

KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

spared Agag and <u>09_1SA_15_09</u> # But Saul and the people spared Agag, and the best of the sheep, and of the oxen, and of the fatlings, and the lambs, and all [that was] good, and would not utterly destroy them: but every thing [that was] vile and refuse, that they destroyed utterly.

spared Mephibosheth the <u>10_2SA_21_07</u># But the king spared Mephibosheth, the son of Jonathan the son of Saul, because of the LORD'S oath that [was] between them, between David and Jonathan the son of Saul.

spared Naaman this <u>12_2KI_05_20</u># But Gehazi, the servant of Elisha the man of God, said, Behold, my master hath spared Naaman this Syrian, in not receiving at his hands that which he brought: but, [as] the LORD liveth, I will run after him, and take somewhat of him.

spared not his <u>45_ROM_08_32</u># He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?

spared not the <u>61_2PE_02_04</u> # For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast [them] down to hell, and delivered [them] into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment;

spared not the <u>61_2PE_02_05</u># And spared not the old world, but saved Noah the eighth [person], a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood upon the world of the ungodly;

spared not the <u>45_ROM_11_21</u># For if God spared not the natural branches, [take heed] lest he also spare not thee.

spared not their <u>19_PSA_78_50</u># He made a way to his anger; he spared not their soul from death, but gave their life over to the pestilence;

spared the best <u>09_1SA_15_15</u> # And Saul said, They have brought them from the Amalekites: for the people spared the best of the sheep and of the oxen, to sacrifice unto the LORD thy God; and the rest we have utterly destroyed.

spared thee and <u>09_1SA_24_10</u> # Behold, this day thine eyes have seen how that the LORD had delivered thee to day into mine hand in the cave: and [some] bade [me] kill thee: but [mine eye] spared thee; and I said, I will not put forth mine hand against my lord; for he [is] the LORD'S anointed.

spared them from <u>26_EZE_20_17</u> # Nevertheless mine eye spared them from destroying them, neither did I make an end of them in the wilderness.

spared to take <u>10_2SA_12_04</u> # And there came a traveller unto the rich man, and he spared to take of his own flock and of his own herd, to dress for the wayfaring man that was come unto him; but took the poor man's lamb, and dressed it for the man that was come to him.
