spoil all that [24_JER_50_10](#) # And Chaldea shall be a spoil: all that spoil her shall be satisfied, saith the LORD.

spoil all the [24_JER_47_04](#) # Because of the day that cometh to spoil all the Philistines, [and] to cut off from Tyrus and Zidon every helper that remaineth: for the LORD will spoil the Philistines, the remnant of the country of Caphtor.

spoil and all [24_JER_30_16](#) # Therefore all they that devour thee shall be devoured; and all thine adversaries, every one of them, shall go into captivity; and they that spoil thee shall be a spoil, and all that prey upon thee will I give for a prey.
