, and of great destruction.

sound of chariots <u>66_REV_09_09</u># And they had breastplates, as it were breastplates of iron; and the sound of their wings [was] as the sound of chariots of many horses running to battle.

sound of cornet <u>19_PSA_98_06</u># With trumpets and sound of cornet make a joyful noise before the LORD, the King.

sound of going <u>13_1CH_14_15</u> # And it shall be, when thou shalt hear a sound of going in the tops of the mulberry trees, [that] then thou shalt go out to battle: for God is gone forth before thee to smite the host of the Philistines.

sound of her <u>11_1KI_14_06</u># And it was [so], when Ahijah heard the sound of her feet, as she came in at the door, that he said, Come in, thou wife of Jeroboam; why feignest thou thyself [to be] another? for I [am] sent to thee [with] heavy [tidings].

sound of his <u>12_2KI_06_32</u># But Elisha sat in his house, and the elders sat with him; and [the king] sent a man from before him: but ere the messenger came to him, he said to the elders, See ye how this son of a murderer hath sent to take away mine head? look, when the messenger cometh, shut the door, and hold him fast at the door: [is] not the sound of his master's feet behind him?

sound of his <u>26_EZE_31_16</u># I made the nations to shake at the sound of his fall, when I cast him down to hell with them that descend into the pit: and all the trees of Eden, the choice and best of Lebanon, all that drink water, shall be comforted in the nether parts of the earth.

sound of many <u>66_REV_01_15</u># And his feet like unto fine brass, as if they burned in a furnace; and his voice as the sound of many waters.

sound of the <u>13_1CH_15_28</u># Thus all Israel brought up the ark of the covenant of the LORD with shouting, and with sound of the cornet, and with trumpets, and with cymbals, making a noise with psalteries and harps.

sound of the <u>11_1KI_01_41</u># And Adonijah and all the guests that [were] with him heard [it] as they had made an end of eating. And when Joab heard the sound of the trumpet, he said, Wherefore [is this] noise of the city being in an uproar?

sound of the <u>10_2SA_06_15</u># So David and all the house of Israel brought up the ark of the LORD with shouting, and with the sound of the trumpet.

sound of the <u>10_2SA_15_10</u># But Absalom sent spies throughout all the tribes of Israel, saying, As soon as ye hear the sound of the trumpet, then ye shall say, Absalom reigneth in Hebron.

sound of the <u>30_AMO_02_02</u> # But I will send a fire upon Moab, and it shall devour the palaces of Kirioth: and Moab shall die with tumult, with shouting, [and] with the sound of the trumpet:

sound of the <u>30_AMO_06_05</u># That chant to the sound of the viol, [and] invent to themselves instruments of music, like David;

sound of the <u>27_DAN_03_05</u> # [That] at what time ye hear the sound of the cornet, flute, harp, sackbut, psaltery, dulcimer, and all kinds of music, ye fall down and worship the golden image that Nebuchadnezzar the king hath set up:

sound of the <u>27_DAN_03_07</u> # Therefore at that time, when all the people heard the sound of the cornet, flute, harp, sackbut, psaltery, and all kinds of music, all the people, the nations, and the languages, fell down [and] worshipped the golden image that Nebuchadnezzar the king had set up.

sound of the <u>27_DAN_03_10</u> # Thou, O king, hast made a decree, that every man that shall hear the sound of the cornet, flute, harp, sackbut, psaltery, and dulcimer, and all kinds of music, shall fall down and worship the golden image:

sound of the <u>27_DAN_03_15</u> # Now if ye be ready that at what time ye hear the sound of the cornet, flute, harp, sackbut, psaltery, and dulcimer, and all kinds of music, ye fall down and worship the image which I have made; [well]: but if ye worship not, ye shall be cast the same hour into the midst of a burning fiery furnace; and who [is] that God that shall deliver you out of my hands?

sound of the <u>21_ECC_12_04</u> # And the doors shall be shut in the streets, when the sound of the grinding is low, and he shall rise up at the voice of the bird, and all the daughters of music shall be brought low;

sound of the <u>26_EZE_10_05</u># And the sound of the cherubims' wings was heard [even] to the outer court, as the voice of the Almighty God when he speaketh.

sound of the <u>26_EZE_27_28</u> # The suburbs shall shake at the sound of the cry of thy pilots.

