spoiled a voice <u>38\_ZEC\_11\_03</u># [There is] a voice of the howling of the shepherds; for their glory is spoiled: a voice of the roaring of young lions; for the pride of Jordan is spoiled.

spoiled against the <u>30\_AMO\_05\_09</u> # That strengtheneth the spoiled against the strong, so that the spoiled shall come against the fortress.

spoiled all the <u>14\_2CH\_14\_14</u># And they smote all the cities round about Gerar; for the fear of the LORD came upon them: and they spoiled all the cities; for there was exceeding much spoil in them.

spoiled and all <u>24\_JER\_10\_20</u> # My tabernacle is spoiled, and all my cords are broken: my children are gone forth of me, and they [are] not: [there is] none to stretch forth my tent any more, and to set up my curtains.

spoiled and dealest <u>23\_ISA\_33\_01</u># Woe to thee that spoilest, and thou [wast] not spoiled; and dealest treacherously, and they dealt not treacherously with thee! when thou shalt cease to spoil, thou shalt be spoiled; [and] when thou shalt make an end to deal treacherously, they shall deal treacherously with thee.

spoiled and gone 24\_JER\_48\_15 # Moab is spoiled, and gone up [out of] her cities, and his chosen young men are gone down to the slaughter, saith the King, whose name [is] the LORD of hosts.

spoiled and his <u>24\_JER\_49\_10</u> # But I have made Esau bare, I have uncovered his secret places, and he shall not be able to hide himself: his seed is spoiled, and his brethren, and his neighbours, and he [is] not.

spoiled and maketh 18\_JOB\_12\_17\_# He leadeth counsellors away spoiled, and maketh the judges fools.

spoiled and my <u>24\_JER\_04\_20</u> # Destruction upon destruction is cried; for the whole land is spoiled: suddenly are my tents spoiled, [and] my curtains in a moment.

spoiled and overthroweth 18\_JOB\_12\_19 # He leadeth princes away spoiled, and overthroweth the mighty.

spoiled and their <u>23\_ISA\_13\_16</u># Their children also shall be dashed to pieces before their eyes; their houses shall be spoiled, and their wives ravished.

spoiled and when <u>23\_ISA\_33\_01</u> # Woe to thee that spoilest, and thou [wast] not spoiled; and dealest treacherously, and they dealt not treacherously with thee! when thou shalt cease to spoil, thou shalt be spoiled; [and] when thou shalt make an end to deal treacherously, they shall deal treacherously with thee.

spoiled as Shalman <u>28\_HOS\_10\_14</u># Therefore shall a tumult arise among thy people, and all thy fortresses shall be spoiled, as Shalman spoiled Betharbel in the day of battle: the mother was dashed in pieces upon [her] children.

spoiled Babylon and <u>24\_JER\_51\_55</u># Because the LORD hath spoiled Babylon, and destroyed out of her the great voice; when her waves do roar like great waters, a noise of their voice is uttered:

spoiled Betharbel in <u>28\_HOS\_10\_14</u># Therefore shall a tumult arise among thy people, and all thy fortresses shall be spoiled, as Shalman spoiled Betharbel in the day of battle: the mother was dashed in pieces upon [her] children.

spoiled by violence <u>26\_EZE\_18\_12</u> # Hath oppressed the poor and needy, hath spoiled by violence, hath not restored the pledge, and hath lifted up his eyes to the idols, hath committed abomination,

spoiled by violence <u>26\_EZE\_18\_16</u># Neither hath oppressed any, hath not withholden the pledge, neither hath spoiled by violence, [but] hath given his bread to the hungry, and hath covered the naked with a garment,

spoiled cry ye <u>24\_JER\_49\_03</u># Howl, O Heshbon, for Ai is spoiled: cry, ye daughters of Rabbah, gird you with sackcloth; lament, and run to and fro by the hedges; for their king shall go into captivity, [and] his priests and his princes together.

spoiled even all <u>01\_GEN\_34\_29</u> # And all their wealth, and all their little ones, and their wives took they captive, and spoiled even all that [was] in the house.

spoiled evermore and <u>05\_DEU\_28\_29</u># And thou shalt grope at noonday, as the blind gropeth in darkness, and thou shalt not prosper in thy ways: and thou shalt be only oppressed and spoiled evermore, and no man shall save [thee].

spoiled for the <u>23\_ISA\_24\_03</u> # The land shall be utterly emptied, and utterly spoiled: for the LORD hath spoken this word.

spoiled he hath <u>33 MIC\_02\_04</u># In that day shall [one] take up a parable against you, and lament with a doleful lamentation, [and] say, We be utterly spoiled: he hath changed the portion of my people: how hath he removed [it] from me! turning away he hath divided our fields.

spoiled his brother <u>26\_EZE\_18\_18</u> # [As for] his father, because he cruelly oppressed, spoiled his brother by violence, and did [that] which [is] not good among his people, lo, even he shall die in his iniquity.

spoiled howl O <u>38\_ZEC\_11\_02</u># Howl, fir tree; for the cedar is fallen; because the mighty are spoiled: howl, O ye oaks of Bashan; for the forest of the vintage is come down.

spoiled Kiriathaim is <u>24\_JER\_48\_01</u> # Against Moab thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Woe unto Nebo! for it is spoiled: Kiriathaim is confounded [and] taken: Misgab is confounded and dismayed.

spoiled many nations <u>35\_HAB\_02\_08</u># Because thou hast spoiled many nations, all the remnant of the people shall spoil thee; because of men's blood, and [for] the violence of the land, of the city, and of all that dwell therein.

