

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

spear against eight <u>10\_2SA\_23\_08</u># These [be] the names of the mighty men whom David had: The Tachmonite that sat in the seat, chief among the captains; the same [was] Adino the Eznite: [he lift up his spear] against eight hundred, whom he slew at one time.

spear against three <u>13\_1CH\_11\_11</u># And this [is] the number of the mighty men whom David had; Jashobeam, an Hachmonite, the chief of the captains: he lifted up his spear against three hundred slain [by him] at one time.

spear against three <u>13\_1CH\_11\_20</u># And Abishai the brother of Joab, he was chief of the three: for lifting up his spear against three hundred, he slew [them], and had a name among the three.

spear against three <u>10\_2SA\_23\_18</u># And Abishai, the brother of Joab, the son of Zeruiah, was chief among three. And he lifted up his spear against three hundred, [and] slew [them], and had the name among three.

spear and let <u>09\_18A\_26\_22</u># And David answered and said, Behold the king's spear! and let one of the young men come over and fetch it.

spear and lo <u>10\_2SA\_01\_06</u> # And the young man that told him said, As I happened by chance upon mount Gilboa, behold, Saul leaned upon his spear; and, lo, the chariots and horsemen followed hard after him.

spear and shield <u>14\_2CH\_25\_05</u> # Moreover Amaziah gathered Judah together, and made them captains over thousands, and captains over hundreds, according to the houses of [their] fathers, throughout all Judah and Benjamin: and he numbered them from twenty years old and above, and found them three hundred thousand choice [men, able] to go forth to war, that could handle spear and shield.

spear and stop <u>19\_PSA\_35\_03</u> # Draw out also the spear, and stop [the way] against them that persecute me: say unto my soul, I [am] thy salvation.

spear and the <u>09\_1SA\_26\_12</u># So David took the spear and the cruse of water from Saul's bolster; and they gat them away, and no man saw [it], nor knew [it], neither awaked: for they [were] all asleep; because a deep sleep from the LORD was fallen upon them.

spear and the <u>18\_JOB\_39\_23</u> # The quiver rattleth against him, the glittering spear and the shield.

spear and there <u>34\_NAH\_03\_03</u> # The horseman lifteth up both the bright sword and the glittering spear: and [there is] a multitude of slain, and a great number of carcases; and [there is] none end of [their] corpses; they stumble upon their corpses:

spear and they <u>10\_28A\_23\_07</u># But the man [that] shall touch them must be fenced with iron and the staff of a spear; and they shall be utterly burned with fire in the [same] place.

spear and with <u>09\_1SA\_17\_45</u># Then said David to the Philistine, Thou comest to me with a sword, and with a spear, and with a shield: but I come to thee in the name of the LORD of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel, whom thou hast defied.

spear came out <u>10\_2SA\_02\_23</u> # Howbeit he refused to turn aside: wherefore Abner with the hinder end of the spear smote him under the fifth [rib], that the spear came out behind him; and he fell down there, and died in the same place: and it came to pass, [that] as many as came to the place where Asahel fell down and

died stood still.

spear even to <u>09\_1SA\_26\_08</u># Then said Abishai to David, God hath delivered thine enemy into thine hand this day: now therefore let me smite him, I pray thee, with the spear even to the earth at once, and I will not [smite] him the second time.

spear for the <u>09\_1SA\_17\_47</u># And all this assembly shall know that the LORD saveth not with sword and spear: for the battle [is] the LORD's, and he will give you into our hands.

spear found in <u>09\_18A\_13\_22</u># So it came to pass in the day of battle, that there was neither sword nor spear found in the hand of any of the people that [were] with Saul and Jonathan: but with Saul and with Jonathan his son was there found.