sound of the <u>26_EZE_33_04</u># Then whosoever heareth the sound of the trumpet, and taketh not warning; if the sword come, and take him away, his blood shall be upon his own head.

sound of the <u>26_EZE_33_05</u> # He heard the sound of the trumpet, and took not warning; his blood shall be upon him. But he that taketh warning shall deliver his soul.

sound of the <u>24_JER_04_19</u># My bowels, my bowels! I am pained at my very heart; my heart maketh a noise in me; I cannot hold my peace, because thou hast heard, O my soul, the sound of the trumpet, the alarm of war.

sound of the <u>24_JER_04_21</u> # How long shall I see the standard, [and] hear the sound of the trumpet?

sound of the <u>24_JER_06_17</u># Also I set watchmen over you, [saying], Hearken to the sound of the trumpet. But they said, We will not hearken.

sound of the <u>24_JER_08_16</u> # The snorting of his horses was heard from Dan: the whole land trembled at the sound of the neighing of his strong ones; for they are come, and have devoured the land, and all that is in it; the city, and those that dwell therein.

sound of the <u>24_JER_25_10</u># Moreover I will take from them the voice of mirth, and the voice of gladness, the voice of the bridegroom, and the voice of the bride, the sound of the millstones, and the light of the candle.

sound of the <u>24_JER_42_14</u># Saying, No; but we will go into the land of Egypt, where we shall see no war, nor hear the sound of the trumpet, nor have hunger of bread; and there will we dwell:

sound of the <u>18_JOB_21_12</u># They take the timbrel and harp, and rejoice at the sound of the organ.

sound of the <u>18_JOB_39_24</u># He swalloweth the ground with fierceness and rage: neither believeth he that [it is] the sound of the trumpet.

sound of the <u>06_JOS_06_05</u> # And it shall come to pass, that when they make a long [blast] with the ram's horn, [and] when ye hear the sound of the trumpet, all the people shall shout with a great shout; and the wall of the city shall fall down flat, and the people shall ascend up every man straight before him.

sound of the <u>06_JOS_06_20</u># So the people shouted when [the priests] blew with the trumpets: and it came to pass, when the people heard the sound of the trumpet, and the people shouted with a great shout, that the wall fell down flat, so that the people went up into the city, every man straight before him, and they took the city.

sound of the <u>16_NEH_04_20</u> # In what place [therefore] ye hear the sound of the trumpet, resort ye thither unto us: our God shall fight for us.

sound of the <u>19_PSA_150_03</u># Praise him with the sound of the trumpet: praise him with the psaltery and harp.

sound of their <u>66_REV_09_09</u># And they had breastplates, as it were breastplates of iron; and the sound of their wings [was] as the sound of chariots of many horses running to battle.

sound of them <u>11_1KI_01_40</u># And all the people came up after him, and the people piped with pipes, and rejoiced with great joy, so that the earth rent with the sound of them.

sound of thy <u>26_EZE_26_13</u> # And I will cause the noise of thy songs to cease; and the sound of thy harps shall be no more heard.

sound of thy <u>26_EZE_26_15</u># Thus saith the Lord GOD to Tyrus; Shall not the isles shake at the sound of thy fall, when the wounded cry, when the slaughter is made in the midst of thee?

sound on the <u>03_LEV_25_09</u># Then shalt thou cause the trumpet of the jubilee to sound on the tenth [day] of the seventh month, in the day of atonement shall ye make the trumpet sound throughout all your land.

sound shall be <u>02_EXO_28_35</u> # And it shall be upon Aaron to minister: and his sound shall be heard when he goeth in unto the holy [place] before the LORD, and when he cometh out, that he die not.

Sound speech that <u>56_TIT_02_08</u># Sound speech, that cannot be condemned; that he that is of the contrary part may be ashamed, having no evil thing to say of you.

sound that goeth <u>18_JOB_37_02</u> # Hear attentively the noise of his voice, and the sound [that] goeth out of his mouth.

sound the mystery <u>66_REV_10_07</u> # But in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he shall begin to sound, the mystery of God should be finished, as he hath declared to his servants the prophets.

sound thereof but <u>43_JOH_03_08</u># The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit.

sound they shall <u>19_PSA_89_15</u># Blessed [is] the people that know the joyful sound: they shall walk, O LORD, in the light of thy countenance.

sound thine arrows <u>19_PSA_77_17</u># The clouds poured out water: the skies sent out a sound: thine arrows also went abroad.

