sour grape and <u>24\_JER\_31\_29</u># In those days they shall say no more, The fathers have eaten a sour grape, and the children's teeth are set on edge.

sour grape his <u>24\_JER\_31\_30</u> # But every one shall die for his own iniquity: every man that eateth the sour grape, his teeth shall be set on edge.

sour grape is <u>23\_ISA\_18\_05</u># For afore the harvest, when the bud is perfect, and the sour grape is ripening in the flower, he shall both cut off the sprigs with pruning hooks, and take away [and] cut down the branches.

sour grapes and <u>26\_EZE\_18\_02</u> # What mean ye, that ye use this proverb concerning the land of Israel, saying, The fathers have eaten sour grapes, and the children's teeth are set on edge?

sour they have <u>28\_HOS\_04\_18</u># Their drink is sour: they have committed whoredom continually: her rulers [with] shame do love, Give ye.