spear in his <u>09\_1SA\_22\_06</u># When Saul heard that David was discovered, and the men that [were] with him, [now Saul abode in Gibeah under a tree in Ramah, having his spear in his hand, and all his servants [were] standing about him;]

spear in his <u>10\_2SA\_23\_21</u> # And he slew an Egyptian, a goodly man: and the Egyptian had a spear in his hand; but he went down to him with a staff, and plucked the spear out of the Egyptian's hand, and slew him with his own spear.

spear in sunder <u>19\_PSA\_46\_09</u> # He maketh wars to cease unto the end of the earth; he breaketh the bow, and cutteth the spear in sunder; he burneth the chariot in the fire.

spear is and <u>09\_1SA\_26\_16</u># This thing [is] not good that thou hast done. [As] the LORD liveth, ye [are] worthy to die, because ye have not kept your master, the LORD'S anointed. And now see where the king's spear [is], and the cruse of water that [was] at his bolster.

spear staff was <u>13\_1CH\_20\_05</u># And there was war again with the Philistines; and Elhanan the son of Jair slew Lahmi the brother of Goliath the Gittite, whose spear staff [was] like a weaver's beam.

spear stuck in <u>09\_1SA\_26\_07</u># So David and Abishai came to the people by night: and, behold, Saul lay sleeping within the trench, and his spear stuck in the ground at his bolster: but Abner and the people lay round about him.

spear that he <u>06\_JOS\_08\_18</u># And the LORD said unto Joshua, Stretch out the spear that [is] in thy hand toward Ai; for I will give it into thine hand. And Joshua stretched out the spear that [he had] in his hand toward the city.

spear that is <u>09\_1SA\_26\_11</u># The LORD forbid that I should stretch forth mine hand against the LORD'S anointed: but, I pray thee, take thou now the spear that [is] at his bolster, and the cruse of water, and let us go.

spear that is <u>06\_JOS\_08\_18</u> # And the LORD said unto Joshua, Stretch out the spear that [is] in thy hand toward Ai; for I will give it into thine hand. And Joshua stretched out the spear that [he had] in his hand toward the city.

spear the dart <u>18\_JOB\_41\_26</u># The sword of him that layeth at him cannot hold: the spear, the dart, nor the habergeon.

spear they are <u>24\_JER\_06\_23</u># They shall lay hold on bow and spear; they [are] cruel, and have no mercy; their voice roareth like the sea; and they ride upon horses, set in array as men for war against thee, O daughter of Zion.

spear thirty and <u>13\_1CH\_12\_34</u> # And of Naphtali a thousand captains, and with them with shield and spear thirty and seven thousand.

spear until he <u>06\_JOS\_08\_26</u># For Joshua drew not his hand back, wherewith he stretched out the spear, until he had utterly destroyed all the inhabitants of Ai.

spear was like <u>09\_1SA\_17\_07</u># And the staff of his spear [was] like a weaver's beam; and his spear's head [weighed] six hundred shekels of iron: and one bearing a shield went before him.

spear was like <u>10\_2SA\_21\_19</u> # And there was again a battle in Gob with the Philistines, where Elhanan the son of Jaareoregim, a Bethlehemite, slew [the brother of] Goliath the Gittite, the staff of whose spear [was] like a weaver's beam.

spear weighed three <u>10\_2SA\_21\_16</u> # And Ishbibenob, which [was] of the sons of the giant, the weight of whose spear [weighed] three hundred [shekels] of brass in weight, he being girded with a new [sword], thought to have slain David.

spear were six <u>13\_1CH\_12\_24</u># The children of Judah that bare shield and spear [were] six thousand and eight hundred, ready armed to the war.

spear <u>13\_1CH\_11\_23</u># And he slew an Egyptian, a man of [great] stature, five cubits high; and in the Egyptian's hand [was] a spear like a weaver's beam; and he went down to him with a staff, and plucked the spear out of the Egyptian's hand, and slew him with his own spear.

spear <u>10\_28A\_23\_21</u># And he slew an Egyptian, a goodly man: and the Egyptian had a spear in his hand; but he went down to him with a staff, and plucked the spear out of the Egyptian's hand, and slew him with his own spear.

