spoil all that <u>24\_JER\_50\_10</u> # And Chaldea shall be a spoil: all that spoil her shall be satisfied, saith the LORD.

spoil all the <u>24\_JER\_47\_04</u># Because of the day that cometh to spoil all the Philistines, [and] to cut off from Tyrus and Zidon every helper that remaineth: for the LORD will spoil the Philistines, the remnant of the country of Caphtor.

spoil and all <u>24\_JER\_30\_16</u># Therefore all they that devour thee shall be devoured; and all thine adversaries, every one of them, shall go into captivity; and they that spoil thee shall be a spoil, and all that prey upon thee will I give for a prey.

spoil and all <u>04\_NUM\_31\_11</u># And they took all the spoil, and all the prey, [both] of men and of beasts.

spoil and didst <u>09\_1SA\_15\_19</u># Wherefore then didst thou not obey the voice of the LORD, but didst fly upon the spoil, and didst evil in the sight of the LORD?

spoil and execute <u>26\_EZE\_45\_09</u># Thus saith the Lord GOD; Let it suffice you, O princes of Israel: remove violence and spoil, and execute judgment and justice, take away your exactions from my people, saith the Lord GOD.

spoil his goods <u>40\_MAT\_12\_29</u># Or else how can one enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he first bind the strong man? and then he will spoil his house.

spoil his house <u>41\_MAR\_03\_27</u> # No man can enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he will first bind the strong man; and then he will spoil his house.

spoil his house <u>40\_MAT\_12\_29</u># Or else how can one enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he first bind the strong man? and then he will spoil his house.

spoil his labour <u>19\_PSA\_109\_11</u># Let the extortioner catch all that he hath; and let the strangers spoil his labour.

spoil in them <u>14\_2CH\_14\_14</u> # And they smote all the cities round about Gerar; for the fear of the LORD came upon them: and they spoiled all the cities; for there was exceeding much spoil in them.

spoil is heard <u>24\_JER\_06\_07</u> # As a fountain casteth out her waters, so she casteth out her wickedness: violence and spoil is heard in her; before me continually [is] grief and wounds.

spoil of silver 34\_NAH\_02\_09 # Take ye the spoil of silver, take the spoil of gold: for [there is] none end of the store [and] glory out of all the pleasant furniture.

spoil of that <u>06\_JOS\_08\_27</u> # Only the cattle and the spoil of that city Israel took for a prey unto themselves, according unto the word of the LORD which he commanded Joshua.

spoil of the <u>09\_1SA\_30\_26</u> # And when David came to Ziklag, he sent of the spoil unto the elders of Judah, [even] to his friends, saying, Behold a present for you of the spoil of the enemies of the LORD;
