spreadeth a net 20\_PRO\_29\_05 # A man that flattereth his neighbour spreadeth a net for his feet.

spreadeth abroad her <u>05\_DEU\_32\_11</u># As an eagle stirreth up her nest, fluttereth over her young, spreadeth abroad her wings, taketh them, beareth them on her wings:

spreadeth abroad the <u>23\_ISA\_44\_24</u> # Thus saith the LORD, thy redeemer, and he that formed thee from the womb, I [am] the LORD that maketh all [things]; that stretcheth forth the heavens alone; that spreadeth abroad the earth by myself;

spreadeth forth her <u>25\_LAM\_01\_17</u> # Zion spreadeth forth her hands, [and there is] none to comfort her: the LORD hath commanded concerning Jacob, [that] his adversaries [should be] round about him: Jerusalem is as a menstruous woman among them.

spreadeth forth his <u>23\_ISA\_25\_11</u># And he shall spread forth his hands in the midst of them, as he that swimmeth spreadeth forth [his hands] to swim: and he shall bring down their pride together with the spoils of their hands.

spreadeth her hands <u>24\_JER\_04\_31</u># For I have heard a voice as of a woman in travail, [and] the anguish as of her that bringeth forth her first child, the voice of the daughter of Zion, [that] bewaileth herself, [that] spreadeth her hands, [saying], Woe [is] me now! for my soul is wearied because of murderers.

spreadeth his cloud <u>18\_JOB\_26\_09</u># He holdeth back the face of his throne, [and] spreadeth his cloud upon it.

spreadeth his light <u>18\_JOB\_36\_30</u># Behold, he spreadeth his light upon it, and covereth the bottom of the sea.

spreadeth in the <u>03\_LEV\_13\_08</u># And [if] the priest see that, behold, the scab spreadeth in the skin, then the priest shall pronounce him unclean: it [is] a leprosy.

spreadeth it over <u>23\_ISA\_40\_19</u># The workman melteth a graven image, and the goldsmith spreadeth it over with gold, and casteth silver chains.

spreadeth out her <u>24\_JER\_17\_08</u># For he shall be as a tree planted by the waters, and [that] spreadeth out her roots by the river, and shall not see when heat cometh, but her leaf shall be green; and shall not be careful in the year of drought, neither shall cease from yielding fruit.

spreadeth out the <u>18\_JOB\_09\_08</u> # Which alone spreadeth out the heavens, and treadeth upon the waves of the sea.

spreadeth sharp pointed <u>18\_JOB\_41\_30</u> # Sharp stones [are] under him: he spreadeth sharp pointed things upon the mire.

spreadeth them out <u>23\_ISA\_40\_22</u> # [It is] he that sitteth upon the circle of the earth, and the inhabitants thereof [are] as grasshoppers; that stretcheth out the heavens as a curtain, and spreadeth them out as a tent to dwell in:
