spare all the <u>01\_GEN\_18\_26</u># And the LORD said, If I find in Sodom fifty righteous within the city, then I will spare all the place for their sakes.

spare and I <u>42\_LUK\_15\_17</u> # And when he came to himself, he said, How many hired servants of my father's have bread enough and to spare, and I perish with hunger!

spare children <u>23\_ISA\_13\_18</u> # [Their] bows also shall dash the young men to pieces; and they shall have no pity on the fruit of the womb; their eye shall not spare children.

spare continually to <u>35\_HAB\_01\_17</u># Shall they therefore empty their net, and not spare continually to slay the nations?

spare for his 20\_PRO\_19\_18 # Chasten thy son while there is hope, and let not thy soul spare for his crying.

spare for I <u>18\_JOB\_06\_10</u> # Then should I yet have comfort; yea, I would harden myself in sorrow: let him not spare; for I have not concealed the words of the Holy One.

spare he poureth <u>18\_JOB\_16\_13</u># His archers compass me round about, he cleaveth my reins asunder, and doth not spare; he poureth out my gall upon the ground.

spare he would <u>18\_JOB\_27\_22</u># For [God] shall cast upon him, and not spare: he would fain flee out of his hand.

spare him but <u>05\_DEU\_29\_20</u> # The LORD will not spare him, but then the anger of the LORD and his jealousy shall smoke against that man, and all the curses that are written in this book shall lie upon him, and the LORD shall blot out his name from under heaven.

spare his brother <u>23 ISA 09 19</u> # Through the wrath of the LORD of hosts is the land darkened, and the people shall be as the fuel of the fire: no man shall spare his brother.

spare in the <u>20\_PRO\_06\_34</u># For jealousy [is] the rage of a man: therefore he will not spare in the day of vengeance.

spare it and <u>18\_JOB\_20\_13</u> # [Though] he spare it, and forsake it not; but keep it still within his mouth:

spare me according <u>16\_NEH\_13\_22</u> # And I commanded the Levites that they should cleanse themselves, and [that] they should come [and] keep the gates, to sanctify the sabbath day. Remember me, O my God, [concerning] this also, and spare me according to the greatness of thy mercy.

spare me that <u>19\_PSA\_39\_13</u> # O spare me, that I may recover strength, before I go hence, and be no more.

spare neither have <u>26\_EZE\_09\_05</u># And to the others he said in mine hearing, Go ye after him through the city, and smite: let not your eye spare, neither have ye pity:

spare neither shalt <u>05\_DEU\_13\_08</u># Thou shalt not consent unto him, nor hearken unto him; neither shall thine eye pity him, neither shalt thou spare, neither shalt thou conceal him:

spare neither will <u>26\_EZE\_05\_11</u># Wherefore, [as] I live, saith the Lord GOD; Surely, because thou hast 1/19/2022

defiled my sanctuary with all thy detestable things, and with all thine abominations, therefore will I also diminish [thee]; neither shall mine eye spare, neither will I have any pity.

spare neither will <u>26\_EZE\_07\_09</u># And mine eye shall not spare, neither will I have pity: I will recompense thee according to thy ways and thine abominations [that] are in the midst of thee; and ye shall know that I [am] the LORD that smiteth.

spare neither will <u>26\_EZE\_08\_18</u># Therefore will I also deal in fury: mine eye shall not spare, neither will I have pity: and though they cry in mine ears with a loud voice, [yet] will I not hear them.

spare neither will <u>26\_EZE\_09\_10</u> # And as for me also, mine eye shall not spare, neither will I have pity, [but] I will recompense their way upon their head.

spare neither will <u>26\_EZE\_24\_14</u> # I the LORD have spoken [it]: it shall come to pass, and I will do [it]; I will not go back, neither will I spare, neither will I repent; according to thy ways, and according to thy doings, shall they judge thee, saith the Lord GOD.

spare Nineveh that <u>32\_JON\_04\_11</u># And should not I spare Nineveh, that great city, wherein are more than sixscore thousand persons that cannot discern between their right hand and their left hand; and [also] much cattle?

spare no arrows <u>24\_JER\_50\_14</u> # Put yourselves in array against Babylon round about: all ye that bend the bow, shoot at her, spare no arrows: for she hath sinned against the LORD.

spare nor have <u>24\_JER\_13\_14</u> # And I will dash them one against another, even the fathers and the sons together, saith the LORD: I will not pity, nor spare, nor have mercy, but destroy them.

spare not lengthen <u>23\_ISA\_54\_02</u># Enlarge the place of thy tent, and let them stretch forth the curtains of thine habitations: spare not, lengthen thy cords, and strengthen thy stakes;

spare not lift <u>23\_ISA\_58\_01</u> # Cry aloud, spare not, lift up thy voice like a trumpet, and show my people their transgression, and the house of Jacob their sins.

spare not thee <u>45\_ROM\_11\_21</u># For if God spared not the natural branches, [take heed] lest he also spare not thee.

spare not to <u>18\_JOB\_30\_10</u># They abhor me, they flee far from me, and spare not to spit in my face.

spare so that <u>23\_ISA\_30\_14</u> # And he shall break it as the breaking of the potters' vessel that is broken in pieces; he shall not spare: so that there shall not be found in the bursting of it a sherd to take fire from the hearth, or to take water [withal] out of the pit.