spear <u>35\_HAB\_03\_11</u># The sun [and] moon stood still in their habitation: at the light of thine arrows they

spear <u>18\_JOB\_41\_29</u> # Darts are counted as stubble: he laugheth at the shaking of a spear.

spear's head weighed <u>09\_1SA\_17\_07</u># And the staff of his spear [was] like a weaver's beam; and his spear's head [weighed] six hundred shekels of iron: and one bearing a shield went before him.

spearmen the multitude <u>19\_PSA\_68\_30</u> # Rebuke the company of spearmen, the multitude of the bulls, with the calves of the people, [till every one] submit himself with pieces of silver: scatter thou the people [that] delight in war.

spearmen two hundred <u>44\_ACT\_23\_23</u> # And he called unto [him] two centurions, saying, Make ready two hundred soldiers to go to Caesarea, and horsemen threescore and ten, and spearmen two hundred, at the third hour of the night;

spears and arrows <u>19\_PSA\_57\_04</u> # My soul [is] among lions: [and] I lie [even among] them that are set on fire, [even] the sons of men, whose teeth [are] spears and arrows, and their tongue a sharp sword.

spears and bucklers <u>14\_2CH\_23\_09</u> # Moreover Jehoiada the priest delivered to the captains of hundreds spears, and bucklers, and shields, that [had been] king David's, which [were] in the house of God.

spears and helmets <u>14\_2CH\_26\_14</u> # And Uzziah prepared for them throughout all the host shields, and spears, and helmets, and habergeons, and bows, and slings [to cast] stones.

spears and made <u>14\_2CH\_11\_12</u># And in every several city [he put] shields and spears, and made them exceeding strong, having Judah and Benjamin on his side.

spears and put <u>24\_JER\_46\_04</u> # Harness the horses; and get up, ye horsemen, and stand forth with [your] helmets; furbish the spears, [and] put on the brigandines.

spears and shields <u>12\_2KI\_11\_10</u># And to the captains over hundreds did the priest give king David's spears and shields, that [were] in the temple of the LORD.

spears and their <u>16\_NEH\_04\_13</u> # Therefore set I in the lower places behind the wall, [and] on the higher places, I even set the people after their families with their swords, their spears, and their bows.

spears and they <u>26\_EZE\_39\_09</u> # And they that dwell in the cities of Israel shall go forth, and shall set on fire and burn the weapons, both the shields and the bucklers, the bows and the arrows, and the handstaves, and the spears, and they shall burn them with fire seven years:

spears from the <u>16\_NEH\_04\_21</u># So we laboured in the work: and half of them held the spears from the rising of the morning till the stars appeared.

spears into pruninghooks <u>33\_MIC\_04\_03</u> # And he shall judge among many people, and rebuke strong nations afar off; and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruninghooks: nation shall not lift up a sword against nation, neither shall they learn war any more.

spears let the <u>29\_JOE\_03\_10</u># Beat your plowshares into swords, and your pruninghooks into spears: let the weak say, I [am] strong.

spears out of <u>14\_2CH\_14\_08</u># And Asa had an army [of men] that bare targets and spears, out of Judah

three hundred thousand; and out of Benjamin, that bare shields and drew bows, two hundred and fourscore thousand: all these [were] mighty men of valour.

spears the shields <u>16\_NEH\_04\_16</u># And it came to pass from that time forth, [that] the half of my servants wrought in the work, and the other half of them held both the spears, the shields, and the bows, and the habergeons; and the rulers [were] behind all the house of Judah.

spears <u>09\_1SA\_13\_19</u># Now there was no smith found throughout all the land of Israel: for the Philistines said, Lest the Hebrews make [them] swords or spears:

spears <u>18\_JOB\_41\_07</u># Canst thou fill his skin with barbed irons? or his head with fish spears?