sound throughout all <u>03_LEV_25_09</u> # Then shalt thou cause the trumpet of the jubilee to sound on the tenth [day] of the seventh month, in the day of atonement shall ye make the trumpet sound throughout all your land.

sound to be <u>14_2CH_05_13</u> # It came even to pass, as the trumpeters and singers [were] as one, to make one sound to be heard in praising and thanking the LORD; and when they lifted up [their] voice with the trumpets and cymbals and instruments of music, and praised the LORD, [saying], For [he is] good; for his mercy [endureth] for ever: that [then] the house was filled with a cloud, [even] the house of the LORD;

sound went into <u>45_ROM_10_18</u> # But I say, Have they not heard? Yes verily, their sound went into all the earth, and their words unto the ends of the world.

sound whether pipe <u>46_1CO_14_07</u> # And even things without life giving sound, whether pipe or harp, except they give a distinction in the sounds, how shall it be known what is piped or harped?

sound who shall <u>46_1CO_14_08</u># For if the trumpet give an uncertain sound, who shall prepare himself to the battle?

sound wisdom and <u>20_PRO_03_21</u># My son, let not them depart from thine eyes: keep sound wisdom and discretion:

sound wisdom for <u>20_PRO_02_07</u># He layeth up sound wisdom for the righteous: [he is] a buckler to them that walk uprightly.

sound wisdom I <u>20_PRO_08_14</u> # Counsel [is] mine, and sound wisdom: I [am] understanding; I have strength.

sound with cymbals <u>13_1CH_15_19</u># So the singers, Heman, Asaph, and Ethan, [were appointed] to sound with cymbals of brass;

sound with cymbals <u>13_1CH_16_05</u> # Asaph the chief, and next to him Zechariah, Jeiel, and Shemiramoth, and Jehiel, and Mattithiah, and Eliab, and Benaiah, and Obededom: and Jeiel with psalteries and with harps; but Asaph made a sound with cymbals;

sound words which <u>55_2TI_01_13</u># Hold fast the form of sound words, which thou hast heard of me, in faith and love which is in Christ Jesus.

sound <u>42_LUK_15_27</u> # And he said unto him, Thy brother is come; and thy father hath killed the fatted calf, because he hath received him safe and sound.

sound <u>19_PSA_92_03</u> # Upon an instrument of ten strings, and upon the psaltery; upon the harp with a solemn sound.

sound <u>66_REV_08_06</u> # And the seven angels which had the seven trumpets prepared themselves to sound.

sound <u>66_REV_08_13</u># And I beheld, and heard an angel flying through the midst of heaven, saying with a loud voice, Woe, woe, woe, to the inhabiters of the earth by reason of the other voices of the trumpet of the three angels, which are yet to sound!

sounded again and <u>44_ACT_27_28</u># And sounded, and found [it] twenty fathoms: and when they had gone a little further, they sounded again, and found [it] fifteen fathoms.

sounded and all <u>14_2CH_29_28</u># And all the congregation worshipped, and the singers sang, and the trumpeters sounded: [and] all [this continued] until the burnt offering was finished.

sounded and as <u>66_REV_08_08</u> # And the second angel sounded, and as it were a great mountain burning with fire was cast into the sea: and the third part of the sea became blood;

sounded and found <u>44_ACT_27_28</u># And sounded, and found [it] twenty fathoms: and when they had gone a little further, they sounded again, and found [it] fifteen fathoms.

sounded and I <u>66_REV_09_01</u># And the fifth angel sounded, and I saw a star fall from heaven unto the earth: and to him was given the key of the bottomless pit.

sounded and I <u>66_REV_09_13</u># And the sixth angel sounded, and I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar which is before God,

sounded and the <u>66_REV_08_12</u> # And the fourth angel sounded, and the third part of the sun was smitten, and the third part of the moon, and the third part of the stars; so as the third part of them was darkened, and the day shone not for a third part of it, and the night likewise.

sounded and there <u>66_REV_08_07</u> # The first angel sounded, and there followed hail and fire mingled with blood, and they were cast upon the earth: and the third part of trees was burnt up, and all green grass was burnt up.

sounded and there <u>66_REV_08_10</u> # And the third angel sounded, and there fell a great star from heaven, burning as it were a lamp, and it fell upon the third part of the rivers, and upon the fountains of waters;

sounded and there <u>66_REV_11_15</u># And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become [the kingdoms] of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever.