spare the place <u>01\_GEN\_18\_24</u> # Peradventure there be fifty righteous within the city: wilt thou also destroy and not spare the place for the fifty righteous that [are] therein?

spare the poor <u>19\_PSA\_72\_13</u> # He shall spare the poor and needy, and shall save the souls of the needy.

spare thee neither <u>26\_EZE\_07\_04</u># And mine eye shall not spare thee, neither will I have pity: but I will recompense thy ways upon thee, and thine abominations shall be in the midst of thee: and ye shall know that I [am] the LORD.

spare them as <u>39\_MAL\_03\_17</u> # And they shall be mine, saith the LORD of hosts, in that day when I make up my jewels; and I will spare them, as a man spareth his own son that serveth him.

spare them neither 24\_JER\_21\_07 # And afterward, saith the LORD, I will deliver Zedekiah king of Judah,

and his servants, and the people, and such as are left in this city from the pestilence, from the sword, and from the famine, into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon, and into the hand of their enemies, and into the hand of those that seek their life: and he shall smite them with the edge of the sword; he shall not spare them, neither have pity, nor have mercy.

spare them not <u>09\_1SA\_15\_03</u> # Now go and smite Amalek, and utterly destroy all that they have, and spare them not; but slay both man and woman, infant and suckling, ox and sheep, camel and ass.

Spare thy people <u>29\_JOE\_02\_17</u> # Let the priests, the ministers of the LORD, weep between the porch and the altar, and let them say, Spare thy people, O LORD, and give not thine heritage to reproach, that the heathen should rule over them: wherefore should they say among the people, Where [is] their God?

spare ye not <u>24\_JER\_51\_03</u># Against [him that] bendeth let the archer bend his bow, and against [him that] lifteth himself up in his brigandine: and spare ye not her young men; destroy ye utterly all her host.

spare you I <u>47\_2CO\_01\_23</u> # Moreover I call God for a record upon my soul, that to spare you I came not as yet unto Corinth.

spare you <u>46\_1CO\_07\_28</u># But and if thou marry, thou hast not sinned; and if a virgin marry, she hath not sinned. Nevertheless such shall have trouble in the flesh: but I spare you.

spare <u>47\_2CO\_13\_02</u> # I told you before, and foretell you, as if I were present, the second time; and being absent now I write to them which heretofore have sinned, and to all other, that, if I come again, I will not spare:

spared Agag and <u>09\_1SA\_15\_09</u> # But Saul and the people spared Agag, and the best of the sheep, and of the oxen, and of the fatlings, and the lambs, and all [that was] good, and would not utterly destroy them: but every thing [that was] vile and refuse, that they destroyed utterly.

spared Mephibosheth the <u>10\_2SA\_21\_07</u> # But the king spared Mephibosheth, the son of Jonathan the son of Saul, because of the LORD'S oath that [was] between them, between David and Jonathan the son of Saul.

spared Naaman this <u>12\_2KI\_05\_20</u> # But Gehazi, the servant of Elisha the man of God, said, Behold, my master hath spared Naaman this Syrian, in not receiving at his hands that which he brought: but, [as] the LORD liveth, I will run after him, and take somewhat of him.

spared not his <u>45\_ROM\_08\_32</u># He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?

spared not the <u>61\_2PE\_02\_04</u> # For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast [them] down to hell, and delivered [them] into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment;

spared not the <u>61\_2PE\_02\_05</u> # And spared not the old world, but saved Noah the eighth [person], a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood upon the world of the ungodly;

spared not the <u>45\_ROM\_11\_21</u># For if God spared not the natural branches, [take heed] lest he also spare not thee.

spared not their <u>19\_PSA\_78\_50</u># He made a way to his anger; he spared not their soul from death, but gave their life over to the pestilence;

spared the best <u>09\_1SA\_15\_15</u> # And Saul said, They have brought them from the Amalekites: for the people spared the best of the sheep and of the oxen, to sacrifice unto the LORD thy God; and the rest we have utterly destroyed.

spared thee and <u>09\_1SA\_24\_10</u> # Behold, this day thine eyes have seen how that the LORD had delivered thee to day into mine hand in the cave: and [some] bade [me] kill thee: but [mine eye] spared thee; and I said, I will not put forth mine hand against my lord; for he [is] the LORD'S anointed.

spared them from <u>26\_EZE\_20\_17</u># Nevertheless mine eye spared them from destroying them, neither did I make an end of them in the wilderness.

spared to take <u>10\_2SA\_12\_04</u> # And there came a traveller unto the rich man, and he spared to take of his own flock and of his own herd, to dress for the wayfaring man that was come unto him; but took the poor man's lamb, and dressed it for the man that was come to him.

spareth his own <u>39\_MAL\_03\_17</u> # And they shall be mine, saith the LORD of hosts, in that day when I make up my jewels; and I will spare them, as a man spareth his own son that serveth him.

spareth his rod <u>20\_PRO\_13\_24</u> # He that spareth his rod hateth his son: but he that loveth him chasteneth him betimes.

spareth his words 20\_PRO\_17\_27 # He that hath knowledge spareth his words: [and] a man of understanding is of an excellent spirit.

spareth not <u>20\_PRO\_21\_26</u># He coveteth greedily all the day long: but the righteous giveth and spareth not.

transparent glass <u>66\_REV\_21\_21</u> # And the twelve gates [were] twelve pearls: every several gate was of one pearl: and the street of the city [was] pure gold, as it were transparent glass.