spoiled none by <u>26\_EZE\_18\_07</u> # And hath not oppressed any, [but] hath restored to the debtor his pledge, hath spoiled none by violence, hath given his bread to the hungry, and hath covered the naked with a garment;

spoiled out of <u>24\_JER\_21\_12</u># O house of David, thus saith the LORD; Execute judgment in the morning, and deliver [him that is] spoiled out of the hand of the oppressor, lest my fury go out like fire, and burn that none can quench [it], because of the evil of your doings.

spoiled out of <u>24\_JER\_22\_03</u> # Thus saith the LORD; Execute ye judgment and righteousness, and deliver the spoiled out of the hand of the oppressor: and do no wrong, do no violence to the stranger, the fatherless, nor the widow, neither shed innocent blood in this place.

spoiled principalities and <u>51\_COL\_02\_15</u># [And] having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a show of them openly, triumphing over them in it.

spoiled shall come <u>30\_AMO\_05\_09</u># That strengtheneth the spoiled against the strong, so that the spoiled shall come against the fortress.

spoiled suddenly are <u>24\_JER\_04\_20</u> # Destruction upon destruction is cried; for the whole land is spoiled: suddenly are my tents spoiled, [and] my curtains in a moment.

spoiled the city <u>01\_GEN\_34\_27</u># The sons of Jacob came upon the slain, and spoiled the city, because they had defiled their sister.

spoiled the Egyptians <u>02\_EXO\_12\_36</u># And the LORD gave the people favour in the sight of the Egyptians, so that they lent unto them [such things as they required]. And they spoiled the Egyptians.

spoiled the tents <u>12 2KI 07 16</u> # And the people went out, and spoiled the tents of the Syrians. So a measure of fine flour was [sold] for a shekel, and two measures of barley for a shekel, according to the word of the LORD.

spoiled their pasture 24\_JER\_25\_36 # A voice of the cry of the shepherds, and an howling of the principal of the flock, [shall be heard]: for the LORD hath spoiled their pasture.

spoiled their tents <u>09\_1SA\_17\_53</u> # And the children of Israel returned from chasing after the Philistines, and they spoiled their tents.

spoiled them and <u>26\_EZE\_39\_10</u># So that they shall take no wood out of the field, neither cut down [any] out of the forests; for they shall burn the weapons with fire: and they shall spoil those that spoiled them, and rob those that robbed them, saith the Lord GOD.

spoiled them and <u>07\_JUD\_02\_14</u># And the anger of the LORD was hot against Israel, and he delivered them into the hands of spoilers that spoiled them, and he sold them into the hands of their enemies round about, so that they could not any longer stand before their enemies.

spoiled them <u>09\_1SA\_14\_48</u># And he gathered an host, and smote the Amalekites, and delivered Israel out of the hands of them that spoiled them.

spoiled them <u>07\_JUD\_02\_16</u> # Nevertheless the LORD raised up judges, which delivered them out of the hand of those that spoiled them.

spoiled them <u>20\_PRO\_22\_23</u># For the LORD will plead their cause, and spoil the soul of those that spoiled them.

spoiled they are <u>23\_ISA\_42\_22</u># But this [is] a people robbed and spoiled; [they are] all of them snared in holes, and they are hid in prison houses: they are for a prey, and none delivereth; for a spoil, and none saith, Restore.

spoiled they have 19\_PSA\_76\_05 # The stouthearted are spoiled, they have slept their sleep: and none of the men of might have found their hands.

spoiled to the <u>23\_ISA\_18\_07</u> # In that time shall the present be brought unto the LORD of hosts of a people scattered and peeled, and from a people terrible from their beginning hitherto; a nation meted out and trodden under foot, whose land the rivers have spoiled, to the place of the name of the LORD of hosts, the mount Zion.

spoiled we are <u>24\_JER\_09\_19</u> # For a voice of wailing is heard out of Zion, How are we spoiled! we are greatly confounded, because we have forsaken the land, because our dwellings have cast [us] out.

spoiled what wilt 24 JER\_04\_30 # And [when] thou [art] spoiled, what wilt thou do? Though thou clothest thyself with crimson, though thou deckest thee with ornaments of gold, though thou rentest thy face with painting, in vain shalt thou make thyself fair; [thy] lovers will despise thee, they will seek thy life.

spoiled you for <u>38\_ZEC\_02\_08</u># For thus saith the LORD of hosts; After the glory hath he sent me unto the nations which spoiled you: for he that toucheth you toucheth the apple of his eye.

spoiled <u>30\_AMO\_03\_11</u># Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; An adversary [there shall be] even round about the land; and he shall bring down thy strength from thee, and thy palaces shall be spoiled.

spoiled <u>26\_EZE\_23\_46</u># For thus saith the Lord GOD; I will bring up a company upon them, and will give them to be removed and spoiled.

spoiled <u>23\_ISA\_18\_02</u> # That sendeth ambassadors by the sea, even in vessels of bulrushes upon the waters, [saying], Go, ye swift messengers, to a nation scattered and peeled, to a people terrible from their beginning hitherto; a nation meted out and trodden down, whose land the rivers have spoiled!

spoiled 24\_JER\_02\_14 # [Is] Israel a servant? [is] he a homeborn [slave]? why is he spoiled?

spoiled <u>24\_JER\_04\_13</u> # Behold, he shall come up as clouds, and his chariots [shall be] as a whirlwind: his horses are swifter than eagles. Woe unto us! for we are spoiled.

spoiled **24\_JER\_48\_20** # Moab is confounded; for it is broken down: howl and cry; tell ye it in Arnon, that Moab is spoiled,