sounded in mine <u>42_LUK_01_44</u> # For, lo, as soon as the voice of thy salutation sounded in mine ears, the babe leaped in my womb for joy.

sounded long and <u>02_EXO_19_19</u># And when the voice of the trumpet sounded long, and waxed louder and louder, Moses spake, and God answered him by a voice.

sounded my father <u>09_1SA_20_12</u># And Jonathan said unto David, O LORD God of Israel, when I have sounded my father about to morrow any time, [or] the third [day], and, behold, [if there be] good toward David, and I then send not unto thee, and show it thee;

sounded out the <u>52_1TH_01_08</u> # For from you sounded out the word of the Lord not only in Macedonia and Achaia, but also in every place your faith to God ward is spread abroad; so that we need not to speak any thing.

sounded the trumpet <u>16_NEH_04_18</u> # For the builders, every one had his sword girded by his side, and [so] builded. And he that sounded the trumpet [was] by me.

sounded trumpets before <u>14_2CH_07_06</u> # And the priests waited on their offices: the Levites also with instruments of music of the LORD, which David the king had made to praise the LORD, because his mercy [endureth] for ever, when David praised by their ministry; and the priests sounded trumpets before them, and all Israel stood.

sounded with the <u>14_2CH_13_14</u># And when Judah looked back, behold, the battle [was] before and behind: and they cried unto the LORD, and the priests sounded with the trumpets.

sounded with trumpets <u>14_2CH_23_13</u> # And she looked, and, behold, the king stood at his pillar at the entering in, and the princes and the trumpets by the king: and all the people of the land rejoiced, and sounded with trumpets, also the singers with instruments of music, and such as taught to sing praise. Then Athaliah rent her clothes, and said, Treason, Treason.

soundeth long they <u>02_EXO_19_13</u># There shall not an hand touch it, but he shall surely be stoned, or shot through; whether [it be] beast or man, it shall not live: when the trumpet soundeth long, they shall come up to the mount.

sounding again of <u>26_EZE_07_07</u># The morning is come unto thee, O thou that dwellest in the land: the time is come, the day of trouble [is] near, and not the sounding again of the mountains.

sounding brass or <u>46_1CO_13_01</u># Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, and have not charity, I am become [as] sounding brass, or a tinkling cymbal.

sounding by lifting <u>13_1CH_15_16</u># And David spake to the chief of the Levites to appoint their brethren [to be] the singers with instruments of music, psalteries and harps and cymbals, sounding, by lifting up the voice with joy.

sounding cymbals <u>19_PSA_150_05</u># Praise him upon the loud cymbals: praise him upon the high sounding cymbals.

sounding of thy <u>23_ISA_63_15</u> # Look down from heaven, and behold from the habitation of thy holiness and of thy glory: where [is] thy zeal and thy strength, the sounding of thy bowels and of thy mercies toward me? are they restrained?

sounding trumpets to <u>14_2CH_13_12</u> # And, behold, God himself [is] with us for [our] captain, and his priests with sounding trumpets to cry alarm against you. O children of Israel, fight ye not against the LORD God of your fathers; for ye shall not prosper.

sounding with trumpets <u>14_2CH_05_12</u> # Also the Levites [which were] the singers, all of them of Asaph, of Heman, of Jeduthun, with their sons and their brethren, [being] arrayed in white linen, having cymbals and psalteries and harps, stood at the east end of the altar, and with them an hundred and twenty priests

sounding with trumpets:]

soundness in it <u>23_ISA_01_06</u># From the sole of the foot even unto the head [there is] no soundness in it; [but] wounds, and bruises, and putrifying sores: they have not been closed, neither bound up, neither mollified with ointment.

soundness in my <u>19_PSA_38_03</u># [There is] no soundness in my flesh because of thine anger; neither [is there any] rest in my bones because of my sin.

soundness in my <u>19_PSA_38_07</u># For my loins are filled with a loathsome [disease]: and [there is] no soundness in my flesh.

soundness in the <u>44_ACT_03_16</u> # And his name through faith in his name hath made this man strong, whom ye see and know: yea, the faith which is by him hath given him this perfect soundness in the presence of you all.

sounds how shall <u>46_1CO_14_07</u> # And even things without life giving sound, whether pipe or harp, except they give a distinction in the sounds, how shall it be known what is piped or harped?
